CONEY HATCH, "FANTASY", MERCURY... Their best radio song to date comes up with more quality in what was a tough week for all but the hottest newer acts--New on WRIF, WCMF, WEBN, WRCN, KILO, WIMZ, and more...WLLZ and WQFM have already increased play and those on include KISS, KISW, KZEW and KTXQ... Dave Kane comments "We had a good run last time with Coney and 'Fantasy' fits in that same groove of tight, melodic rock and roll."

GARY O, "SHADES OF 45", RCA... The Song Index is humming--49-37--and there's oomph in the add count, too. It includes WRIF, DC101, KATT, WOUR, KISS, KLPX, and WDHA...Increases at WLLZ, WQFM and KILO with none down and 34 steady...Exploding might be an understatement.

DIGNEY FIGNUS, "GIRL WITH THE...", COLUMBIA... I remember the fight we had with "Down Under" out of the box as Larry Bruce was one of the few majors helping out, and that's 'cause he heard it in Australia. I think "Hand" offers a lot of the same appeal--with CHR rumbling and the New England AOR success story, why wait?

GENERAL PUBLIC, "NEVER" BW "BURNING", IRS... "Tenderness" surprised a lot of people in terms of sell through and Top 40 exposure...That track record warrants a close look at the new single "Never" and an even harder look at the excellent B Side "Burning". The edge and production are better suited for AOR; KRQR and several more used it out-of-the-box.

CHAIN REACTION CONTINUED

THE TUBES, "LOVE BOMB", CAPITOL... They never go out without bringing back at least one hit per album and "Piece" picks up a 37-30 Primer in the shadow of the Mick and Phil show. Eleven new, 72 total, and ups at KZEW and WBCN ain't exactly piece-meal either! WEBN's Curt Gary flips over: "Probably the most amazing musical experience I've had in quite some time. Side 2 might be the best nine-song dance medley I've ever heard. These guys are undoubtedly the best white funk band in the world." Yow!

VAN MORRISON, "A SENSE OF WONDER", MERCURY... The majors continue to roll in (WIYY, WHJY, WSHE, WLLZ, and 6 others) as do the play increases on WHCN, KZOK, WBRU, and WRCN. Us Van fans love these wonderful numbers: 78-70 Song Index, 47-43 National Lp's. We've got "comeback", "his best in years", and "upper demo city" quotes up the wazoo--obviously "Rimbaud" is the Tour de Force radio has been waiting for.

LOS LOBOS, "WILL THE WOLF SURVIVE", WB... Don't let the Back Page fool you--with six debuts backing everything up, the real story is the adds on KGB, KLOS, WTUE, WAQX, WCCC, WRKI, and the 45-42 Song Index progress. Six ups, 5 max and 10 heavy reports are equally convincing. "Don't Worry" got their attention, but "Survive" will bring these wolves home.

RONNIE DIO, "HUNGRY FOR HEAVEN", GEFLEN... In the soundtrack tone arm wrestling championship, "Vision Quest" pins 'em to the mat. Dio's "Heaven" is heating up the phones at WHCN, WIOT, KGON and KILO, while the bell sounds a 54-43 Index Underline. WYNF, WQFM, KLOS, WYSP, WAAF, WWCK, and 5 more climb in--and heavyweights KISW, KTXQ, WOVE, WHCN, and WRIF take the count to 47 after three weeks.

SAITANA, "SAY IT AGAIN", COLUMBIA... Album radio leads the way but CHR is lined up for heavy breathing, pronto. Carlos charges up to #14 on the Index thanks to 97 on and 36 up to heavy with 15 "Say" increases. Bob Bittens at WHCN is ready for more, "I got a chance to hear the whole album. It has plenty of that searing guitar work that makes Carlos one of the best."

DEEP PURPLE, "NOBODY'S HOME", MERCURY... The granddaddies of Heavy Metal unleash their third round from the "Perfect" arsenal and it scores one of the week's prime moves 53-44. Increases at KSHE and WDIZ, max rotation at WYNF, WLAV and KICT, combine with the retail and tour tonnage to make Purple one of the year's long-haul premier performers.

SIGNIFICANT SONGS:

"JOHNNY BYE BYE", BRUCE SPRINGSTEEN, COLUMBIA... Haven't even heard it, but it's apparently selling the single and in the case of fresh Springsteen, you can almost play now and listen later.

JOHN PARR, "MAGICAL", ATLANTIC... Underlined 60-52-45 in the last three weeks. New on KLOS, WMMS, WLLZ, WSHE, KRCI, WQFM, KQRS, and three more...Increased airspace on KSHE and WLQV with none down. As noted by The Roz, "After just a couple of weeks on the air, it's becoming as addictive as 'Naughty Naughty' was. I'll be surprised if this doesn't sell".

