## The Aircheck's In The Mail—And Don't You Wish It Stayed There?

Besides raising the station's ratings and revenue, one of the programmer's most important responsibilities is finding and developing the great air talent of the future. Hey, it's a dirty job, but someone's got to do it.

Every time an on-air opening is publicized, scores of tapes and résumés will flood a station. Most are from up-and-comers who are a bit rough around the edges. The PD's duty is to wade through the mountain of tapes and cover letters to find that diamond in the rough—the future Rick Dees, Tom Joyner, or Howard Stern.

This story is not about those airchecks. Nor is it about the countless

packages that are merely marred by sloppily handwritten cover letters, inferior-quality tapes, misspelled call letters, miscued or even blank tapes, and the like. The following airchecks should've first been evaluated by bomb-sniffing dogs.

What you are about to read is true. The names have been changed to protect the innocent, the guilty, and the potentially dangerous.

### THIS IS PAYING YOUR DUES

"One guy sent me a letter, wanting to change careers and be a DJ," country KFDI-AM-FM Wichita, Kan., OM John "Boy" Speer says. "The only problem was he had a couple of more years to 'serve' because of his 'previous position.' He still had to do two



***1998 Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar and Awards - Sept. 17-19***





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## Allen Kovac To Speak At Radio Seminar

Allen Kovac, chairman/CEO of the Left Bank Organization, has amassed quite a track record of creating successful entertainment projects and enterprises over the last two decades, while building a Who's Who of artist careers, including Duran Duran, John Mellencamp, Luther Vandross, the Bee Gees, Deana Carter, Motley Crue, En Vogue, Clint Black, and Blondie.

Kovac will share his unique brand of industry knowledge, including his perspective on how radio plays into the big picture, as keynote speaker at the Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar and Awards at 11:45 a.m. Sept. 18. The conference is being held at the Pointe Hilton Resort at Tapatio Cliffs in Phoenix.

Kovac began his career with a successful concert-promotion business while still an undergraduate at the University of Oregon. He then created an independent record company, working with Jeff Lorber, Dave Koz, and Karyn

White, before founding Left Bank in 1983.

In addition, Kovac has created businesses aimed at helping artists target their audiences. In a partnership with Strategic Research, Left Bank pioneered a research venture that applies sophisticated demographic info to the marketing and promotion of artists and music events.

In a recent alliance with DDB-Needham Worldwide, Left Bank has developed advertising campaigns for recorded music, as well as creating original programming, special promotions, and live concert events for artists.



Most recently, Kovac launched independent label Beyond in worldwide partnership with BMG. It comprises national radio, publicity, marketing, and sales departments, as well as local and regional grass-roots support to reach audiences on the street level. The label is home to Blondie, Sponge, Motley Crue, and others.

## Hicks, Muse To Build Global Empire?

**H**icks, Muse, Tate & Furst, the Dallas-based investment firm that has principal interest in both Chancellor and Capstar, continued to show signs that it will make a push to expand its broadcast interests beyond our borders. MVS Communications SA, a Mexican radio group in which Hicks, Muse has a 20% stake, has purchased Radio Grupo Met SA. Grupo Met owns a UHF TV channel and six radio stations in northwest Mexican cities, including Tijuana, Ensenada, and Mexicali. Earlier, Hicks, Muse acquired a 50% interest in Mexico's largest radio firm, Radio Grupo Sexo SA. Further, it has just been reported that the company has acquired a 32.7% stake in Argentine telecom firm CEI Citicorp Holdings for \$700 million.

Hicks, Muse also plans to open an office in London and is reportedly trying to raise up to \$4 billion for its fourth buyout fund. The previous three buyout funds enabled it to turn Capstar into a 300-plus-station radio group and Chancellor into a billion-dollar group. What it would do with that money, we'll soon find out.

### MANAGEMENT: ROBBINS' NEW HOME

Dave Robbins, former GM of Nationwide's Columbus, Ohio, triumvirate of WNCI, WCOL, and WFII-AM, has officially left the company as ownership transfers to Jacor. He didn't have to go far to find a new employer, as he is now VP/GM for CBS' Columbus cluster of album WAZU, country WHOK, and classic rock WLVQ. Expect plenty of competitive fireworks in the coming weeks and months.

