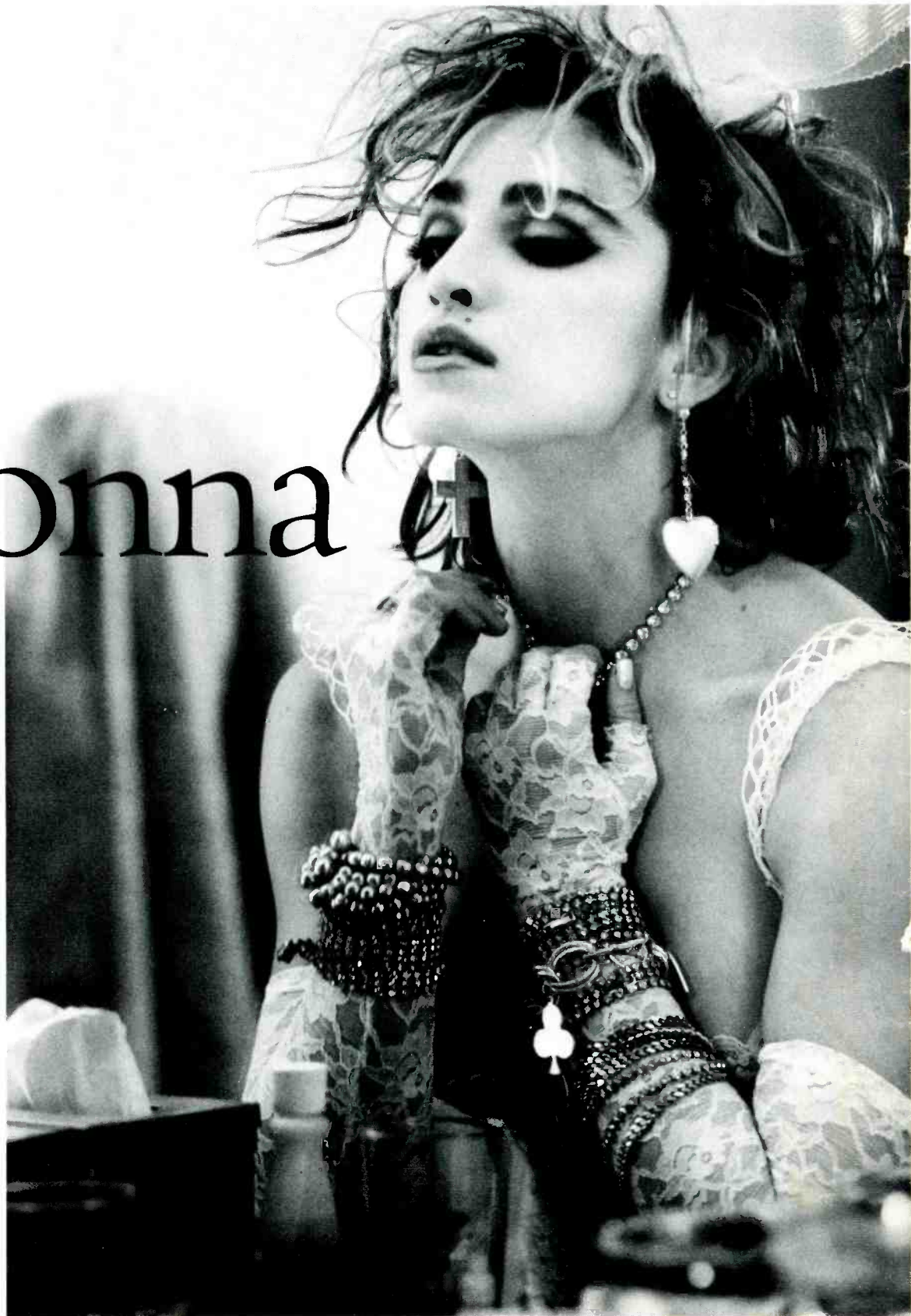

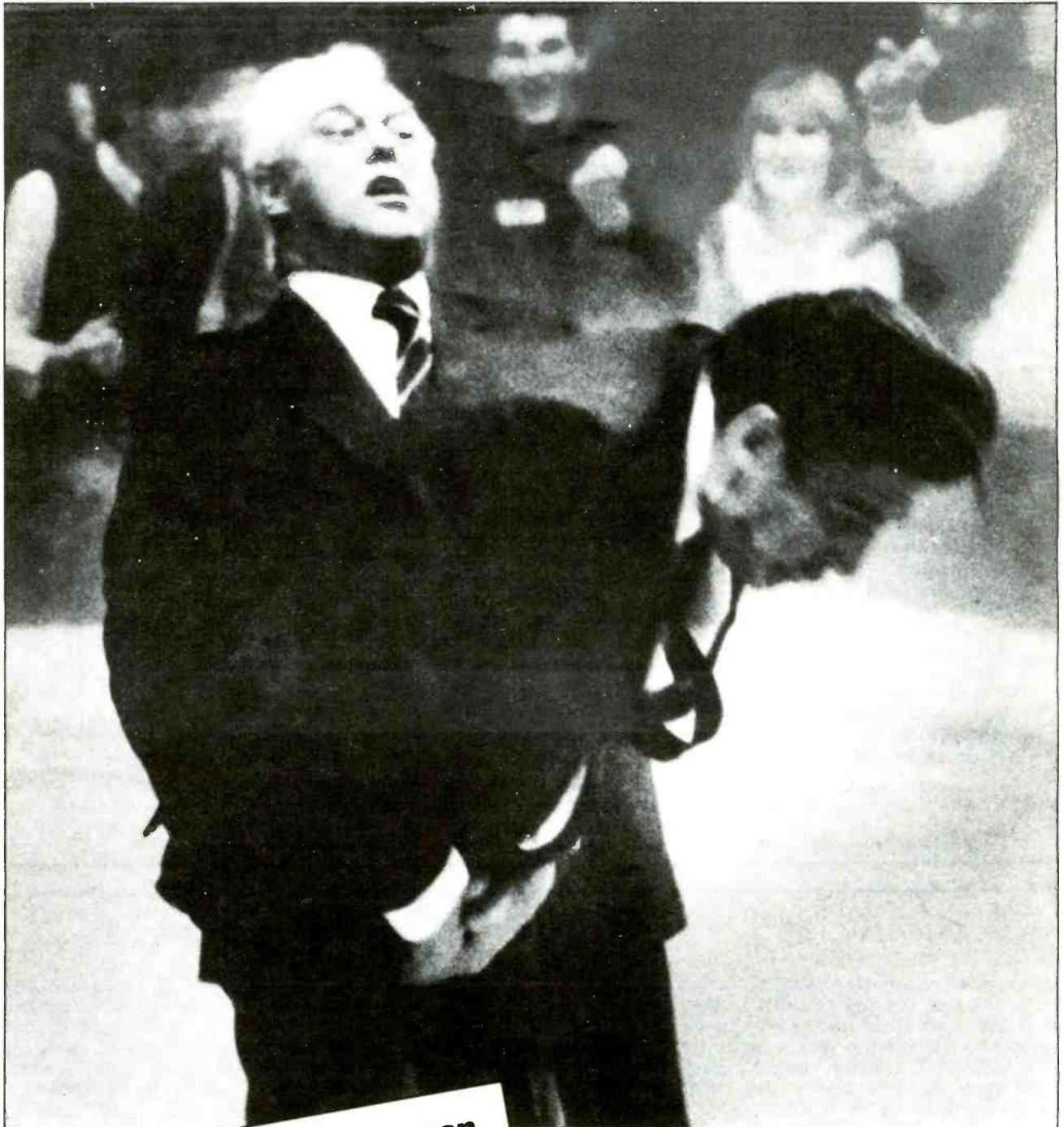

ANALYSIS

Little question about this week's number one song. WHAM! ranks at the top in both airplay and total chart points and is definitely on the Go-Go! An exceptionally strong top five accepts only one new member...HALL & OATES, which currently is sitting with a "Hit Factor" of 96%! TINA TURNER isn't far behind, charting top twenty at 217 of the 229 stations who reported playing it this week, giving her a "Hit Factor" of 94%. CHAKA KHAN continues to surprise many programmers, becoming the highest ranked newcomer to the top ten. LIONEL RICHIE's fifth single joins the top ten also with ease. PAUL McCARTNEY more than doubles in hit factor, moving from 29% to 67%! Logging a total of 246 reports out of this week's possible 258 puts it at number three in overall airplay stats. HONEYDRIPPERS is happening fast, going top 15 after becoming "Certified" in our October 19th issue. Explodes 21-13 at WIIZ-Jacksonville, 26-17 KUBE-Seattle, 23-14 KOLL-Gillette, 17-10 WBIZ-Eau Claire, 23-18 KKLS-Rapid City, 22-15 B-97 New Orleans, and a debut at #10 in Houston at 93/FM. Some stations also reporting action on the flip "Midnite". PAT BENATAR nears top twenty on this week's Top 40 as half of her 234 reports show it charted between #21-30. Based

