WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

A 21-plaintiff lawsuit has been filed against the FCC. NAB, the ACLU, Infinity Broadcasting and other group owners are among those charging the FCC with denying their right to a fair and speedy trial by not giving them a faster avenue for judicial redress than waiting around for the FCC to collect its fine through a civil suit. The plaintiffs want the U.S. District Court in Washington to throw out all pending indecency fines and keep the commission from issuing new ones.

The Commission has revoked the license of Starett Media Corporation for WFRK, Coleman, for being off the air without notifying them.

In the fine department this week, KSIX Corpus Christi TX got hit for \$750 for public inspection file problems. "Broadcast and/or Tower Violations" cost KCOH Houston TX \$5,650; KEXS Excelsior Springs MO \$375; and KBOR/KTJN Brownsville TX \$20,000.

ELSEWHERE

Arbitron has announced that it will allow an on-air survey announcement test in Atlanta during the last two-thirds of the Spring '93 book. The Atlanta Radio Association had asked to make such announcements to "improve response rates without affecting the results." The stations are allowed to identify themselves immediately before and after. The announcements may happen in Detroit, Las Vegas, and Greenville, SC.

After a year of distribution on vinyl disc, The Nashville Network Radio has announced that its "Nashville Record Review" will be distributed on CD effective with the April 3-4 edition. TNRR will be making this announcement officially at the Country Radio Seminar around the time you read this.

Independent Broadcasters Network midday host Ellen Ratner moves from 11-12 a.m. to 1-3 p.m. Ratner, who also co-hosts IBN's "Battleline" twice a week, has moved her show against EFM's Rush Limbaugh program in hopes of being a liberal counter-point to the conservative host.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

In a surprise development, the National Assn. of Broadcasters and the Electronic Industries Association have agreed to work together to develop technical standards for in-band DAB. The March 8 announcement has the EIA and NAB working through the National Radio Systems Committee and splitting their costs. NRSC is now shooting to complete testing of potential in-band systems by June 30, 1994 "and will recommend a single [in-band] system if appropriate." The EIA will work alone on out-of-band and satellite DAB testing.

As part of its comments on an FCC proposal to ask station renewal applicants if they're on the air, the NAB has asked that the FCC shut down FMs that have been off for more than six months. The comments are in keeping with similar protectionist-style NAB statements over the past 18 months. Watch for the Commission to take a tougher stand on silent and long-unbuilt licenses in the coming months. According to the M Street database, 382 stations are silent as of this week.

ELSEWHERE

Interrep has announced the merger of Durpetti & Associates and HNW H Radio Sales into one firm, Durpetti & Rossinsky. Tony Durpetti will be chairman/CEO; Jacqui Rossinsky of HNW H will be president/COO. Durpetti's John Fabian is executive VP/client development. HNW H's Kirk Combs is now executive VP/client services. D&R is opening an Atlanta office and Interrep promises to add three more by this summer, bringing its total to offices in 21 cities.

Inside Radio and R&R both report that EFM Media is now asking Rush Limbaugh affiliates for "\$30,000 and up in some medium and large markets" in addition to the four minutes of inventory stations are already giving them. No word on whether the \$30,000 includes handy BMI log sheets.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

Remember the Arbitron revolt of 1991-92? Before the departure of Birch? Before the announcement of the People Meter? Before people got too busy being mad about whatever they're mad about this week? Well, Inside Radio reports that EZ Communications, whose anti-Arbitron crusade became major industry news, is an Arbitron subscriber again. EZ came back first through its duopoly deals in Charlotte and Pittsburgh where the station it was acquiring subscribed to Arbitron. Now Inside Radio says the Arbitron contract is "group wide" except for KMPS Seattle.

In the recently released RADAR 46 network ratings, ABC Prime remains the leading network, despite a 1.2% drop in audience share. It is followed by WW1/Mutual (-5.1%), ABC Platinum (+1.0%), ABC Genesis (+7.2%), and CBS Spectrum (-0.2%). The biggest losers are WW1/NBC (-9.7%), WW1/WONE (-13.6%), and the American Urban net, off 6.2%. The biggest increase goes to Unistar's Ultimate, up 11.2%. ABC's Paul Harvey has the top three most listened to programs.

In duopoly news this week, the Pyramid/Atlantic merger is off, at least for now. Boston's WXKS-AM-FM and WHDH/WRKO/WBMX remain separate combos. Also, WING/WGTZ Dayton is now operating crosstown WAZU. Terry Robinson's WAVH Mobile, Ala., is sold to rival WKSJ-AM-FM.

The Radio Advertising Bureau's second Certified Radio Sales Manager training program will be held in conjunction with the spring NAB convention in Las Vegas, April 17-19. For more info, call 800-722-7355.