AUTOGRAPH, "MY GIRLFRIEND'S BOYFRIEND ISN'T ME", RCA... Note the early request action on WLQV and WKLS and tell us you haven't seen this movie before. "Girlfriend's Boyfriend" muscles a 91-81 underline, with increases on KISS and KGB, and adds that include WRIF, KTXQ and WLPX. WPDH's Pam Brooks sez, "We still get tremendous phones for 'Turn Up The Radio', which was never treated as the radio anthem it should have been. Tom Petty couldn't have given us a better song title".

LOUDNESS, "CRAZY NIGHTS", ATCO... As serious backers and believers, here's a quick note updating Loudness... Do not be at all concerned regarding the lateral back page numbers this week. With six debuts, almost all the newer acts took it in the shorts--and we're still hearing about unusually active early retail in the fashion of Ratt and Twisted...Action to date includes: WYNF, KMET, KISS, KTXQ, KICT, KZEW, WHJY, WNEW, WRIF, WYSP, WKLS, and WLLZ.

TWO QUICKPICKS: "Get Tough" from the DEL LORDS on EMI truly stood out as one of the most entertaining items we auditioned all week--and believe me, we listened to loads of new material. And this time out, you'll hear multiple trax backing the BLASTERS always hot press and publicity profile. We like "Colored Lights" and "Dark Night".

ACCEPT, "MIDNIGHT MOVER", PORTRAIT/EPIC... Their industrial strength street buzz will require asbestos underwear in about a minute--for now, you can feel the heat on DC101, KGB, WQFM, WAQX, WOUR, and three more just in...Upped at KLAQ and WRCN. Now this from Ted Edwards, "Got a heavy street buzz on the Lp and 'Midnight Mover' is in and delivering. Very strong song, excellent ballsy production and a solid performance. This one looks like a winner."

GO WEST, "WE CLOSE...", CHRYSALIS... Up a couple of notches to #97, and new on nine. WCPZ's Kevin Young confesses, "I waited a week on this one and that was 7 days too long. That keyboard hook and blue-eyed soul vocals make this one a must"...WOUR's Tom Starr expects it to be "wall to wall", and as far as our ears hear it, that's the right call.

WANG CHUNG, "FIRE" (BREAKFAST CLUB), A&M... A&M is probably so pleased with the Simple Minds progress they won't be leaning on you for Wang Chung--but if you played "Dance Hall" consider a track we think is at least as good...Wake up!

JOAN ARMATRADING, "TEMPTATION", A&M... The Northeast base firms up with WQBK, WPLR, WBRU, WBAB, WDHA, WBLM, among the 15 first weekers. WQBK's John Collins tells us "Temptation" is getting instant phone response". And, WBRU's Amanda Tepper concurs, "The horn and acoustic guitar are a nice combo and the voice is as warm and smooth as ever. We'd like to see her have a hit".

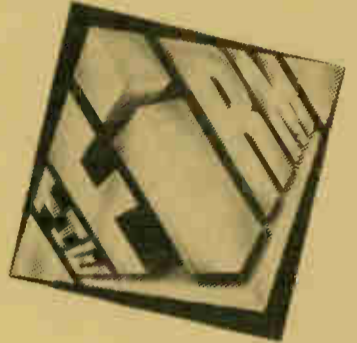

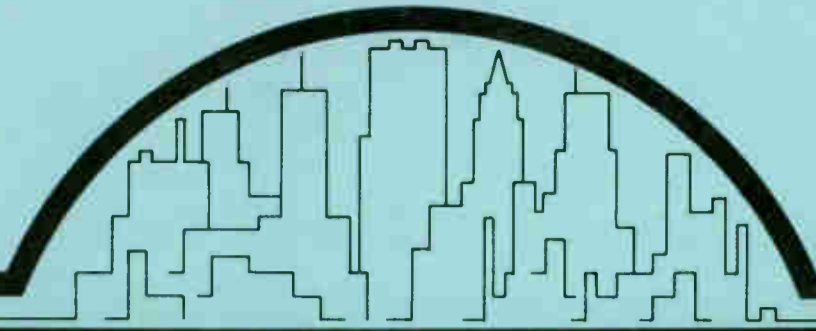

MCA Delivering The Music Of The 80's

News From Rock Over London



ELTON JOHN recently revealed in an interview that his next musical project will be a duet with KIKI DEE, and he sees the possibility of writing a song for TINA TURNER.

GODLEY AND CREME are changing gear from video making as they get set for the release of a new single early next month.

"Everytime You Go Away" is the title of the latest track from PAUL YOUNG, and that's from his "Secrets Of Association" Lp. By the way, the song was originally done by HALL & OATES.

DAVID BOWIE has been invited to write a song for a JULIEN TEMPLE film, "Absolute Beginners". It's a film about the impact of the 50's. Other British contributors to the soundtrack include: ELVIS COSTELLO and PAUL WELLER of STYLE COUNCIL, who has put forward something called "Have You Had It Blue". The film is to have a jazzy feel about it. BOWIE is considering a small acting role, SADE is featured singing in a jazz club scene, and

RAY DAVIES is said to have accepted an acting part too. BOY GEORGE, MICK JAGGER, and KEITH RICHARDS are also interested in the film, but their contributions are to be confirmed.