on comments received the past few weeks, DURAN DURAN doesn't seem to be a favorite of programmers but it sure is with listeners. No surprise to find it's become the most requested song and debuting inside the top twenty at WHTX and B-94-Pittsburgh, CKOC-Hamilton, WBTT-Milwaukee, KIXS-Killeen, KZZB-Beaumont, WNPT-Tuscaloosa, KMGX and KYNO in Fresno, KSTN-Stockton, etc. Another big phone and sales item is JACK WAGNER, which slips right by "Chartbound" and comes on the chart at number 40. KZBQ-Pocatello takes it to number one. The excellent product released over the past 6-8 weeks is evidenced by the debuting of 6 records onto the Top 40, followed by 5 "Chartbounds". DAN HARTMAN is the only one of the bunch out for more than two weeks, and is continuing to roll up impressive airplay. Watch out...here comes another Jackson....sister REBBIE already has a "Hit Factor" of 13% with only 46 total reports. Atlanta leads the way as Z-93 moves it 6-3, with nearby WBBQ-Augusta jumping it 29-19. 14 adds, including B104-Baltimore, Q107 and WAVA in Washington, D.C., Z100-New York, WKCI-New Haven WZUU-Milwaukee, etc.

P.D. NOTEBOOK by Eric Norberg



Last week's column was about writing a resume and letter for your job application. This week we're talking about the tape that goes with it.

This is a telescoped aircheck. I think it's strongly advisable for it to be consecutive. Even pro's sometimes send airchecks that are not, but I am always skeptical of such tapes regardless of who they come from, and I believe many PD's are. The reason, you see, is that it appears you've been cherry-picking—selecting only the good breaks and leaving the others out! A PD wants to know what you would sound like on his/her station if you didn't know they were listening. They want your *average* work, not your "best" (though it's nice when you're pretty good, when you're average!) ... And if you make a gaffe that's so bad you dare not leave it in an otherwise good aircheck, a PD is naturally alert to that.

The aircheck you submit should be short. Five or six consecutive breaks, if you are satisfied that it is typical of your work, is enough. (A PD does not want to listen to a long tape. If you send a reel, and it is a large reel, he/she will assume there is a lot on it; I've put off listening to a tape for weeks, thinking I'd need a half hour, since the tape was a full seven-inch reel, only to discover when I finally sat down to listen to it, that it's only a few minutes, and most of the tape is blank.) If you are sending a tape on reel, by all means slice the tape shortly after you've finished the audio, so it LOOKS short. This also means you can buy a nice big reel of quality tape and lots of little reels, duplicate

your aircheck over and over on the reel, cutting and winding each one onto a small empty reel, and saving yourself many bucks over buying lots of little reels of tape already wound. Cassettes are quite acceptable nowadays, by the way, and are often preferred by PD's; inexpensive is good, but avoid the "assembled in Mexico" bargain bags of tapes. The oxide sheds on the PD's machine and clogs it up, and the cassette often will make you sound rotten anyway.

Getting back to the content of the aircheck: Why not more breaks? Actually, a good PD can tell whether you interest him/her after hearing just your first break—and will make the decision whether to keep listening based on the impression of that first break! So a PD doesn't need many breaks to decide whether to contact you or not.

But since that first break is so important, be careful selecting your aircheck. Even experienced DJ's will be self-conscious when making an "important" aircheck, so experienced airpeople try to keep a skimmer tape running at all times, so as to always have a current, "typical" aircheck. But start the dub of your aircheck with a good break!

A word to beginners who don't have their first "real" aircheck yet. A "production room job" is OK, provided you don't try to fool the PD that it isn't. But there are a couple of pitfalls to avoid.

First, since you're self-conscious enough about the aircheck you're making, put on a big reel of tape and

record the whole show in "real time." *Don't* try to telescope it as you go! Cue the records, let them play through, and do it just like a real show. If you constantly take it out of the context of being a real show by 'scoping it as you go, you'll never get your *real* ability on tape.

Second, when you telescope your finished aircheck down, *don't* start with the first break you did. This is a very common mistake with beginners making a tape this way. The first break when you're starting an aircheck is usually your *worst* break since you haven't gotten into doing a show yet—it's still "starting an aircheck" and you'll be awkward. Roll into the tape till you find your first good break and start your 'scoped aircheck with that. Then keep it consecutive after that.

