Top 40 Has Worst Numbers In Seven Years In Monitor Winter Arbitron Study

How bad was it for top 40 radio this winter? Well, according to Airplay Monitor's exclusive national Arbitron ratings study, based on results from the 84 continuous-measurement markets, top 40 posted its worst numbers in the seven years we've been compiling national ratings, falling to sixth place 8.8-7.2 12-plus in the winter. In addition, top 40 has lost more than 50% of its market share since 1989.

Top 40's troubles seem to have been good news for everybody else:

- The increasingly rock-based AC format rebounded from seven consecutive down books, 14.1-15.0, which ties the shares that the format posted in winter '95. AC remained second only to news/talk (16.9-16.5) nationally.

- R&B radio, boosted by a slew of gold and platinum releases that many top 40 stations wouldn't touch, posted its third consecutive up book, 9.8-10.7, and tied its best-ever book.

- Modern rock radio, which had grown slowly over the past six

months, is again moving at a nice clip, up 3.9-4.4, while album rock stayed flat at 7.7, suggesting that most of modern's growth took place at top 40's expense. Classic rock, which is seeing an influx of new outlets that were '70s stations, rose slightly, 3.4-3.6.

WAIT, IT GETS WORSE

Some frightening facts.

- Top 40 is down 2 shares from its 9.2 of a year ago; it lost 1.6 shares this time, its largest single-book drop ever.

- Top 40's current 7.2 share is less than half of its 15.9 share of spring '89. At that point, top 40 was the second-most-listened-to format nationwide. Now it's No. 6, having surrendered the No. 5 spot to album rock.

- The format was down 8.2-6.5 in mornings, 6.9-5.9 in middays, 9.7-7.8 in afternoons, and 12.5-10.0 in nights. It was off 13.1-10.9 in 18-34, 6.8-5.8 in 25-54, and 4.1-3.5 in 35-64.

