To Concert Woes, Add Sales/Pricing Issues

Multi-act listener appreciation concerts remain a staple for most stations, despite challenges that include rising production and talent costs, difficulty in securing headline-worthy acts, competition from big tours, and, for at least some of the shows, declining ticket sales.

While many of the concerts are free, a number of PDs who are in the ticket-selling business in several formats are suddenly facing soft sales. While others say their shows are selling just fine, the debate over how and whether to do station shows continues.

Three days before WMIL Milwaukee's June 8 Country Fest, PD Kerry Wolfe reported that only 2,600 tickets had been sold, significantly less than the 7,500-ticket target, despite a strong lineup that included Lonestar and Tracy Byrd.

The station gave away as many of the remaining tickets as it could, with Wolfe joking about on-air prompts where "the next 50 people who call [win] a family reunion for 50 at Country Fest."

With soft sales, the station didn't even come close to recouping the \$100,000 it paid in talent fees, something Wolfe says has never happened before at the annual show. In the past, he says, "we've had lesser-known acts sell more tickets." This year, he adds, "we could have made the show free with much more success."

One problem is that two other big, multi-act concert tours—headlined by Kenny Chesney and Brooks & Dunn—are also coming through town within a week of each other this summer. Those shows, Wolfe says, have already sold about 11,000 tickets each. But he also thinks "the economy has something to do with it," noting that his jocks talked to many listeners who would like to come to Country Fest but can't afford it this year, despite

Radio Split On Playing R. Kelly

Will radio continue to play R. Kelly records, now that the format's core artist has officially been charged with 21 counts of child pornography? The answers are mixed from format to format, with mainstream R&B radio still taking a wait-and-see attitude. But other formats are responding more negatively. Consultant McVay Media has sent a memo to its AC clients recommending they pull the song "I Believe I Can Fly" and any other Kelly songs from their music library after the singer was indicted and arrested last week. In Chicago, Kelly's home town, rhythmic top 40 WBBM (B96) has banned Kelly's music as well. And according to *The Detroit News*, top 40 WKQI PD Dom Theodore believes "R. Kelly is not an artist we can support right now."

R&B *Airplay Monitor* polled R&B programmers and managers—as well as several who have been quoted in newspapers around the country—as to whether they will continue to play Kelly's songs despite his current legal troubles. WJLB PD K.J. Holiday is still playing Kelly. He was also quoted in the *Detroit News* article, saying, "What we're hearing from the listeners is that the case isn't affecting what they think of his songs." Judy Ellis, VP/GM of Emmis/New York, told the city's *Newsday* that her adult R&B WRKS and WQHT (Hot 97) stations would continue to play Kelly's music, adding, "As far as I remember, the people in this country are innocent until proven guilty."

At WGCI-FM Chicago, which aired a prerecorded message from Kelly denying the allegations several months ago, OM Elroy Smith says his station will be sensitive to which songs it plays but will not stop playing all of Kelly's records. "A song like 'Feelin' on Yo Booty' is probably inappropriate at this time, but we'll continue to air songs, such as 'I Wish' and others. The majority of listeners have told us they want to continue to hear his music on WGCI." And in response to cross-

town B96's reaction, Smith says, "Most top 40 stations only play two to three Kelly songs, so for them it wouldn't hurt them to pull those tracks, and they get a lot of publicity out of it. For us, he's still a core artist."

MANAGEMENT: JONES LOVE

WJLB/adult R&B WMXD Detroit taps Earl Jones as GM, replacing Terry Arnold. A former Atlanta Falcons player, Jones was GSM at sports outlet WGST and the Georgia News Network, as well as director of sports marketing for the Atlanta Falcons' Radio Network in Atlanta.

Clear Channel/Savannah, Ga., market manager Jerry Stevens exits the cluster, where he oversaw WQBT (the Beat) and adult R&B WLVI, among others.

Michael Mallace is named GM of R&B oldies KAJM/classic rock KAZL Phoenix. He replaces the stations' owner, Ken Brentlinger, who remains with the company.

PROGRAMMING: LYLES LOVE

Consultant Harry Lyles picks up Citadel as a client, working with the company's R&B and gospel stations.

Consultancy PriceChampion Communications is set to launch the syndicated gospel program *Joyfulnoyze*. The show originally aired on CFXJ (the Flow) Toronto, where PriceChampion principle Michelle Price was previously PD. Price is also seeking gospel service mailed to her attention at 2800 Old Dawson Road, Suite 2, No. 159, Albany, Ga., 31707.