### PROGRAMMING

Former WMXV/WDBZ New York PD Steve Weed is named acting PD at top 40 KNDN (the End) Sacramento, Calif.

Chris Miller vacates the PD chair at KKRH (Rosey 105) Portland, Ore. Joel Grey, PD at oldies sister KKS, will assume Miller's duties until a successor is named.

On the heels of PD Wayne Coy's departure for KQKQ (Sweet 98) Omaha, Neb., and its best ratings in many years, WABB-FM Mobile, Ala., has promoted co-APD/mornings Jay Hasting to OM/mornings and co-APD/MD/afternoons Darren Stone to PD. Stone will move to mornings to work with Hasting. Also, overnighter Jeff Jordan moves to Stone's afternoon slot.

WFBC Greenville, S.C., finally found a new PD: WWXM Myrtle Beach, S.C., OM Nikki Nite, who'll start Aug. 25.

KQXY Beaumont, Texas, PD Dale Baird heads north to be PD at WGTZ Dayton, Ohio.

Baird will start in late August.

### PEOPLE: E.Z. DOES IT

One of WROX (X96) Richmond, Va., PD Bill Thorman's first hires is ex-KKFR (Power 92) Phoenix air talent E.Z. Street as MD/afternoons.

Ex-KKPN (the Planet) Houston afternoon host Dave Morales crosses the street to do mornings at KHYS. Also at KHYS, KJYO Oklahoma City afternoon host Todd Tucker comes on board to take an identical shift.

Meanwhile, at sister KBXX (the Box) Houston, PD-turned-OM Rob Scorpio will soon be bowing out of his morning gig; the station is already looking for his successor.

WKRQ (Q102) Cincinnati morning host John

Jay and sidekick Dangerboy Bobo have left the station; they'll resurface elsewhere in the near future. Meanwhile, afternoon guy Brian Douglas and MD Jim Kelly will co-host the shift until a permanent replacement is made; Mark McFadden takes afternoons for now.

Former country KZLA Los Angeles jock Bo Reynolds heads for the Rockies to co-host afternoon drive with Greg Thunder at KALC (Alice at 106) Denver.

Although he just joined the station, Mark "Mojo JoJo" Allen exits his MD/afternoons post at KGBT (the Beat) Austin, Texas.

KSIV (Kiss) Bakersfield, Calif., husband-and-wife morning duo Davin and Ann Fesmire are crossing the street for the same at KKXX.

WNST Charleston, S.C., PD Beau Richards segues to WAOA Melbourne, Fla., for afternoons.

MD Eric Moon is promoted to APD of WNKI Elmira, N.Y.

Crossover WPGC-FM Washington, D.C., co-APD/creative services guy Bob Holmcrans exits the station after 11 years. Holmcrans, who is opting to stay home to raise his children, can be reached at 301-589-7125.

### IT'S ALL OVER BUT THE FORMAT FLIP

With the sale of KKLQ (Q106) San Diego from Jacor to Heftel just hours or days away, Q106 has stopped running all station IDs, and it's playing a brand of mainstream top 40, similar to what Jacor sister KHTS (Channel 93-3) is playing, in anticipation of a flip to Spanish.

### CONTROVERSIES R US

Say what you will about top 40's inherent female appeal and its normally topically wholesome or cash-based promotions (give or take a Clinton-inspired dry-cleaning giveaway), two heritage top 40s are pushing the envelope when it comes to playing off touchy subjects. KIIS Los Angeles is