- Top 40 has been as high as a 7 share in the 35-64 demo since na-

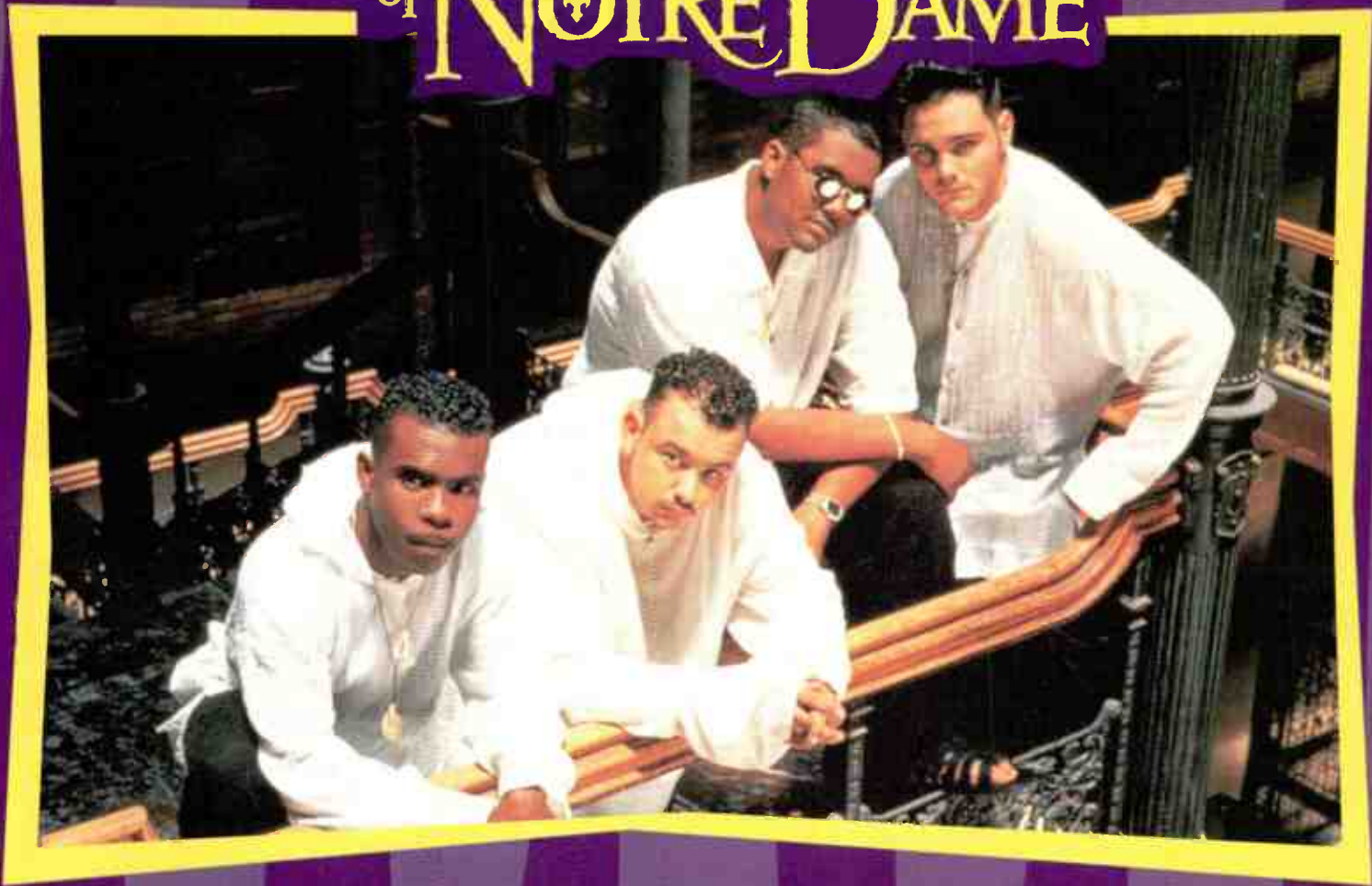

TOP 40 TOPICS BY SEAN ROSS

In Search Of The 'Strange Way' Of The '90s

Nearly six months ago, Rock Airplay Monitor managing editor **John Loscalzo** launched his weekly column in that publication with the "classic rock-to-modern rock conversion chart," his guide to '90s artists and their '60s/'70s equivalents, for example, "Smashing Pumpkins = Pink Floyd, Hootie & the Blowfish = Doobie Brothers, Marilyn Manson = Kiss," etc. About the time that John and I were talking about how the column should really be something deeper and more analytical—like, well, this column—someone stuck his head in the door with the first compliment.

Since then, John has gotten four columns out of the concept, with readers faxing in their own lists. Besides having to admit that I was wrong about John's column, I figure that given the amount of mileage this column has gotten out of "then and now" parallels, I can probably milk at least one week's column out of the concept, too.

Here, then, is the late-'70s/early-'80s-to-mid-'90s conversion chart, with one major modification—I decided to compare today's hits with the individual songs, not artists, that served the same function at the time. Since many of today's artists have already made it to their second hit, and since a lot of 1977-80 artists never got there, this is *not* a comment on the durability of the artist. It is also worth noting that most of these should be taken as compliments, since I reverse 90% of the oldies in question. (I am, for that reason, *not* mentioning the current record that strongly recalls "You Take My Breath Away" by **Rex Smith**, although I'll be curious to know if you figure it out.) Today's hits are first, followed by their spiritual predecessors:

Tony Rich Project, "Nobody Knows"; **Commodores**, "Sail On"/"Still."

Green Day, "When I Come Around"; **Knack**, "My Sharona."

Hootie & the Blowfish, "Only Wanna Be With You"; Doobie Brothers, "What A Fool Believes."

Hootie & the Blowfish, "Old Man & Me"; Doobie Brothers, "Real Love."

Brandy, "Sittin' Up In My Room"; **Stacy Lattisaw**, "Let Me Be Your Angel"—besides the talented teen parallel, there's the uphill struggle each faced at top 40 during an R&B backlash and the fact that each had several solid R&B hits that top 40 overlooked before breaking through.

Jewel, "Who Will Save Your Soul"; **Rickie Lee Jones**, "Chuck E's In Love"—you could also make the same case for "Chuck E's" and **Joan Osborne's** "One Of Us." The biggest difference is that "Chuck E's" exploded out of the box in an era when female folkies weren't a regular part of the landscape. So why did Jewel, in this more enlightened era, need a year and a half?

Collective Soul, "December"; **Firefall**, "Strange Way"—two deceptively mellow records with a lot of venom at the core. And it's not as if rock stations didn't play Firefall at the time or AC stations don't play Collective Soul now.

The Fugees, "Killing Me Softly"; **Club Nouveau**, "Lean On Me"—I'm slightly out of era with Club Nouveau here. The only real difference is that in 1986-87, top 40 PDs were looking for this type of record instead of having to be clubbed over the head with the evidence.

The Fugees, "No Woman, No Cry"; **Blondie**, "The Tide Is High."

