T40, R&B Overlap Nearly 50%

Last fall, mainstream top 40 was ratcheting down the amount of music it took from the rhythmic and R&B world (at least slightly) and reaching out for more rock titles, particularly as acts like Linkin Park, Nickelback, and Staind heralded a resurgence of guitar rock.

But that was before rock acts began making it clear that they didn't want to play top 40 station shows or even be interviewed on top 40 stations. So this fall, *Airplay Monitor's* latest look at musical sharing between formats shows that the amount of music coming from rock is leveling, but the percentage of rhythmic top 40 and R&B hits that eventually show up at top 40 has skyrocketed, more than doubling in the case of R&B/hip-hop radio.

Monitor looked at eight major current-based formats to see how many of their hits eventually made it to mainstream top 40. We did so by tallying the percentage of songs on those formats' May 31 chart that had made it to mainstream top 40 by Sept. 27. The four-month lag was meant to give songs time to cross over; we weren't necessarily measuring the amount of songs that are on both formats at any given time as top 40 PDs' willingness to acknowledge the major records on their competitors at some point.

And, boy, were top 40 PDs willing to acknowledge hits from R&B—a major change from past years. In 1997, the first year for which we've compared the numbers, only 15% of the 40 most-played songs at R&B could count on ever getting to mainstream top 40. Now, an incredible 43% of the songs on R&B/hip-hop radio in May had shown up at mainstream top 40 by summer's end. That's easily the highest percent of musical sharing in the *Monitor* era, although that era began in late '92/early '93, just as an R&B backlash was taking hold at mainstream top 40; the

Flex/Lova Spat Spurs Legal Action

The altercation reported last week between **WQHT** (Hot 97) New York's **Funkmaster Flex** and rival **WWPR** (Power 105.1)'s **Steph Lova** has escalated to more legal action. New York's *Daily News* reports that Hot 97 plans to seek an order of protection against Lova, charging that "many of our staff have witnessed her lingering in front of the Hot 97 offices at all hours of the night and day. Her repeated, uninvited presence has made our employees extremely uncomfortable."

Lova has in turn filed a lawsuit against Flex, charging that she suffered emotional and physical pain when he allegedly attacked her outside the Hot 97 offices. Flex, who was released from police custody after turning himself in after the incident, had earlier denied to the *News* that he attacked Lova.

MMTC BREAKS IT DOWN FOR FCC

The Minority Media and Telecommunications Council (MMTC) has sent a letter to the FCC documenting a 1999 study that outlines discrimination by broadcasters and cable companies against minorities and women. The MMTC represents civil rights and religious organizations and educational institutions in the FCC's EEO rule-making proceedings. The study found that 20% of broadcasters intentionally discriminate against African-Americans and 15% intentionally do so against women. The letter to the FCC said, "The study examined minority and female employment patterns of companies . . . and identified firms' departures from these employment patterns that were so extreme that intentional discrimination is legally presumed."

BUSINESS: SUPERADIO SOLD

Syndicator SuperRadio has been sold to Access 1 Communications—a minority-owned broadcast group that owns **WWRL** New York and **KDKS** and **KBTT** Shreveport, La.—by Superadio CEO/principal **John Garabedian**.

The National Assn. of Broadcasters (NAB) names **Marcellus Alexander Jr.** executive VP of the NAB's TV department, making him the highest-ranking African-American executive at the group. He's the former GM of **KYW-TV** in Philadelphia.

XM Satellite Radio and Delphi are teaming for a "boombox" receiver that will give the service new portability. Due this month, the **SKYFi** and its companion hardware will retail for about \$200.

Recent R&B sign-on **WARL** Providence, R.I., is a little ticked off at **Luther Campbell** of **2 Live Crew**. GM **Charlie Profit** says the station had verbally agreed to hire Campbell as morning man via ISDN from his Miami home, along with co-host **Jill Tracy** (who also co-hosts afternoons at adult R&B **WQHT** in that city). But when it came time to debut the show, Campbell never showed up. The station launched Sept. 18, and Profit says his station paid for a plane ticket for Campbell to arrive Sept. 15. He didn't show. Another ticket was sent for Campbell to arrive Sept. 22. Again, a no-show, although Tracy did arrive. There were also talks of syndicating Campbell through Profit's Cab Radio, which will now instead syndicate Tracy's daily fashion/entertainment feature.