A posthumous bootleg release by JOHN LENNON is causing quite a mystery over here. The single called "Serve Yourself" apparently features LENNON knocking politics, religion, and everything in between. It's also present on another bootleg Lp, "Ying And Yang". It's claimed that a possible source of "Serve Yourself" could be Bermuda, where LENNON's former personal assistant FREDERICK SEAMENS is from. SEAMENS was once charged with stealing various LENNON items including this song. The tapes were returned but it seems that at some point copies were made.

Drummer COZY POWELL has left Whitesnake to join ELP, which is now EMERSON, LAKE and POWELL. Apparently KEITH EMERSON and GREG LAKE were determined that CARL PALMER's place should be taken by another drummer with a name starting with the letter "P".

PHIL COLLINS' third solo Lp, "No Jacket Required", has been released to coincide with his British tour. A track called "Take Me Home" features PETER GABRIEL, HELEN TERRY, and STING on backing vocals. Speaking of Lps, ERIC CLAPTON's next "Behind The Sun" is due out in March.

SPANDAU BALLET are not happy with their record company, Chrysalis. They've served a writ claiming breach of contract. They reckon that they have not received enough support from Chrysalis and point out they are responsible for 25% of their record sales. Plus the fact they broke box office records in Wembley by selling out six successive dates. For the time being, Chrysalis are saying they'll continue to promote SPANDAU's World Parade Tour.

WHAM! also found themselves in the middle of a legal wrangle this week. DICK JAMES MUSIC, the publishers of BARRY MANILOW's "Can't Smile Without You", claims that WHAM! have copied passages of that song for their Christmas hit "Last Christmas". WHAM!'s publishers have written back to refute the claim, so it's a stalemate at the moment. As usual, it's others who are being hurt as this is hampering royalties from their record to go to Famine Aid To Ethiopia.

It's a very informal affair on ROCK OVER LONDON this week as there's "No Jacket Required" in the company of PHIL COLLINS and the track "Doesn't Anybody Stay Together Anymore"...THE ALARM sounds with "Absolute Reality", and we debut a reggae BAND AID style song in the form of "Starvation", which includes members of MADNESS and UB40...We "Close Our Eyes" to GO WEST and work out our state of consciousness with DEAD OR ALIVE ...Also listen out for BOB GELDOF, FRANKIE GOES TO HOLLYWOOD, GEORGE MICHAELS of WHAM!, and more at the British Music Awards...And finally, don't forget those naughty, naughty bits. This week we'll tell you a tale of the Purple Prince of Darkness.

The Rock Report

THE ROCK REPORT SPOKE to ex-Led Zeppelin bassist John Paul Jones who told us about his upcoming soundtrack to the Michael Winter film "Scream For Help". The film, due this spring, is a suspense story revolving around a girl who thinks her stepfather is trying to murder her mother. One especially interesting note concerns Jones' daughter's involvement in the upcoming Lp. John told us that he was having some trouble writing the lyrics for the songs he had written and approached his daughter with his dilemma. Before he knew it, she had the words to three songs written. This is the first time the two of them have collaborated on musical material.

WELL, THE DATE DRAWS NEAR for the release of "Willie And The Poor Boys": April 25th, to be exact, and we can't wait! By now you should be familiar with the project - some of the best musicians around today collaborating on some of the greatest material ever written. We're talking about such songs as "Slippin' And Slidin'", "These Arms Of Mine", "You Never Can Tell", "Baby Please Don't Go" and eight great others. These songs were originally recorded by Otis Redding, Little Richard, and Chuck Berry, to name just a few. This time around Bill Wyman, Chris Rea, Andy Fairweather Low, Gerant Watkins, Jimmy Page and Paul Rodgers are giving them a try. Also included on this all-star get together Lp is one original, titled "Poor Boy Boogie", which was penned by Bill Wyman. Next week the band plans to rent out an English venue and stage their own mock 50's sock-hop for the cameras. The result will be a full-length video that will feature the members of the band performing the material. The video will be made available thru mail order, and details will be included on the record sleeve. Hopefully, Jimmy Page and Paul Rodgers will be able to attend the shoot as long as they have no prior firm commitments.

BLOND BILLY IDOL IS GOING SILVER screen by way of "King Death". It seems Billy read the novel by author Nick Kohn and thought it would make a worthwhile film. So good, in fact, that Billy himself has shopped the project to six major film studios. But Idol has opted to go with an independent film company because the artist is usually given more creative control. A script is now being worked on and directors are being considered. Idol has asked his producer Keith Forsey and his guitarist Steve Stevens to help him out with the soundtrack. Idol is currently working on his upcoming Chrysalis release which will include some songs from the film.

