## Summer Brings Outdoor Concert Events—And Tales Of Disasters Past

With the first sultry breezes of the new season come the summer concert promotions. For many stations in all formats, these outdoor concert events are the highlight of the year in terms of publicity and listener participation. Promotion directors plan for months in advance to secure locations, confirm performers, establish ticket-distribution channels, rent equipment, and set up remote broadcasting facilities.

But as the old saying goes, the best-laid plans of mice and men can often go awry. Despite stations' best efforts, unforeseen circumstances can turn summer jams into frustrating, surprising, and even scary experiences.

### WEATHER OR NOT

Of course, one of the major variables

at an outdoor event is the weather. Kellie Shipp, marketing director of top 40 KKRZ Portland, Ore., recalls that two years ago at the station's Last Chance Summer Dance concert, lightning struck the bridge under which Kool & the Gang was performing during a torrential downpour, making a huge noise and "scaring the hell out of everyone," Shipp says. Luckily, the power stayed on, and the band kept playing.

Country WPOC Baltimore promotion director Sheila Silverstein worked for five months to put together a concert and "balloon glow" that was thwarted by bad weather earlier this month. Plans called for 25 hot-air balloons to light up the evening sky after two performers. Four thousand listeners showed up just as a thunderstorm hit. A jock told the crowd that the safest place to be was in their cars and to tune in to the station for an announcement before con-

### Monitor Editor Dragged Kicking And Screaming Into The '90s: Film At 11

**T**his isn't going to help cement my image as a cutting-edge, trend-conscious, forward-thinking guy, but I just discovered music video.

OK, rediscovered music video. My junior and senior years of college were the first two years of MTV, meaning that I have a greater familiarity with "That's The Way That It Is" by Uriah Heep than most folks, but I've somehow managed to live without cable (or a VCR) since leaving student housing 14 years ago, meaning that my access to music video was limited to hotel rooms and friends' apartments.

I'd thought about acquiring cable and a VCR, but they were on the list below electricity and indoor plumbing. Besides, my cable system has never had Country Music Television and recently booted the Box, removing a lot of my impetus to get cable. Then the Box became available for free via the miracle of low-powered TV. Since then, I've been watching the Box for long stretches of time, the way that folks watched MTV at its inception.

Here's what I've realized:

1. If you're 33 years old and in the industry, the Box is a pretty good way to keep up with new R&B and hip-hop music without doing a lot of work. There are a lot of new songs on the Box that are still in my "to play" pile at work. And having titles flashed on screen is a lot more convenient than thumbing through the Power Playlists, trying to guess what I'm hearing, and somehow makes some street rap more accessible for me. This won't be a new discovery for anybody else, but it's one that I'm making now.

2. At the recent Impact R&B industry convention in Nashville, there was a lot of discussion about whether the Box was trying to downplay its reputation as a hip-hop channel. The network's official line is that it's always added everything and let the viewers decide. Compared to 1992-93, which was the last time I spent any significant amount of time with the Box, there appears to be more imaging around modern

rock artists, including some new music promos that feature only modern rock titles. In midtown Manhattan, however, what gets played is almost entirely R&B and rap, save an occasional "Amish Paradise" or Marilyn Manson video.

3. Unless every record person in town is calling to play their own videos (and I know at least one who does), then viewers pick up on new music faster than we think, and not only reaction records. There's other evidence that listeners don't always react as we believe. For those who believe that only East Coast rap gets over in New York, I've seen "Tha Crossroads"—which isn't on New York radio—played three times in 70 minutes one evening. (Same goes for Quad City DJs.) And for those who believe that the poppier-leaning R&B records don't get over with R&B fans, I've seen an awful lot of 3T and J'son between the hip-hop videos. (The common denominator seems to be that they're both teen-idol records, since I see a lot of Quindon and Immature, too.)

Does music video cut into a listener's radio time? After years of being told by music channels that it does not, I can attest that my Box time has tended to take place when I wouldn't have the radio on—usually early mornings or late nights, when I'm attempting to find something on TV and being reminded of why I haven't watched TV for years. There's still the alarm clock and the office for radio listening, especially since New York radio is in flux again. So relax, friends. I haven't switched loyalties.

