Top 40 Springs Forward: A Hunk Of Arbitron Ratings Success Stories

After a winter Arbitron survey in which the format fell to its lowest national numbers ever, top 40 stations across the country are getting good news as the spring books roll in. Some of the spring successes, from WKTU New York to KQKQ Omaha, Neb., have already been profiled in these pages. Another, WGTZ (Z93) Dayton, Ohio, is this week's Monitor Profile subject (see page 6). Here's the first in a two-part random sampling of some of the others.

MONTEREY POPS UP AGAIN

Michael Newman had a fairly nice book. His KDON Monterey, Calif., rebounded 4.0-7.3 12-plus, scored No. 1 rankings with women, men, and persons 18-34, No. 1 with 25-54 women, and No. 2 with men and persons 25-54. "And it was all done with no dayparting to speak of," says Newman proudly. "We ran wide open except for certain daytime ballads, but we were playing stuff like Nas, Too Short, Mack 10, and LL Cool J 24 hours a day."

Newman admits the station had

strayed off expectation, so a musical tightening was needed. "We had been straddling the fence between rhythmic AC and top 40," he says. "It was time to get back to our roots."

It was no secret that a major factor in KDON's previous down book had been the Wild 107 factor. KYLD San Francisco had been simulcasting into the market on the 99.1 frequency until April of this year, when Evergreen bought KYLD, but not its duopoly partner KYLZ, which now simulcasts R&B adult KSOL. "Some people think [Wild 107] is still there," Newman says. "They still write them down, so we're still seeing a residual effect."

KDON refocused on the 12-24 demo and played the right reaction records. "We didn't wait around anymore for them to become hits. We made them hits," Newman says.

Like many stations during the spring book, it was time to dust off the old tried-and-true top 40 forced-listening gimmicks. KDON kicked off a \$1,000-a-week key-song contest, which helped with 25-54s, according to Newman. And how about something for the kids: The KDON School

More Mega-Sales; Cuddy Upped At ABC

In Monday's mega-sales shocker, American Radio Systems announced its \$655 million acquisition of EZ Communications, putting the group at 96 stations in 20 markets. EZ president/CEO **Alan Box** will remain with the new company as executive VP. EZ will have to sell three of its Sacramento, Calif., outlets—**KQPT**, **KSSJ**, and **KMJI**—as a result of the acquisition.

In other mega-sales news, Jacor Communications has reached an agreement with the Justice Department's antitrust division allowing it to proceed with its acquisition of Citicasters. Jacor will have to sell top 40 **WKRC** (Q102) Cincinnati as a result of the agreement. Also, top 40 **WNUD-FM** (U93) South Bend, Ind., and its '70s oldies sister have been sold by Notre Dame University to Pathfinder Communications, owners of country rival **WBYT** (B100.7).

Top 40/adult **WPLJ** New York VP/programming **Tom Cuddy** adds VP of music programming stripes for ABC's Radio Division. He'll maintain his duties with **WPLJ**. Also, **WPLJ** researcher **Joey Kramer** adds P/T duties. . . . Interim PD **Kid Curry** becomes official at top 40/rhythm **WPOW** (Power 96) Miami. **Phil Jones**, who had been handling music duties, remains music coordinator. No official MD has been named.

Steve Reynolds, most recently morning producer at **WRAL** (Mix 101.5) Raleigh, N.C., is named PD at **WRAL**, following the transfer of **Todd Fisher** to group PD duties. Across the Research Triangle, **WDCG** (G105) Raleigh PD **Brian Burns** adds OM stripes for G105 and album **WRDU**. MD **Kip Taylor** adds PD stripes for G105. **Andy Holt**, PD of oldies sister **WTRG**, is named OM for that station and classic rock **WZZU**. G105 promotion director **Chris Edge** gets promo duties for all four SFX stations.