AS WE REPORTED, THE UPCOMING TOM PETTY LP, "Southern Accents", is due March 11th on Backstreet/MCA. The first single will be "Don't Come Around Here No More", which is due this week. Some other songs included on the album are: "Rebel", "It's Nothin' To Me", "Dogs On The Run", "Mary's Car", "Spike" and the title track. The first single was co-written and co-produced by Dave Stewart of Eurythmics.

LAST WEEK WE TOLD YOU THAT RIC OCASEK has chosen Jimmy Iovine to produce his second solo Lp and the two of them will be entering Electric Ladyland Studio in New York this week. We have now learned that Cars bassist/vocalist Benjamin Orr has taken the first steps toward a solo album. The record will be produced by the respected Arif Mardin for Elektra.

THE ROCK REPORT SPOKE to Ray Manzarek, Former Member of the Doors, who told us about the bands upcoming video cassette due in April. The title of this collection of conceptual videos and never seen before concert footage is "Dance on Fire". To coincide with the video release is a new Lp called "Classics, which will feature previously released Doors tunes like "Break On Through" and "Unknown Soldier" to name just a few. Plans are also in the works to produce a full length movie on the life and times of Jim Morrison and the Doors. We have heard that Bill Graham Productions and Warner Bros. Films are behind this project but this could not be confirmed at press time.

MADONNA BEGINS HER FIRST EVER U.S. tour on April 8th with the Bronski Beat supporting. The tour should last about two months. She has no plans to do Europe as of yet. Included in her band will be musicians from the Jackson's Victory Tour.

IN SOME OTHER TOUR NEWS, Todd Rungren and Utopia hit the road with the Tubes on April 3rd in Laramie, Wyoming for a 14 week tour. Both bands are out supporting new albums. Rungren produced the Tubes latest "Love Bomb" and Utopia's most recent "P.O.V".

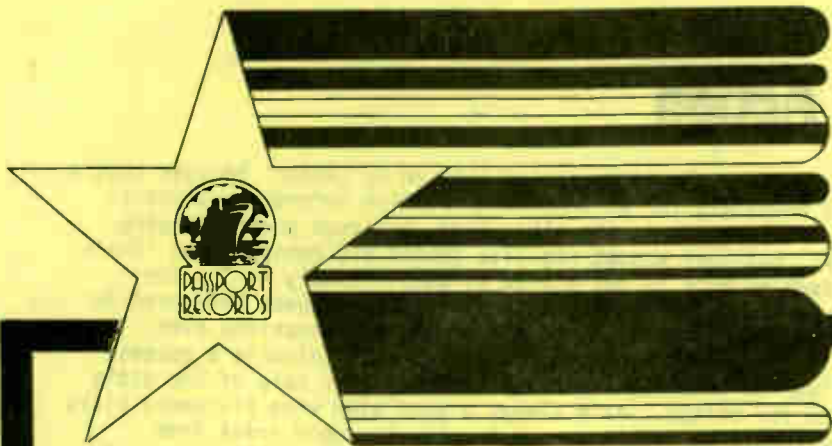

Radio Action

WHJY, PROVIDENCE, RI M.D.-JEFF RICCIO: "The new Tubes tune should be called 'Listen By Listen' because that's what it takes to bring this song home. It's almost necessary for an increased rotation before you start to get response--which is now happening with us...The Mick Jagger, on the other hand, has kept phones dancing since Monday morning. 98% of the calls are positive, but just enough negative phones are coming in on 'She's The Boss' that show people are still interested enough in Mick to get pissed at him. 'Lonely At The Top' sizzles, 'Half A Loaf' bounces and 'Lucky In Love' cruises with the ingredients that The Stones have used in the past 20 years. And now Mick has incorporated them into what might be one of the best sessions ever assembled in the 80's. Talk about dropping names!...'Everybody's Crazy' could be one of Columbia's success stories of the year. Michael Bolton came so-o-o close to breaking last time that with the help of the title track of the second Lp, success should be no problem for Bolton...It's always a good sign when Blackmore kicks you off the opening slot of his tour, so that alone should be reason enough to play a second track from Giuffria. Combine that with the quality of 'Do Me Right' and you've got a sure winner. 'Do Me Right' should enable Giuffria to take his show on its own headlining tour!"

Hey, if the match was half as good as the pre-bout hype, Madison Square Garden would be all over 8th Avenue...Getting back to the real world, Triumph was here over the weekend and Reunion Arena was SRO. The show, incidentally, was State Of The Art. Special thanks are due to MCA's Bubba Wayne and Joe Owens for a job well done with our Rock-Star-For-A-Day promotion. It certainly is nice to know everything is fully taken care of in advance. Incidentally, if anyone sees Joe Owens in the near future, ask him how much he liked the strip search at the airport?! (Editors Note: How cold was that flashlight, Joe?)... Phil Collins is one of the best albums that I've heard in some time--start to finish. We like 'Don't Wanna Know', 'Inside Out', and 'Don't Lose That Number'...Same goes for the Jagger--pick the cuts. Jeff Beck is fantastic on this record. With albums like these, Q102 is smoking and we will be for some time!...Keep it rolling!"

