Classic Rock Up Sharply, Top 40 Off, Country Rises In National Arbs

In a winter book in which radio listening went largely unchanged, the only seismic shift took place between album rock and classic rock stations. The latter format, battered by a series of defections a year ago, was up sharply for its highest 12-plus number ever in Billboard/Airplay Monitor's national Arbitron ratings, rising 3.9-4.5, while mainstream album outlets were off 7.2-6.7 for their lowest number ever.

In other news, country pulled out its first rise in six books; its nudge forward (10.5-10.6) tended to confirm our sense three months ago that the worst of the bleeding had stopped—except among older listeners. AC, up 14.5-14.7, continued a two-book recovery. Top 40, without a significant gain in new stations to power its resurgence, was off slightly (8.6-8.4). Spanish-language radio also managed its best numbers ever, nudging forward 6.2-6.3 vs. a 5.6 at this time last year.

Billboard/Airplay Monitor's exclusive national Arbitrons represent a combined sample of the 96 markets with year-round measurement. The top 10 formats are news talk (16.8-16.6), AC,

R&B (flat at 10.9), country, top 40, album, Spanish, oldies (6.2-6.0), classic rock, and modern rock (flat at 4.1).

AC, customarily the No. 1 music format, continues to recover from a sharp drop last summer, although it didn't get quite the spike that it did last winter, when it was up 14.1-15.0. Its biggest rises were in afternoons (15.1-15.4), nights (12.3-12.5), teens (8.0-8.3), and 35-64 (16.5-16.7). That it would be up in those last two demos suggests that perhaps AC really is the format the whole office can agree on. Beyond that, it also suggests a polarization between those stations that are modern AC or adult top 40 and those that are softer, suggesting that both ends of the spectrum feel more super-served by the format.

R&B keeps its hold on the No. 3 format slot, if you combine mainstream and adult outlets. Only a slight drop in mornings (9.4-9.3) keeps its overall 12-plus number from rising, since the format was up in every other daypart. It was up 8.4-8.6 middays, 10.8-10.9 afternoons, and 16.9-17.1 at night; in the last two dayparts, it posted its best number ever. It also posted record numbers in the 18-34 demo (13.9-14.4) and with

Letters: Where Was The First Modern AC?

The following is a series of E-mail exchanges following May 16's Top 40 Topics column.

I enjoyed Sean Ross's column on modern AC with one minor exception. KYSR (Star 98.7) Los Angeles was not the first modern AC. It was KALC (Alice 106) Denver. KALC signed on April 1994 and by May was fully engulfed in what is now known as "modern AC" (actually "modern AC" is trademarked by consultants Sinton/Barnes out of Atlanta, which we hold a license to).

Alice is also the [first] "modern AC" to achieve significant ratings success: It's presently No. 4 12-plus, No. 2 18-34, No. 7 25-54, No. 1 women 18-34, No. 2 women 25-34, No. 3 women 25-49, and No. 3 18-49 adults.

Just wanted to set the record straight. Thanks.

Ross replies:

I consider Star the first pure modern AC because Alice was deliberately defined by its target and not by the genres of music it played. Unlike most modern ACs, which usually expect artists to have some track record with the modern audi-

ence (or at least be neutral), KALC could play Mary Chapin Carpenter, Van Morrison, Diana King, Janet Jackson, Toni Braxton, Spice Girls, La Bouche, Hansen, and whatever else reached critical mass with 18-34 women, which is one of the reasons that we treat it as a mainstream top 40. In any event, KALC clearly was important in terms of getting the rest of the world to think of "Should I Stay Or Should I Go" and songs like it as adult top 40 music and not just modern rock. Besides, I thought the whole point of Alice was that it didn't wish to be defined as any specific format.

Lawson responds:

First of all, let me say that I don't want to discredit anything that Star in L.A. or KFMB-FM (Star 100.7) San Diego or Randy Lane or Tracy Johnson has done. We made a point of not labeling the station, but reflecting the tastes of 18-34 females; KALC is still programmed to be whatever the listener thinks it is, so Alice is not a niche station in the sense that modern AC is a niche, but constantly revises and improves its personality. But we did license the term "modern AC" for sales purposes in 1994 and have been doing what we feel is our version of modern AC since then. So it all depends on how you define it.