KWMX (Mix 107.5) Denver's first act under new PD **Dan Bowen** was to dump its Mix nickname Aug. 1 at midnight, becoming America's Radio Movie Channel, and, armed with only a VCR in the studio, it began running many of your favorite films in their entirety, including "The Incredible Mr. Limpet," "The Shaggy Dog," "Duck Soup," and "Star Wars." On Aug. 7, the station re-emerged as K-Hits 107.5, Denver's Hit Music Station. It remains mainstream top 40. Night jock **Rick O'Bryan** moves to middays. P/T **Rick Evans** is handling nights for now, as Bowen seeks a full-time replacement.

WXLK (K92) Roanoke, Va., PD/night jock **Rich E. Cunningham** exits. T&Rs to OM **Sammy Simpson**. . . . **Tomm Rivers**, morning man at country **WGEE-FM** Green Bay, Wis., is the new OM at rival **WQLH** (Mix 98.5), replacing **John Thomas**. Look for **WQLH**, which has been on the cusp between top 40 and hot AC, to go "more adult."

GSM **Bill Hendrich** is upped to GM for country **WKKA** (K92) and N/T sister **WDBO** Orlando, Fla. Hendrich assumes those duties from **Rich Reis**, who remains VP for NewCity's Orlando stations, as well as GM of co-owned rhythmic AC **WCFB**.

Former **WTIC-FM** Hartford, Conn., PD **Paul Cannon** is named PD of Lappin Communications' AC/standards combo **WMAS AM-FM** Springfield, Mass.; he'll also do 1-4 p.m. on the FM. **WMAS** also hires **Dina Cox** out of college as a morning team member.

After several days of stunting with **Garth Brooks**, **the Village People**, etc., top 40 **WJJB** (B106) Fort Wayne, Ind., goes more rhythmic, becoming **The Killer B**.

KCAQ (Q105) Oxnard, Calif., PD **Rooster Rhodes** exits after 10 years; MD **Lucy Barragan** is out after eight. **Dan Garite** is named PD at **KCAQ** from classic rock sister **KOCP** (the Octopus). As previously announced, **Hal Abrams** returns for mornings, teaming with **Juanita**; middayer **Kelly McKay** and p.m. driver **Ravin' Dave** remain on board. Night jock **Jacqué James** exited three weeks ago and is still doing swing at **KOST** Los Angeles; new night jock **Rico Santana**, is upped from P/T. The longtime Q105 nickname becomes Q104.7. **Rhodes** will concentrate on his new Internet technology company, **Net Concept**.

Look for **WNVZ** (Z104) **WWDE** (2WD) Norfolk, Va., GM **Elise Kennett** to add GM duties for rival AC combo **WFOG/WPTE**, following its LMA of those stations.

Former **WBLI** Long Island, N.Y., PD **Stefan Rybak** can be reached at 516-473-0948. Also out at the top 40/adult station, as a result of its sale to Chancellor, are morning co-host **Ken Rhodes** and p.m. driver **Kelly Nash**.

Look for **WKSS** Hartford, Conn., morning co-host **Robin King** to jump to crosstown N/T **WTIC-AM**, teaming with **Ray Dunaway**, when her noncompete expires next April 1.

WPGC-FM Washington, D.C., has a second opening, as late nighter **Prince Da-Jour** exits. PD **Jay Stevens** needs a morning sidekick and a host for the late night "Cool Out" program.

Here's the lineup for **KWKH-FM** Shreveport, La., which flipped from country to top 40 last week as **KRUF** (Big Dog 94.5); **KWKH**'s **Marty Sullivan** remains PD. **KITT** acting PD/full-time MD **Gary Robinson** will handle music for the new top 40 and middays. **KITT** P/T **Robert J. Wright** is in mornings on **KRUF**. **KWKH** p.m. driver **Danny Fox** keeps that shift on **KRUF**. **KWKH**'s **Donna Corina** is in nights.

We Monitor The Debut Of MTV's M2

Had a chance to see MTV's M2 channel yet? Airplay Monitor got a look at the new channel Aug. 2—a day after M2 signed on with a one-hour simulcast on MTV. Here's what we saw.