FORMATS: DENVER DANCING

After stunting for several days, R&B KXUU (U92) Denver flipped to dance-driven rhythmic top 40 as KXDC (102.1X), under the direction of consultant Bill Tanner. The station is currently running jockless.

WHVL Savannah, Ga., flips to network sports. The station also picks up heritage area call letters WSGA. All staffers, including PD L. Boogie, exited in the months prior to the format flip.

He Can Have 'Anything' . . . Eventually

Jaheim Featuring Next's "Anything" (Divine Mill/Warner Bros.) reaches No. 1 in its 30th week on the adult R&B chart. Until now, the longest trip to the top was in February 1997, when "Tears" by the Isley Brothers needed 29 weeks. No other R&B *Airplay Monitor* chart has seen a song take as long to reach the top.

"Anything" is the first No. 1 for Jaheim, whose last single, "Just in Case," peaked at No. 6. It's also a first No. 1 at adult R&B for Next. The act is now signed to J Records, which controls the remainder of the chart's top three with Angie Stone's "Wish I Didn't Miss You" and Luther Vandross' "I'd Rather."

At the other end of the adult R&B chart, Cooly's Hot Box debuts at No. 40 with "It's Alright" (OmTown/Virgin). The first single from the quartet's debut album, *Take It*, is ranked No. 5 at WHUR Washington, D.C. Lead singer Angela Johnson had success as a solo artist with "Ordinary Things," which landed on the *Billboard* Hot R&B/Hip-Hop Singles & Tracks chart last February.

Cam'ron earns his first mainstream R&B No. 1 with "Oh Boy" (Roc-a-fella/Def Jam/IDJMG). The track features Juelz Santana and eclipses "Addictive" (Aftermath/Interscope) by Truth Hurts Featuring Rakim for the top spot. "Addictive" retains its bullet despite the downward movement and decrease in spins since the percentage decrease does not exceed the overall downtime percentage for the format. "Oh Boy" also moves 3-1 on the crossover chart, where "Addictive" slips 1-3 and retains its bullet. Ninety spins separate "Oh Boy" from Nelly's "Hot in Herre" (Fo' Reel/Universal), which advances 4-2 on the crossover chart.

is looking for an air talent who can take over afternoons from Elektra artist Lil' Mo. The singer is going on maternity leave and completing work on her sophomore set.

Former WQHT (Hot 97) New York morning co-host Missjones joins the syndicated *AllStar Mix Party*, along with DJ Bent Rock and Big Les.

WBWT (the Beat) Tallahassee, Fla., midlayer Rasha adds MD duties.

WIZF (the Wiz) Cincinnati nights are still open. While PD "Hurricane" Dave Smith says P/T Bill Greg has the inside track at this time, he's still accepting T&Rs.

WKKV (V100) Milwaukee mixer Tony Neal joins Superadio's Supersquad of syndicated mix DJs.

WCHH Charlotte, N.C., taps Shaggy for production from crosstown country WKKT, where he held the same position.

WHBX Tallahassee, Fla., night jock Dallas Scott exits. He's returning to his hometown of Minneapolis.

WKPO Madison, Wis., MD/morning host Latone Hart heads to KTCX Beaumont, Texas, for nights, replacing Munah.

Radio and label veteran Jacque Gonzales James begins the next chapter of her career as an on-air host on cable's QVC home shopping channel.

MORE ONLINE LISTENERS, FEWER STATIONS

A report by Internet ratings-measurement company MeasureCast shows that during May, Internet radio listening increased by 400,000, with 4.3 million listeners, up from 3.9 million in April. However, those people are listening to fewer stations, as the company surveyed 1,351 stations in April but 1,294 outlets in May.

UPCOMING SEMINARS

Not many of today's radio executives started in programming, but next month's Conclave conference in Minneapolis hopes to shift those numbers as it hosts "So, You Wanna Be the GM?" The session is designed to show PDs the path to the GM seat. The panel will feature four former PDs who currently function in a GM or higher capacity: Emmis' Rick Cummings, Susquehanna's Dan Halyburton, and Clear Channel's John Gehron and Lee Clear.

that all but a handful of premium tickets sold for a relatively low price of \$15 or \$30.