Are Station Concerts Still A Big Deal?

Judging from the length of the Radio Concert Monitor these days, spring concert season is bigger than ever (see page 4). This despite the fact that some label reps say they're fed up with station demands for acts and the market wars that granting such requests can touch off. This despite the fact that "A list" acts are supposedly harder to find these days, with some of them now seemingly touring the Far East all year long, even though many stations are, as a result, paying for acts now, thus upping the ante.

I didn't see WXKS-FM (Kiss 108) Boston's Kiss Concerts until the late '80s, by which time they'd already reached critical mass. But I did see the early KPWR (Power 106) Los Angeles Powerhouse shows in the mid-'80s, when they were clearly something fresh and new in the market. The multi-artist track-date show lost its potency as it proliferated. Then station concerts got a new boost of energy in the mid-'90s, when the modern rock revolution made many of the shows more like real concerts again.

More than a decade after the first Powerhouse show, I still see stations trying to be creative with their concerts, especially here in New York. WHITZ (Z100)'s next show will be on an aircraft carrier. WQHT (Hot 97) has staged an early-'80s-style old-school battle of the MCs. WKTU's Three Divas show with Donna Summer, Chaka Khan, and Gloria Estefan seems to have touched off a slew of similarly retro shows at other Evergreen outlets, since WKQI (Q95.5) Detroit is presenting Heatwave and soft AC WGAY Washington, D.C., is offering B.J. Thomas and Captain & Tennille shortly.

At their best, station concerts still display two key traits of the best radio promotions—

they involve starpower and something listeners can't buy. Then again, as stations start shelling out more for acts, more shows seem to involve paid tickets. And the novelty of large numbers of acts on one bill has been diluted by the post-Lollapalooza rise of other '70s-style festivals.

Then there's the issue of having to support acts who may not have hit records when your show rolls around. I've seen some stations whose franchise was based largely on playing fewer bad records than their competition give that up to become the concert station. Sometimes the summer book spike doesn't compensate for what a station gives up in the spring by opening up its playlist.

So is it worth it? Depends what else a station is spending its money on. If your owner has decided that owning six stations in the market has eliminated the need for outside marketing, you might want to deploy some of your concert money there. Depending on your format, you might put some of that money into on-air cash, too, except that this is a relatively healthy economy and on-air cash isn't quite the magic bullet it used to be. And even if only a small percentage of your cume can attend a station concert, that argument hasn't kept the same stations from pumping money into their World Wide Web sites.

For years, the right concert could make a station larger than life. But the process works in reverse, too. A lot of the excitement at both WKTU's and WQHT's concerts in recent years has been part of the excitement already created by the station and the other things it had to offer. The number of believers shows that concerts can make a significant contribution to a top 40's stationality. It's just not a substitute, particularly now.

Emmis Adds WQCD For Big Apple Trombo

Emmis Broadcasting has entered into a three-year agreement to take over the operations and eventually purchase Tribune jazz outlet WQCD (CD101.9) New York. This deal gives Emmis a third station to combo with R&B WQHT (Hot 97) and R&B adult WRKS.

VIACOM SALE CHALLENGED

A civil-rights group headed by the Rev. Jesse Jackson has formally challenged Viacom's proposed sale of four Washington, D.C., stations, including WMZQ, to Evergreen Media, according to The Washington Post. Jackson's Rainbow-PUSH Coalition asked the FCC to block the transfer until Viacom seeks minority buyers for the stations, the paper reports. A Viacom spokesman told The Post that Rainbow's filing is without merit and would not delay completion of the deal.

FORMATS: KPXX STAFF ON NOTICE

As Bonneville prepares to take over N/T KPXX-FM San Francisco, rumors are circulating that most or all of the current staff, along with the format, will be going away on or about May 30, according to PD Ken Beck. Alan Hotlen, former PD of KOIT San Francisco, currently GM of Bonneville sister station WWZZ (Z104) Washington, D.C., is rumored to be transferring back to the Bay Area in some capacity and was reportedly vacationing in San Francisco at press time.