M2 is still, according to its creators, a work in progress. But in its first days, the 24-hour, all-video channel is, as promised, broader musically than MTV and still identifiable as an MTV product. M2's logo is a variant of MTV's, with a "2" at the lower right of the channel's trademark "M" and the words "music television" reversed below the M—as if seen backward in a mirror. Many of the new channel's promos show the MTV logo flipping around to become the M2 logo.

On-air promos and drop-ins for M2 are primarily live-action, as opposed to the animated logos that helped make MTV famous. Promos include a group of teens talking about how

they've had to go to CDs to hear the music they wanted, as well as P-Funk guru George Clinton talking about what alternative music means to him. The chief positioner in the hour we monitored was "24 more hours of music television."

Like MTV at the time of its sign-on 15 years ago, M2 went back for a lot of older videos on "shoulda-been" hits, in addition to currents that hadn't made the main channel yet. There were also theme sets; for example, bands from Minneapolis followed by a set of bands from Boston.

M2 signed on Aug. 1 with Beck's "Where It's At." Here's an hour from Aug. 2: Soul Asylum, "Cartoon"; Jayhawks, "Blue"; Goo Goo Dolls, "Long Way Down"; Of Dirty Bastard, "Shimmy Shimmy Ya"; Metallica, "One"; Belly, "Feed The Tree"; Aerosmith, "Eat The Rich"; Electronic, "Get The Message"; Tracy Bonham, "Mother, Mother"; Cars, "My Best Friend's Girl"; Screaming Trees, "All I Know"; Don Henley, "The Heart Of The Matter"; Lyle Lovett, "Penguins"; and Customers, "Bastard Before Me."

M2, at present, is running commercial-free. Its three VJs are Matt Pinfield of "120 Minutes," KPNT St. Louis' Kris Kosach, and Rolling Stone's Jancee Dunn.

Time To Retire The 'Too Black' Excuse

How things change over a few months. Or don't.

Why, just a few months ago, the RCA folks were trying to cross "I Will Survive" by **Chantay Savage** to top 40 and being told by PDs that it was "too black"; that no matter how much it was selling, it couldn't possibly be selling to their audience; and that the folks buying it couldn't have any interest in their stations.

Top 40 is much more broad-minded now, right? Having moved past its "rhythm is a danger" period, the format has kinda sorta accepted the **Fugees**, **Bone Thugs-N-Harmony**, **Brandy**, **Toni Braxton**, and the **Quad City DJ's**. Some PDs are even playing the **New Edition** reunion record without waiting for it to build up three months' worth of story somewhere else. Are these not more enlightened times?

Maybe not. One of the Arista reps working "You're Making Me High" still hears from some holdout PDs that it too is "too black." Which tends to bring back memories of another less enlightened time, 1980-82, the period between "Good Times" and "Sexual Healing" during which any R&B act besides the **Pointer Sisters** had a hard time crossing over. There were PDs then who thought that "Turn Your Love Around" was "too black." Who thought "Upside Down" was "too black." Who thought "That Girl" by **Stevie Wonder** was "too black" and who said so in trade articles.

"Turn Your Love Around" and "That Girl" are soft AC staples these days. And it seems entirely within the realm of possibility that "You're Making Me High" will join them at some point—along with the handful of Braxton's midtempo and ballad titles that are already mainstays at soft AC. That either "You're Making Me High" or "I Will Survive" could have ever been lumped in with "Woo-Hah!! Got You All In Check" will, in six months to a year, seem implausible to most PDs—possibly because it's implausible now. When that mind-shift comes, it won't make any difference for Braxton's record, which has become a hit despite all this, and it won't be able to help "I Will Survive."