KGON, PORTLAND, OR M.D.-INESSA YORK: "A warm 'thank you' to the indefatigable Warner team for paving the way Purple to Seattle. Prince, a true knockout--two massive sellouts this past week--Need I say more?...Since everybody is concerned about that AOR core that appears to steadily be turning into the new mainstream, what better music to ply them with than Mick, Phil, The Firm (at least with those 'Money' and 'Midnight' tracks), and now the new Clapton. M-m-m!"

KGB-FM, SAN DIEGO, CA ASST. P.D./M.D.-TED EDWARDS: "Did you notice that 'Mr. Record Head' looks an awful lot like Drew Murray? And I thought Mike Bone was the only one with balls big enough to put his face in one of his own adds? What's this industry coming to anyway? The next thing you know, a bunch of industry geeks will start an air band and open up for Triumph somewhere! But, let's hope we don't sink to that base level...Onto the hits: Hey, how about that Phil Collins? What a guy! He certainly qualifies as the overachiever's musician. As productive as a rabbit ranch! Fabulous music. Strong and multi track deep--in other words, a perfect record for AOR...And while we're on the subject, Weapon-Of-The-Week honors go to Mick Jagger's 'She's The Boss'. Very strong song--excellent, ballsy production and a solid performance. This one looks like a winner...And speaking of good buzz, especially in Southern California, we've decided to 'Take A Turn' with Armored Saint. Chrysalis is committed, and we have a little room, so we decided to squeeze it in...The Beat Farmers--San Diego's contribution to fun the American way, continue to perform well. Solid sales equal cut #2 for us, the rock and roll version of Springsteen's 'Reason To Believe'... We've also moved further into the Los Lobos record with a well deserved re-add on 'Will The Wolf Survive?'... P.S.: Thanks for the calls on last week's CD rave. We really appreciate the cooperation we've gotten so far. More raves to follow...P.P.S.: To Bruce: Thanks for the magazine!"

KISS, SAN ANTONIO, TX M.D.-TOM SCHEPPKE: "Man, I need some help! We're going several cuts on superstar releases. I've got new artists backing up something fierce. This job's too big for Roto-Rooter! We need the services of the almighty rock and roll plunger! When the airwaves finally get unclogged, check out some of this action: Michael Bolton 'Everybody's Crazy'. These guys must use their big note songbook to get that git-tar wall of sound. As you can tell from the flip side, Michael's voice has really taken on a whole new dimension, thanks to the doctor...Coney Hatch 'Fantasy'. Sounds like more formula rock, except this time it's a winning formula...Question: Is there still room for quality songs by new artists? WEBN, CINCINNATI, OH M.D.-CURT GARY: "Well, the week started out great getting 'She's The Boss' in my hand! There's a lot of great tunes, but I must admit I'm partial to the ballad 'Hard Woman'. Sounds like single material to me...But probably the most amazing musical experience I've had in quite some time is Side Two of The Tubes 'Love Bomb'. Probably the best nine-song dance medley I've ever heard. These guys are undoubtedly the best white funk band in the world...Let me put a plug in for a local artist from Cincinnati: His name is David Chastain. If you've got a metal shop, ask Shrapnel Records out of San Francisco, about a record called 'Mystery Of Illusion' by Chastain...Chicago sure pulled a surprise on me. I never thought that song would catch me like it did...And in the same mode, Gary O is just sounding better and better on-the-radio everytime I hear it...Watch out for those Elvis Brothers...Deep Purple, as we get closer to the show, just keeps getting hotter and hotter--on the phones and at retail. WYDD, PITTSBURGH, PA M.D.-DAVE SHEDLOCK: "The Phil Collins album is a knockout. It was the #2 seller in our research this week. The album's packed with strong material and we're going to go a few cuts deeper immediately...For the past few weeks I've been talking up the Animation 12". We're seeing Top 5 phones for 'Obsession' for the second straight week. Don't overlook the song. You'll be missing out on a hit...The phones have been hot for Murray Head this week too. The problem is I haven't decided whether the listeners are really into 'Bangkok' or if they just want more 'head'--(Sorry). Either way if you want to see immediate response play the song...U2's back on our list this week. Last week we announced their Pittsburgh concert. Tickets went on sale Monday and over 10,000 were gone in one day. The excitement over the tour is enough to justify more airplay, but the fact that 'A Sort Of Homecoming' sounds great, makes it a must play."