Tracy Chapman, "Give Me One Reason"; **Gordon Lightfoot**, "Sundown"—again, I'm a few years off, but they're very similar grooves.

Blues Traveler, "Run-Around"; **Sanford-**

Townshend Band, "Smoke From A Distant Fire"—you could also make a case for **Atlanta Rhythm Section's** "So In To You."

Folk Implosion, "Natural One"; **Sniff 'n' the Tears**, "Driver's Seat."

Groove Theory, "Tell Me"; **Luther Vandross**, "Never Too Much"—two more records with very pop sensibilities that weren't treated that way during the respective backlashes.

D'Angelo, "Brown Sugar"/"Lady"; **Prince**, "Soft & Wet"/"I Wanna Be Your Lover"—one of the few cases where the artist parallel works better than either individual song. Like D'Angelo, the artist then known as Prince had already made his reputation as a young gun at R&B radio well before top 40 took notice.

Ace Of Base, "Lucky Love"; **Abba**, "Does Your Mother Know."

Toadies, "Possum Kingdom"; **Billy Thorpe**, "Children Of The Sun"—two rock anthems each powered by a jackhammer riff. Most of the top 40 stations willing to play Thorpe were borderline rock outlets; most of those that played the Toadies were borderline modern rockers.

Tracy Bonham, "Mother"; **Heart**, "Barracuda"—tough female rock records that didn't seem like the sort of thing top 40 would play, but became anthems. (You could also compare Bonham to **John Lennon's** "Mother," the original 30-years-of-rage-in-three-minutes song.) Agree or not, it's still better than hearing Bonham compared to **Alanis Morissette** again!

Quad City DJ's, "C'mon N' Ride It (The Train)"; **Mass Production**, "Firecracker";

Freedy Johnston, "Bad Reputation"; **Ian Gomm**, "I Hold On"—I have also, on previous occasion, compared "Bad Rep" to **Steve Forbert's** "Romeo's Tune," another unlikely escapee from Folk City.

Live, "Lightning Crashes"; **Kansas**, "Dust In The Wind"—even though they draw radically different conclusions about the circle of life.

There are just as many parallels that elude me, at least at the hour when this column is usually written. Where, for example, are the medium-weight pop/rock records? Even amid the modern-to-top 40 crossovers, there's no great-sounding car-radio record at the moment that's nearly as friendly and unassuming as "Don't Bring Me Down." Morissette is today's most consistent pop/rock hitmaker; and "Hand In My Pocket" was certainly amiable, but her hits are considerably more ambitious than the sort of records I have in mind.

Dance revival or no dance revival, it's hard to find a "Good Times" or "I Will Survive" for the '90s. There *are* quality dance records, but anthems? (I can't remember quite how long it took for "Good Times" or "I Will Survive" to be recognized as records for the ages either. Plenty of folks would have granted those songs that distinction right away; they'd just have to be weighed against those who hated disco altogether.)

I'm also not quite sure what late-'70s niche "Macarena" fills. The most obvious parallel is to **Marcia Griffiths'** mid-'80s "Electric Boogie," another line-dance record that ended up being reissued at the behest of thousands of satisfied office-party guests. The original disco era was full of novelties, but almost all of them came out of the disco underground at some point. These days, there is a massive difference between what they play downtown (where the jocks play lots of dubs and very few lyrics) and what they play at weddings—which is probably why we've had so few dance hits for the last several years.

Fullam Commutes To KTU; WTIC Shake-Up

WKQI (Q95.5) Detroit GM **John Fullam** transfers to the VP/GM post at **WKTU** New York. He will commute throughout the summer while the search for his replacement continues.

With the sale to ARS done, **WTIC-FM** Hartford, Conn., PD **Paul Cannon** exits, along with the **Kelly and Kline** morning show. Vet programmer **Bill Stairs** is now OM for **WTIC-AM-FM**, with the FM reportedly continuing to evolve in an adult direction. As was tipped last week, **Gary Craig** returns to mornings from '70s sister **WEGQ** Boston. **Suzanne McDonald**, GM of ARS Hartford properties **WZMX/WRCH/WNEZ**, picks up **WTIC**. Sales manager **Jodi Long** is named station manager. Longtime morning traffic guy **Roger Stafford** is out.