You can try to refute arguments about "You're Making Me High" on their own terms

by pointing out that it shouldn't be a problem for PDs who are also playing **New Edition** or **Bone Thugs-N-Harmony**. You could also use "Give Me The Reason" and point out that we've had a top five blues record at top 40 in recent months, which nobody seemed to think was "too black," despite the cultural roots of blues.

But all of this just plays into the trap. You shouldn't have to prove a song is mass-appeal by denying its ethnicity. The first 500,000 copies sold ought to prove a song is mass-appeal. And there aren't many PDs who would claim with a straight face that "Macarena" is "too Hispanic." Even in a society that is famously inept for its race relations, most top 40 listeners have lived in a world that is at least nominally multicultural for their entire lives and probably have never decided that a record was "too black." (The only folks who seem to remain sheltered are some broadcasters, given the number of stations that still have trouble meeting EEO requirements or meet those requirements by hiring minorities for overnights, human resources, and the front desk.)

So can one at least say that three years ago, when top 40's hip-hop backlash began, listeners were alienated by too many musically abrasive and nonmelodic records that talked about a world to which they could not relate? There were, in fact, top 40 and R&B listeners who felt that way about hardcore rap. There were plenty of others who didn't, as witnessed by the recent success of **Bone Thugs-N-Harmony** and "Gangsta's Paradise." It was a typically top 40 response to assume that not wanting a constant diet of just one thing means not wanting that thing at all. It was also a typically top 40 response to decide that the antidote for too much abrasive rap was too much abrasive modern rock.

In 1996, it's time for all people of goodwill to retire the "too black" excuse once and for all. Especially when—like many excuses—it's often not what the PDs in question really mean. Even now, the old rationales for not playing a song—"it's not selling," "nobody's calling for it," and "nobody seems to care whether we play it"—are still the most valid ones. So why are they the ones now invoked least?

Spirit contest for a free concert by Silk and LAD drew more than 3.5 million entry cards.

Newman also had to break in two new day-parts during the book. Marcus D. from KBOS (B95) Fresno, Calif., started doing nights in April, followed by Dr. Bruce Maims from KTHI Fresno, Calif., in mornings in May.

"Last year, [WQHT (Hot 97) New York PD and longtime mentor] Steve Smith told me if I superserved the core, in this case 18-24, everything else will spill over; and it has," says Newman. "The contesting has to be right, and the music has to be on the money. You always know when you're playing stiffs, because the audience complains you're playing the same songs over and over again. Once we thinned out the list and just played hit after hit, they stopped complaining and their perception changed."

A RIVER RUNS OVER RIVALS

"Retribution!" shouts WRVW Nashville PD Charlie Quinn to those who thought his River wouldn't flow. Quinn and staff took a lot of abuse in February when they blew up heritage top 40 WYHY (Y107), changed calls to WRVW (the River), and began leaning more adult. In its first full book as the River, WRVW is up 5.4-7.7 12-plus.

Quinn says the station dumped the longtime Y107 moniker because it carried a negative image for clients and listeners. Years of on-air outrage had branded Y107 "that teen/party station with a frat-boy mentality." "We couldn't continue to use the Y107 name if we were going to target a wider span of demos," Quinn says.

Quinn also "borrowed" morning talent Mary Glen Lassitter from crosstown classic rocker WGFX (the Arrow) in March. "Mary is my captain and one of the main reasons we've been so successful," he says.

"The [name] River certainly lends itself creative marketing and imaging," says Quinn, who cites initial industry concerns that the River had become an AC station. "I believe we've finally lived that down. Musically, we're not that different, with the exception of maybe some rap-type songs that are missing. Today, we're much quicker to move on a Gloria Estefan or Whitney Houston for the purposes of daytime imaging, and we're less concerned with nighttime imaging records."

KISS OF LIFE

"I have a great idea! Let's change our name and call letters in the middle of the spring book!"

Other than those few minor changes, Brian Bridgman is breathing a whole lot easier today. His WEDJ (the Edge) Charlotte, N.C., became WNKS (Kiss 95.1) May 31, three weeks before the end of the book.