Memorial Day is also the rumored date for Nassau Broadcasting to unwrap its new top 40 format (B98.5) on WQNJ Monmouth/Ocean, N.J. Neal Sullivan (ex-WOVV West Palm Beach, Fla.; WKDD Akron, Ohio) is already in place as PD.

AC WLRS (Mix 102) Louisville, Ky., was, at press time, stunting for an apparent format change by playing "I Am The Walrus" repeatedly.

WYXR (Star 104.5) Philadelphia is now using the slogan "hits of the '80s and '90s" and has toned down its music over the past few weeks. PD Dave Allen says the station is "still hot AC, just playing fewer modern AC crossovers."

WSPT Stevens Point, Wis., completes its transition from AC to modern AC. PD Keith Collins exits to be PD of country WNPQ Canton, Ohio. PD packages to regional PD Darren Lee.

Speaking of modern adult, the Phoenix-based Hot Mix Radio Network is now producing modern AC and rhythmic AC mix shows.

PROGRAMMING: QIZ KIDS MAKE GOOD

KQIZ Amarillo, Texas, PD Ted Kelly returns to his old New Orleans stomping grounds (WEZB [B97], WNOE-AM) to become PD/morning guy at the new WKSX (Kiss Country 106.1).

KPRR El Paso, Texas, PD John Candelaria adds MD duties for Bob Mitchell's consultancy.

Jack Day is the new PD/p.m. driver at new top 40 outlet WBDR (the Border) Watertown, N.Y./Kingston, Ontario. Day returns to the company; he had been OM of sister outlets WTOJ/WLKC.

Denny Alexander, PD of Heritage oldies outlet WKLX Rochester, N.Y., joins Paxson Communications as VP/director of programming/Tallahassee [Fla.], overseeing oldies WSNI-FM, country WTNT, jazz WJZT, modern WXSX, and sports WNLS-AM... Former WKBQ (now WALC) St. Louis staffer Chad Elliott is named PD of classic rock WXLB Carbondale, Ill. Meanwhile, WALC awards APD stripes to MD Tommy Mattern.

PIRATES OF THE AIRWAVES, PT. II

KZZU Spokane, Wash., PD Ken Hopkins reports all quiet on the radio-pirate front. After enduring repeated profane break-ins to KZZU's frequency, Hopkins says no activity has been monitored in more than a week. PEOPLE: Q106 PINCHES SPICER

KKLQ (Q106) San Diego taps Cindy Spicer as MD from classic rock duopoly partner KGB. Next door, KHTS (Channel 933) plugs its midday shift with Randy DeWitt (aka the Ran-Man), former morning guy at modern rival XHRM (the Flash).

KHTN (Hot 105) Stockton, Calif., MD Mark Medina takes nights at KRQQ Tucson, Ariz. He replaces Smasher, now doing afternoons, who is in turn replacing Ryno, now at KKLQ.

WGTX (Z93) Dayton, Ohio, morning host Jack Pohl exits to become a sports anchor at crosstown WDTV-TV. Also, promotions assistant Amy Green is upped to promotions director for WGTX and classic rock WING.

men (8.8-9.0), which, one suspects, could have had something to do with the amount of rap on the radio during the winter and the publicity surrounding the murder of the Notorious B.I.G. R&B adult stations, which we also track separately, have been virtually flat for their first year as a discrete format. They held at a 3.7 share this winter.

Country's move forward puts the format flush with its fall '90 number. It's up by a tenth or two in most demos and dayparts with the exceptions of afternoons, 25-54, where it's flat with a 10.9, and 35-64, where the 11.9 share is the format's lowest number in the eight years that we've looked at national Arbitrons. The format's much-publicized broader gold libraries and the advent of several gold-based country FMs this winter may have had something to do with a much-needed rebound in men (9.9-10.3), but there's no sign of the 35-plus audience being repatriated by the changes.

Top 40 was off in all dayparts except middays, where it was flat. It was down most at night (12.2-11.6). But the format is still well ahead of last winter, when it had a spectacular 8.8-7.2 overall drop. Top 40 is, however, closer than ever to losing its longstanding lead among teens, with whom it was off 29.1-27.8, while R&B was flat at a 24.3 share.