Former **WMTX** (Mix 96) Tampa, Fla., PD/morning guy **Mason Dixon** indeed ends up at rival **WUSA**, not only for mornings, replacing **Bob and Judd**, but replacing PD **Pat McMahon**. Former **WMTX** MD **Rico Blanco** replaces MD **Johnny Michaels**. Mainstream AC **WUSA** becomes hot AC Kiss FM. Here's a sample: **Hall & Oates**, "I Can't Go For That"; **Natalie Merchant**, "Carnival"; **a-ha**, "Take On Me"; **Michael Bolton**, "Steel Bars"; **Celine Dion**, "Because You Loved Me"; **Dan Hartman**, "I Can Dream About You"; **Hootie & the Blowfish**, "Time"; and **Kool & the Gang**, "Celebration."

Clear Channel, which owns 21% of Hefel Broadcasting, buys the rest for \$275 million.

WEDJ (the Edge) Charlotte, N.C., changes its moniker to **WNKS** (Kiss 95.1). **WNKS** is using the same nickname and logo as that market's former **WCKZ** (Kiss 102).

KHKS Dallas APD/MD/midday jock **Mr. Ed Lambert** has been officially named interim PD. **KGOR** Omaha, Neb., PD **Bryan Jackson** is the new PD of AC **KYMX** Sacramento, Calif.

KRBE Houston PD **John Peake** hires **KDGE** Dallas MD **Jay Michaels** as MD.

Atlantic Broadcasting corporate PD/OM **Dave Baker** exits to be a trainer for Scott Studios, maker of broadcast hard-drive automation used by Baker for Atlantic's **WJMX** Florence, S.C. **WJMX** PD **Keith Mitchell** replaces Baker. Former **WHYN-FM** Springfield, Mass., PD

Bill Hess is the new regional VP of programming and operations for Commodore Media, based at **WKHL** Stamford, Conn.

Chris Kampmeier is now VP of programming for Paxson's Orlando, Fla., stations.

Top 40 **CKZZ** (Z95.3) Vancouver's new GM is **Gary Russell** from co-owned **CJAY** Calgary, Alberta. Russell's replacement is veteran PD **Pat Holiday** from top 40/adult **CJFM** Montreal. Holiday's replacement at **CJFM** will be promotion director **Martin Spalding**. Also, longtime **CJFM** MD **Henry VanDenHoogen** exits to join Sony as its Montreal rep.

Top 40 **WFGM** Morgantown, W.Va., goes country this week as part of a three-way change that sees country duopartner **WKKW** moving onto its frequency. **WKKW** goes classic rock as **WFBY** (the Bureau). Seventies oldies **WSSN** goes top 40 under new PD **Mike Bradley**, who was promotions director.

Gary Waldron's new Salt Lake City station, currently standards **KRGO**, will have a relationship with his old stations. Crosstown **KUTQ/KZHT** will handle sales for the new station when it hits the air later this month.

Former **WBBM** (B96) Chicago p.m. driver **Gary Spears** launches a nightly six-hour hot AC overnight show that will be available from SuperRadio beginning June 15.

Mike Stiles, formerly of **Bob and Mike** (ex-**KHFI** Austin, Texas, **WDCG** Raleigh, N.C.), is named morning producer at **WSTR** (Star 94) Atlanta, replacing **Shawn Dion**, now morning sidekick at **WPNT** Chicago.

Tony "Wild Child" Hamilton exits nights at **KRQQ** Tucson, Ariz. PD **Mark Todd** needs nights/overnights replacements... **KSFM** Sacramento, Calif., night jock **Naughty Boy** has left the building; overnight jock **J.B. tional measurement. Now, it leads only modern rock, classical, adult standards, and religion in that demo, trailing even jazz/AC.

• As for teens, top 40, which only fell below the one-third mark in teen listening a year ago, now falls below a 25 share, going 31.5-24.9, which leaves it barely ahead of R&B radio, which was up 20.5-24.5 in teens. (Modern, classic, and album rock have a 22.9 share in teens among them.)

The only other format that got hit on the same scale as top 40 was country, which fell 12.1-11.0 for its lowest share since winter '91.

SO WHAT HAPPENED?

One explanation is that it's winter. Top 40 doesn't traditionally do well in cold weather. N/I radio usually does, and while it couldn't match its fall "O.J. verdict" numbers, that format was still ahead of its numbers from the previous, milder winter and from its pre-verdict summer book. AC also tends to do well in colder weather.

Another explanation is that top 40 continued to lose stations in the winter, and it has usually been the case that when top 40 outlets go away, remaining top 40 stations don't pick up the listening. Top 40 was down 12 stations this book, although, to be fair, so was AC.

