## Boberg's Alternative Roots Reinvent MCA And Score Mainstream Success

About 20 years ago, Jay Boberg, as UCLA's student-body concert director, staged a free daytime Talking Heads concert on campus. A few months later, he helped start up I.R.S. Records, a label that would help introduce what was then called "new wave" to a very resistant America. Now, as president of MCA Records, he's using some of the tactics from his I.R.S. tenure to break such MCA acts as Sublime, Semisonic, and K-Ci & JoJo into the mainstream.

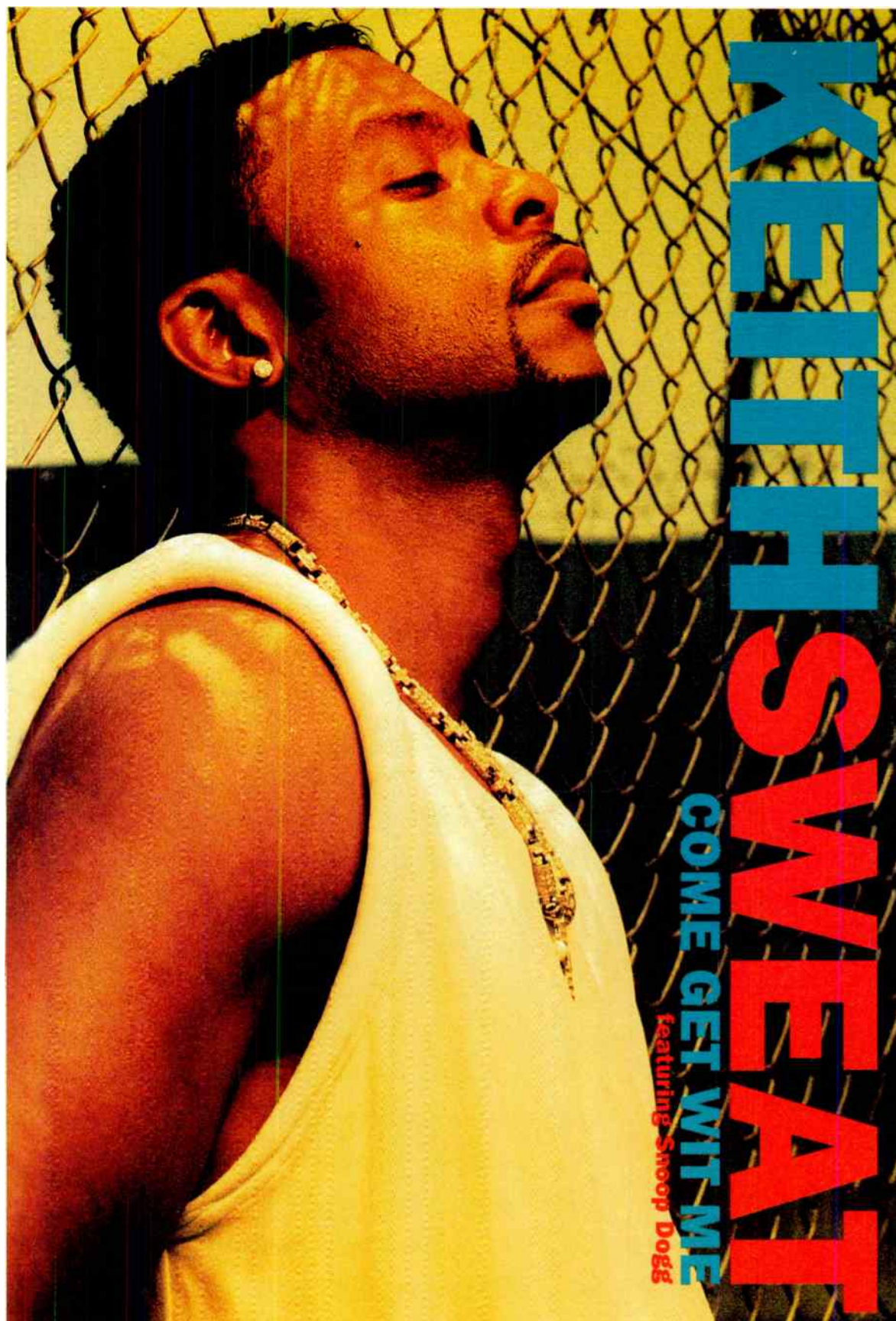
Boberg attributes his success to his willingness to take risks and stay true to his passion for music and artist development. In the late '70s, he had to

choose between graduation, with a future in computer studies or law school, and being VP of I.R.S. Records for Miles Copeland, who managed an up-and-coming band called the Police.