There is, however, a buddy of mine who just got satellite TV and the audio channels that come with it. He now has buttons for country oldies, show tunes, '70s oldies, '80s oldies, jazz, top 40, and a half-dozen other things that aren't commercially available in his market. He has, by and large, given up conventional radio. Fortunately, there's no room for a mini-dish on my building's roof. So we won't have this test of my loyalty anytime soon.

ing back. Attendees sat in their cars for an hour and 45 minutes before the storm cleared. The concert went on, but because of the late start, it didn't end until after 10 p.m., and, Silverstein says, "no balloons glowed that night."

Country KEEY (K102) Minneapolis' afternoon host Donna Valentine learned about the dangers of gusty winds at last year's Fan Jam. Valentine was onstage talking to the crowd in front of an eight-foot-high booth the station was using to play the game show "Name That Country Tune" between acts. According to promotion director John Nelson, "a big gust of wind knocked over the booth, which hit [Valentine] in the head, knocked her out, and knocked her offstage. It stopped the concert until the ambulance came."

Valentine spent most of the concert in the emergency room, getting 10 stitches in her head. Upon returning to work at the station, she turned the mishap into a two-week running bit that included having the paramedic who helped her come to the station to deliver a helmet. "We had some fun with something that wasn't really funny," Nelson says.

At this year's Fan Jam, scheduled for Sept. 14, Valentine plans to come out in a hard hat, accompanied by medical technicians, perhaps on a stretcher. Nelson says that at this year's event, the game-show booth will be secured to the stage.

Sometimes it's heat that can wreak havoc on a show. Sharon Klein, marketing director for R&B KKBT (the Beat) Los Angeles, says the station's outdoor Summer Jam at local Irvine Meadows frequently gets local headlines that mention the temperature, not the acts. "The first year we did it, it was brutally hot, but the... concertgoers dealt with it. We didn't lose anybody to fainting or anything [but] the reviewers from the general media said, 'Why did they have to pick the hottest day of the year?' and 'The lemonade line was too long'—like it was something we could control."

### STAR TURNS

Performers can be a temperamental and unpredictable lot, as many station-event coordinators have found out.

When triple-A WXRT Chicago hired the Replacements to headline the station's annual Fourth of July free concert in the city's Grant Park, no one could have predicted the outcome. "It was their absolute last concert ever," says PD Norm Winer. "They broke up before our very eyes."

The band had been on the road for a while, extending its tour to include the WXRT show. "They went down in a blaze of glory," Winer recalls. "As the set went on, there was more tension, animosity, and antagonism. When they left the stage for the encore, they handed their instruments to the DJs, who didn't know what to do... The band just stormed out and left. As it happened, the roadies went out and played the encore."

KMEL San Francisco marketing director Katie Eyerly has survived nine KMEL Summer Jams, with No. 10 set for Aug. 3. Eyerly's advice: Never make your show a two-day event. KMEL tried it for two years, "and that nearly killed us," she says. "We'd booked about 22 acts on each day, and naturally, every act was booked on a tight performance time line." Because of the number of performers, backstage dressing-room space was at a premium, forcing KMEL to utilize a convoy of limos to shuttle artists to the venue with military precision.

Eyerly recalls the limo driver going to pick up an artist for a set, only to find that the artist had disappeared to go shopping. Another well-known female artist refused to get in the limo because her nails were not yet dry. "We've had track artists who have shown up and forgotten to bring the DAI with their backing tracks," recalls Eyerly, resulting in an unscheduled dash to Tower Records to buy the album.

Missing DAIs have caused problems for artists at R&B WKVV Milwaukee's Summer Jam, says MD Lauri Jones. "Last year, M.C. Breed forgot to bring his DAI, so he had to go out there and do a dry thing, a cappella," she says. "Another time, the group Kut Klose went onstage, but their tape was cued to the middle of the song. They got booed."

KKBT's Klein recalls a few other artist-related incidents: "In 1994, Jamie Foxx [formerly of TV's "In Living Color"] tried to beat up a security guard who was taking away his video camera... The in-

cident made it to the paper," says Klein. Then last year, performances by a pair of big-name rap groups were impaired by the fact that "a couple of the members were arrested," she says.

