The Dixie Chicks will perform on the Academy of Country Music Awards tomorrow night live via satellite from Austin, but they won't be playing the song the ACM said they would. A press release from the ACM says the song choice will be "Truth No.2." However, the decision has been made that the Chicks first new single since "Travelin' Soldier" won't be "Truth No. 2" but "Godspeed (Sweet Dreams)," a song

that was digitally delivered to radio last night. R&R has learned that based on that decision, the Chicks have made a last-minute change and will instead perform that song. The Dixie Chicks are up for Entertainer of the Year, Album of the Year and Top Vocal Group at the ACM award show.

Reigning NASCAR Winston Cup Champion **Tony Stewart** will also be part of the ACM festivities. He's set to introduce good friends **Diamond Rio** — who were actually once booked to play at his wedding (later canceled) — on this year's show.

June Carter Cash Laid To Rest

It was a highly emotional tribute to **June Carter Cash** Sunday in Hendersonville, TN, where celebrities, artists and common folk alike gathered to pay tribute to the legendary star. Cash, 73, died last week following complications from heart surgery. She was remembered by performers Emmylou Harris, The Oak Ridge Boys, Sheryl Crow and The Gatlin Brothers during the two-hour service, as well by people who made her acquaintance outside of the music industry. The funeral was originally planned as private, but Cash's husband of 35 years, Johnny Cash, requested that the service be opened to the public.

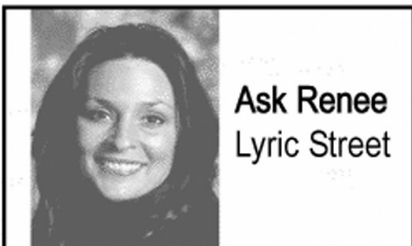