"I helped him and his brother, Ian, on the Police's college tour of the West, so when he asked me about starting a label, I didn't wonder who this crazy guy was," Boberg says. "Well, he was crazy, but at least I knew who he was."

"Miles pitched it as an entrepreneurial opportunity. I'd co-own it with him, and if we turned it into something, great. Plus, I was passionate about the music. It was a cause to us, even though most people thought

## Top 40 Titans Converge At Radio Seminar

The programmers set to appear on the "Will Success Spoil Top 40?" panel Sept. 18 at the Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar and Awards illustrate the format's dramatic resurgence.

The panelists include WHITZ (Z100) New York PD Tom Poleman, who has returned the Big Apple's heritage outpost from an also-ran to a major player, with its best numbers in years; KHS Los Angeles PD Dan Kieley, credited for breathing new life into the cume monster; KRBE Houston PD John Peake, whose station defines mainstream music in the market; WKRQ (Q102) Cincinnati OM Mike Marino, who has quickly turned the tide for Cincy's heritage top 40; WZJM Cleveland PD "Big" Dave Eubanks, who has established the station as a formidable pop force in a once rock-only market; and PD Todd



Shannon, who has just recently veered KHTS (Channel 933) San Diego into the pop mainstream. Moderating the panel will be Airplay Monitor editor Sean Ross.

Expect the panelists to discuss how they fine-tuned their respective stations into winning market contenders, as well as how they plan to maintain their success in the coming era of further consolidation, increased competition, and demands for more revenue streams.

"Will Success Spoil Top 40?" will run 10-11:15 a.m. Sept. 18 at the Pointe Hilton Resort at Tapatio Cliffs in Phoenix. The seminar runs Sept. 17-19.

Accommodations for the seminar are going fast, as both the host Pointe Hilton at Tapatio Cliffs and nearby Pointe Hilton at Squaw Peak have already sold out.

## Jacor Settles With DOJ, Closes On Nationwide

Jacor has reached a settlement with the Department of Justice allowing it to close on its \$620 million acquisition of Nationwide Communications. The purchase is conditional on Jacor's already-announced divestiture of five stations in Columbus, Ohio; two in San Diego; and one in Cleveland. With the closing comes news from the stations, yet unconfirmed by Jacor, that WMVX Cleveland GM Jim Meltzer will oversee Jacor's market cluster there and that his Louisville counterpart, Tom Schurr, will transfer to KHMJ/KTBZ Houston.

In other Jacor news, its modern WAQZ (Channel Z) Cincinnati adds a liberal dose of rhythmic hits this week. Although that would seem to put it in the neighborhood of the Jerry Clifton-inspired Extreme radio (as heard on KXME Honolulu and KPTY Phoenix), PD Matt Harris describes the new sound as "pure top 40, just playing all the hits." The station's handle and staff remain the same.

Also, WSJW Louisville, Ky., which is separately owned, but in a JSA with Jacor, flips from jazz to adult top 40 as WMHX (Mix 103.9). Finally, Randy Starr remains station manager/PD. Former Jacor top 40 PD Gabe Hobbs is named Jacor director of N/T programming.

### PROGRAMMING: G105 EXPANDS

After 12-18 months as a de facto modern AC outlet, WDCG (G105) Raleigh, N.C., is opening up this week with the addition of Aerosmith's "I Don't Want To Miss A Thing" and Savage Garden's "To The Moon And Back." OM Brian Burns says the station will still lean modern but G105 "went a little further than we needed to" toward the modern side.

Top 40 WXYV Baltimore, becomes "B102.7—the Buzz." No staff changes at WXYV, which is using the positioner "Baltimore's hit music."

In addition to Big City's flip of WCBR Chicago to a simulcast of modern KLYY (Y107) L.A., the company also picks up country WLRT Kankakee, Ill., and top 40 WDEK, De Kalb, Ill., and adds them to the Y107 convoy circling the Windy City.