Oh, by the way, if, as a DJ, you want to include a newscast and/or production, fine—but put it on the tape *after* the DJ work. I have gotten many tapes with a newscast first, which has to be waded through to get to the part relating to the job being applied for. I do make the effort to do the wading, but most PD's don't—because they know the person who would make that mistake is probably not ready for the job. (And if you're applying for a news

job, don't start your tape with DJ work! I've gotten tapes like that too.)

One other tip for beginners: Avoid the "Whitman's Sampler" approach in your aircheck. Having ONE good break, ONE good spot, ONE good joke, etc., really does brand you as a beginner. Show AVERAGE work!

Springsteen tickets were as difficult to locate in Hollywood this past week as guaranteed reservations for the *Mondale Inaugural Gala*, but your loyal reporter attended all seven four hour performances so that we could provide you with this brief review:

Not since **The Lemon Pipers** introduced '*Green Tambourine*' at the Whisky A-Go-Go in 1967 has this aficionado been as moved as he was during the week-long Los Angeles stint by The Boss. From the opening sensual moments as a security guard's body scanner searched me for contraband, to the six cans of Coors tossed on my head by a burned-out Fruitgum Company freak, it was an experience to savor for the ages.

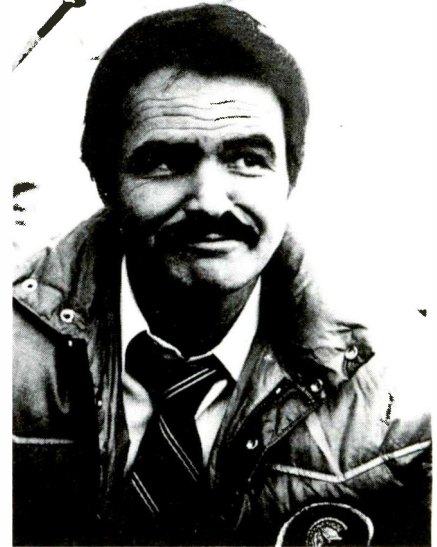
Difficult as it must have been to follow hilarious opening act **Charlie Callas**, Springsteen wrapped up the crowd as he launched into his inspiring version of 'Lollipops and Roses' with back-up vocals by the **Joe Isgro Singers**.

Springsteen's cover of Mel and Tim's '*Backfield in Motion*' was infused with a searching plea for peace in our time and the subtle undertones in his touching rework of **Melanie's** '*Brand New Key*' gives brand new pride to a generation heretofore aching for validation.

In a plaintive mid-concert statement, the performer shrugged off the four million dollars he receives as payment for each concert as an unfortunate tribulation which comes with the territory, as a sympathetic audience roared in agreement. The evening's

central theme of understanding for those who must live out their lives in hopelessness and despair was clearly relatable to those who had shelled out up to seven hundred dollars for seats in the men's room.

In the hands of a lesser talent, Springsteen's taut '*Ode to Mike Curb*' would never have packed such a



compassionate roundhouse right. As The Boss presented it, millions of displaced youths can now claim an anthem giving tribute to the benefits of manufacturer's coupons. The very FEEL of invigoration permeated the cavernous arena, and when Springsteen closed the lengthy set with an announcement of the donation of a pound of cottage cheese to the Finorken Food Foundation, the spirit of indomitable truth moved the throng to a four second standing ovation.

There IS hope for this planet, we concluded, as we exited the venue and headed straight to Chasen's for a plate of Beef Wellington.

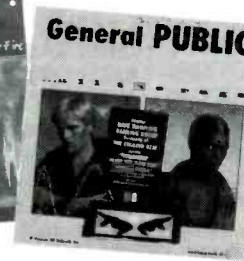

Releases

Relax/War/Two Tribes/Born To Run/Side 1/Side 2-FRANKIE GOES TO HOLLYWOOD (Island) The phenomenon is finally loose and unleashed. THE GAVIN REPORT has been feeling the early distant pulses of FGTH since last year when "Relax" was a hit by most every station smart enough to play it. Next came "Two Tribes", where stations playing eight minute mixes were making sizeable retail impact, getting phones galore. Now the whole concept is tied together by a complete double pocket LP, TV appearances, videos, and a national tour hot on the release of this LP. The album is immaculately recorded by TREVOR HORN (no stranger to the American charts) in 70 MILLIMETER TECHNICOLOR THX VISTA VISION. Halfway through side three I felt like knocking over every desk in this office because---HEY---PLEASURE DOME is the most important release of 1984 if only from the standpoint that radio has a rare change to get in on the ground floor and take the big ride by leading the way. I'll be surprised if this LP isn't PLATINUM by spring. It's almost halfway there.