Adult R&B WHQT (Hot 105) Miami dropped its annual Hits and Oldies Family Reunion two years ago. "Even though it was very well-received by listeners [drawing 70,000 in 2000], it wasn't profitable enough to continue," PD Derrick Brown says. To resume the shows, he says, the station would have to sell tickets and have a lineup that merits charging \$10-\$15. More important, "we'd have to see a title sponsor kick in \$50,000-\$60,000 up front, and in these economic times, that's hard to find. Also, we would have to look at how we deal with vendors. In the past, we had them pay a flat-rate fee, like a couple hundred dollars, yet they would walk away with bags of money—\$9,000-\$10,000 for the day."

Country WBCT Grand Rapids, Mich., has found a way to make money from its June 22 B93 Birthday Bash, despite giving away the tickets. Doug Montgomery, director of FM programming for Clear Channel/Grand Rapids, says B93 will make "six figures" in merchandise sales alone in the month of June, much of it at the show, which draws 60,000-80,000 fans each year.

COMPETING FOR ACTS

Among the most commonly cited challenges in producing station shows are the inability to secure headlining acts—many of which are doing their own tours during the summer—and the difficulty in competing with the big package tours that are coming through town.

Some major-market R&B station concerts are already sold out, including WQHT (Hot 97) New York's June 26 Summer Jam and WJMN (Jam'n 94.5) Boston's June 29 Summer Jam. But as WHRK (K97) Memphis promotions director Frank Gilbert notes, those stations "are the ones who can get the big acts."

Top 40 WKSS Hartford, Conn., promotion director Gregdog sees problems on the horizon with more and more package tours slated for summer. The Anger Management tour and the Pop Disaster tour are "coming in one after the other." To avoid seeming mundane by comparison, "we took some artists that were in this area anyway and we packaged it together, called it Pop Divas Live, and presented an all-female lineup. We tried to theme it differently instead of the 'Kiss 95.7 Show.'"

Top 40 WDRQ Detroit PD Alex Tear agrees that "there are so many superstar acts out there touring that it's very competitive" and cites an increasing number of package tours, along the line of Moby's Area2 festival. "The average DRQ concertgoer only hits two to three shows a year. It's just the reality."

WBLS New York promotion director Tina Nachman believes fans are losing interest in multi-act shows overall. "Back in December, [New York's] *Daily News* did a story comparing all the radio station Christmas shows [in the city]. It said they all sold poorly and that listeners [who were] interviewed said they didn't want to see these 'laundry list of artists' concerts anymore. They're just not entertaining," she says. "The shows that sell out are the ones geared to a 12-24 audience. The adult audience would rather see their favorite artist perform an entire show, rather than 10 acts doing one or two songs to track. That's why so many station concert shows are having a hard time."

Some PDs are hoping to build station shows that transcend their lineup, such as top 40 KMXV Kansas City OM Jon Zellner. "Stations need to sell these concerts more as events and less as concerts," he says. "Otherwise, people are not going to buy the ticket." Zellner's Red, White & Boom is almost sold out. "That has as much to do with the branding of the show as the lineup."

At Radio One/Detroit's R&B cluster, promotion and marketing director Vicki Preston prefers to partner with existing concerts. "That way, we brand ourselves with the hottest shows. Not only do we get a promotional value out of it, we also still get advertising dollars from the promoters, which affects the bottom line. It doesn't make

MONITOR PROFILE

Charleston, S.C., Heats Up Again With The Straight-Up R&B Of WSSP

Once the site of R&B radio's most crowded battle in the late '80s/early '90s, Charleston, S.C., is heating up again. On Jan. 25, market leader WWVZ (Z93) and recent challenger WWBZ (Hot 98.9) were joined by WSSP (Power 94.3), which segued from rhythmic top 40 to what PD Jeff Lee calls straight-up R&B, with several days' stunting as a modern rock station in between.

Lee joined Power 94.3—which launched with 10,000 songs in a row—Feb. 11. Lee says that unlike WWBZ, which had recently presented itself to the industry as rhythmic top 40, "we're going right after Z93. The mistake that Hot made in the past was that they were trying to say they were churban or whatever, and they weren't focusing on the main demo. They were also playing so much hip-hop, you would think they were only targeting a male listener."

Lee admits that ownership realized WSSP was missing the boat as a rhythmic top 40 and made the decision to go after "the 18-34 African-American female," to sandwich itself among Hot 98.9, Z93, and adult R&B sister WMGL.

More recently, former heritage R&B outlet WPAL relaunched as Mega 100.9, adding another competitor to the mix, although Lee says, "Their signal is very poor, making it hard for them to compete with the other stations."

Licensed to Concord Media but in a joint sales agreement with Clear Channel, Power 94.3 was up 3.4-4.0 12-plus in its first book, Lee says. "We've already seen an 83% increase in listenership with the target demo. We moved from 13th to fourth place in some dayparts and to No. 2 in other dayparts."