New top 40 WRX Norfolk, Va., which planned to bill itself "Tha Bomb," instead decides to use its old modern rock handle, 96X. Its secondary positioner is "Virginia's new music vibe."

### BUSINESS: PARTY FINE UPHELD

The FCC has upheld a \$7,500 notice of liability against KPTY Phoenix for playing Prince's "Erotic City" in November '96. The FCC rejected the station's arguments that, among other things, the song was not indecent by its own community standards or that the song's use of the "F word" was comparable to a case where the FCC had allowed the word in news programming. Mean-

while, KPTY's "Shadie Katie" Makos join classic rock rival KGLQ a recent Nationwide-to-Jacor transfer, amid rumors of a flip to adult top 40.

Capstar taps WPLR New Haven, Conn., GM Rob Williams to succeed Gordon Weingarh as VP/GM of its Hartford, Conn., cluster: top 40 WKSS, modern WMRQ, classic rock WHCN, country WWYZ, and sports WPOP.

With CBS Radio's San Jose, Calif., properties now consolidated, soft AC KBAY VP/GM David Burke assumes similar duties for CBS Radio's hot AC KEZR as San Jose market manager. Also, KEZR PD Jim Murphy is upped to OM, adding KBAY to his overview.

Nassau Broadcasting adds oldies/AC combo WDLG/WTSX Port Jervis, N.Y., to its northwest New Jersey cluster.

### PEOPLE

The New York Post reports that MTV and WKTU New York are possible new homes for Doctor Dre, former morning host at crosstown R&B outlet WQHT (Hot 97). At press time, WQHT's morning show was continuing with Ed

Lover and Lisa G. Meanwhile, WKTU PD Frankie Blue is quoted as saying, "Maybe there's a home here for [Dre]," while an MTV spokesperson says the network is planning to bring back "Yo! MTV Raps," the show that brought Dre and Lover to stardom.

KHMJ (Mix 96.5) Houston middayer Ann Duran is now doing the same at adult top 40 WBIX (Big 105) New York.

Former KPWR (Power 106) Los Angeles morning co-host Big Lez joins rival KKBT (the Beat) for middays, replacing Diana Steele, now at co-owned KMEL San Francisco.

KBKS (Kiss 106) taps P/T Corey Dillon for its long-vacant midday position. Dillon was also morning producer for Robin and Maynard at classic rock sister KZOK.

WQZQ (the Party) moves overnighter Rick the Driver to nights, replacing Lulu.

WZYP Huntsville, Ala., names KYRX Cape Girardeau, Mo., APD/MD/mornings Stu Gray MD. He joined WZYP for nights several weeks ago with ex-KYRX morning partner Ryan Williams.

WQEN (103.7, the Q) Birmingham, Ala., picks up Luka, former morning host at modern rival WRAX, for afternoons, sending Scott Bohannon back to middays, replacing Jamie Green.

WZEE (Z104) Madison, Wis., has shuffled its lineup. PD Jimmy Steele goes from afternoons to noon-3 p.m., Bonnie Oleson's midday gig is now 10:00 a.m.-noon, and MD Tommy Bo Dean segues from nights to afternoons.

WINX Rockville, Md., weekend air personality Dan Lane heads for WRVQ (Q94) Richmond, Va., for P/T.

## Epic Names Bisceglia Executive VP

MUSICAL CHAIRS: As expected, former Crave Records president Rick Bisceglia is named executive VP of Epic Records Group (ERG). Bisceglia will direct all promotion activities for ERG labels Epic Records, 550 Music, and Work. Bisceglia will report to the presidents of the respective labels: Polly Anthony at Epic Records and 550 Music and Jeff Ayeroff and Jordan Harris at Work. As executive VP of ERG, however, he reports directly to ERG chairman David Glew. Look for further changes at ERG in the coming weeks. Epic Records senior VP of promotion John Boulos has resigned; he can be reached at 914-271-6012.

Geffen's national director of promotion, Kevan Rabat, exits, and Elektra quickly taps Rabat for regional duties in Virginia, Baltimore, Washington, D.C., and the eastern part of North Carolina. In a related move, Elektra's Atlanta-based regional John McFadden will work all stations east of Tennessee to Charlotte, N.C., and Charlotte-based regional Jennifer Sligh will relocate to Chicago. Elektra has its eye on someone in particular for a newly created Philadelphia-based regional position. And Geffen San Francisco promotion rep Scott Perlewitz joins Reprise in the same capacity.