PROGRAMMING: NEW CC RVPS

Didn't take long for new Clear Channel/Detroit OM **Darren Davis** to get promoted again, and he wasn't even in the building. Davis is one of a slew of new regional VP announcements at CC this week. Also getting stripes are CC/Virginia trading area VP of operations **Bill Cahill**; CC/Louisville, Ky., director of operations **Kelly Carls**; CC/Tampa, Fla., director of FM programming **Brad Hardin**; **WLIT**/WNUA Chicago OM **Bob Kaake**; CC/Orlando, Fla., director of programming **Chris Kampmeier**; CC/Pittsburgh OM

Dave Labrozzi; CC/Cleveland regional director of programming operations **Kevin Metheney**; and **WNCI** Columbus, Ohio, PD **Jimmy Steele**.

KRPW (Power 97.5) Houston takes a more adult R&B stance, dropping most current rap but keeping a specialty show focusing on old-school hip-hop every weeknight hosted by **Cut Creator**. The Power 97.5 staff stays intact. Late-nighter **Lil' G.** picks up production director duties as well.

WKQB Fayetteville, N.C., PD/p.m. driver **Bill Black** returns to **WHXT** (Hot 103) Columbia, S.C. (where he was previously MD/afternoon host) for nights.

KTCX Beaumont, Texas, hires **Kim Stevens** as PD, replacing **Chris Clay**, who exited during the summer. Stevens was most recently production director at **WVEE** (V103) Atlanta.

It generated tons of publicity and attracted the attention of Canada's broadcast regulator. Now market observers say the uncensored rap records have stopped airing on new crossover R&B outlet **CKEY** (Wild 101) Buffalo, N.Y. Locals say the unedited titles—thought to be airable under Canada's different broadcast rules—only lasted about a week. **Phil Becker**, PD of **WJFX** Fort Wayne, Ind., is the new PD at **CKEY**. **Rob Grey** remains OM for owner Niagara Broadcasting, which is in a sales arrangement with U.S. broadcaster Citadel. Also, Citadel's **Scott Mahalick** says that the station is *not*, as widely believed, being consulted by **Jerry Clifton**, although the veteran programmer *was* involved in the sign-on.

KTBT (the Beat) Tulsa, Okla., staffs up, under newly official PD/middayer **Steve Fisk**. Via voice-tracking, **Krazy Kidd** and **Ruben** will handle mornings (they're based at sister **KZZP** Phoenix), and **DeJa Vu** will do afternoons from **WWPR**. Live in nights is **Big Juice** and in late nights **C.C. Love**, both from crosstown **KJMM**.

Noncommercial **WDET** Detroit picks up the syndicated *Tavis Smiley Show* for the 9 a.m.-10 a.m. weekday slot.

IN REMEMBRANCE

Sorry to report the loss of two broadcasters this week. **WUSL** (Power 99) and gospel/adult R&B **WDAS-AM-FM** Philadelphia director of sales **Dwayne Perry**, 35, was killed in a car accident Sept. 28. He's survived by his wife, **Marie Tolsen**, director of promotions and marketing for **WUSL** and **WDAS**.

Dr. **Charles E. Cummings**, 70, co-founder of **WKIE** Richmond in the late '70s and the first African-American broadcast owner in that city's history, died Sept. 27. In 1997, Cummings teamed with other businessmen to create **FM 100 Inc.** to buy the then-silent **WKIE**, relaunching it as gospel **WREJ**. He was later co-owner of **WSOJ** and adult R&B **WKJS**. The company was sold to Radio One in 2000.

PEOPLE: HARPER'S BACK

WBLS New York is making some lineup changes: **Kid Capri**, who was doing a nightly one-hour mix at 6 p.m., exits, while legendary Quiet Storm host **Vaughn Harper** returns to host that show, starting Oct. 14. He replaces **Raymond Anthony**, who exits. **Tre' Rene**, who has been filling in nights since **J.C. Jordan** exited in May, moves back to weekends, leaving that shift open.

At crosstown **WWPR**, morning traffic anchor and hip-hop veteran **Flava Flav** is in jail after violating his probation. A station representative expects Flav to return to the morning show in about two months.

