

HOW TO TUNE A RADIO SET SCIENTIFICALLY

There are over 800 Broadcasting Stations in North America. Each of these sends out electrical impulses or vibrations at a certain frequency per second. This frequency, measured in kilocycles, is assigned each station by its governmental authorities.

To receive any of these stations, a radio set must be tuned exactly to the desired frequency. When you know how to do this, your pleasure in radio will be multiplied many times for you can then set your dials instantly to the frequency of any desired station. As you tune in a station, you will be able to identify it immediately without waiting for the announcement.

Many people have written us that until they used the RADEX system of tuning, they had been unable to receive California or other distant stations but as soon as they learned exactly where to place their dials, they brought them in easily.

Any child can, of course, turn the dials and bring in stations, but to compile a log of several hundred stations and bring in any one desired requires a real knowledge of tuning.

Try This Method On Your Own Radio

RADEX contains fourteen pages of Index by Frequencies in which all the stations of the North American Continent are arranged in groups in the order in which they will come in on your dial. One of these fourteen pages is shown opposite.

Take this page and tune in any station listed thereon, from 680 to 780 kcys. Let us imagine that the first station you receive will be WJZ New York. Enter your dial numbers for this station in the squares opposite 760 kcys., the frequency of WJZ. Let us say that your dial numbers for this station are 58 and 53. You may have one or two or three dials—it makes no difference. Enter this 58 and 53 in two of the squares. Now tune in some other station.

Let's say we receive WLW Cincinnati at 64-60 on our dials. Enter these numbers opposite 700 kcys. Our third station perhaps is WGN Chicago which comes in at, say 62-58. Entering all these numbers in their proper places, we find that 700 kcys. is received at 64-60 and 720 at 62-58. It is obvious that 710 kcys. must come in midway between 64-60 and 62-58 or at 63-59. If we set our dials at 63-59 we will tune in WOR Newark, if that station is on the air and within range of our set, because we have now tuned the set to 710 kcys. which is WOR's frequency.

Similarly, if 740 kcys. is 60-56 and 760 kcys. is 58-53, then 750 kcys. must come in at 59-55. Setting our dials at 59-55 we bring in WJR Detroit. Thus you will see that after you have filled in the dial numbers for a few stations on each page, you can tell at a glance where to set your dials for any station you want, even those you have never received before.

When your book is fairly well filled out, you can identify programs you receive the instant you hear them merely by referring to your list of dial numbers. True, several stations often use the same frequency but the power, shown in the third column, and the distance of the stations from your set, will enable you to name almost any station before you hear the announcement.

The first column indicates those stations which are willing to verify your reception of their programs and those which send you station stamps for your collection.

The fourth column shows those stations which share time, those that are daylight only, those belonging to the National and Columbia chains, etc.

Fill out this sample RADEX page with your own set and see how much more pleasure it is when you know what you are doing.