## Crossover Reports To R&B At Interscope

**MUSICAL CHAIRS:** In an unusual step, Interscope has assembled a regional crossover promotion staff reporting to R&B promotion head Step Johnson. Duties for Interscope's national crossover promo guru Nino Cuccinello essentially remain the same, while Northeast regional Karen Rait drops several stations to concentrate on the rhythmic outlets in her region. Los Angeles-based mix-show promotion guy Brian Grey moves to Houston to work stations there. Interscope will hire a Northeast regional to replace Rait. New to the label's promotion staff are former Universal Los Angeles R&B promo rep Tony Collins, who will be based in L.A.; former WPGC Washington, D.C., mix-show coordinator Tracy Young, who joins in Miami; former EMI Bay Area local Sam Bates, who picks up San Francisco-area stations; and former Chicago-based Crave staffer Jamie Guzman, who joins in that market . . . Epic Boston-based regional Jimmy Walorj joins Hollywood for Northeast regional promotion chores. Switching from Epic's artist-development department to promotion to fill Walorj's shoes is Bill Millman, while New York regional Todd Glassman adds national pop responsibilities to his plate. Recently departed Crave staffer Dawn Fox will focus on crossover promotion for the Epic Records Group . . . Elektra's Eric Olesen has relocated to the label's New York offices; he can be reached at 212-275-4097 . . . Skip Bishop's indie promo and marketing firm, Bishop Bait & Tackle, is relocating from Panama City Beach, Fla., to New York in September . . . Atlantic names Robert Wieger VP of product development. Wieger recently headed his own company, Worldwide Artist Management, of which Real McCoy was a client . . . Former Geffen national promotion guy David Grant has joined Maverick as marketing manager . . . TVT names Nadine Gelineau director of product management and artist development. She was director of international marketing at Freeworld . . . Mildred Morgan joins Verity from Epic as manager of publicity . . . By the time you read this, there will have been a major executive shake-up in the Sony building. Next issue, the Spin will have all the details.

The name of Columbia's Roze Braunstein was incorrectly spelled last issue . . . Last issue, spring Arbitron ratings for WWZZ Washington, D.C., and KTXQ Dallas were omitted by mistake. WWZZ's 12-plus share was 4.1, good for sixth in the market, and KTXQ's was 2.4 . . . Last week's playlist for AC reporter KSNE Las Vegas was reused this issue because the station was mistimed during the survey period.

giving away actual pieces of O.J. Simpson's Brentwood estate, which was recently demolished by its new owner.

Touchier still was KKRZ (Z100) Portland, Ore.'s reward for capturing a teenage armed robber. When "Morning Zoo" host John Murphy got wind of a local high schooler bragging about his exploits (19 holdups) to his friends in Mexico, Z100 offered a \$1,000 reward for the tip that

## Jimmy Steal Finds The Right Mix Of Hits, Image, And Personality At KDMX Dallas

Even months ago, Jimmy Steal was faced with a career-defining choice: stay at the successful heritage top 40 WKRQ (Q102) Cincinnati or take a shot at a less-than-sure thing in a larger market.

"Leaving is never easy when you've built a great team and are doing great radio," he says of his PD tenure at Q102. "We doubled our billing by pulling an 8 share, but like a lot of people in this business, when a new challenge is presented to you at the right time, there's no way you can pass it up."

That opportunity was KDMX (Mix 102.9) Dallas. "After hearing the station and monitoring the tracking to see where they sized up in the market matrix, it seemed like an opportunity that called for my area of expertise—namely, station imaging and assembling a team that responds well when you throw raw meat in the control room."

What made KDMX a less-than-sure thing? "It needed a complete marketing overhaul, on-air and otherwise," Steal says. "After ab-

sorbing myself into KDMX's history, I built a timeline on what we have to do in increments to achieve our goals, revenue-wise. The length of that timeline depends on the people you're trying to displace in the ratings. You have to find out the best ways to undo their market equity. Here, our three main rivals' morning-drive hosts have over 60 years in the market. Mine has less than a year, so we had our work cut out for us."

The first order of business was the music library, because "that could be fixed the quickest," Steal says. "The music needed a better focus. The station had to be known for something musically. When people can't describe what we do in a few words, that's a problem. We had to ascertain our listeners' musical appetite to fill holes in the matrix and exploit our competitors' weaknesses."