WNEW-FM, NEW YORK, NY MUSIC COORDINATOR-AMY GROSSER: "I got a chance to see the movie 'The Breakfast Club' this past weekend and it's one of the better 'teen' films around today. The Simple Minds song 'Don't You (Forget About Me)' was really powerful under the opening credits...Alan Parsons' 'Vulture Culture' is a great sounding record. Along with 'Let's Talk About Me', I like 'Separate Lives'...If you need to hear some new old music, try Lloyd Cole And The Commotions. Their cut 'Perfect Skin' reminds me of Lou Reed meets R.E.M...Well, Scott Muni just came back from his trip to England for a press conference with The Firm. He brought us a present -- a new Firm song called 'Live In Peace'. This was recorded live at the Hammersmith Odean in 1984 and was also originally on Paul Rodgers' 'Cut Loose' Lp...I hope Elliot Easton's Lp gets the credit it deserves. This is a strong first effort with many possibilities for hit singles. The more I listen, the more I like...WNEW's Top 5 requests this week: #1 REO Speedwagon 'Fight', #2 The Firm 'Radioactive', #3 Bryan Adams 'Somebody', #4 Foreigner 'Want', #5 Survivor."

WSKS, CINCINNATI, OH M.D.-MARTY BENDER: "Even though the single isn't the strongest thing on the album, I see the Alan Parsons Lp taking the same eventual turnaround and rise as 'Chicago 17'. Side One is filled with multi-format hits...Thorogood's 'I Drink Alone' is double edged but so strong in male numbers and phones we had to bump it into heavy...Follow Your Heart' and 'Spellbound' segue emphasis positions nicely...Side Two of the new Tubes must have sent a few deja vu shivers up the tower. 'Macho City' revisited...I'm not gonna say anything stupid like 'Everybody's Crazy' about the Michael Bolton--but they are!...Jagger's 'Lucky In Love' is the grit and funk of 'Fingerprint File'--with a hook...Satisfaction' and 'Money' eventually get emphasis on The Firm...I think we'll just rotate the Phil Collins cuts alphabetically to make the choice easier...Check out the B. B. King songs for an off-air listening...What's next from Chrysalis--a Frankie Miller or Rory Gallagher 12"?...And whatever happened to the All Sports Band? Solo careers maybe?"

KBPI, DENVER, CO M.D.-LYNN WELLS: "I would have to be crazy to pass on the new Michael Bolton 12", 'Everybody's Crazy'! It is the first in a long line of hits from Bolton's latest project. No sophomore jinx here...The Phil Collins album is amazing. Deciding which track to play is no problem--just drop the needle down anywhere! At a time when CHR is sounding burned out, the Collins is a real shot in the arm for AOR...The writing is on the wall for Simple Minds. 'Don't You (Forget About Me)' is the record that will bring this band to the attention of the masses. Of course, a successful movie doesn't hurt the cause...Even though we didn't have a huge success with Triumph's 'Spellbound', I'm excited about playing 'Follow Your Heart'. A much hookier cut and this band is simply too talented to let slide to recurrent...The countdown is on--I'm looking forward to the Rockers '85 Convention and seeing you all there!"

WHCN, HARTFORD, CT ASST. P.D.-BOB BITTENS: "Besides being a great sounding album in general, the new Mick Jagger has really whetted my appetite for the forthcoming Jeff Beck record. Next to Mick's voice, Beck's guitar work is the album's most outstanding feature...I'd listen to the Jagger more if I could just get the Phil Collins off my turntable! I raved enough about that one last week to last for a while; so suffice it to say that, although the 400 or so spins I've given the record so far have worn out the vinyl--my ears will never tire of Phil's music. By the way, both the Collins and the Jagger are selling Top 5, barely 24 hours after they hit the stores...I got a chance to hear the whole Santana album, and those of you who were put off a bit by the slick pop of the single need not fear. The album has plenty of that searing guitar work that makes Carlos one of the best! Looking forward to going deeper on that one...Danny Buch: I'd tell you how much I like that advance cassette from Fiona, but you'd probably expect an out-of-the-box add, too!"

WMMR, PHILADELPHIA, PA M.D.-ERIN RILEY: "I can't seem to get over the thrill of seeing Hall & Oates on the 'Big Bam Boom' tour! You'll just have to see them to see how much they rock out live. The show is full of Top 10 hits from beginning to end. Thanks and a half to Jeb Brien, Tommy Mottola, and the entire crew for taking such wonderful care of us in Miami. I'll never forget it and I'll see you all in Philly...So, we're finally allowed to play the Jagger album. I like it a great deal. We've chosen to deal immediately with 'Lonely At The Top' and 'Running Out Of Luck', which I think has the most terrific grooves. It's a great party album, but what would you expect from Mick?...Philly's favorite artist Phil Collins has given us an album to deal with for at least six months. There's 'Who Said I Would' and 'Inside Out' and, thanks to imports, a whole host more. It seems the man just can't do anything wrong!...Happiness is having a Program Director in the flesh for a music meeting...Lastly but not leastly, I'd like to thank Mr. Biff Kennedy (local guy extraordinaire) for all his help with Survivor and REO last Tuesday above and beyond the call of duty."