Priority ups Jennifer Norwood from national manager of mix-show promotion to Northeast regional promotion director. Norwood will relocate to New York... Former Sony Music Distribution honcho Richard Bengloff has joined Elektra Entertainment Group as senior VP/CFO... Legacy's Seth Rothstein is upped to senior director of jazz marketing.

ON THE CHARTS: Effective this issue, the number of spins required for Airpower status on the mainstream top 40 chart is raised from 1,500 to 2,000, due to the large number of reporters that has been added in the past few months. The number of Airpower spins is raised from 700 to 900 for the adult top 40 chart and 500 to 600 for the rhythmic top 40 chart.

The following stations are added to the mainstream top 40 panel: WEZB (B97.1) New Orleans (PD Rob Wagman, MD Stacey Brady, 504-834-9587); KQMQ Honolulu (MD/interim PD Cathy Nakagawa, 808-591-9369); KDND (the End) Sacramento, Calif. (acting PD/MD Steve Weed, 916-334-7777); WROX Norfolk, Va. (PD Bill Thorman, MD E.Z. Street, 757-640-8500); and WXSS (Kiss 103.7) Milwaukee (PD Brian Kelly, MD Jojo Martinez, 414-529-1250). In addition, KKRH (Rosie 105) Portland, Ore. (acting PD/MD Joel Grey, 503-223-0105), is added to the adult top 40 panel, and KRUZ Santa Barbara, Calif. (PD/MD Mike O'Brian, 805-963-1831), is added to the adult top 40 and modern adult panels. There are now 102 mainstream top 40, 34 rhythmic top 40, 78 adult top 40, and 61 crossover reporters.

ARTIST MONITOR: Did you know that Sarah McLachlan's first band was a new wave group called *October Game*?... Look for Brandy to be featured in a special DC Comics publication this fall and in Cover Girl's TV spots... *Voices Of Theory* have switched management, moving from Donny Linton of Dick Scott Entertainment to Durrell Bottoms and Michael McCary of *Boyz II Men*'s camp... Work artist Tatyana Ali starts her freshman year at Harvard this September... Puff Daddy's 32-piece spring clothing line now has a name, Sean John... How's this for an unlikely artist collaboration: bump-and-grind king R. Kelly and "Titanic" queen Celine Dion? Those artists have teamed up for "Like An Angel," which will be released to radio in September... Madonna's "Power Of Goodbye" has been selected by WB-TV as the theme song for the new show "Felicity." The single, which will be Madonna's third from her album "Ray Of Light," is tentatively slated for release Sept. 15. The single will also include a live recording of "Little Star" culled from a performance on "Oprah" earlier this summer... Toni Braxton makes her Broadway debut Sept. 9 in "Beauty And The Beast"... The experience Master P has gained writing, producing, and acting in his home video releases "I'm Bout It" and "I Got The Hook Up!" has gotten him noticed by the Hollywood establishment. He's joined the cast of Dimension Films/Millennium Films' "Takedown," a true story about the FBI's two-year pursuit of an alleged computer hacker.

## MONITOR PROFILE

### KPRR El Paso PD John Candelaria Seeks Hits Beyond The Dancefloor

**W**hile the ascent of Spanish-language radio to the No. 1 spot in New York got the headlines, it's an issue for rhythmic programmers nationwide, as illustrated by the spring Arbitron book in El Paso, Texas. There, 12-plus leader KPRR (Power 102) took an almost two-point hit in the spring and lost its market lead to a Spanish AC.

Despite this, the station still pulled a 13.7 share 12-plus. And when it comes to competing against a Spanish-language station, even in El Paso, PD John Candelaria agrees with Emmis VP of programming Steve Smith, who asserts that there's little, if anything, a rhythmic PD can do about it. "You're talking about two different lifestyles," Candelaria says. "To some extent, you want to relate to the [Spanish-speaking] audience as much as possible, but as far as lifestyle and music product, you can't get close to them."

"We do have success reaching [the Spanish-speaking audience] with Latin dance. The Ricky Martins, the Artie The 1 Man Par-

need more Angelinas."