As it turns out, the music of choice in Dallas is not too dissimilar to what he played at WKRQ. "Both Mix and Q102 are very hit-oriented," he says. "Being in a smaller market, it was easier to get quick read on a song at WKRQ. Here in a market of almost 4 million people, you have to devote a few more spins to get an accurate read."

Here's a typical hour on KDMX: Goo Goo Dolls, "Iris"; 10,000 Maniacs, "Trouble Me"; matchbox 20, "Push"; Edwin McCain, "I'll Be"; Go-Go's "We Got The Beat"; Semisonic, "Closing Time"; Madonna, "Frozen"; Fastball "The Way"; OMD, "If You Leave"; Alanis Morissette, "Uninvited"; Sugar Ray, "Fly"; ABC, "The Look Of Love (Part 1)"; and Joan Osborne, "One Of Us."

That music mix places KDMX in the modern AC/adult top 40 realm, yet Steal refrains from jumping on the Alice bandwagon. "It's dangerous to base your success on music trends," he says. "I'm a big believer in playing hit music; we're just a non-rhythmic pop station for adults. You can call us modern AC or hot AC—as long as we're successful."

Several of Mix's powers practically refuse to die. "I've had to move some songs back on gut since research showed no burn," Steal says. "Every so often, a song like Sister Hazel's 'All For You' comes along, which appeals to males and females equally. You can sing along after one listen, and there's no abrasiveness. You can't have too many of those songs."

Choosing the hits are Steal, APD Race Taylor, and MD Lisa Thomas. "I like to be surrounded by people who are passionate about music," he says. "Even our marketing director is music-intensive. We take hits wherever and whenever we can get them. If the artists have a track record, we may give them the benefit of the doubt, but are they automatics? Only the audience decides that."

Steal realizes that the right music mix won't turn a station around by itself. "Although I'm a real stickler with the music, it takes more to bring people to KDMX. That's where your personality franchise comes in. It's an unduplicable success component."

To combat rival KIIKS (Kiss-FM) and KVIL's morning franchises, Steal showcases Alan Kabel, a veteran of stations such as KIIKS Los Angeles and WBBM-FM (B96) Chicago. "He totally gets winning radio," Steal asserts. "I basically built Mix around him and gave him the freedom to do what he does best. He's extremely creative and witty. His show is as good as any show in the market. It's just that our primary competitors each have 15 to 20 years of market equity, and that doesn't get erased fast."

A typical promo event designed around Kabel was a "mammogram party bus." "He took people without health insurance to a place for free mammograms, as well as other health and medical giveaways," Steal says. "Our female co-host, U-Turn Laverne, got her mammogram live on a local TV-news broadcast with the newscast's female anchor. We raised awareness and had fun at the same time."

Awareness isn't the only thing KDMX has raised. By going 3.8-5.0 12-plus in the spring book, KDMX achieved its highest ratings in its 25-year history. Those kinds of numbers help Steal resist the temptation of adding units to increase revenue.

"As a programmer, I have two jobs," he says. "One is to create revenue, but first and foremost is to program to an audience. If you put the audience first, you'll reach your station's revenue goals. In Cincinnati, I took Q102 from \$4 million to \$9 million in revenue without adding one unit. We increased the property's value through ratings."

"We do 10 units per hour now, but being third for the first time ever in 25-54 adults will generate more revenue without adding units. Now I temper that by totally getting the notion of debt service, yet I still believe the entertainment value of your station will ultimately make or break you, not the extra unit per hour. Seizing the moment creatively and intelligently will have more impact on your success. Truly entertaining stations can do 20 units an hour and still be No. 1."

By the time you read this, KDMX will have a new owner—Jacor. Suffice it to say, Steal relishes the chance to work with the likes of B.J. Harris, Tom Owens, and Marc Chase. "CEO Randy Michaels used to be a PD. Can you ask for anything more than that?"

"Jacor is built on the notion that radio is show biz, and I believe that, too," he says. "Creatively, I think they'll let me get wilder and do things that will really raise some eyebrows. We're not going to be coarse and vulgar, but we are going to be foreground and interactive—a self-deprecating entertainment product. That's how we provoke listeners to make them remember our call letters in the Arbitron game."