A native of Jacksonville, Fla., Lee started in broadcasting in 1983 at the age of 14 and eventually became MD at that market's WJBT. In 1997, he moved to WHRK (K97) Memphis, where he remained until he joined WSSP, his first programming job. While his career has seen him in three Southern cities, Lee says, "the South is different wherever you go . . . Jacksonville is a little more cosmopolitan, while Memphis is a little thuggish. When you look at the rap that comes out of Memphis, it's more [like] the Three 6 Mafia, gangsta-walk style. It's definitely more down and dirty."

Lee adds that because of "the huge, local underground rap scene in Memphis, radio there has to play more of that style of music. There's more local music coming out of Memphis than I've seen in any other city I've worked. And that's probably because Memphis has a long history and heritage of music in general, from blues to jazz to rap."

But he adds that in Charleston, "some of the thuggish stuff gets over, but a lot of it does not. I have learned that Petey Pablo is like a king around here, though. They do support their

own, and Petey is from the Carolinas."

Lee describes the city as "really laid-back. The attitude here is, 'Sure, my appointment may be for 3 o'clock, but I'll get there sometime around 3:15 or 3:30.' Even the mayor is late for things. It's the lifestyle here." For that reason, Lee says, "in this market, it really doesn't matter if you play a song first or not."

Positioned as "No. 1 for hip-hop and R&B," Lee says "the mix isn't too much hip-hop or too

much R&B. We probably play some R&B that other hardcore hip-hop stations won't. But at the same time, we'll still play the Clipse's 'Grindin'' and that kind of rap, as long as it's a hit."

Lee cites Maxwell's "This Woman's Work" as one R&B record that a lot of harder mainstreams stayed away from. "Here, no one was playing it when I arrived. I knew from the success I had with it in Memphis that it was the perfect female record. So we started playing it, and eventually we forced the other stations on it as well . . . While some programmers may be reluctant to play a song like this—because of the tempo and content—if you're going for a female listener 18-34, you'd be making a mistake by missing this type of song."

Lee's five hottest records at the moment are "Eminem's ['Without Me'], Lil' Corey's 'First

sense for a radio station to compete against those shows, because in reality, we can't. We can't pay those big-time artists what they demand, and you also would be competing with one of your biggest advertisers—the promoter."

KEEPING PRICES LOW

Regardless of the lineup, the biggest challenge for broadcasters trying to sell tickets to their shows is keeping prices low. "A lot of radio stations think if they have a 10-15 act lineup, then they can charge \$30-\$40 or more for tickets," K97's Gilbert says. "But let's look at the overall picture. If you're a family of five, that's \$150 for tickets alone. Then they have to pay for parking and food. That's over \$200 for a one-day event." WHRK keeps its tickets at \$10 and throws in free parking. "We make our money off sponsorships, anyway," Gilbert says. "That's the main reason why we've been able to consistently sell tickets at our events." Top 40 KHKS Dallas gave listeners a bar-

gain the day before its June 9 show when the station offered two-for-one tickets.

"I've seen a lot of the radio show prices pop up," Tear says. "I'm thinking, 'Isn't this supposed to be a gift to your listeners?'" The WDRQ Heat Rave ticket prices range from the high 20s to the high 40s. But Tear has seen \$80 tickets for some station shows and wonders how a station can expect parents to pay for themselves, their kids and friends, parking, food, and souvenirs. "By the time you're done with it, you've dropped \$700," he says. "Are the Beatles back to life now?"

"The value of the dollar is [such that] they could be buying food or whatever with that money," rhythmic top 40 KNDK Corpus Christi, Texas, OM Bill Thorman says. "Sometimes one of the first audiences to attach itself to a new artist is a younger audience, but they don't have a lot of money to spend." His station is doing a series of smaller \$1.29 shows.

"The major problem is radio stations are

Time,' 'Anything' by Jaheim, 'We Ready' by Archie Eversole, and 'Oh Boy' by Cam'ron."

As for gold product, Lee says that a lot more stations will start to "return to playing more gold, but they will be more selective in the titles. My competition, Z93, has a Back in the Day Buffet [feature] every day at noon, where they play everything from Lisa Lisa to UTFO to Regina Belle. I think that's too much."

Meanwhile, Lee says, "we're about to add an old-school show on Sunday nights that will be two hours [long] and will focus only on classic hip-hop. You have to narrow down the years, too, like from '81 to '92. I had a show like that in Memphis called *Old School Jointz*."