Top 40 is no longer getting the boost it got over the last year from a net gain in the number of stations, as the format moved into markets where it hadn't previously existed. If the rumors about Chicago and San Francisco getting mainstream top 40s turn out to be true, those stations, even with modest ratings, would do a lot to drive the national number, given the number of listeners that even a

few shares represent in a major market.

That also explains some of what happened between mainstream and classic rock this time. Two top 10 market heritage rockers, WNEW New York and KLOL Houston, flipped to classic rock (although KLOL is sort of heading back these days). KBBG San Francisco, one of numerous '70s oldies stations to evolve into something more Arrowsque, was also reclassified as classic rock this winter. In a book in which the station count for most formats was as static as the numbers themselves, classic rock gained a total of 10 stations nationally, and mainstream album rock lost seven.

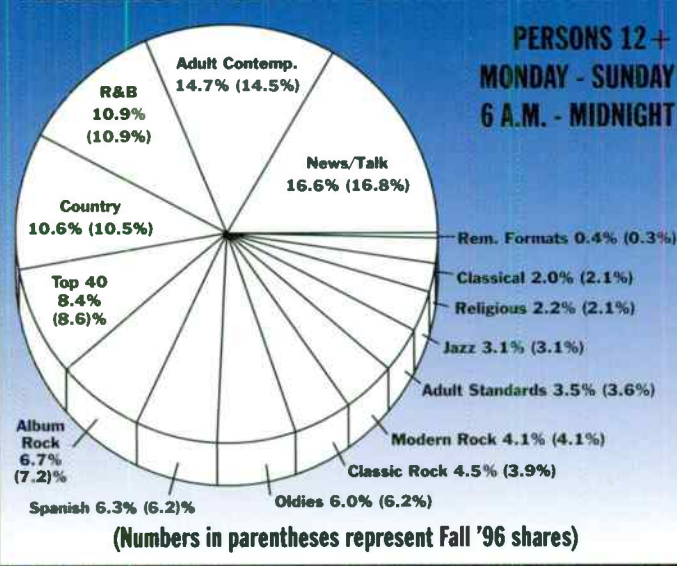
There's no sign that mainstream rock's drop represents a listener migration to modern, since that format was pretty much flat everywhere, except teens (where it seems to be losing a few bodies to modern AC). One might wonder if the increasingly hard nature of some mainstream rockers is driving folks over to classic, but the migration transcends demo, instead of getting sharper as the audience gets older. In 18-34, album is down 12.3-11.7, while classic rock is up 5.2-6. In 25-54, album is off 8.8-8.1, while classic rises 4.3-5.1. In 35-64, it's album 5.4-4.9, classic 4.3-5.1.

Spanish was only up by a tenth in most dayparts and demos, but that was enough for the format to post its third straight record book. One interesting note about Spanish, despite its longstanding stereotype as a format that appealed only to older (read less-assimilated) listeners: Its best numbers are consistently in the 18-34 demo these days. Spanish was flat in 18-34 with a 7.5 share but ahead of 25-54 (6.5-6.6) and 35-64 (5.9-5.9)—this despite the

fact that many of the new builds in the format have been Spanish-language ACs, as opposed to the younger-targeted Tejano, regional Mexican, and salsa/merengue outlets that gave the format its first boost among younger listeners.

The oldies format posted its lowest numbers since winter '93. A lot of that can be traced to the near dissolution of '70s oldies stations, which only represented a 0.8 share last spring, when Arbitron began breaking them out, but which now represent only a 0.4 share. At its peak, the numbers suggest that the '70s accounted for about a share and a half of overall listening in the first half of '95.

MONITOR PROFILE

Janitor Uses Giant Broom To Sweep Up Big Chunk Of San Antonio

Can your format do this? KTFM San Antonio, Texas, PD Cliff Tredway and staff are still basking in the glow that only a No. 1 book can provide. In the winter Arbitron ratings, rhythmic-leaning KTFM is No. 1 in almost every conceivable demo: 12-plus (10.2-11.3), 18-34, and even 25-54. The station also placed an unheard-of No. 5 35-64. "Yeah, the ad agencies are freaked, but imagine how the other stations feel," says Tredway.