KKBT (the Beat) Los Angeles morning man/actor **Steve Harvey** has been tapped as spokesman for Burger King.



Plenty Of Change On Charts For Musiq

It's a big week for **Musiq** at various *R&B Airplay Monitor* formats, as "dontchange" (Def Soul/IDJMG) . . .

- Moves 15-10 on the R&B/hip-hop chart, bringing his tally there to four top 10 hits.
- Earns Greatest Gainer honors on the adult R&B chart with an increase of 105 spins. It's now No. 5, right behind its predecessor, "halfcrazy."
- Gains 225 crossover spins, cracking the top 20 in both audience and detections on that chart, thus qualifying for Airpower status.

number might have been different in, say, 1990.

The number of R&B hits that top 40 is now acknowledging is even more incredible when you consider that the percentage of songs on the crossover chart that eventually made it across was 45%—a difference of only one song. (That record, by the way, was Aaliyah's "More Than a Woman," a hit on both charts that had already fallen off the R&B chart by May 31.)

The greater amount of musical sharing speaks not only to top 40's greater acceptance of rap and hip-hop but also to changes at R&B radio itself. The sort of midtempo or ballad R&B that top 40 stations rarely play isn't heard much on mainstream R&B these days either. There are exceptions—on the week we looked at, the biggest R&B hit that top 40 hadn't acknowledged was Musiq's "halfcrazy," which was No. 4—but they're few and far between.

As for rhythmic top 40, the amount of its music heard on mainstream rebounded sharply, from 63% in fall 2000 to 48% last year to 63% again this time around. That number is even higher if you count Ja Rule's "Down A** Chick," which sort of crossed over later that summer in slightly revised form as Irv Gotti Presents the Inc.'s "Down 4 U."

While we've seen more cases of labels breaking records solely at rhythmic in recent years, there were very few songs of that sort in May (Isyss, Rayvon, and Amanda Perez, all of which were on the bottom half of the chart). There are still songs that become research monsters at rhythmic without crossing pop, but they're more likely to be "Pass the Courvoisier" or "Welcome to Atlanta" these days.

ROCK INFLUENCE CREEPING, MODERN INFLUENCE FLAT

One of last fall's most interesting findings was that album rock, not thought of as a particularly fertile ground for top 40 music, was sharing more songs thanks to Nickelback, Linkin Park, etc. Between 2000 and 2001, top 40 went from covering 15% of rock radio's hits to 20%. This fall, it was 25%, right behind modern rock's 32% (which was flat from last fall).

So those calls that top 40 PDs began getting last year telling them not to play rock crossovers, or at least not to expect any promotional support for it, didn't manage to kill modern rock's presence at mainstream top 40, but it did perhaps cap it a little. If you look at our Radio Concert Monitor feature for late May, you don't find Linkin Park or Nickelback playing top 40 station concerts. But you do see Ja Rule, Ashanti, P. Diddy, and even Mary J. Blige. By contrast, the rock act seen most often in those listings is the Calling—and it had already been exiled from modern rock.

Look at the modern rock chart from May, and there's only one major hit that was worked to mainstream top 40 without acceptance—Unwritten Law's "Seein' Red." The remaining top 10 modern hits that top 40 failed to acknowledge were a mix of nu-metal (Korn, Papa Roach), neo-progressive (System of a Down), and deeper cuts from albums that had already yielded a top 40 hit by such acts as Staind and Puddle of Mudd. Then there was the neo-garage movement (the Strokes, the Hives, the White Stripes) that top 40 has yet to embrace, although Capitol is hoping to change that with the Vines.

ADULT TOP 40 DECLARES ITS DEPENDENCE

While adult top 40 has historically been a format that takes its musical cues from top 40, the amount of shared music was down to its lowest point a year ago—even if that percentage was still 70%. This summer, the number was 78%, reflecting a sudden return to conservatism at adult top 40 that most record reps were noticing at the time. Of the 40 titles we looked at, only one was by an act that had never charted at mainstream top 40 (Rubyhorse, in this case).