According to Monica Starr, PD of hip-hop WEJM (106 Jams) Chicago, rap group Onyx generated some surprise and anger at a Back to School Jam in Chicago when the group decided to pour water on the crowd. While this cool-down tactic would have been perfect at a hot outdoor show, this was indoors, and moisture wreaks havoc on those elaborate, just-for-the-concert hair styles. "You know people had just gotten their 'dos done, and they were mad!" she says.

### COME ONE, COME ALL

No matter how many security precautions are taken, how meticulous the planning, or how thoroughly rules are communicated, KMEL's Eyerly says it's inevitable that some young artist, caught up in the sea of love while onstage, will blurt out, "You're a beautiful audience, and you're all invited to the after-party at [insert name of top-secret, swanky hotel where all the artists are staying]."

Then there's backstage crowd control. WEJM's Starr recalls, "At our Back to School Jam... we had an entourage backstage that kept growing until it grew onto the stage. Acts were performing with a backdrop of people."

Thanks to today's home-computer technology, the forgery of backstage passes has become rampant. It's now possible for someone to arrive at the show, get a quick look at a pass, then run home and punch out a close approximation on their color copier and laminating machine, says Eyerly. KMEL and many other stations have had to stay a step ahead by using expensive holographic passes.

Eyerly recalls one pre-holograph year, when KMEL held a 90-minute, pre-show backstage party for contest winners and clients, the only time anyone from the public was to be allowed backstage. "Literally hundreds more people than we anticipated suddenly appeared backstage, crammed together and spilling out the exits," she says. Eyerly soon realized that those extra people were wearing forged laminated passes, causing security to clear everyone out of the backstage area.

### BELIEVE IT OR NOT

Then there are stories that defy categorization. Equipment problems, location snafus, gimmicks that don't work, and other variables can drastically upset the concert equation.

Gregg Steele programs album rock WZLX Miami. But when he worked on the West Coast, he was part of a massive promotion that shipped 300-400 listeners to Cabo Wabo, Mexico, for a three-day festival of music headlined by Alice In Chains. Almost nothing went right. First, some of the other acts on the bill ran afoul of the local constabulary over illegal substances. The labels had brought in radio folks from around the country, and, Steele says, "we had visiting PDs that disappeared. They literally wandered off and were missing for days."

Worse were the Mexican rentals, old VW vans with no air-conditioning. In 102-degree weather, it was Steele's job to ferry artists from airport to hotel, a 20-mile trek down one-lane dirt roads. A similarly rocky 20-mile journey lay between the hotel and the venue for soundchecks. In all the frenzy, Steele misread the gas gauge and ran out of gas after dropping off his last band halfway between airport and hotel on an abandoned stretch of road in the middle of the night. Steele was alone in the dark and didn't know a word of Spanish.

One year, KMEL had jocks make a grand entrance onstage. "Someone wanted to have [then morning man] Bill Lee ride in on an elephant," says Eyerly. Several thousand dollars later, KMEL located an elephant that had to be trucked in from Southern California. It was quickly discovered that the elephant was too heavy for the stage, so Lee, complete with Aladdin-style garb and cheesy music, had to ride it down the center aisle of the venue. After taking that budget hit, Eyerly and staff decided to let future jocks just walk onstage.

Unforeseen circumstances don't stop stations from planning mega-concert events. Stations stress that the entertainment value and the money raised for charity are the bottom line.

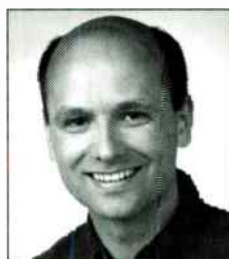
### Whatever Its Format, WKTI Can Dance The Macarena With Barenaked Ladies

**W**KTI Milwaukee has been the center of Danny Clayton's radio universe since 1982, give or take the 10 months he spent as PD of WBZZ (B94) Pittsburgh in 1990.