# TOP 40 TOPICS

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## As Format Grows, Wars Are Inevitable

**O**ver the last three years, a new handful of top 40 sign-ons have shown that there's room for at least one mainstream top 40 in each market. What we haven't seen so far is much evidence that there's room for the multi-station top 40 wars that used to exist in the mid-'80s. Only two mainstream top 40s, WWHT (Hot 107.9) Syracuse, N.Y., and WVTI (196) Grand Rapids, Mich., have made much headway into their respective markets, and only 196 has done it, at least thus far, without cannibalizing its format rival, WSNX.

Despite that, as top 40's resurgence continues, it's clear that we're going to see more markets with mainstream top 40 wars. Honolulu was never known for its ability to support one mainstream top 40, but the success of KXME was enough to draw KQMQ back from rhythmic. In Birmingham, Ala., it took only the announcement that Cox intended to present mainstream top 40 on WEDA to draw Captain's WQEN over from adult top 40. In Houston, KHYS is now head to head with rival KRBE, despite signal limitations. In Washington, suburban AM WINX hopes top 40 will put it on the map, despite even greater odds.

Perhaps the biggest surprise, however, is Norfolk, Va., where two stations are joining the fray. Nearby WCXL (Beach 104), previously a hot AC to Elizabeth City, N.C., is now targeting Norfolk with mainstream top 40, while WROX (X96) recently gave up modern rock to become top 40 Tha Bomb under PD Bill Thorman. WROX, despite considerable signal limitations, was earning about a 4 share as the only full-fledged modern rocker in the market (although there was plenty of competition, including a modern adult outlet). And while there's been a hole for mainstream in the market, rhythmic WNVZ (Z104) has always been close enough to the pop side that the difference between it and a Thorman outlet, which traditionally has a heavy R&B flavor, may not be that obvious to the casual listener.

The new cluster of top 40 sign-ons represents a considerable change in thinking from just a few years ago. At that point, it was hard enough to convince many operators that there was a hole for one top 40 in many markets. Now, instead of looking for a hole in the market, many owners just want to take a piece of the biggest player—and only now, after a seven- or eight-year drought—are we seeing enough top 40s atop their market's ratings that they've become tempting targets again, just as country stations were in the early '90s.

Many of the second and third country stations that signed on in that era managed to grow the format's shares, at least initially. However, those stations were usually the first ones hurt when country's young end left. And when the stations' shares dwindled, or when they

went away altogether, their audience didn't move to the other country station. They just drifted elsewhere; that also happened when the second top 40s went away in the early '90s.

If you believe that a second top 40 can help grow the audience, and if, like most people, you subscribe to the notion that competition makes everyone better, then we should be in for some really terrific radio nationwide in the months ahead. Thus far, Grand Rapids is the only evidence that a second station grows the shares, however. And as for competition, I'd like that to be true. Just as often, head-to-head format wars provoke stations to narrow their focus as they react to each other and not the needs of the audience. That saps the resources these stations need to do better radio.

Top 40 is healthier these days, but it's not strong enough to support the wars of attrition that sprung up a decade ago. One hopes that the new stations will play gently with one another, at least for a little while, until the top 40 outlets, having dispensed with the rest of the market, can turn their guns on one another. Clearly, that's not the goal of KHYS, which is there for the obvious purpose of shaving points off KRBE on behalf of R&B rival KBXX (the Box). Otherwise, the new outlets are in the format because they think there's some upside for them. And that's encouraging.

It's also encouraging to see Thorman back in action. And I'm happy to be able to hear WROX on the Web (you can find it through broadcast.com). Already, I've heard one liner on WROX that I'd steal tomorrow if I were programming. There's a line in WROX's music-image promo in which the announcer declares, "We took the best songs from all the [other] stations." That's a pretty obvious selling point for top 40 but not one that I've heard put that way anywhere else until now.