Despite any possible listener confusion, the new WNKS was up 4.6-5.7 12 plus, good enough for No. 6 in the market. (Kiss is also No. 5 18-49 and No. 3 18-34 adults, going 7.7-9.5.)

Bridgman had been moving the station away from its modern rock lean to mainstream since January, thus separating the Edge from WEND (the End), the crosstown modern rocker whose progress the station had earlier hoped to impede by trying to pre-empt the modern position.

While Kiss enjoyed its best book ever, so did the End. "When we were spending all this time and energy trying to cover them, it seemed both stations negated each other," Bridgman observes. Today, however, even though the stations are targeting similar demos, getting there by two distinct roads has benefited both.

"Playing dance music has helped us tremendously and has really been the savior of the station," Bridgman says. "Those unique titles and artists like La Bouche and Los Del Rio have become our signature hit records, and no one in town can touch them."

Strangely, during the transitional period, the station spent next to nothing during the book—there was no TV and no direct-mail campaign. On the other hand, Bridgman estimates that the End and crosstown AC WWSN (Sunny 107.9)

each spent about \$150,000 during the book. "We just played the hits," he says, with the exception of a small "phrase that pays" contest.

Although Kiss enjoyed a healthy upswing, Bridgman says that the next monthly trend will be vitally important. "We have to rack up a few good trends in row and establish a pattern of success," he says. "Fortunately, top 40 music is much better and more mass appeal than ever."

Q94 GETS A LIFE

Clear Channel's WRVQ (Q94) Richmond, Va., was up 4.5-6.2 12-plus in the spring book, with night host Billy Surf up 4.1-11.0 18-34.

The reason for the improvement? "It wasn't one big thing. It was a combination of small elements," says PD Lisa McKay, who cites the example of crosstown modern rocker the Buzz, which exploded with a TV campaign that generated more than 600 impressions and a large word-of-mouth two books ago. "They took out our lower end and some of our 18-24s," McKay says.

Soft AC WTVR (now owned by Clear Channel) had shaved off a bunch of Q94's upper end, leaving it with a rather anemic chunk of 25-34s. "Not enough to sustain a top 40," McKay says.

What's a PD to do? "We fought back," she says. Q94 bought a ton of TV time during NBC's "must see TV" Thursday lineup soliciting listeners for Q94's "Flashback Fridays" featuring '70s and '80s product mixed with currents, which helped its upper end. Q94 also came out swinging with the Get a Life promotion, the Name Game, and pulled out the wallet, giving away wads of cash, including \$10,000 in one morning.

Consultant Dan Vallie supervised a music library spring cleaning, tossing out expired sounds to better focus the station and incorporating such new mass-appeal dance records as "Macarena," the Quad City DJ's, etc.

Q94's image enema included a new station voice, Chris Corley, and a new jingle package from Reel World in Seattle that combined parts of the WKTU and KUBE jingle packages. The last order of business was changing the slogan from "today's best music variety" to "today's best music for all people."

B95'S BIGGER, BETTER BALANCE

Even though KBOS (B95) Fresno, Calif., went from 8.6-9.8 12-plus and is No. 1 in its market, PD Mark Adams is surprised about the big fuss everyone's making—after all, B95 has traditionally lived in the world of double digits. The station currently sits at a 14.5 share 18-34 (No. 1 "by a landslide," says Adams) and shows surprising strength with 25-54s, up to No. 3 with a 7.4 share.

"This is not a hip-hop radio station," Adams reminds us. "We're not alternative. We're not a dance station. It's top 40. We're playing hit records that are very different in sound, like Alanis, Mariah, and Fugees, but it's mainstream for Fresno. We're making sure we stay on top of what 25-34 women want to hear."

"I realize I'm not making any piercing observations here," says Adams. "But for the past six to eight months, we've seen an influx of quality pop/dance product which has enabled us to achieve a better balance and sound more pop, mainstream, and rhythmic with a lot less effort."

