WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The D.C. Circuit Court of Appeals has denied the bid of WBUZ-1570 Fredonia NY its license, which the FCC revoked upon finding owner Henry Serafin unfit to hold a license. Allegations included racial discrimination and contest rigging. The ruling apparently ends WBUZ's ten-year battle to stay on air, as Serafin says he's inclined to not pursue further appeals. Meanwhile, license revokee WBBY-FM-103.9 Westerville (Columbus) OH changed plans and now intends to continue appealing the FCC's ruling. The station had previously announced that court costs for its ten-year fight were too expensive and protracted, and that WBBY would end operations Jan. 1. It's still on air and now plans to stay on while appeals continue.

WZTA Miami says it will probably pay without further appeal a \$2,000 indecency fine assessed against the station for a 1987 incident in which the station's morning show played the song "Penis Envy" by folk-rock comics Uncle Bonsai. WZTA noted that the cost of fighting the assessed fine was far greater in time and money than the fine itself. Meanwhile - following up on last month's story of FCC indecency fines - Infinity Broadcasting did indeed raise the ad rates for Howard Stern's morning show to cover the cost of its fines (and much more), citing the publicity windfall the case has generated. Infinity's determination to mount a court challenge to both the FCC's indecency regulations and its authority to enforce them is apparently encouraging other targeted broadcasters to go along

with FCC assessments and let Infinity spend the money to fight everyone's battle.

KMMW Maljamar NM has been ordered to forfeit \$10,000 for violations of tower lighting regulations. The FCC rejected the station's claims that fines should be lowered since tower light maintenance had been subcontracted to another company, the problems were attended to promptly upon notification by the FCC, and the amount of the fine could financially cripple the station, a small country outlet in economically depressed rural southeast New Mexico. M Street comments: you can ignore your community of license, provide no listener, advertiser or public service of any kind and run your station with a satellite dish, a telephone pole and the FCC's blessing - but make sure to light your pole and file proper EEO reports or you may be put out of business. Check those lights.

ELSEWHERE

There is a great deal of news on the financial state of the radio industry as we enter the new year, and it is all bad.

In the format sector, April 15 is the date on which Unistar network will end its distribution agreement with Fairwest Productions for Al Ham's "Music of Your Life" adult standards format. Unistar has notified its staff and Fairwest, but not, at press time, its affiliates. Cited in an internal Unistar memo were the lack of growth in MOYL's affiliate base and difficulties in selling the format's older adult demographics. There is no official word yet from Fairwest on who will distribute MOYL or in what form. At least one current MOYL affiliate has been told by Al Ham that the format will continue after April 15 but revert to the tape distribution used before the agreement with Unistar in early 1988. Music of Your Life currently has about 35 full and part time affiliates.

More than 20 Progressive Music Network affiliates had to scramble for two days at the beginning of 1991 when PMN's "The Breeze" new AC format went off the air. By the afternoon of Jan. 3, the network was back up after PMN had made new arrangements for its satellite uplink; however, rumors of financial instability continue to follow the nation's only remaining satellite-delivered new AC format.

Finally, as reported in M Street December 17, the ill-fated Money Radio Network did in fact cease operations on January 1 - in the middle of a talk show. At the time of its demise MRN affiliates still had never been notified by the network that it was in any difficulty. For the time being, beleaguered MRN flagship KMNy-1600 Pomona CA remains on the air.

On the sales side of the industry, prominent brokerage house Chapman & Associates is out of business. The Atlanta-based firm cited slow station sales in 1990 and difficulty in closing sales as reasons for its demise; a number of Chapman's principals are said to be reorganizing new, smaller brokerage firms. After Tom Gammon's Americom, Chapman becomes the second major radio industry broker to fold in a year. More bad times may be ahead: sale prices are said to be down to seven and heading for a multiple of only six times annual cash flow, less than half of what some stations were trading at three years ago. Gary Stevens, the former Doubleday exec whose name became synonymous with highly leveraged megadeals in 1987, is reported to be closing down his Park Ave. office and working out of his apartment. Jacor Communications has announced a \$130 million restructuring of debt in an effort to forestall creditors until the long-delayed sale of WMJI Cleveland and WYHY Nashville can close. Reams Broadcasting Corp. saw its third attempted sale of WBVE (now WZRQ) Cincinnati, this time to L. C. Communications Group, fall through late last month; some WBVE staff found out about the failed sale through an article in the local newspaper. Financially troubled Olympia Broadcasting has agreed to sell six of its seven remaining stations (keeping only KZZR Kansas City) to long-time Oregon broadcaster Gary Capps for only \$3.5 million - less than 1/3 of the combined purchase price for the stations in the mid-1980's.