**STILL "CRAZY":** I often see parallels between today's hits and the key records in top 40's early-'80s resurgence. But for a parallel to Edwin McCain's "I'll Be," you have to go back a few years further to Paul Davis' "I Go Crazy." That song, released in the summer of '77, got immediate airplay in the Southern secondary markets where Davis (like McCain) had already garnered attention with previous releases. But it took "I Go Crazy" more than six months to become a major-market hit in the North. The song would eventually spend a surprising 40 weeks on the Hot 100 chart, getting as high as No. 7. Because the song had already run its course in many of its original markets, "I Go Crazy" probably would've been an even bigger chart record if it had developed everywhere at the same time. (Davis, by the way, after more than a decade's hiatus as a solo artist, is recording again on the incarnation of his former label, Bang, as BANG II.)








Question: Which do you read regularly; that is, at least 3 out of 4 issues?



more years in prison for armed robbery."

### YOU NEVER FORGET THE FIRST TIME

One of the first T&R packages Mark Anderson received as PD of top 40 WYSS (99.5 Yes FM) Sault Ste. Marie, Mich., "came in a sloppily addressed, dirty manila envelope. The cover letter/résumé was written, also in poor penmanship, on a page from a Kelly Music Research notepad that was distributed to attendees of the 1997 Conclave. His stock, five-minute cassette contained nothing but ambient household noise on the front side, as if he were using a dual-cassette jambox to dub the aircheck but without the source cassette. On the reverse side was a poorly home-made, off-the-air skim of the night jock on WPLT [the Planet] Detroit. Ironically, I work weekends at WPLT, and that jock's a good friend of mine."

### SO MUCH FOR BEING A NICE GUY

Album KRXQ Sacramento, Calif., PD Curtiss Johnson remembers when he was in Phoenix and received a certain aircheck. "The guy had this lisp and was absolutely awful, stilted and stiff," he says. "I sent him back a rejection letter, but I invited him to keep sending tapes so I could hear how he was progressing. I'd get a new tape from this guy every three months for maybe two years—and they never got any better."

### TODAY JACKSONVILLE, TOMORROW...

"One guy, in addition to his tape, sent a head shot of himself wearing a crown on top of his cowboy hat," WROO (Rooster Country 107) Jacksonville, Fla., PD Buzz Jackson says. "He even signed it, 'Buzz, together we can rule Jacksonville. Long live the King!'"

### 'MR./MS. CONGENIALITY' WINNERS

Wayne Coy, imminent PD of top 40 KQKQ (Sweet 98) Omaha, Neb., recalls two aircheck packages that really stood out. "One guy stuck his package on a prosthetic leg and left it at the door. On his résumé he wrote, 'Whatever it takes to get my foot in the door.' Another guy's package was delivered by a female [ahem] 'entertainer.' The tape sucked, but the presentation was great."

### AT LEAST HE'S CONSISTENT

Country WESC-AM-FM Greenville, S.C., OM Ron Brooks says he couldn't begin to count the number of "incredibly horrible aircheck packages." One, however, stands out. "It did everything wrong," he asserts. "The cover letter was addressed 'to whom it may concern' and was a multiple-generation photocopy that was skewed noticeably, as was the photocopied résumé. The aircheck tape was of incredibly poor quality, and the audio level was so low that the tape hiss buried most of the audio. To cap it all off, the aircheck sounded like it was recorded with the condenser mike on a portable recorder."

### ALMOST BEATS A RABBIT'S FOOT

Album WYSP Philadelphia PD Neal Mirsky has carried one aircheck around with him for 20 years. "This guy did it on a boombox and could not string three words together. At first, all you can hear is a very loud but stilted voice say, 'W-Q-X-M. This is 98 Rock!' Then he goes into some horrible old pop song from the late '70s, and to make matters even worse, he breaks in throughout the record and yells, 'This is 98 Rock!' and 'Look out now! This is 98 Rock!'"

