## Boberg's Alternative Roots Reinvent MCA And Score Mainstream Success

About 20 years ago, Jay Boberg, as UCLA's student-body concert director, helped stage a free daytime Talking Heads concert on campus. A few months later, he got involved in the start-up of I.R.S. Records, a label that would help introduce what was then called new wave to a very resistant America. Now, as president of MCA Records, he's using some of the tactics from the late '70s and early '80s to break such MCA acts as Sublime, Semisonic, and K-Ci & JoJo into the mainstream.

According to Boberg, the key to his success has been his willingness to take risks and stay true to his passion for music and artist development. Back in the late '70s, he had to choose between

graduation, with a future in computer studies or law school, and being VP of I.R.S. Records for Miles Copeland, who managed an up-and-coming band called the Police.

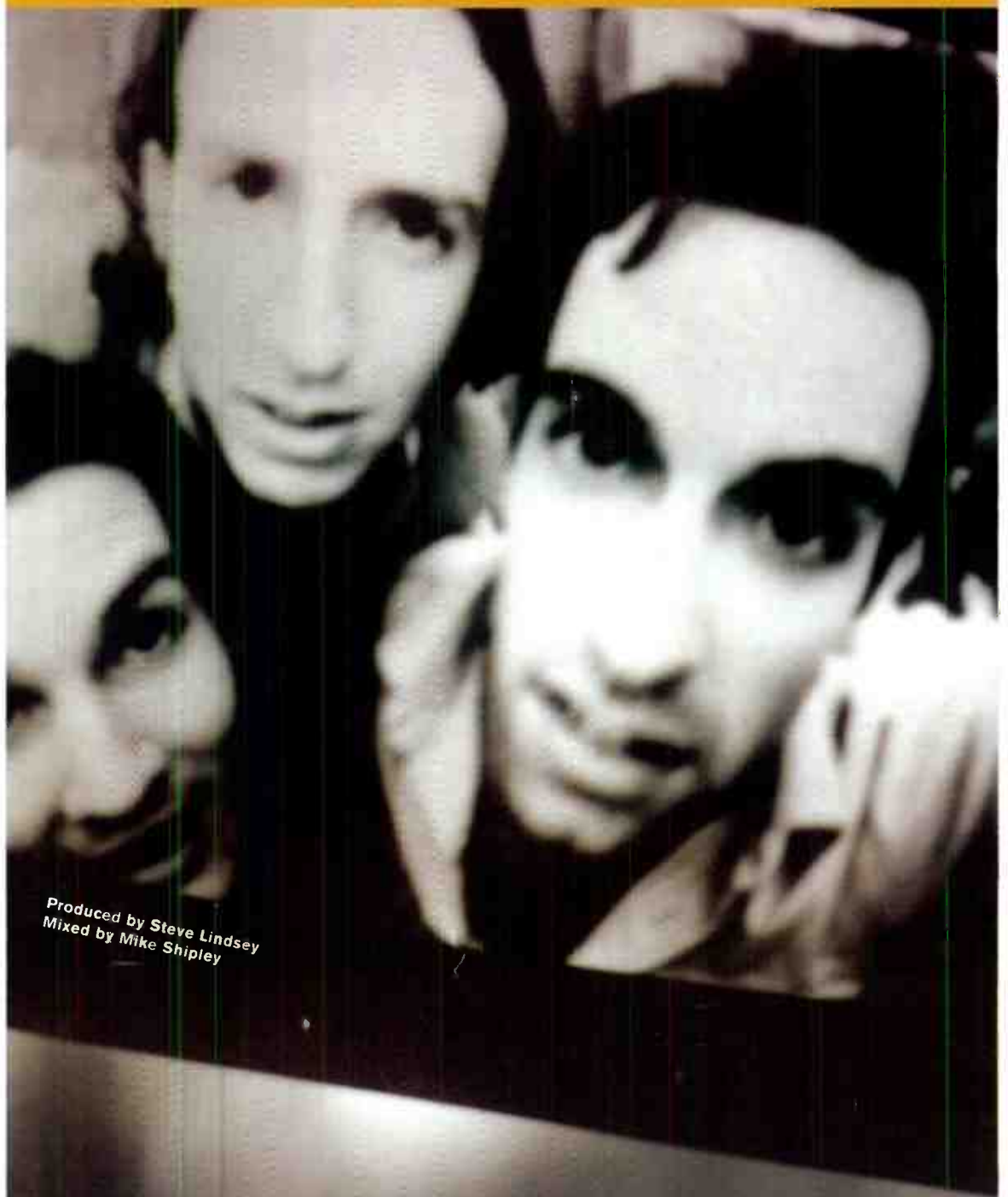

## Jacor Settles With DOJ, Closes On Nationwide

**J**acor has reached a settlement with the Department of Justice allowing it to close on its \$620 million acquisition of Nationwide Communications. The closing was conditional on Jacor's already-announced divestiture of five stations in Columbus, Ohio; two in San Diego; and one in Cleveland. This puts classic rock WOCT Baltimore, album WMMS Cleveland, album KEGL Dallas, modern KTBS Houston, classic rock KGLQ Phoenix, classic rock KSD St. Louis, classic hits KKGL San Diego, and classic rock KUFJ San Jose under the Jacor umbrella.

With the closing, Louisville, Ky., market manager Tom Schurr shifts to Houston as VP/marketing manager, overseeing KTBS and adult top 40 KHMN. KDMX Dallas GM J.D. Freeman is now VP/market manager of Dallas, including KEGL. Jacor St. Louis GM Lee Clear adds KSD. WPOC Baltimore GM Jim Dolan picks up WOCT, and Cleveland GM Jim Meltzer becomes VP/market manager, picking up GM duties at WMMS.

In other Jacor news, its modern WAQZ (Channel Z) Cincinnati flips to what PD Matt Harris describes as "pure top 40, just playing all the hits." The station's handle and staff remain the same.

In Columbus, Jacor's modern WZAZ moves up the dial from 98.5 to 105.7, former home of classic hits WKFX. WZAZ promotion assistant Ben Williams is now APD. Jacor's Spanish KZWC San Francisco drops the format to simulcast album KSJO San Jose, Calif. And KGLQ is rumored to be planning a format flip, perhaps to adult top 40, by the time you read this.