One outfit that does have plenty of cash is Minnesota Public Radio. The nation's largest statewide public radio network has announced plans to buy WLOL-FM 99.5 Minneapolis from Emmis for a surprisingly low \$12 million. WLOL's long-time CHR format will cease to exist; in its place, MPR plans to drop KSJN-FM's news, shift its fine arts programming and the KSJN-FM calls to 99.5 from 91.1, move its news-talk service from KNOW-1330 to 91.1 (to be KNOW-FM), and spin off the AM station (which, ironically, was the original WLOL). It is believed to be the first time in decades that a noncommercial operator has purchased, at market price, a full sized major market facility. MPR attributes its success to for-profit businesses such as catalog sales, old Garrison Keillor tapes and an in-house magazine.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The long-standing struggle to put KOZN-99.3 back on the air in Imperial CA may now be resolved. A license transfer has been approved by the FCC to shift the station from a bankruptcy trustee to Acadia Amusement Corp. The FCC substituted Acadia for New World Communications, the assignee previously approved for the license, after the original owner, Stereo 99 Ltd., was stripped of its license due to false citizenship claims by general partner Richard Green. The station has been off the air for the last year.

Another lengthy license battle has been resolved, with implications for any owner with multiple stations in the same market. KQED-TV San Francisco retained its license and that of KQED-FM but lost the license for co-operated KQEC-TV, also in San Francisco. The competing KQEC applicant won by proposing a separately owned, minority owned station in combination with the ownership demerits given KQED-TV.

In response to a question certified by the Review Board, the FCC has declined to modify the comparative criteria currently applicable to noncommercial educational hearings, retaining the existing policy of disregarding ownership of other media as a comparative factor. The action was taken in response to a comparative hearing which granted the application of Jimmy Swaggart Ministries for a new educational FM in Baton Rouge LA. The losing party claimed that, since noncommercial stations are media voices like commercial stations, the same set of public interest factors, including diversity criteria, should be used. However, owners of multiple stations may still face license challenges for poorly utilized second stations, as with KQEC-TV above.

As a follow-up to last November's FCC enforcement effort on tower regulations, the FCC has announced fines totalling more than \$350,000 to several dozen radio stations. And, WZAM-1110 Norfolk VA has been issued \$7,900 in fines for multiple technical violations of FCC rules. Transgressions included: operation after sunset by the daytime-only station for several hours with an unmodulated carrier signal; operation of WZAM's directional system by remote control without FCC permission; failure to cease operation by remote control within three hours after a malfunction was detected; inoperative EBS equipment, with no evidence the station had ever conducted an EBS test; failure to post the station license; failure to designate a chief operator; failure to observe tower lights at least once each 24 hours; failure to report tower light top beacon outage to the FAA, and failure to maintain a complete Public File.

The FCC has affirmed a license renewal grant for WKLX Rochester. The license had been challenged by cross-town WCMF, which has claimed that WKLX's new transmitter site causes unacceptable levels of interference to WCMF. Also approved: a license transfer for WAPA-680 San Juan PR; the new licensee also owns WMTI-1580 in Morovis PR, which is a separate market but has a prohibitive amount of signal overlap with WAPA. The owner, Blanco Pi, must still sell WMTI within a year. And, the FCC denied a petition for reconsideration of a proceeding which granted new facilities to KUIC Vacaville CA.

In a new twist on minority groups challenging stations at license renewal time, the Detroit chapter of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC) is reportedly erecting billboards urging a listener boycott of Detroit talk station WXYT-1270. SCLC claims that news reports and talk show commentary on the station is consistently anti-black. WXYT management is concerned that a boycott may include a specific request that listeners not credit WXYT in ratings diaries even if the station is listened to.

ELSEWHERE

Very late word that Progressive Music Network's "The Breeze" new AC format went silent again on Tuesday. This is the second time in the last month the format has gone off air and left its affiliates high and dry with little warning. Most affiliates filling in with local tapes or records. A PMN executive attributed the interruption to problems with the company's uplink arrangements but says The Breeze is committed to remaining on the air and serving its affiliates.

Billboard reports that WRCN-FM will file a formal request with the FCC to investigate the simulcast of WNEW-FM New York on WWHB Hamptons Bay NY. M Street comments: this could be a landmark challenge to the propriety of allowing full program lease agreements on the basis that the license has given up control of its facility. We also expect to see license challenges based on licensee's abandonment of responsibility for station programming.