After manning Power 102 for 11 years, Candelaria is quite cognizant of the tastes of the populace, which is at least 70% Hispanic. "The city, in a lot of ways, has stayed the same in terms of the listeners being loyal. Hispanics are comfortable with familiarity; they stick with records for a long time and are very slow to get off."

Add that to the need to maintain adult listeners without "bastardizing" the sound of the station, and the result is a lot of dayparting. "Research will tell us when to open up on a Pras or Aaliyah. We don't want to be ahead of the pack, but move with the pack," he says.

Candelaria may practically be an institution in El Paso, yet he was tempted to take his talents elsewhere. Last year, the Albuquerque, N.M., cluster that includes KYLZ (Wild 106) made a serious bid. "It was an attractive offer, since Albuquerque was my hometown," he admits. "I'd have the opportunity to grow and learn different formats, including the Mega [R&B oldies] format that Don Parker is doing so well with [at KCMG] Los Angeles. That's just what adult Hispanic listeners need."

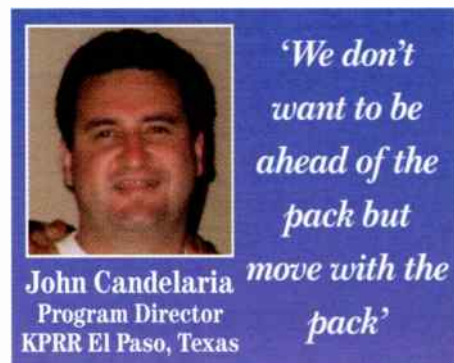
"I hate to say it, but there's considerable room for a Mega here, and one would hurt Power 102, since those records are in our gold library," he adds. "However, the suits are afraid of it, because they don't understand the lifestyle. You constantly have to educate GMs to what you're doing. I'm lucky to have a GM [Bill Struck] who trusts me after the track record I've built over the past seven years."

Instead of losing Candelaria to Albuquerque, Clear Channel upped the ante and signed him to an extension at KPRR. And Clear Channel gave him oversight of what is now a five-station cluster. "We just acquired N/T KTSM-AM and [KTSM-FM] Sunny 99, a satellite AC," he says. "We're going to take it local on Sept. 1 and flavor it with Hispanic Mega records. The satellite AC would normally play Luther Vandross' 'Always And Forever.' But to be in touch with the vibe of this city, we'll play Heatwave's 'Always And Forever.' Luther's is a good AC record, but for El Paso, Heatwave's is better."

Ironically, by flavoring the AC with Hispanic-appeal Mega records, Candelaria admits that Sunny 99 might cut into the size of KPRR's audience. But that's all for the better in a corporate radio world. "That's the name of the game," he says. "Corporations are bringing station clusters together to not only broaden the profit margin but to protect and guard themselves from competition. Mom-and-pop stations can't compete anymore."

"Here, we can use Power to attack from the young end," he adds, "and for Sunny to go for the adults. Together, we can squeeze competing ACs [such as adult top 40 rival KSII]. At the same time, while we push from both ends, each station will guard their core by keeping on their respective targets."

ties, and the Bayside Boys—their records transcend everyone. High-energy dance records with a big Latin appeal are our bread and butter. They give us the perception of being a fun, dance station. Unfortunately, we're at the mercy of available product, and there hasn't been a lot of current Latin product to play."

Compounding his predicament is the fact that pop records are testing well with his 18-34 Hispanic female core. "If they tell us that Natalie Imbruglia's 'Torn' is their favorite record, why shouldn't we play it?" he asks. "We used to be so boxed in with hip-hop and urban that we'd never touch pop, but we're now having so much success with Alanis Morissette and LeAnn Rimes. Our biggest-testing record now is [Shania Twain's] 'You're Still The One.' Not playing [pop], just to stay within a rigid format, will lose a good portion of our audience to the AC stations, which target many of the same females. There's a lot of sharing going on right now."

Here's a typical hour on KPRR: Brandy & Monica, "The Boy Is Mine"; Big Punisher, "Still Not A Player"; Armand Van Helden, "The Funk Phenomenon"; En Vogue, "No Fool, No More"; Mase, "What You Want"; Jon B., "They Don't Know"; Lauryn Hill, "Can't Take My Eyes Off You"; Backstreet Boys, "I'll Never Break Your Heart"; Mighty Dub Kats, "Magic Carpet Ride"; K-Ci & JoJo, "All My Life"; Monifah, "Touch It"; and Depeche Mode, "Personal Jesus."