### FORMATS: KPOI GETS ACTIVE

Modern KPOI Honolulu flips to active rock under PD Brock Whaley.

KPEL Lafayette, La., has dropped simulcasting the N/T format of its AM sister, moved its dial position from 107.7 to 107.9, and become classic rock KXRZ (the New 107.9 K-Rock). Modern sister KFTE PD Fast Eddie picks up programming duties, and the syndicated Bob and Tom do wake-ups. Alan Sneed consults.

In addition to Big City's flip of triple-A WCBR Chicago to a simulcast of modern KLYY (Y107) L.A., it picks up country WLRT Kankakee, Ill., and top 40 WDEK, De Kalb, Ill., and adds them to the Y107 convoy circling the Windy City.

### BUSINESS: BUBBA "BUSTED" BY FCC

The FCC has sent a \$4,000 Notice of Apparent Liability to album WXTB (98 Rock) Tampa, Fla., for broadcast of allegedly indecent content. The fine stems from the Bubba The Love Sponge morning show June 12 and 20, 1997.

Capstar taps album WPLR New Haven, Conn., GM Rob Williams to succeed Gordon Weingarth as VP/GM of its Hartford, Conn., cluster: top 40 WKSS, modern WMRQ, classic rock WHCN, country WWYZ, and sports WPOP.

The Ackerley Group picks up classic rock KXLR Fairbanks, Alaska, in an \$8 million deal including an AM and TV facility. . . . Classic rock WCPV Burlington, Vt., and two sisters are picked up by Capstar's Atlantic Star division.

SFX Entertainment creates a new division, SFX Media Marketing, to produce nontraditional revenue opportunities for radio and TV broadcasters. Beginning in the fourth quarter, the division plans to produce turnkey, live, multi-act concert events for radio stations nationwide. Rock radio vet Ted Utz is now senior VP of SFX Media Marketing, which has offices in L.A. and New York.

### PROGRAMMING: NEUMANN TO DC101

WMMS PD Bob Neumann is heading east to helm album WWDC (DC101) Washington, D.C., replacing long-term PD Dave Brown. Now that WMMS is a Jacor station, Jacor veteran Greg Ausham moves from WAZU/WLVQ Columbus to program WMMS. WZAZ MD Mark Pennington joins Ausham at WMMS.

Classic rock WFXF Mobile, Ala., OM Scott

Hamilton heads to album WBYR Fort Wayne, Ind. as PD.

As album WRCN Long Island, N.Y., PD/afternoons Donna Rodger exits, morning man Chaz is PD, and middayer Drew slides to afternoons.