Tredway, now in his second tour of duty, left KTFM in 1988, making stops at the late WAPW (Power 99) Atlanta, the late WDFX (the Fox) Detroit, and KKKR (Power 92) Phoenix, returning to KTFM in '92 for afternoons as "the Janitor."

When Tredway was upped to PD 2½ years ago, he says the station was fluctuating between No. 2 and No. 3 18-34 and anywhere from ninth to 13th 25-54. "That's when I decided that the usual rules of radio don't need to exist anymore," he says. "No doubt KTFM sounds different from your textbook top 40. We're probably the most dayparted station in America," he says. You're just as likely to

Wind & Fire, "Let's Groove"; Toni Braxton, "Un-Break My Heart"; Tony Rich Project, "Nobody Knows"; Jodie Watley, "Looking For A New Love"; Jewel, "You Were Meant For Me"; and Crystal Waters, "100% Pure Love."

Along with KTFM's deep Hispanic bloodlines comes a dedication to family-oriented events. "We'll just go and hang out where our listeners are, whether a church bazaar or a day in the park," he says. "We have an informal mission statement that says 'KTFM—we're not just a radio station, we're a way of life.'" The station's current positioning statement, "Pure San Antonio," amplifies that mission.

Mornings are helmed by station vet Dr. Drex, along with Roberta Varela (ex-KPRR El Paso, Texas) and Miss Ree, radio's first transsexual jock. The show features no music Monday through Thursday. "I believe that a 24-year-old woman has very different musical tastes from a 44- or 54-year-old woman," says Tredway, who discovered that the no-music approach actually increased the station's cume, drawing from every format in town. On Fridays, it's back to music for the "Weekend Blastoff."

Radio vet Christopher Lance recently arrived from KPRR for middays, followed by San Antonio homegirl Hot Henrietta, an intern for Dr. Drex in the '80s. Joey Deee is doing nights, followed by Larry Chase and Kyle.

"This station has always had a very low turnover rate," says Tredway. "We pride ourselves on the fact that this is a great place to work. Joey Deee just built a house—how many night jocks own their own home? In the age of consolidation, this place has remained very stable, and our employees appreciate that."

Indeed, while its profile has continued to grow along with its profits, KTFM, amazingly, has managed to avoid the consolidation craziness that has enveloped the rest of the industry. Not that Waterman Broadcasting doesn't have potential suitors. "[Owner] Bernie Waterman is one of the last of the radio renegades," says Tredway. "He's in it for the thrill of victory."

After doing a contemporary format for 27 years, KTFM is now, Tredway says, "being passed down from one generation to the next." GM Joe Ernest has been aboard for those 27 years. "Just when we start to get cocky, Joe always likes to remind us, 'We won with you, and we can certainly win without you,'" Tredway says.

MD Steve Chavez is the brother of former MD Charles Chavez, now at KHYS Houston. "The Chavez brothers have the greatest ears in the business," says Tredway. "Steve also lives the lifestyle, which enables me to go to bed early at night."

Tredway also lives by another Joe Ernest nugget of wisdom: "Never program your radio station to white guys in business suits," he says. "We enjoy repeating those words back to him every time he runs into my office to suggest we play this really great song he just heard."

"I still believe I have the easiest job in the world. All I have to do is run up and down the hallways making everybody smile, being the cheerleader, letting the jocks do their jobs without any unnecessary pressure on them," Tredway says. "KTFM may not technically be the best radio station to the industry's ears, but we're the best station in our listeners' ears."

hear "Reunited" by Peaches & Herb or "Sleep Walk" by Santo & Johnny during the day as you are to hear "Feelin' Horny" by Sex Kraz'd Superstars after the sun goes down.

A large part of the eclectic nature of KTFM is its refusal to be pigeonholed, something made possible by the lack of a direct competitor. Although the station leans rhythmic, it has enjoyed success with Celine Dion, Jewel, Hanson, and (brace yourself) George Strait.

Tredway explains: "When our research showed listeners who chose KTFM as their favorite station also wanted to hear George Strait, once again we threw the old-school-radio rules out the window." Tredway took a deep breath and popped "Blue Clear Sky" on the air. "Sure it sounded weird," he says. "But we decided to live by the theory 'If they want it, we'll play it.'"