Unistar has signed an agreement with Armed Forces Radio & Television Service (AFRTS) to broadcast three of its radio formats via satellite to U.S. troops stationed around the world, including those in the Middle East. AFRTS will begin transmitting live broadcasts of Unistar's AC2, Adult Rock 'n' Roll and Country formats "any day now."

Also overseas, the Shadow Radio Authority, which oversees radio in the United Kingdom, has announced plans to take bids this month on the first of three new Independent National Radio (INR) licenses to be awarded in the next year. The new INR service will be awarded to two AM stations and one FM; the FM service will be awarded first. Bids taken this month must be on a newly available FM frequency range between 99.8 and 102.0 MHz and must specify any type of "non-pop" music service. The license will be awarded to the highest cash bidder, probably some time in summer 1991. Once the first license is determined, a call will go out for the next license on AM, taking into account whichever format is a part of the winning first bid. Eventually a third INR service will also be launched on the AM band, using some of the facilities formerly occupied by BBC Radio 1.

In the ongoing battle to make its world safe for digital broadcasting, the NAB (National Association of Broadcasters) has responded to a Library of Congress proceeding by urging that it would be premature to impose home-taping fees or restrictions on DAB. The Library of Congress inquiry is being held to determine, among other things, whether DAB would have an adverse impact on copyright holders. The NAB filing states that it is "simply too soon to tell" whether land-based DAB delivery would affect copyright holders of music and other radio programming; and opposed requirements that DAB broadcasters scramble their signals, a measure that would limit DAB to a pay service. The NAB's filing did not address possibilities of satellite-delivered DAB, a technology the NAB strongly opposes.

The NAB and the Association for Maximum Service Television (MSTV) have also filed joint comments urging the Federal Aviation Administration to work more closely with the FCC in crafting electromagnetic interference standards. The FAA's current EMI prediction standards are far more rigorous than those of the FCC.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has affirmed the Review Board decision granting license renewal to WWKB-1520, Buffalo NY, and denying the mutually exclusive application to increase the power of WTHE-1520 Mineola NY. WTHE had appealed based on its application for a waiver of co-channel interference rules that would have meant its application was not mutually exclusive with WWKB's license renewal. The FCC noted as part of its affirmation that, without grant of a waiver of interference standards, such competing applications against existing stations face "virtually insurmountable" burdens of proof for the applicant, and so has directed the Mass Media Bureau "to consider appropriate rule changes to permit the summary rejection of [these types of] renewal challenges."

In other FCC actions this week, the Commission has: rescinded the grant of a renewal application for KGDP-660 Orcutt CA; officially revoked the license of WKSP-1090 Kingstree SC, for failing to disclose felony drug charges pending against its principal owner; and dismissed an appeal in a Pawley's Island SC new FM station proceeding as moot, since a settlement agreement has now been approved.

The NAB has requested that the FCC consider additional FM translator reforms. The NAB's suggestions are intended to reinforce the FCC ruling that translators be used strictly as a secondary radio service. They include granting only one (rather than three) years for compliance with the new regulations, and reconsideration of the FCC decision to allow advertising messages on translators.

Effective January 22, the FCC has a new Forms Self-Service Center, located at 1919 M Street NW, Washington, in Room L-17. The center, open 8 AM-5 PM weekdays, will house the most frequently requested FCC forms. These forms and all FCC publications may still be obtained by calling 202-632-FORM, or by mailing in the FCC's 207 Form Order Card.

ELSEWHERE

As the long-anticipated Middle East war began last week, radio stations divided into three distinct groups: 1) Let the network worry about it, we'll go 100% to them; 2) Nothing is going to stop my music sweep; and 3) Put our plan in action. Although it was the smallest segment, many stations were ready with a modified play list, assignments for the staff and a clear idea of how to react.

Network coverage of the war has drawn mixed reactions thus far, with some stations praising the service and others feeling they were reduced to simulcasting television reports. In each market we surveyed, we found several stations dropping regular format for full war coverage, often simulcast on AM and FM and sometimes simulcast on competing stations (e.g., when both were carrying the same network feed). As time went on, some fully simulcast stations set up their AM as an all news alternative. Stations with the Business Radio Network and CNN found it very easy to tie in to full war coverage. BRN, a primarily AM service, found its service showing up on companion FM stations across the country. After full time programming, the most popular war coverage programming was Associated Press hourly updates; many stations are still running the hourly reports and plan to continue. Several news networks continue to provide as many as four update reports an hour.

In times of emergency, listeners use radio differently. A major problem for many stations we monitored was the inflexibility of their music scheduling. We noted many songs that, on the evening war began, took on new, often entirely inappropriate meanings and would have been better off shelved. When questioned, stations usually responded that they "just played what was scheduled." If you use a music scheduling system, think about pre-planning an emergency program that can replace regular programming when needed.