Charleston's laid-back atmosphere extends to its night life, Lee says. "They have a lot of house parties and barbecues or oyster roasts. They do like to get dressed up and go clubbing, but they are very finicky about where they go."

Lee says that before Power signed on, there wasn't much to offer in terms of night life for his listeners. He hopes to change that. "The African-American population in this area is about 33%. It's not really a city where different folks hang out together. There is a big club area in downtown Charleston, but it's mostly patronized by the Caucasian audience. The blacks don't really have an area to call their own."

He continues, "We're getting ready to do our first free listener party at a club, and we plan to continue to do events like it throughout the summer."

WSSP's lineup has the Russ Parr and Olivia Foxx morning show, Jen Torrez in middays, Lee in afternoons, and Rory Dap Boi in nights. He also has a weekend, Milk Stylz, who is straight out of a local high school and "is going to be very well-known in radio in a few years," Lee says. "He just started hanging around the station to learn about radio. He and his partner would [serve as DJs] at high school dances, and he'd come by to get our banner to put up so that other students would know about Power. Then one day I came in and there was a message on my voice-mail with a spot on it. He had gone in and produced it to show me what he could do. It was amazing."

"It's a very young, hungry staff," Lee continues. "You can do so much more with them than with some more experienced vets. I can call Rory in the morning, tell him I need him to show up at the station right away to go out with the van for a remote that afternoon, and he'll do it. Try to get someone who's been doing radio for 10-15 years to do that and the first thing out of their mouth is, 'Is there a talent fee?'"

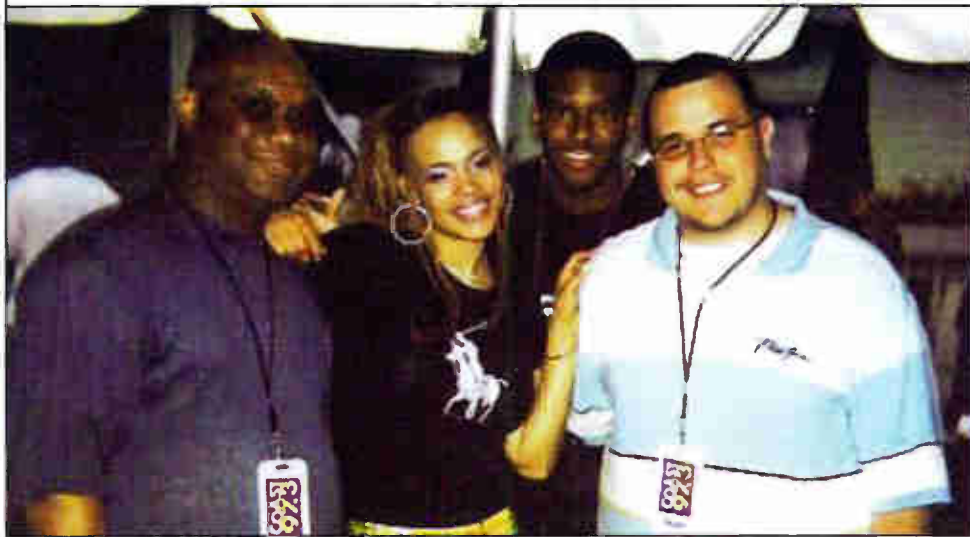

spending exorbitant amounts of money on acts that are not headliners," Zellner says. "We're kidding ourselves if we think people can afford \$80 concert tickets. The managers and the bands and the promoters and the promotions teams are sometimes seeing the desperation in PDs' eyes and saying, 'I can get you this band, but it's going to cost you \$80,000 or \$100,000' for an act with one or two hits."

Some of the desperation comes from the fact that station shows—once intended to bolster a station's image—have become vital sources of nontraditional revenue. But Dick Stark, director of marketing for Regent/Albany, N.Y., says, "Stations need to look at listener appreciation shows as a great marketing tool, a great thank-you to your fans. If you're looking at it to make money, you're doing it for the wrong reason."

In the end, Tear says it comes down to "why do you want to do a show? You want to take ownership of the artist and give a gift back to your listeners."

Summer's No Time To Slack Off

Traditionally, stations put the bulk of their promotion muscle into the spring and fall Arbitron surveys, using the "off" books to plan ahead. While the biggest giveaways—cash and cars—are still saved for those key books, our Promoganda panelists contend there is no such thing as downtime, especially during the summer.