One Night Love Affair/Run To You/Heaven/She's Only Happy.../Summer Of 69/It's Only Love/Long Gone-BRYAN ADAMS (A&M) For some odd reason, I needed re-reminding of the fact that BRYAN ADAM's contribution to great backbeat rock is supreme. In the tradition of TWILLEY and PETTY, ADAMS' punches are direct hits to the face, the upper body torso region, and best of all, the heart. RECKLESS is far from being sq. It is a coolly compiled piece of work that will easily appeal to those who dwell in the mainstream (i.e. your listeners). I guess it's snobs like me who needed an extra nudge. RECKLESS is absolutely brilliant, or as the guy yells at the tail end of "One Night Love Affair"--- yeah!! Featured help by TINA TURNER and LOU GRAMM.

Perfect Strangers/A Gypsy's Kiss/Under The Gun/Knocking At Your Back Door-DEEP PURPLE (Mercury) This is the bonafide real deal. Not the original original DEEP PURPLE with vocalist ROD EVANS who sang "Hush", but the five piece who etched "Made In Japan" and "In Rock" permanently into the hallowed annals of METAL history. Compared to four solid sides of MOTORHEAD, DP does sound a little A/C, but BLACKMORE (who has a hand in writing all eight trax) is in good form. The title track is a close-ringer to LED ZEP's "Kashmir". My personal fave is "A Gypsy's Kiss" with the same power of "Highway Star" (live). Will be huge, no doubt.

Painted Desert/Diamond Field/We Belong/Takin' It Back-PAT BENATAR (Chrysalis) PAT BENATAR sings hard above a thunderation of drums on "Diamond Field", TROPICO's opener. Like the single, the overall sound is PAT BENATAR's most technologically daring effort, relying on the cleanliness of digital recording versus the reverberation of percussive sound and quite a bit of guitar and keyboard subtleties. TROPICO sounds like a kissing cousin to former label-mate JOHN WAITE's LP, in that both are traditional rock singers flirting with new ideas while staying inside the confines of Album Radio programming. Still, trax like "Painted Desert" and "Takin' It Back" (with its curious lyric line) impress me most because MS.BENATAR is being challenged as a vocalist by having to compete with some pretty articulate production ideas. Nice work.

Five Minutes-BONZO GOES TO WASHINGTON (Sleeping Bag-12") TALKING HEADS' JERRY HARRISON and BOOTSEY COLLINS adapt RONALD REAGAN's famous slip of the tongue ("we'll begin bombing in five minutes") into a novel election piece. The Prez was cleverly caught by a Milwaukee college station. Call Sleeping Bag at 212-724-1440 for your copy.

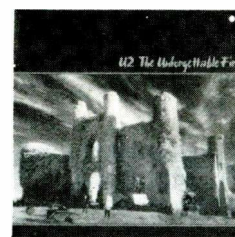

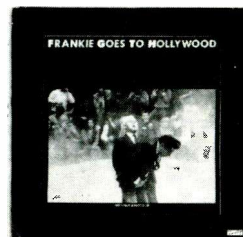

ANALYSIS

This week's chart is a competitive rumble. Notice that the underlines are primarily in clusters from 5 thru 9, 15 thru 21, and 24 thru 32. Some records that were indefinite in their growth patterns were bumped by those who had no hesitation towards moving up. This week's CERTIFIEDs are comprised of a trio of records that couldn't be more different--J.GEILS, DON HENLEY, and DEEP PURPLE. JULIAN LENNON is strongly gunning for TOP THREE status. PRIME GAINERS include the following: HONEYDRIPPERS, ROGER HODGSON, PAT BENATAR, BRYAN ADAMS (both with great new LP's), FRANKIE GOES (whose LP is also excellent) and the CERTIFIED TRIO, PURPLE, HENLEY,