Despite the greater acceptance of pop crossovers, Candelaria is constantly looking for new Latin product. "We use the mix show specifically to break new records," he says. "Some records that were developed on the mix show have gone into regular rotation; others haven't. The Latin dance records are our secret weapon to guard against the ACs. That's why I keep screaming at Tommy Boy to send me the new Jocelyn Enriquez. We

### The Best Mix Of Shantys & Vets, With No Rap

**P**eople say not to listen to the radio on vacation, and if I were the kind of person who could take that sort of advice, Atlantic Canada would be a logical place to go into radio detox, simply because there's not that much radio available. I've just spent a week driving through the Maritime Provinces of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, and Prince Edward Island, without having more than a few music FMs available at any time. Often, not much at all came in clearly, save for the NPR-like programming of the CBC.

But if I'd done the normal thing and tried to escape from radio on my vacation (the scenery was lovely, by the way; thanks for asking), I would've missed the sea shantys. Twenty-three years ago, a routine on a National Lampoon album, suggested that whaling songs would be the next big thing, and, like the "punk country" that another mid-'70s radio-parody album once jokingly prophesied, they've actually materialized. "Lukey," on which Canadian rock band **Great Big Sea** teams up with the **Chieftains**, wasn't just on the CBC, it was on at least one top 40 station's top eight at 8. And it wasn't that surprising in a region where Celtic-based folk has had a presence at both pop and country radio for the last five to seven years or in a country where **Loreena McKennitt** has been a star for most of the decade.

A lot of Canadian radio's eccentricity is by government mandate. The best-known regulation, the one requiring all stations to play at least 30% Canadian music, is going up to 35% next year. Already it means that if you hear "Me And Bobby McGee" on a Canadian oldies station, it will be by **Gordon Lightfoot**, not **Janis Joplin**. "Jimmy Mack" will be not by **Martha & the Vandellas** but by **Charity Brown**, the first (OK, only) lady of '70s Canadian soul. And "The First Cut Is The Deepest" will be by **Keith Hampshire**, the Canadian who covered it a few years before **Rod Stewart**.

The odd part is that a lot of Canada's more onerous radio regulations have gone away over the last couple of years, and yet Canadian radio is only starting to sound different. Top 40's resurgence is taking place as surely as it did here, but it's being filtered through a broadcast culture that assimilates change slowly.

Until a few years ago, Canadian FMs were effectively prevented from doing top 40 by

rules that limited the number of spins any record could receive to 14-18 a week and required 51% of a station's music to be "non-hit"—records that hadn't reached the top 40 on Billboard's Hot 100. Stations were also required to play about 1,000 different titles a week. Top 40 languished in the U.S. in the mid-'90s, but it disappeared almost totally in Canada, except on video channel MuchMusic.

When the rules changed, some new top 40s cropped up in the larger markets. What exists elsewhere is a handful of very broad FMs on the cusp of hot AC and mainstream top 40. The spin count is higher, but the eclecticism remains. Most of the stations I heard have changed their currents but haven't weeded their gold, and the result is often "Good For Me" by **Amy Grant** into "I Will Buy You A New Life" by **Everclear**. And a lot of artists who haven't been automatics here in a while are still stars on Canadian radio. Even with fewer FM choices, one can still hear "Dance Into The Light" by **Phil Collins** twice within a few hours' time. The positioning also reflects stations in transition. **CHLQ** (Magic 93.1) Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, the hottest of the hot ACs I heard, has modified its "lite rock" slogan and now promises "great lite rock hits."

Most of these top 40/hot AC hybrids play the teen-idol groups. They play **Janet's** "Together Again." **CHLQ** goes as far as **Brandy & Monica** and **Next**. What they don't play yet is rap, despite the fact that hip-hop is a significant presence on Canadian sales charts. Stroll through downtown Halifax on the weekend and hip-hop is blaring from any passing car or open storefront (unless it's classic R&B, which was also playing in a surprising number of shops and restaurants). But the only place you'll hear rap on the radio is in club spots.