MONITOR PROFILE

Ed Lover, Doctor Dre, And Lisa G. On Their Return To New York Radio

With the March debut of WWPR (Power 105.1), New York's hip-hop radio battle began to heat up. Since then, Power and well-entrenched rival WQHT (Hot 97) have traded the format lead in 12-plus while carving out their individual places in the market. Part of creating a niche for Power 105.1 was bringing back the trio of Ed Lover, Doctor Dre, and Lisa G., who helped bring Hot 97 to prominence in 1994.

R&B Airplay Monitor spoke with the Power 105.1 morning crew about its return to New York airwaves as a team, its view on the city's radio landscape, and its impact on R&B/hip-hop radio over the years.

What was your initial reaction to returning to mornings in New York? Was there any hesitation on anyone's part?

Ed: When I was contacted by Steve Smith, there was absolutely no hesitation on my part. I said, "Hell yeah, a job." And with Dre and Lisa on top of that? I know for a fact there is nobody else I could work as well with than these two.

Dre: I said, "Hell no, I ain't coming back," but then Ed put a shotgun to my head, and I agreed.

Lisa: I had e-mailed Ed and said, "The time for us is right to get back together," not knowing that he had already been approached about Power 105.1. He told me he was coming back east and that he was working on some possible things, but I thought he meant TV or movie stuff. It's really ironic that right about the time I was feeling we should work on getting back together, the plan was already in the works.

How far in advance were you as a team involved in the pre-planning of Power 105.1?

Ed: We knew long before. In fact, Dre and I had to sign a confidentiality agreement. But before that, we only knew that we would be working for Clear Channel—we didn't know which market. I was initially considered for the WJLB Detroit [morning] job as well.

Once the show came together on Power, were you trying to recreate the original show from your Hot 97 days or create a whole new vibe?

Ed: It was a little bit of both. We wanted to recreate what we knew worked but also didn't want to dwell so much on the past. We are creative people, so that aspect was going to come naturally. You try different new things—some stick and some don't. The same goes for bringing back some of the older features. The main goal was to bring the entertainment value back to mornings, from a New York point of view. That's not to say that [syndicated WBL's morning man] Doug Banks or [syndicated WRKS counterpart] Tom Joyner are not creative or entertaining. They simply are not New Yorkers.

Lisa: In my mind, I felt we were cut short the first time. We were going along just fine, continuing to grow, then all of a sudden we were dismantled. So for me, this new job was to pick up where we left off and move further along.

What are the features you brought back?

Ed: We brought back the Roll Call and the Booty Call. For a while there, we thought we were going to get rid of the Roll Call, because it was hard to get people to participate. It's a Catch-22—people loved to hear it, but they weren't calling to do it. So I decided, "If that's how it's going to be, let's put it to bed." What I didn't realize at the time was that because it was summer, all the teens who would normally participate were either still sleeping or not around. Once they started to get back to school, they were calling to do the Roll Call, to shout out to their friends and so forth. So it's back.

What are some of the new features?

Ed: The Hip-Hopera. It started as a skit put together by one of our team members, Spruce. These are real opera singers who come in and sing live. We suggest the hip-hop song, and they perform it.

Lisa: I also have a segment called Ask Lisa G., where people can call in for love-life advice. It's mostly females, but we get an occasional guy.

Ed: Lisa gives out the real serious advice and answers, whereas I give the street advice.

You mentioned you get a lot of female callers for the love-life advice feature. Overall, who is your main target? Is it the same audience you were talking to at Hot 97?

Ed: It's the same audience, only they are older now and more mature. A lot of them might have a family of their own. We always had a lot of female listeners, even at Hot. Now, they're much more male-oriented in their morning show. You know, everybody does what's good for them. But our target is 18- to 34-year-old, black, Hispanic, and white females. That's who we go after, and that's who we find are listening. I believe they hear something with our show that is sensible. We are entertaining, but respectfully so. We'll ride that line, but we're not going to cross it too often.

What else makes your Power show different from the Hot morning show?

Ed: In part, it's about being a little more mature. Lisa: Also, everything has changed since we were together last. We live in a different world, a different New York City. We've experienced the horror and aftermath of 9/11. We've all grown and changed because of that. Many of our former listeners who are tuning in now have kids of their own, so their priorities have changed. We also have a lot of younger listeners, who were too young to have listened to Hot 97 when we were on, so we're a whole new experience for them.