Album KNCN Corpus Christi, Texas, MD/mornings Eric Slayter becomes album KZRK Amarillo, Texas, PD/mornings.

Album WKLS Atlanta OM Bill Wise exits. Classic rock KKHK Denver PD/middays Lois Todd is exiting. Reach her at 303-232-4298.

Glenn Stewart, PD of album WGIR Manchester, N.H./album WHEB Portsmouth, N.H., exits.

Modern KKDM Des Moines, Iowa, PD/afternoons Sophia John will exit the station Aug. 31.

Classic rock-to-talk convert WCKG (the Package) Chicago is seeking brokered programming on weekends, according to local press reports.

### PEOPLE: STERN 'RADIO' SHOW TO BOW

Howard Stern's latest stab at TV will be called "The Howard Stern Radio Show" and picks up Jim Biederman as executive producer, according to the New York Daily News. As a creative executive with Lorne Michaels' Broadway Video, Biederman was executive producer of "Kids In The Hall." Stern goes head to head with "SNI" starting Aug. 22.

Album KBUY Amarillo, Texas, adds Bob and Tom in mornings. PD/MD Kidd Manning is doing afternoons and continues in middays at sister KFMX Lubbock, Texas, through Gulfstar's Star System. He says that KBUY will evolve to active rock over time.

Album WNCN Youngstown, Ohio, picks up the syndicated Bob and Tom feed for mornings.

Modern WRXQ Memphis waves goodbye to morning partner Rob Harder. PD Tony Williams and J.C. will carry on as a duo.

Following up on last week's report of Bill Jones joining album KQDS Duluth, Minn., for mornings, he'll also be MD, replacing Shelly Carr.

In other morning news, Chicago Sun-Times columnist Robert Feder reports that modern WKQX (Q101) Chicago is enjoying an uptick in listeners with its new Mancow morning show. In the four-week rolling average of AccuRatings for July 20-Aug. 10, WKQX has risen with persons 12-plus in mornings 4.2-4.5-5.8-7.1, while album WRCX is off 4.3-2.6-2.0-1.6 in mornings. As Mancow searches for a co-host to replace Irma Blanco, he's giving the seat to various celebs, including Andrew Dice Clay this week. Meanwhile, WRCX Chicago afternoon producer Taz gets his very own weekend air shift.

The New York Daily News says album WNEW OM Garry Wall is still searching for nights but puts market veteran Matt DeVoti into the shift for now. Meanwhile, WNEW vets Pat St. John, Dennis Elsas, and Pete Fornatale, who have been off the air, have all officially left the station.

Album WLUP Chicago promotion coordinator Geli Silkowski is now promotion manager.

Luka, former morning host at modern WRAX Birmingham, Ala., surfaces across the street at top 40 WQEN (103.7, the Q) in afternoons.

Modern KXPK Denver production director Tom Koetting forms his own production company. KXPK remains a client.

The L.A. Times reports that the Copeland brothers—Stewart, Miles, and Ian—are launching a talk show, "Sibling Rivalry," 5:30-6:30 p.m. Fridays on KPLS. It will cover music news and gossip and include tips on breaking into the biz.

### A PROMOTIONAL HEATWAVE

Album KLOL (Rock 101) Houston has turned the Texas heat wave into a dual promotion. Every day the temperature at Bush Intercontinental Airport hits 101 degrees, listeners are invited to call in and win \$1,001. Concurrently, the station will donate \$1,001 to local

Modern rock has evolved from an upstart outsider to a cornerstone of the very corporations at which it once thumbed its programming nose. And on Sept. 19 at the Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar and Awards, SW Networks director of programming John Loscalzo will lead a panel discussion with modern programmers on the latest chapter of modern rock's life in a consolidated world. Confirmed so far for the "Modern Rock: Conform And Conquer" session are KTEG Albuquerque, N.M., PD Skip Isley; WDX Pittsburgh PD John Moschitta; and KROX Austin, Texas, PD Sara Trexler.

In other seminar news, Allen Kovac, chairman/CEO of the Left Bank Organization and

founder of the new Beyond record label, will address the gathering from the perspective of a music executive who has seen both the management and label side of things and is cutting forward-looking deals with radio that are in line



with the changing terrain of the industry. The seminar will be held Sept. 17-19 at the Pointe Hilton Resort at Tapatio Cliffs, Phoenix. The two days of panels will culminate in the annual Radio Awards the night of Sept. 19.