Adams says that just a few short years ago, rhythm/crossover radio was leaning much more R&B, but given the wider variety of hit music available today, "I feel we've now been able to turn an 8 share into a 10 share by playing more hits," he says. "We're now reaching outside our core to build new cume, and the new dance product has made it much easier."

One hurdle B95 had to overcome before the book started was losing longtime morning team Rik McNeil and Lorraine Love, who crossed the street to AC KTHI. Nineteen days later, Adams hired former B95 morning team Hart and Coffee. Spring book results for morning drive show B95 sitting at No. 1 12 plus, 18-34, and 25-34.

MONITOR PROFILE

Louis Kaplan Celebrates Four Years At WGTZ Dayton; Slams 12 In A Row Every Hour

Jam four candles in the cake and get ready to blow. PD Louis Kaplan was hired by WGTZ (Z93) Dayton, Ohio, GM David Macejko four years ago this month. Kaplan has an additional reason to celebrate: a healthy spring book, 6.0-7.8 12-plus, which is good enough for No. 4 in the market.

While Z93 has no direct format competition, Kaplan has to share his toys with crosstown hot AC WMMX (No. 2 12-plus with a 9.3), soft AC WLQT (No. 5, 6.4-7.3), R&B WROU (No. 3 overall and up 6.4-7.9 in a market that's only 12% black), and 1-year-old modern rocker WXEG, also up in the spring book, 5.0-5.3.

With so many stations jumping on the modern rock bandwagon, Z93 prefers to lean toward more female-friendly music, including select dance titles, and more mass-appeal R&B and alternative product. "There's not a lot of great pop music available right now," Kaplan says. "Stuff like Ace Of Base, Real McCoy, and the George Michael records we used to get are few and far between."

Today's top 40 musical menu, according to

Kaplan's observation, is derived from clearly and narrowly defined genres: For example, he notes, Celine Dion comes from the AC world, Alanis Morissette from alternative, Bone Thugs-N-Harmony from the R&B side, etc. And all happens to test great. "It's difficult riding that mainstream train when you share with niche formats," he says. "We certainly can't beat them at their game, so we have to seek the middle ground."

Being surrounded by competing formats was beginning to give Z93 claustrophobia until it started pushing back, Kaplan says. "We started flexing our muscles to make some more room. Because we're a mainstream station, we're unable to create that one sound that's unique, like the other stations." That's where Z93 puts that top 40 edge to work for it. "We have to use our imaging, our attitude, and our presentation to keep Z93 sounding upbeat and positive with an element of fun, mixed with that air of unpredictability," he says. "We also use the traditional top 40 strengths of promotions and personality to further set us apart."

"With the urban and the alternative stations, it's pretty easy to anticipate what type of song they'll play next," adds Kaplan. "With the ACs, you can bet most of their promotions will revolve around a song of the day-type image." But on Z93, Kaplan says, lucky caller 13 is liable to win anything, from an Olympic vacation to an all-expenses-paid trip to the Betty Ford Center.

"I still believe people will tune in as long as you're playing hits," he says. "Speaking as a PD, I feel we're sometimes too particular about

the music we play. We spend too much time and energy thinking for our listeners. They don't care if it's an alternative song, urban, dance, whatever label we give it. They either like it or they don't."

Here's a recent 2 p.m. hour on Z93: TLC, "Diggin' On You"; Alanis Morissette, "You Learn"; Bobby Brown, "Rock Wit'cha"; Jann Arden, "Insensitive"; Billie Ray Martin, "Your Loving Arms"; Tracy Chapman, "Give Me One Reason"; En Vogue, "Free Your Mind"; Natalie Merchant, "Jealousy"; Whitney Houston, "Why Does It Hurt So Bad"; Collage, "I'll Be Loving You"; BoDeans, "Closer To Free"; Mariah Carey, "Forever"; and Gin Blossoms, "As Long As It Matters."