For many Promogandists, the biggest promotions and prizes this summer revolve around concerts. Album rock KSJO San Francisco's **Jim Sheehan** says his station does as many rock shows as possible, because the station "has been rockin' in the Bay Area since 1968. Our listen-

ers expect [us] to be at shows—invited or not." Country WMZQ Washington, D.C.'s **Wendie Vestfall** agrees. "We've got ticket giveaways scheduled in every daypart through October right now. We give our listeners a chance to win everything from big-event concerts like **Brooks & Dunn** to a **Blake Shelton** county-fair-type show. [We] live and breathe concerts in the summer. We also have a policy of only giving away pavilion tickets to outdoor venues, so they know they are winning the best seats possible."

But adult top 40 **KIMN** (Mix 100) Denver's **Mark Murdock** believes "concert 'presents' and appearances are overrated, unless you have all the tickets to the show. Putting on a free concert is the way to go," he says. "Listeners really feel you are giving them something. Our **Sister Hazel** concert will have free food and free beer. Beat that."

What are the other hot giveaways for summer? Country **WPOC** Baltimore's **Sheila Silverstein** believes the little things make the difference. "We take advantage of the weather in summer to get out into the streets with participation in festivals [and] fairs," she says, "but just stopping with the van and giving out ice cream to little league [teams] or people washing their cars in the local parks [is also important]."

Murdock agrees. "You have to have a summer tie-in to get listeners out to appearances and remotes. This summer, we have pinwheels for kids. At the Six Flags [amusement park] opening, we [gave out] towelettes to cool off. I unloaded three cases in two hours. Hot days are great to have cool drinks or even water for listeners."

Vestfall considers the lure of the ocean as her summer-event competition. "The beach is only two hours away from D.C., so [an event] best be good to get people to give up going to the water," she says. "You want to be in front of lots of people, so fairs, festivals, and concerts are always good places to go."

Sheehan's recipe for summer success is for the carnivores in the audience. "Successful promotions need what I call a 'piece of meat'—a reason for people to come out," he says. "Just to do an appearance because it's a big client does not equate to success. Usually, if there's little to no meat, it's a failure." What are the big plans for his listeners this summer? Sheehan says it's giving away "a grand [\$1,000] at a grand opening," giving the audience a chance to get their picture taken with "hot chicks," and events at "well-traveled locations with built-in crowds."

Clear Channel/Miami's **Camie Dunbar** tailors summer promotions to fit the needs of her stations and their sales departments. Top 40 **WHYI** (Y100) does a \$100,000 back-to-school backpack promotion all summer. The packs are

OM **Jerry Dean** says the scavenger list was difficult and included a "1950s Coke bottle and a \$2 bill with the [station's] frequency in the serial number, [but] the two tough items were an authentic Grammy Award and a 1953 Humes High School yearbook. That's the year and school that Elvis graduated from." Dean says the promotion caused quite a stir. "The classified ads in the paper were full of people who wanted to rent or buy the items." The winning scavenger rode home in a brand-new \$23,000 car.

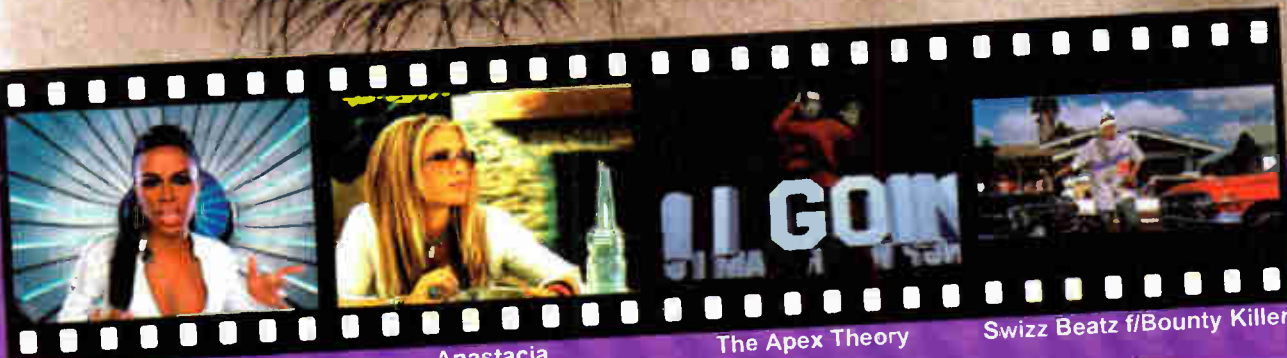