## Epic Names Bisceglia Executive VP

**E**pic Records Group names Rick Bisceglia executive VP, overseeing promotion for Epic, 550 Music, and the Work Group, as Epic senior VP of promotion John Boulos exits. Boulos can be reached at 914-271-6012. . . . Geffen national director of promotion Kevin Raybet exits, joining Elektra for Virginia, Baltimore, Washington, D.C., and eastern North Carolina regional duties. . . . Elektra's Atlanta-based regional, John McFadden, will work all stations east of Tennessee to Charlotte, N.C., and Charlotte-based regional Jennifer Sligh will relocate to Chicago. . . . San Francisco rep Scott Perlewitz segues from Geffen to Reprise.

Former Maverick promotion head Terry Anzaldo and brother Anthony Anzaldo launch artist-relations firm Good Guy Entertainment.

**DUSTING OFF THE RULEBOOK:** Sevendust's "Black" (TVT) spent 21 weeks on the active rock chart between November 1997 and April of this year. TVT has begun to work the track again due to positive research, and "Black" re-entered the active rock chart in the July 10 issue of Monitor. In the past six weeks, the track has continually increased in detections. Despite a slight decrease in spins this week (1.3%), the recurrent rule of removing titles below No. 20 after 26 weeks has been waived in this instance, and the track's progress will be re-evaluated weekly for current status.

**THAT'S WHY WE CALL IT ACTIVE:** Days Of The New's "The Down Town" (Outpost/Geffen) reclaims the top spot from Monster Magnet's "Space Lord" (A&M); combine that with a 6% increase for Creed's "What's This Life For" (Wind-Up) and you have three tracks reaching 1,200 spins for only the second time in the active rock chart's brief history. In the Oct. 31, 1997, issue of Monitor, Days Of The New's "Touch, Peel And Stand" and Creed's "My Own Prison" sandwiched the Foo Fighters' "Everlong" in the top three. And "The Down Town's" 1,280 spins this week is the year's second-highest weekly total, exceeded only by Pearl Jam's "Given To Fly," which tallied 1,284 spins in the Jan. 23 issue.

**SEVERAL YEARS AND 'ONE WEEK' TO SUCCESS:** Barenaked Ladies couldn't crack the modern top 20 last time out with "Brian Wilson," but with "One Week" (Reprise), they've already hit the No. 1 spot in 10 weeks.

**PANELS:** Added to the mainstream and heritage panels is WNEW New York (OM Garry Wall, MD Andrea Karr, 212-489-1027). There are now 111 mainstream and 61 heritage reporters.

### LEVERAGING CONSOLIDATED FORCES

A week after CBS pact with Pennzoil in an unprecedented advertising package covering all of CBS' holdings—radio, radio syndication, TV,

Country Airplay Monitor reports that execs at CBS Cable's CMT have met with most country label heads in an effort to land exclusive use of their top videos for a period of time, reports The (Nashville) Tennessean. In exchange, CMT is reportedly offering \$50,000 per video in advertising credits on any CBS medium.

## MONITOR PROFILE

### McNamara Keeps Modern WQBK Rockin' Hard In Tough Albany, N.Y., Market

**K**elli McNamara grew up, attended college, and then got most of her professional radio experience in the Albany, N.Y., area. So it was little wonder that once modern WQBK PD Dan Binder left, MD McNamara got the gig, given her in-depth knowledge of the market. Little wonder to all, maybe except McNamara herself. While serving as interim PD, she kept the station running, but, she says, "I wasn't thinking about being PD." After a lengthy search, GM David Arcara called her into his office in January. She recalls him saying, "You'll be glad to know this. We found the right person for the job." I was just so relieved. I thought, "Thank god. All this work." Because I'd been working crazy hours. I said, "Oh, really. Who is it?" And he said, "It's you." And I said, "What?"

McNamara reports initially being overwhelmed by juggling an air shift, MD duties, and planning the station's EdgeFest—which just wrapped a few weeks ago. "I already worked on Selector. I already did the jocks' schedules. I was already in management. So

that part wasn't hard," she says. "It was the meetings and dealing with sales all the time. And the conflict of what was good for programming and for sales. That was hard to adjust to."