and GEILS...THE RED ROCKERS are looking to bounce back with a new twelve inch, "BLOOD FROM A STONE", off their overlooked LP...next week, expect a rave review of the new LP by the DEL-LORDS, a cool new American band from ENIGMA/EMI...SPRINGSTEEN gets two compliments this week. RICK SPRINGFIELD issues a tribute entitled "BRUCE" and FRANKIE GOES TO HOLLYWOOD wails a fatal version of "BORN TO RUN" on their new LP...How fast would you add a brand new 76 minute POLICE LP?? Well, such a creature has just been released on BETA or VHS Video Hi Fi that could be compatible to the airwaves. A smart station would cart up a few live options. It's from a recent concert. Video was directed by GODLEY/CREME...the GO-GO's are looking for a bassist after JANE WEIDLIN's departure, but before I could practice up on my chops, I find they want a girl... JIMMY PAGE is firmly back on the rehab trail announcing formation of THE FIRM with BADCO singer PAUL RODGERS, drummer CHRIS SLADE, and bassist TONY FRANKLYN...a few novelty adds on one JULIE BROWN, famous for her song "I Like Em Big and Stupid"...so if you plan on attending the CMJ Conference/Bash, NOVEMBER 8,9,10 (my God, that's this week!), look for PETER STANDISH or myself. We'll both be pontificating on panels and cruising the hallways, looking for familiar faces (in between trips to BLEEKER BOB's, that is). If you're still unsure about going, go. Last year's was very productive...do you read ROCK & ROLL CONFIDENTIAL published and edited by DAVE MARSH and LEE BALLINGER? Shame on you if you don't. Airplay is still growing and the album has a serious opportunity to go number one. While this is their first album, RANKING ROGER and DAVE WAKELING had established a renowned reputation with the ENGLISH BEAT for the past five years.

Our newest member of the POWER TRIO is AZTEC CAMERA. The climb was long, but consistent since the album debuted 5 weeks ago.

The RAMONES and The REPLACEMENTS are both destined for the Top Five. The REPLACEMENTS momentum will certainly be aided by their present live tour. Their raw and raucous style has many Alternative radio listeners and programmers buzzing. This barometer senses a band developing that warrants special attention. Don't miss their live show!

XTC, has entered the Top Ten and is GAVIN CERTIFIED in two weeks. They are sure to enter the POWER TRIO next week.

UB40 gains nearly 50% moving from 21 to 12. Airplay commitment is strong at an early stage of growth - making them a prime candidate for CERTIFIED next week.

I'll see many of you in NEW YORK this week (Nov.8-10) at the CMJ MUSIC MARATHON. KENT ZIMMERMAN and myself will both be bouncing off the walls of the ROOSEVELT HOTEL (I'll be on "THE PURPOSE OF COLLEGE RADIO" panel FRIDAY @ 9:00AM).

JERMAINE STEWART-The Word Is Out (Arista) Former member of Shalamar claims his right to solo stripes by turning out this very strong entry. Building on Black Radio right now, this danceable, singable, and hummable track has more than enough in the grooves to help it cross Top 40.

ALBUMS OF THE WEEK

Truly For You-The Temptations (Gordy) In my many years in this business, I've put these guys out to pasture more than once only to have them jump back with a PAPA WAS A ROLLING STONE or JUST MY IMAGINATION. The arrangements here are up-to-date yet pull up short of discourteous ghetto-blasters. Their game is tight and wide harmony, soul-sure but not punk funky. The five songs which are worth repeated listens are RUNNING, TREAT HER LIKE A LADY, MEMORIES, I KEEP MY LIGHT IN MY WINDOW and JUST TO KEEP YOU IN MY LIFE, a track which sounds more like Earth,Wind & Fire than anything EW&F has done in three years.

High Crime-Al Jarreau (Warner Brothers) One of music's most versatile voices continues his hot streak. His ability to employ his voice as an instrument of both rhythm and melody is a singular trait which distinguishes him from his pop and jazz peers. "High Crimes" starts with a whitewater rapid rocker called RAGING WATERS and then he irons out the rough spots with his more typically graceful eloquence. The predictable charm of Jarreau is most noticed on MURPHY'S LAW, TELL ME, and LET'S PRETEND. He even tears a page from Morris Day and the Time, however inadvertently, by underscoring his STICKY WICKET, with a synthesizer bit from THE WALK.

Reckless-Bryan Adams (A&M) Every attempt is made to retain a rock music feel with stressful vocals, walls of sound anthems and visions of a James Dean/John Cougar Mellancamp stance of defiance. Underneath all that important positioning are the foundation of some very solid, structured melodies. If you're old enough to drink, you're old enough to expect melody and lyric with your music. ADAMS delivers again. SHE'S ONLY HAPPY WHEN SHE'S DANCING/RUN TO YOU/IT'S ONLY LOVE/KIDS WANNA ROCK/ONE NIGHT LOVE AFFAIR.