### TAKES DIRECTION—WELL...

Country WYRK Buffalo, N.Y., APD/MD John Paul likes to offer sage advice to these neophytes. And pays for it, too. "I got a very professional-looking package from a man who had a Ph.D. in a radio/TV-related field," he recalls. "He spent most of his life in school, learning radio and TV by the books, without one day of commercial radio experience—and you could tell by his tape. When I told him he needed some part-time commercial radio experience, he exploded on the phone and told me he had the education and that was the most important thing in any business. I never heard from him again." Let's hear it for happy endings.

### YOU KNOW WHEN YOU KNOW

When consultant Keith Hill was PD of AC WKJY Long Island, N.Y., he received a tape from

"a guy who claimed to know a famous New York jock, who told him that PDs don't need to know that you can do segues. 'I haven't included any segues, even though I work as a mobile DJ and can do them, you know.' He proceeds to spend 10 minutes just talking about what precious little he knows about radio in a thick New York accent, saying 'you know' about 60 times."

### DON'T BELIEVE YOUR EARS

So says consultant Alan Burns about airchecks. Why? "One guy sent me three of the best airchecks I've ever heard, but it turned out he was great in the production studio but so frightened of being on the air, he was near speechless. I interviewed another guy who sent a great aircheck, but he had a murderous stutter. Yet I put him on the air, and he was perfect."

### REALLY GOING POSTAL

Adult top 40 WOMX (Mix 105.1) Orlando, Fla., PD David Isreal is forever haunted by the "postman." "On his aircheck, he had to hit every post, and I mean every damn post. One song had a 52-second intro. Well, here comes the call letters, the state's quick-three lottery numbers, followed by the match-four and finally the Super Lotto jackpot—nine numbers—and, just in case you missed it, those numbers again were . . . And he still hit the post. Well, the guy moved on, but I recently got an updated aircheck from him. He sounds much better—and still hits every damn post."

### THE SOUND OF ONE AIR CHECKING

What happens to PDs when they OD on T&Rs? When Alan Burns was a jock just out of college, he sent an aircheck to the PD of WAKY Louisville, Ky. "Unbeknown to me, a friend also sent a copy of the very same tape, so the PD had two identical airchecks. One tape elicited a rejection letter, while the other incited a call from the PD, who offered me afternoon drive."

### IT CAME FROM VOICE MAIL

Here are some reasons why modern KEDJ (the Edge) Phoenix PD Shellie Hart will print "Absolutely no calls, please" in future job-opening ads. This is a collection of her most memorable voice mails:

• "Hey, Shellie, you know that tape I sent you six months ago? Well, it was my only copy, and I'm coming by today to pick it up."

• "Sorry to bug you again. I was just hoping for a call-back. I realize this is the seventh call today, but . . ." (Call made on a Tuesday.)

• "Hi, I just graduated from broadcast school, and I'm looking for an entry-level on-air position. My annual salary goal is \$75,000. Would you like my résumé? Can you call me back?"

• "Listen here, big baby. This here's Cooky Love. I know you wanna hire my ass. Let hoochie mama come in and make everything OK." (Check that; she hired this guy.)

### SEND THIS TO THE SMITHSONIAN

"A guy sent me an aircheck, and during one of the breaks, I heard a toilet flushing and a door closing, but he made no reference to it," R&B K11Z Killeen, Texas, PD Michael Maguire notes. "When I called to give him feedback, I asked about it. He said he didn't have the equipment at home to do it right, and he had been locked out of the station that fired him. So he did his tape while he did his business."

### FAMOUS LOST WORDS

Before you start calling air-talent syndicators, consider another tale, courtesy of Wayne Coy. "I was PD of WIXX [Green Bay, Wis.] when I got a tape from a weekend guy in Kansas City who demanded that he be hired only to do mornings," he says. "Being half of the morning show at the time, there was no way I was going to take myself off the air. But I still listened to his tape, and the guy was out there, but he was very cliché-ridden. Even though it was pretty bad, I kept the tape."

"Eight years later, I was cleaning out my stuff when I found that tape and played it. I looked at the package, and it was from a guy named Holy Moly Muller. Now he goes by the name of Man-cow. I told him he had a long way to go, but let's compare paychecks now."