McNamara made the adjustment quickly, though. An admitted control freak, she used that to her advantage, starting with newly arrived promotion director Jeremy Bosso, working with him to unclutter the station—concentrating on one promotion at a time—and increasing its street presence. "We rarely had the van out. We were doing remotes, but it was never out there. And that all changed . . . People were much more aware of the radio station. They saw the van out all the time. And that makes a big difference."

In addition, she says, "we were getting stale with our production." She worked with that department to freshen the station's imaging. Then she turned her attention to jocks who "hadn't been airchecked in ages" and were "getting a little too talky." After that, it was "changing music beds. Looking at every single element, listening to the radio station thinking, 'What can I do better? What can make it tighter?'"

Regarding sales, McNamara firmly believes that "everything is a sales opportunity, and we can sponsor everything"—music to her sales department's ears. She tries to be proactive in dealing with salespeople by meeting weekly to exchange ideas. "I let them know everything that I am doing in programming," she says. "And if there's something that's just come across the table, I'll go downstairs and tell them. That's the way it is. It's about communication and working together."

In McNamara's first report card, the WQBK/WQBJ simulcast has returned to form, 7.1-7.8-7.5-6.1-7.1, 12-plus. It's now fifth in the market and first among rock stations.

So how has a modern station come not only to dominate a market, but to do so with such huge numbers? "We're in upstate New York in

Albany, and this market loves rock," says McNamara. She traces that sentiment to her former employer, WPYX, which she says was the front-runner rock outlet going back to her childhood. "There had been other modern experiments in the market, but '80s alternative never really got big numbers in this market," she says. WPYX's success meant that Albany's heritage was rock. "People in this market know rock . . . They like guitars and drums. And they also want it to be current. They want new music, but they want new music that's not all synthesizer or too poppy. They want something with substance."

On the pop side, WQBK has seen triple-A rival WXLE move toward modern adult. "It's sharing a lot of our music, with the Goo Goo Dolls' 'Iris' and Green Day's 'Time Of Your Life' and the softer modern songs," she says. "That has been kind of weird to try to position ourselves in a way that they're not taking away . . . People are starting to notice that radio station and they're sharing some music and I just have to be aware of that."

But McNamara is not biting her nails over WXLE. After all, market rumors have it changing format shortly under new owners. And while there is some music sharing, McNamara says, at their foundations, WXLE and WQBK are very different stations. "We are rock . . . We're playing the Beastie Boys," she says of the act that has racked up multiple weeks at No. 1 on The Billboard 200 with its recent release. "No one else in this market is on that." In addition, "we're playing Soundgarden, STP, Pearl Jam, Alice In Chains. There's no sharing of those artists, really. 'XLE's not playing that, 'PYX is not playing a lot of that. And those are the core for us."

"I make sure that the foundation is there," McNamara adds. "It's just like making sure that when people are listening to the radio station, they're hearing what they want to hear. They're hearing what they know, and they love that they can sing along to it. And they're hearing the spice. I think of all the currents as the spice."

Does she see her role as making sure much of that spice is from career modern artists? "Well, that's the big question, isn't it?" she asks. "It's hard to be faithful and true to an artist when some of their singles may be mediocre . . . That becomes a problem, when you have pop songs like ['Flagpole Sitta' by] Harvey Danger" competing for a slot. "People want to turn on the radio, hear something that hits them, and they want to sing along with it and tap their foot. If that doesn't happen, they're going to [change] the station."

Here's a sample hour on WQBK: Pearl Jam, "Given To Fly"; Green Day, "Time of Your Life (Good Riddance)"; Possum Dixon, "Holding (Lenny's Song)"; Stone Temple Pilots, "Unplugged"; Local H, "All The Kids Are Right"; Nirvana, "Aneurysm"; Sponge, "Molly"; Garbage, "I Think I'm Paranoid"; Alice In Chains, "Down In A Hole"; Goo Goo Dolls, "Iris"; Everclear, "Everything To Everyone"; Beck, "Where It's At"; and Lenny Kravitz, "Are You Gonna Go My Way?"

Another key to McNamara's adjustment was the presence of Howard Stern on the station. "The transition would have been much harder with an in-house morning show," she says. Still, being a female programmer with Stern on the station also takes some getting used to. "As a woman, I don't agree with a lot of things he says personally, but as a programmer, I love having Howard Stern. He's very successful for us. He makes us a lot of money, and there's just no denying his success. There was that conflict initially, [but] I would rather have a very successful morning show like Howard Stern that's fresh and funny than a not-successful politically correct morning show." **MARC SCHIFFMAN**