What sets your show apart from all the other morning shows in New York?

Ed: We are intelligent and informed enough to talk about the kinds of issues and concerns that are important to our listeners, in addition to being entertaining. Let's put it where it really is. Because a lot of these issues affect us personally, we care about what happens in our city, in our schools, and in our neighborhoods. What are the programs that [New York mayor Michael] Bloomberg is putting into the schools system? Is the president going to declare war on Iraq? What's happening with gangs in our school systems? Even things like the high cost of buying your kids' back-to-school clothes. These issues affect me and Dre as dads, and we can relate first-hand.

Lisa: We're also able to make fun of something, and in the next break, we can be as serious as we need to be. Today, we talked about the gang problems in our schools, and there were both students and teachers who called in.

Who are some of the behind-the-scenes morning-team members?

Ed: [APD] Wayne Mayo is our supervising producer—he was with us back at Hot 97 as well. And Anthony Caiazzo is the producer. We also have the folks who help us with production and skits.

Have you been working together as a team so long that you can just wing it, or do you plan out each morning in advance?

Ed: We usually talk about the show after we come off the air—how it sounded—while it's still fresh in our minds. We do that with our PD, Michael Saunders. But we plan the show early in the morning before we go on the air. Each person brings in what they want to talk about or do, then we sit down and determine what gets on. Lisa might say, "I got this thing on a sissy doctor," or Dre will have a great bit for his feature, The Wonderful World of Doctor Dre.

Dre: The Wonderful World of Doctor Dre is pure craziness. It's all the odds and ends of just weird and funny stuff. Most of it comes from e-mails from listeners, but sometimes the funniest stuff comes from when I lose the piece of paper [that] outlines what I was supposed to talk about, so I make up something on the spot.

What does Saunders contribute to the show?

Ed: In the creative aspect of it, Michael really doesn't get involved. He lets us do our thing. Overall, he just tries to keep us on track on the details. For example, he'll tell us, "Guys, don't forget to promote this event" or "Please don't talk over each other" or "Don't forget that when the guest is in the studio, the listeners need to hear them speak," because sometimes we can get carried away and not let them get a word in. Occasionally, when it comes to the creative stuff, we will argue. Mike might say we need to stop doing this or that, but we just say, "Yeah, right."

When you debuted at Hot 97, it was the beginning of a sea change at R&B radio, with hip-hop DJs taking the front seat. How does it feel to have made such an impact on R&B radio?

Ed: It's a good feeling.

Lisa: It's a great feeling. At the same time, no one can take away from us being the originals.

Ed: But that's not to say we don't steal ideas ourselves. Everyone borrows in radio. Actually, I call it "sampling."

Lisa: A lot of the original ideas we did came from living in New York and being New Yorkers. That's why it's so exciting to be doing this on Power 105 now. It's just such a creative city, in so many respects.

Two years ago, Doctor Dre and Ed Lover tried to bring that magic to Los Angeles at KKBT (the Beat). Why didn't the show work there?

Ed: Because they sold the radio station two months after we started. I really think L.A. was warming up to us. We didn't have enough time out there. But I also believe that L.A. has an inferiority complex with New Yorkers—they are intimidated.

So, if Clear Channel decides to syndicate the morning show, could it work in other markets?

Ed: Sure it can. We were syndicated before and it worked... I don't think that jokes are difficult to translate from one city to the next. The biggest issue is localizing the music, because that's where people really differ in their taste. L.A. has a very different sound than New York musically.

Lisa: Funny is funny, and family life is family wherever you go. Listeners identify with those things.

Last week, the rivalry between Hot 97 and Power 105.1 took a serious turn with an altercation between Hot's Funkmaster Flex and Power's Stepf Lova, resulting in charges being filed against Flex. Is this a result of the station war getting out of control or a personal beef that has nothing to do with it?

Ed: It's the rivalry. The rivalry is creating personal problems. Dre, myself, and Lisa, along with Flex and Angie and all of the original staff, we are the architects of that radio station. We made the station what it is. It ran for so long without any real competition, so it's hard for them to swallow that there is a new kid getting the attention. But what bothers me is that people who were friends—the jocks—this radio competition shouldn't make us enemies.