ELSEWHERE (Cont'd)

RAB figures for November 1990 show radio advertising revenue up 4.0% over the same period in 1989. 1990 year-to-date figures through November show ad sales up an average of 5.6% from 1989. The Western region of the country boasted the highest growth rate for both national and local ad revenue. The accounting firms of Miller Kaplan Arase & Co. and Hungerford Aldrin Nichols & Carter provide the figures on the over 100 radio markets RAB uses to calculate its revenue index.

Birch/Scarborough has released a number of changes in its 1991 market surveys. They include: adding the markets of Fort Wayne IN, Litchfield County CT and Eureka/Arcata CA; expanding the Staunton/Waynesboro VA survey from condensed to a standard market report; effective Spring 1991, measuring for six rather than three months the markets of Dubuque IA, Harrisonburg VA, and New London CT; and adding 18 new major markets to its annual Scarborough Consumer, Media and Retail Report, bringing the total to 55 markets covered.

Finally, yet another variation on competing stations combining operations: Radio & Records reports that country-formatted KCTR AM/FM Billings MT is now representing sales for cross-town CHR KZLS. The two stations continue to be programmed and managed separately.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

In actions and appeals this week, the FCC: granted in part an appeal and reduced from \$10,000 to \$7,500 the amount of forfeiture assessed against the former owner of WXTR AM/FM, La Plata MD, for rules violations concerning main studio, program origination and public inspection file regulations...dismissed as moot an appeal of a previous motion in a Northport, AL new FM station proceeding that has since been settled...dismissed a petition and denied an appeal of a previous ruling that refused to disqualify QRW Partners as an applicant for a new FM facility in Mableton, GA...and, in a case dating back at least six years, upheld a previous Review Board decision granting the application of First Class Communications, Ltd. for a new FM in Chatham, MA. (WFCC-107.5 subsequently signed on in early 1987.)

ELSEWHERE

Reams Broadcasting has announced it will switch the calls of Cincinnati Z-Rocker WZRQ-96.5 to WZRZ. The move came in response to a preliminary injunction granted due to a lawsuit from CHR competitor WKRQ, which claimed trademark infringement and advertiser confusion from the similar call letters. Initially, Reams had refused to change calls after a temporary restraining order was issued, claiming that despite the court order it was obligated to use the call letters officially assigned by the FCC. The incident is the second time a new Z-Rock FM affiliate, trying to tie calls into the format, has inadvertently stumbled across a competitor's calls; in Fresno last year, Liggett Broadcasting went through two separate sets of calls and lawsuits before settling on KZZF.

Unistar has announced that the Armed Forces Radio and Television Service (AFRTS) is now carrying a 30 minute audio cycle of CNN Headline News each hour. AFRTS had already begun utilizing several other Unistar format services for its global network, including newly established outlets in the Persian Gulf region.

The Radio Advertising Bureau held its 1991 Managing Sales Conference in Nashville TN last week. Highlights included the introduction of a campaign to target newspaper advertisers and automobile advertisers. The two campaigns should be showing up on stations across the country this week. Eight spots (four, entitled "The Voice of Reason," voiced by Ben Stein, and four, entitled "Foremost Authority," voiced by Ian Shoales) were produced by the Richard Group (the Motel 6 creative team). They are funny, intelligent and should do the job well. The auto spots are being backed up with print ads in auto industry publications.

Also at the RAB Conference: Tom Bodett's excellent presentation, on talking to your audience and not treating them as a "target," is available for purchase; contact the RAB for details...the RAB is introducing a new phone number to help organize national sales leads. The number is 1-800-252-RADIO. Potential advertisers may call the number to be given information on radio, and the lead will be passed on to local sales departments...and a complete copy of the RAB's 1991 radio marketing plan can be obtained by giving them a call at 212-254-4800.

People attending the RAB had for the most part good things to say about the conference; many felt they would bring back useful ideas for their stations. With all the talk about marketing a station, the most obvious topic missing from the show was the value of customer service. Much was said about how to obtain clients but not nearly enough on how to keep them. If radio is to reach its goal of 7% of all advertising revenue by the end of 1991, we must do more than bring them in the door - we must show them that nothing beats radio for generating sales for the client. As one delegate to the hardware show being held in the next hall said: "These radio people don't understand. I need to sell vacuum cleaners...they send me the youngest thing in the tightest fittin skirt, who doesn't know ----, all she wants to talk about is GRPs. But she clams right up when I ask her: How many vacuums will you sell?"