"Although we target 25-34 Hispanic females, we've found major differences between the way our Anglo and Hispanic listeners perceive songs. Anglos, in general, listen for the overall 'sound' of a song, whereas we've discovered that our Hispanic listeners are largely lyrically driven," he adds, explaining the emotional connection between his audience and artists like Alanis Morissette or Jewel.

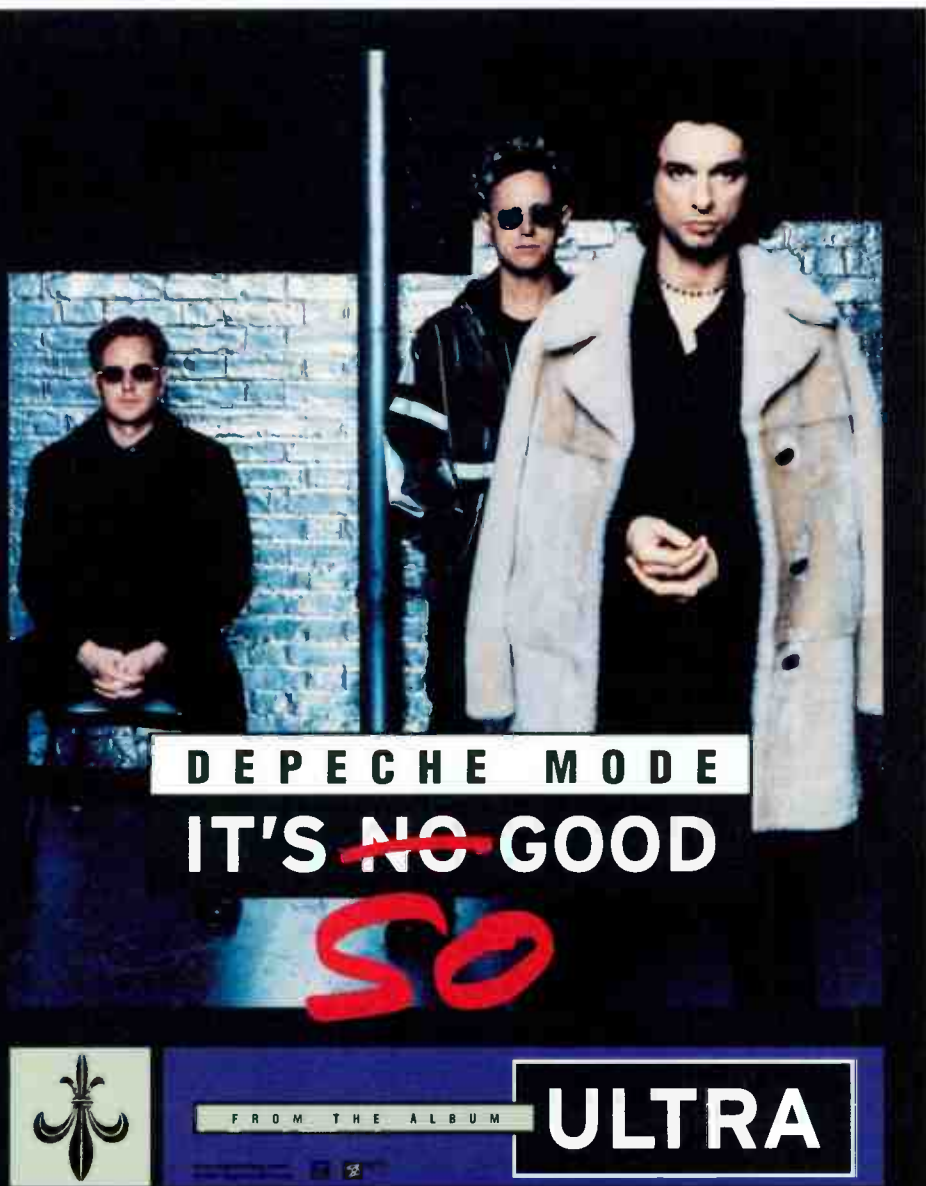