Clayton got his first taste of radio at age 15 in exotic Escanaba, Mich. Block-programmed WDBC was adult standards by day and had a rudimentary top 40 format by night. "Our night guy qualified as the grizzled veteran on the staff, having already worked in a large market [Lansing, Mich.]," says Clayton. "He fashioned together something of a format clock, and since the station had no record service, we used to pull the music off the Casey Kasem show. We would cut Casey's intros off and do quick fades at the end before he started talking again."

Clayton dropped out and turned pro during his junior year and got his first real break in 1978 at WSPF Stevens Point, Mich., the fertile breeding ground of Pat Martin, Don Geronimo, Chris Shebel, Terry Gibson, Jeff Rowe, Kevin Kenney, and many other radio notables.

Clayton returned to Beer City as PD of WKTI in 1991, when Mike Berlak moved up to the OM spot. "WKTI has always been a very curi-

ous station," Clayton says. In the mid-'80s, WKTI was a rock-based top 40, the radio home to Def Leppard, Journey, Bon Jovi, and other Midwestern faves.

When Clayton returned from Pittsburgh, the station began to lean more adult. "Dance music had become Janet Jackson and Bobby Brown, and with the rise of rap music, we began to see a real disparity between the strength of our morning show and the rest of station," Clayton says. "Management wanted [WKTI] to become a more viable adult business." In '95, WKTI went through the same modernization process as most hot AC/adult top 40s. In the winter Arbitron survey, it was up 6.2-7.2 12-plus, making it No. 4 overall and No. 2 25-54. "We swept every female demo starting at 18-24, with 25-34 being our sweet spot," he says. "The longevity and the more adult skew of the morning show also allows us to perform strongly up to the 44 demo."

Here's a recent 2 p.m. hour on WKTI: Spin Doctors, "Two Princes"; Jann Arden, "Insensitive"; Genesis, "Invisible Touch"; Barenaked Ladies, "Shoe Box"; Foreigner, "Feels Like The First Time"; Robert Miles, "Children"; Bruce Hornsby, "Across The River"; Del Amitri, "Roll To Me"; Stevie Nicks and Tom Petty, "Stop Draggin' My Heart Around"; George Michael, "Fastlove"; Seal, "Crazy"; and Celine Dion, "Because You Loved Me."

The morning team, Reitman and Mueller, has been in place for 15 years. "They're local, topical, and sound unproduced," says Clayton. "Bob Reitman is a former AOR jock: a poetry-reading, Pink Floyd-MCing 54-year-old with grown children. He's the Dick Purtan of Milwaukee." The show features producer Gino Salomone,

whom Clayton describes as "well connected, and [he] has interviewed celebrities like Mel Gibson and Sandra Bullock," and Gene Miller, "the fastest, funniest person I know; a burpin', fartin', regular guy, and a rabid sports fan." Freelance writer Joe Queenan, who contributes to People, GQ, Esquire, and Movieline, is a regular guest.

Clayton points to MD/midday jock Leonard Peace as an example of a true radio success story. "Leonard is the 11th of 12 children, started here as an intern at age 17, and scrapped his way out of the inner city. He quickly moved up to weekend/overnights, morning traffic reporter, night jock, and now MD and middays."

Afternoon personality Jim "Lips" Labelle has been with the station since 1982. According to Clayton, WKTI is one of the few stations in the format with afternoon news. "We're in the same building as the NBC-TV affiliate, so anchor Mike Jacobs does the hourly headlines and hangs out, having fun with us," he says.

WKTI night jock Luke Sanders doubles as production director. Cue up another Clayton sports analogy: "Luke was a fifth-round draft pick and is destined to be in the Pro Bowl some day. When I found him, he was out of work in Muskegon, Mich., and he sent me this screaming, high-energy 'Yo, yo, yo' top 40 aircheck." Clayton remembers sitting through the tape and hearing "one break that was exactly what I was looking for." The overnight shift is split between utility player Kyle Christopher and rookie Jason Ryan, who's been known to do off-the-wall stuff, such as giving away movie tickets in the street in front of the station over a cellular phone at 3 a.m.

Promotions director John Reynolds started at WKTI at age 16. After programming elsewhere, he returned to WKTI three years ago. "He lights the promo flame for us," says Clayton. Promotions assistant Lisa Letterman is on the air noon-2 p.m. and does weekends at WTMX Chicago.