Hip-hop has been on the radio in some Canadian markets since the early '90s, but it hasn't reached the Mariannes yet. Having seen the same scenario play out repeatedly in the States, it's not hard to guess what would happen if somebody actually played some, even on a younger-skewing top 40. Same goes for active or modern rock in a region where many of the album outlets still sound more like the classic-skewing U.S. rockers of the late '80s than what exists now. But in a country where new licenses are hard to come by, any change will have to take place among the existing FMs. That change is coming, but slowly.

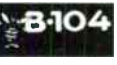

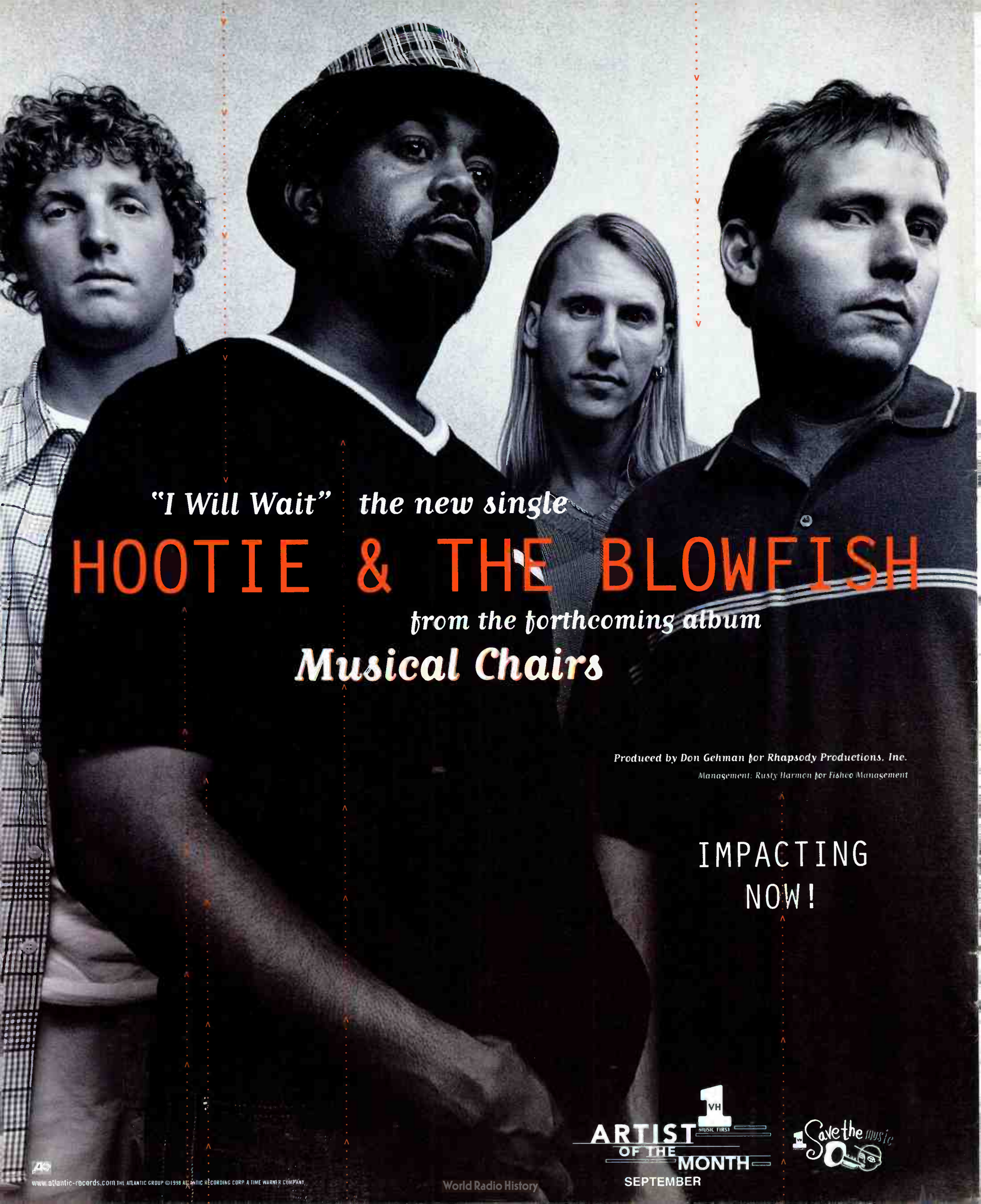