There's probably more to it than outside factors, however: Many top 40 PDs have decided to make medium-weight modern rock crossovers the core sound of their station in the past 15-24 months. If you look at the 18-34 demo, in which top 40 lost more than 2 shares, AC had a 1.5-share gain, R&B radio had a 1.2-share boost in that demo, while modern was up only six-tenths of a share. That suggests that while PDs keep their eyes on modern, listeners who are coming to top 40 for other sounds are now being forced to use multiple formats for variety.

That would particularly seem to be the case for R&B radio, which has gone 9.2-9.1-9.5-9.8-10.7 in the past year. R&B had its best-ever share in all demos and dayparts. R&B continues to accomplish this despite the growth of

jazz/AC, which targets R&B's upper-demo listeners.

Not coincidentally, R&B radio had gold- and platinum-selling releases this winter from Joe, Busta Rhymes, D'Angelo, R. Kelly, and Chantay Savage that were not embraced fully by top 40. In addition, many top 40/crossover stations downplayed R&B to solidify their Hispanic base. While that may have stunted some of Spanish's 18-34 growth, it seems to have alienated R&B fans.

THE ADULT TOP 40 SYNDROME

During the fall, it was starting to look as if hot AC's increasingly modern-flavored approach wasn't such a good idea. AC was on its seventh consecutive down book, including teens and the 18-34 demo, for which the "much more Hootie" approach should've borne fruit.

But this winter, AC rebounded to its shares of a year ago. It was up 13.2-14.4 in mornings, 16.5-17.5 in middays, 14.5-15.5 in afternoons, and 12.0-12.8 in nights. AC was up 7.0-7.7 in teens, 14.0-15.5 in 18-34, 16.2-17.7 in 25-54, and 16.6-17.7 in 35-64. Among women, the format was up 18.5-19.3. Among men, it was up 10.7-11.8.

Notably, AC was a little ahead of where it was this time a year ago among men and 25-54 adults. It was a point ahead of its winter '95 share in 18-34. It was a few tenths off from its share a year ago among women and in the 35-64 demo. This suggests that the new, more modern-based AC format is slightly younger and more male. It also implies that AC, and not top 40 and rock, is where upper demos are going for Blues Traveler and Hootie & the Blowfish.

MODERN LOVE

As for modern rock, it, too, seems to be taking most of its listeners this time from top 40, not from album rock, which was flat at 7.7. Modern was up 10.2-12.6 in teens, meaning that despite modern's attempt to portray itself as an 18-34 format without many teens, 12-18 has been its best demo since summer '94. Album rock, which also claims not to care about teens, had an 8 share in that demo.

How about Spanish-language radio? The good news for crossover PDs is that Spanish, which leveled slightly this time (5.9-5.6), had its biggest hit in 18-34 (7.3-6.8), the demo that many top 40s were trying to protect. The bad news, again, is that if top 40/crossover stations were able to again endear themselves to some younger Hispanics, they did so at the apparent expense of R&B fans.

MONITOR PROFILE

KHOM Finds A Home In New Orleans With Mainstream Top 40 That Reflects Market

In the late '80s, KHOM, licensed to Houma, La., halfway between New Orleans and Baton Rouge, La., thought it had found a franchise in those markets with satellite oldies. Then New Orleans and Baton Rouge got their own oldies FMs, and KHOM was a Houma station again.

KHOM tried going local; it was too late. It tried '70s oldies, then New Orleans and Baton Rouge got their own '70s stations. Then in January '95, KHOM's antenna was struck by lightning, knocking it off the air for nearly two months. (One repairman needed a rescue team to unfreeze him from the tower.) Now, KHOM wasn't showing in New Orleans at all.

When KHOM returned, PD Bill Thorman signed it on as top 40/adult Mix 104.1, targeting listeners disenfranchised by longtime top 40 WEZB (B97) New Orleans' evolution to a modern rock/talk hybrid, then all-talk. Suburban KLRZ (Z100), which also had its sights on former B97 listeners, was making a run at New Orleans with top 40 but was unable to crack a 1 share. In September, as B97 finished its transition, Mix 104.1 moved to mainstream top 40.

The results? In the winter Arbitron, Mix crack-

No. 16 or 20. I don't want to do whatever it was that caused them to be No. 20." When he dayparts, it's to take older records out of nights, rather than to keep newer or edgier titles out of middays.