Even though Z93 fell to a 6 share in the winter, Kaplan had already started to address the eternal top 40 problem: Cume is healthy, time spent listening sucks. Drawing upon his years of expertise, Kaplan did what any other red-blooded PD would do: He stole a great idea. Thus, the Z93 "12-in-a-row music sweep" was born. "I saw the success that [WXKS-FM] Kiss 108 in Boston and other stations were having with music sweeps increasing TSL," Kaplan says. Z93 kicked off the deal with a \$12,000 giveaway and issued the Z93 "12-in-a-row card," redeemable for prizes and discounts at merchants. It seemed so simple and stupid and basic that Kaplan says, "We actually tried to think of reasons not to do it, but we couldn't think of any, even though the idea sounded too normal for us."

Sure enough, Steve Rivers, er, Kaplan's brilliant concept soon began to work. Month by month, TSL increased, from 5:45 in the winter book to seven hours in the spring, while cume remained stable, averaging 180,000.

While there were no staff changes during book, Z93 experienced some growing pains last fall when four-year morning jock Jeff Wicker left for WYSY Chicago. Kaplan transferred Jack Pohl from classic hits duopoly partner WING-FM, teaming him with 15-year vet Kim Faris and producer/sidekick Booger Johnson. In January, Kaplan hired the well-traveled Mojo for nights. "He's had an immediate impact," Kaplan says. MD Gretchen Corbett does middays and has been with the station on and off for 10 years. Afternoon driver Sean Roberts and overnight jock Shawn Stevens have been with Z93 almost five years. Kaplan calls Roberts "our most consistent ratings producer."

Former morning producer Dave Redelberger was named promotions director two years ago and "knows all the right people in town and which rocks to look under to get things done." Bill Richards signed on last year as Z93's consultant.

Before moving to Nashville for Jacor in 1987 as APD/MD of WYHY (Y107)—he was promoted to PD in 1989, when Marc Chase left to fire up WFLZ Tampa, Fla.—Kaplan cites his experience as APD/research director at the late WAPI (195) Birmingham, Ala., as invaluable. "We're all a product of our past," says Kaplan, acknowledging his training under Chase, Mark St. John, and Kevin McCarthy.

While earning his research stripes in Birmingham, Kaplan also picked up programming by osmosis while working part time for Music-Scan, the music-scheduling company. "I talked with PDs on the phone and helped them with music problems," he says. "I became a sponge for information. Those experiences taught me the guts of radio, the 'how.' Jacor taught me the big picture, the 'why.'"

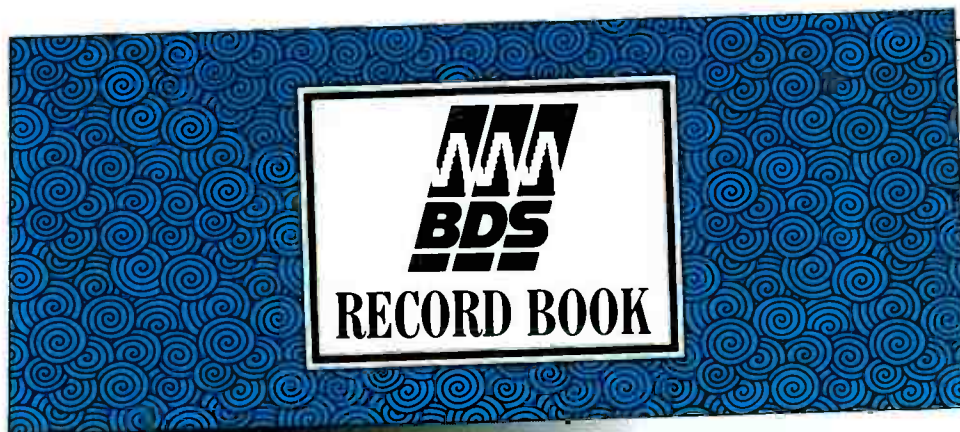