WCKO, MIAMI, FL M.D.-JEAN CASHMAN: "Thank-you's to Twisted Sister and Steve Jones of Atlantic for promoting K102 at the show. Dee and family are very special to us...Why is it everytime someone from Capitol Records comes to town I get crazy? Thanks, Jordan, for Iron Maiden and so much f-u-n!...And to Shirley of RCA for Hall & Oates...Simple Minds and Robin George are #1 phones at K102...Next week will be my last week for reporting--on to bigger and better!"

WYFE, ROCKFORD, IL M.D.-FRED BRENNAN: "I think it would be nice if the Trades would reciprocate with radio on the issue of a Tuesday music deadline! If we get our reports in earlier, I think the Trades might make an effort to get that issue out early, if the following Monday is an observed holiday. It could be an AOR smash... Dio's 'Hungry For Heaven' has the potential to break out of the metal bin and become a great crossover record."

Lots of energy and metal that moves, rather than getting totally bogged down in the 'louder than loud' theory. We still get tremendous phones for 'Turn Up The Radio' which was never touted as the radio anthem it should have been. Tom Petty couldn't have given us a better song title...What more can be said beyond WPDH except Accept. 'Midnight Mover' is a great street song. Crank up the stereo, roll down the windows and let'er rip...More new entries this week from Jagger and Collins. From Mick we're going with 'Lonely At The Top' and our choice of Philfulment is 'Don't Lose My Number'. Both are just downright ear pleasers...Thanks to Jay Miggins for the Mick Jagger preview party in Poughkeepsie Sunday night. About 500 people got the advance treat and we loved it."

Sade is class all the way...Overdue thanks to Joe Ianello, Jay Miggins, and Paul Yeskel...M.D.-PEGGY APPLE: "Simple Minds is a Top 5 request and will be a smash...Also, Go West is a winner...Looking forward to the new Parsons and Joan Armatrading albums."

We mixed up the cuts rather than play a block from each Lp to avoid having people record it. Sounded great!"

When this energy mixes with Keith (my hero), the greatest rock and roll guitar player in the world today, and Charlie (the clock) Watts, along with Woody (the best), and Bill (the quiet one) Wyman--Look the f--k out! P.S.: This was the week of number ones--read our ad...In one of the industry's biggest airplay addition weeks ever, Michael Bolton delivered close to thirty call letters on his new 12" 'Everybody's Crazy' and a lot of those who added it were heavyweights. Michael Bolton promises to be one of the new superstars of 1985--check it out, get on this rocket ship--it's going to the moon...Now, Digneyfied! Dignacious! Dig it--deep! Whatever you want to call him, our man Digney Fignus, has a h-i-t record. Call Boston and surrounding areas for proof--one or two listens to this thing and you're hooked for life!...And, get ready for Alison Moyet. We know there's a lot of talk on the street out there for this one, and boy are we glad cause we think she's major! 'Invisible' is the 12" and the Lp is d-e-e-p!...Lastly, I would like to mention a couple of records that aren't ours but have really caught my ear. First is the Robin George. I know a lot of you are already plugged into this one but some are still discovering it. The call-out is strong as are the phones...I love the Coney Hatch (I see I've already been in print for this one)...And lastly, one that just flattened me--Katrina And The Waves--You must hear this--talk about star potential! Good luck! Buddy Bear...P.P.S.: Do I love ZZ Top or what? Well, if there was ever a 'Jewish ZZ' (I quote Michael Caplan, fast rising star of promotion), it's Leslie West and Mountain. 'Hard Times' reminds us that, although Leslie has been away for a while, he can still play rings around most of today's guitar players and his future looks very, very bright indeed. God Bless you Leslie--plug in and blow their faces off!"

MICHAEL PLEN, I.R.S. (212-980-6699): "This week you'll have the new General Public single 'Never You Done That' from the almost gold album 'All The Rage'. Album Radio: Please give this one serious consideration as 'Tenderness' was a Top 25 hit in America! It's one you won't want to miss...We're still working Let's Active Waters Part'. It keeps selling and the tour keeps rolling... And on March 12th, look for our new Lords Of The New Church record called 'Method To Our Madness'."

LINDA KIRISHJIAN, COLUMBIA (212-975-1701): "There are certain times in this business when what you do for a living and what is reality come together and create a spark! This past week was Mick Jagger week! The record debuted at #1 with one hundred percent of the album stations joined together in a unanimous vote for one of their rock heroes who has managed to help create an era--preserve it, enhance it, and share it with its posterity. This is a labor of love and a sign of true genius. Mick is a master of his craft! To top that off this week, as we're revelling in the office about #1 status, some more magic happens. Our assistant, Robin, and I are in Paul's office getting some business taken care of. Carolyn Joynes, Ray Anderson's assistant nonchalantly strolls in and says 'Mick Jagger's on the phone from Paris'--I go wild! Robin is on the floor in a partially dead faint saying, 'I answer the phone every single minute. The first time I'm away, it's Mick Jagger!' People come rushing in from within earshot at the sound of his name and Rap sits there and looks at the phone. What followed was a true moment shared by a real artist and a real promotion man. Both l-o-v-e their work, both are dedicated and both know the true meaning of 'why' we all do what we do for a living. On behalf of the best promotion team in the Universe, Mick--we thank you for knowing. You're the boss!"