He also pays attention to lyrics. "Words are very important right now. There are songs that women are writing, such as 'Wonder' or 'Ironic,' that men could never have written. No man would've written... 'meeting the man of my dreams, then meeting his beautiful wife.' Before, it was always men writing 'I love you baby and I'm gonna marry you.' Now, songs like 'Insensitive' and 'Give Me One Reason' are putting women's... emotions at the forefront."

Here's Mix 104.1 in p.m. drive: Tracy Chapman, "Give Me One Reason"; Donna Lewis, "I Love You Always Forever"; Melissa Etheridge, "I'm The Only One"; Bone Thugs-N-Harmony, "Tha Crossroads"; Whitney Houston, "Exhale (Shoop Shoop)"; Jamn Arden, "Insensitive"; Los Del Rio, "Macarena"; Lenny Kravitz, "Can't Get You Off My Mind"; Hootie & the Blowfish, "Hold My Hand"; and Fugees, "Killing Me Softly."

After a yearlong evolution, Thorman says KHOM is where he wants it to be musically. The issue now is "attention and awareness." A year ago, he says, no station in town was contesting heavily. Now, thanks to label-sponsored promos, KHOM has managed to become the contest station. Thorman says, despite its lack of a promo budget, (Mix's outside marketing has consisted of only a few bus cards and billboards.) KHOM has given away six cars, and it gives away a concert trip every week, including trips to Las Vegas and Los Angeles for Alanis Morissette Month in May.

All KHOM's contesting, Thorman says, has been used to achieve the station's goals beyond merely expanding time spent listening. "When we needed to have people talk about the station, we told them to tell a friend to listen and gave away a trip for two to Universal Studios. When we [segued to top 40], nobody had heard top 40 music for two or three years. So by using our car giveaway to spotlight certain songs, by the end of the contest, everybody had a list of songs they were familiar with and associated with the station even when they heard them somewhere else.

"There are 32 parades in New Orleans during Mardi Gras. We made 24 of those with two vans and four jocks. We would do three a day. You'd do one and line up to do the next."

As for that four-person staff, KHOM has live DJs in mornings, afternoons, and evenings. Market vet Bill Dutrey does mornings. Tom "Jammer" Naylor, formerly of WEDJ Charlotte, N.C., is MD/p.m. driver. KLRZ's Skid Marx is back from KQID Alexandria, La., for nights. Otherwise, the station has depended on cameos via tape from Bumper Morgan, WKTV New York's Jojo Morales, and the like. Since KHOM isn't on hard drive, those breaks are carted, and customizing them can be quite a chore. When KHOM gave away six cars last fall, it needed 366 separate liners cut, Thorman says.

KHOM's success has put it within inches of B97, prompting rumors that new owners Heritage will take B97 back to top 40 or to modern soon. As Thorman sees it, B97's problems aren't with listeners, since it's No. 2 25-54, thanks to morning man Howard Stern, but with advertisers who object to the station's sex talk at night. "They made people decide between 'the B' and the Bible. They went with the Bible, and B97 is having trouble selling their format," Thorman says. "Even now, B97 has 50,000 more come than we do. They're going to do whatever they want... but I hope they'll appreciate the strength Stern has and find people to complement him, realize the format deserves to be here, and do it right."

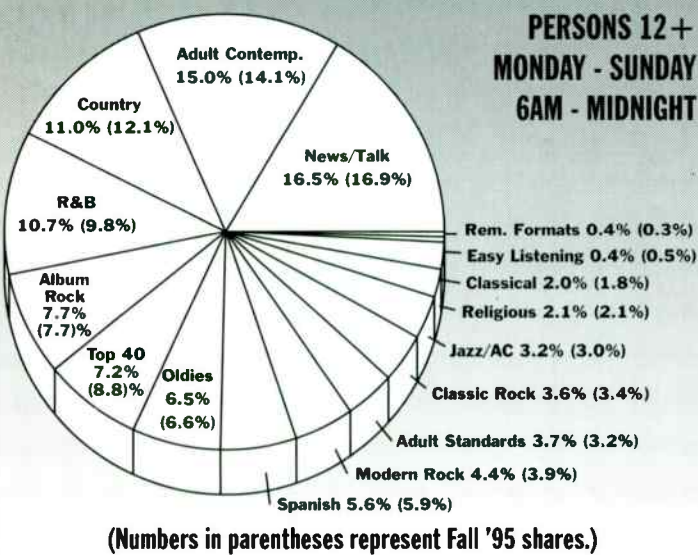

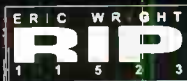