Clayton says WKTI's unique staff chemistry and long heritage makes the station tough for a competitor to figure out and even tougher to beat. "Competing research companies constantly check us out," he says. "They're always positive they can beat us, but they never do. It's not about beating us with 'more music, less talk,' it's trying to beat the whole package."

Clayton says WKTI's history as a former full-blown top 40 gives it additional latitude with music, contesting, and personality. "Because of the 'top 40-ness' of WKTI, we can play stuff like 'Macarena' and new artists like Barenaked Ladies," he says. Given today's more sound-driven adult radio, when someone asks, "Who are they?; who cares? It's wonderful music," he says.

"Those Star and Mix stations have a tougher time because they have no past," Clayton adds. That top 40 latitude allows WKTI to run such specialty programming as the syndicated "Open House Party" on Saturday nights. "It's radically different from our regular programming," he says, "but just as 'Saturday Night Live' is radically different from 'Meet The Press,' they both belong on NBC." (Editor's note: "Meet The Press" is usually funnier.)

Owner Journal Broadcast Group is now in an acquisition mode and is targeting medium markets, having recently bought stations in Tucson, Ariz., and Omaha, Neb. "I have great bosses who let me do my thing," Clayton says. "There's no finger-pointing, only problem-solving."

VP/GM Kris Foate has been aboard nearly four years. "She's an attorney by education, she's calm, and she's a real fan of this station."

Although WKTI is not your textbook screaming top 40 outlet, with former rival WLFM now modern rock, "we are top 40 by default," says Clayton. "Even if another top 40 moved in, they couldn't beat this package." **KEVIN CARTER**

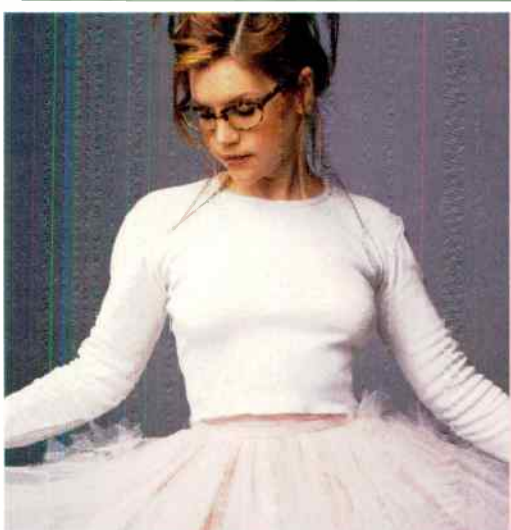

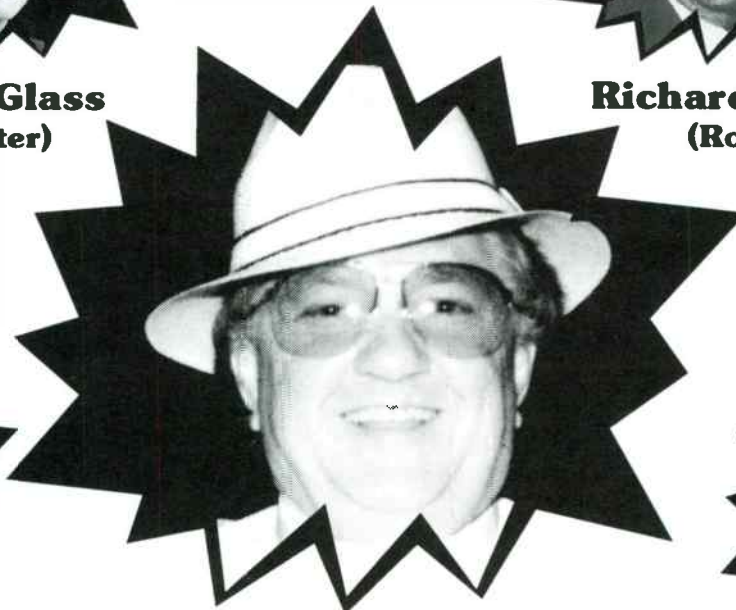