MICHAEL CAPLAN, EPIC (212-975-5687): "Sometime during this week your collective ears will be treated to an aural surprise. February 25th marks the day that Mountain returns to the AOR airwaves. Leslie West And Company, along with such other luminaries as Deep Purple, Led Zepelin and Cream defined the genre we came to know as hard rock. From this music, of course, metal evolved (or de-evolved depending upon your orientation). Groups like Mountain formed the nexus on which AOR radio originated and subsequently flourished. They are part of the collective heritage on which we now all make a living. You owe it to Mountain, just as you did to Deep Purple to play this record and play it to death. Leslie's voice and guitar have never sounded better. Corky Laing has never kicked the shit out of his traps as hard as this before. Mark Clarke, (ex-Uriah Heep, and Jon Hiseman's Tempest) adds youth and exuberance in his role as new bass player. (Let's face it...Felix's shoes are hard to fill.) Pete Solley has likewise done a fine job in capturing the essence of what is Mountain in his production efforts. Take this Lp and walk it straight into the studio. Cue cut 1, side 1, 'Hard Times' with special guest Ian Hunter on synthesizer, and begin pounding the shit out of what will prove to be the comeback Lp of the year! Anybody interested in obtaining a phoner or ID's with Leslie West, please call me at the above number. Thank you."

KEVIN SUTTER, CHRYSALIS (212-758-3555): "Big news at Chrysalis -- Pat Benatar gave birth to a baby girl 10 AM, Saturday, February 16th. Her name is Haley and she weighed in at 8lb 1 oz. Mother and daughter are doing just fine thank you.... How do you follow up news like that? Well, you do it by talking about the hits. Go West 'We Close Our Eyes' did great this week, and I've got to say between Kid Leo's and Dave Shedlock's (WYDD) comments, I think the rest of you at album radio should get hip!...John Waite's 'Change' sure came on strong. Boy, you know it's funny because this is a very unusual situation. Most of you told me you were playing the record in a recurrent situation, then I put this thought to you. What record could still be recurrent after two years? I think it's pretty neat that I'm asking you to deal with a record that has withstood the TEST of TIME and has current drawing power. So why not add it to the currents, because I don't think you've got another record you're looking at that has this strong a track record. Imagine, I'm asking you to report a record you're already playing...Boy, the Armored Saint story keeps getting stronger and stronger. Try this on for size! WBAB, WRUF, KOZZ and KEZL up to medium. Their tour is bringing them through Texas and further west as we speak. I'm telling you it may not be now or next, but it's going to happen and you will end up playing 'Take A Turn'...Now some NEWS for you SPORTS fans Due to outrageous concert and album radio support for the Huey Lewis cut 'Bad Is Bad', we have pressed up a 12" for radio which will arrive at radio right now. The video is being released on February 27. More on the Boy Wonder next week."

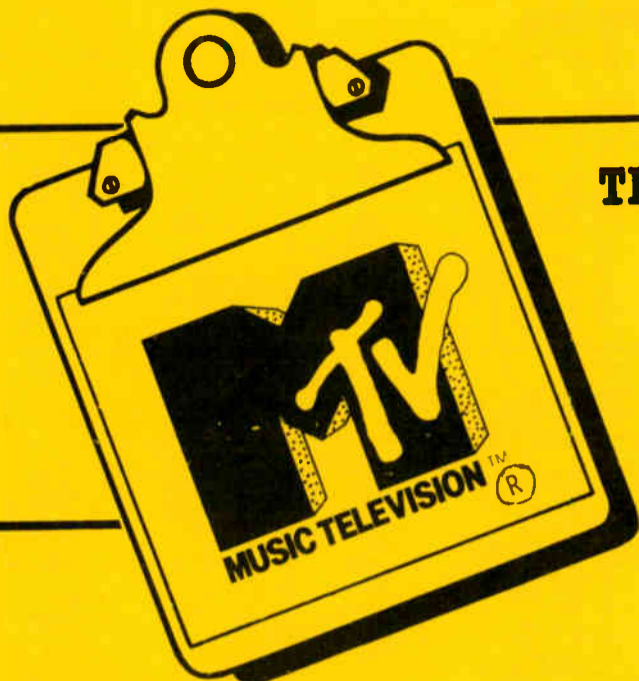

The Airplay Index is our ranking system for the amount of play on albums as a whole. We determine rankings by totalling the emphasis points on cuts.

The methodology for our Top 50 markets Metro Index is the same as our Airplay Index, but instead of using the full sample base, we calculate the ranking from airplay reports from the Top 50 markets, as defined by Arbitron.