With the boom in country stations comes further additions in country syndication. The Drummond Group used the Country Radio Seminar to announce its new weekly one-hour "Simple Life With Ricky Skaggs" described as a combination of country hits and "entertainment and sports industry" guests. Call 800-833-1334. Also, Premiere Radio Networks has signed WSIX Nashville morning man Gerry House to a six year deal and will be offering his show on a national basis. And in related news, former WYAI-WYAY Atlanta PD Russ Schell joins the Lund Consultants as an associate; he'll remain based in Atlanta.

Executive Broadcast Services, the service/marketing company whose clients include M Street, among others, is now representing Hansen Digital Technology's Schafer Digital, maker of digital automation systems. For more info, call 719-579-6664.

Less than two months after his launch as a sports talk host on Business Radio Network, Joe Namath has been off the job since March 1, the result of a squabble with BRN that has both sides claiming breach of contract. The Palm Beach Post reports that the trouble started when Namath wanted to see his affiliate list, prompting BRN's Bruce Vann to say, "We are not turning over proprietary information to somebody who is going to leave." At presstime, Namath's show was being handled by co-host Jerry Gross.

Bob Smith, known to you as Wolfman Jack, has announced that he'll release his autobiography next year through Warner Books. The Wolfman will team up with Byron Laursen (Pat Riley's co-author on "Show Time!") and he promises that the volume will be "filled with backstage intrigue, multi-million dollar deals, and a near-fatal attraction to drugs."

CBS Radio Representatives Atlanta sales manager Chad Brown is named to the new Southern Regional Manager post. He'll also oversee CBS spot sales offices in Dallas and that particularly southern market, Philadelphia.

Jones Satellite Network adds its first CD Country affiliates this week (see above); it has also passed the 500 affiliate mark with the addition of WFFX Tuscaloosa, Ala., reported here on Feb. 17.

Country Radio Seminar

There wasn't much debate at the 24th annual Country Radio Seminar as to whether country had become the new CHR radio--just the drive from New York to Nashville took care of that one. Country stations were the ones with tempo and texture and hot production. CHR stations, where you could find one, were closer to hot AC. It wasn't unusual to hear something uptempo on the two major country FMs in Nashville, then punch over to Y107 and hear the P.M. Dawn ballad, and that's with Y107 making a concerted effort on the tempo issue.

Country Radio Seminar (cont'd)

The real discussion at CRS this year was whether being the new CHR was a good thing, or whether the infusion of CHR formatics, programmers, and listeners would ultimately threaten country radio's identity.

Consider, for instance, the infusion of CHR/AOR style attitude liners in country radio, especially at the handful of younger targeted flanker stations that have popped up over the last nine months. KQBR Sacramento, KRAK-FM's LMA partner, is using the now-infamous "Don't Be A Dick" promo, something that got a gasp out of many in a panel room when it was brought up.

That led WUSN Chicago PD J.D. Spangler to comment, "US99 must be behind the times because we still like to be nice to our listeners ... You can be funny and not be a smartass." Spangler warned PDs not to "lose the value of why people like country music. Even the younger demos tell me they're tired of all the hype."

KSSN Little Rock PD Don Moore told the audience at the programming formatics panel, "Part of the mindset is that country radio has always been nice and friendly." But there aren't very many country PDs being nice and friendly toward each other. Country format battles have always been notoriously fierce, but until recently there haven't been that many major markets where it was an issue. Now even Pittsburgh has three country FMs and the annual panel where PDs debate programming strategy for a hypothetical case study has been replaced by a session on "programming warfare" that was essentially a dirty tricks panel with participants hidden behind a curtain.

So while KSSN's Moore told the audience that he wasn't seeing that many dirty tricks, there were plenty of other folks with stories. One panelist bragged about sending residents of a local homeless shelter to his AC rival's client party. WSM-FM Nashville programmer Kevin O'Neal, who moderated, bragged about once picking up a competitor's concert tickets from a promoter's office, as well as sneaking into a rival station and leaving the GM a map with the routes out of town outlined. And there were so many stories about stealing a competitor's concerts that somebody finally got a hand for asking if radio people were in the programming business or the concert business.

The dirty tricks issue will undoubtedly be back for the next CRS. So will an issue that got mentioned mostly in passing this year, the rise of independent promotion and the possibility of more pop indies following the lead of Chicago-based Jeff McClusky who recently opened a Nashville office.

Epic's Jack Lameier, asked at the Hot Seat panel about pop indies, told the audience not to expect a boom because, "I won't pay their prices." He added, "The pop side is just so scared about what's going on in country that they want to be part of it and that goes for independents and everyone else."

LMAs and duopolies, the big CRS issues last year, were more of a fact of life this year as witnessed by the relatively sparse attendance at this year's duopoly panel. It did make for a few good quotes, however. Pioneering KASE/KVET Austin, Texas GM Ron Rogers told the audience that his daughter now works at WYAY-WYAI Atlanta; when the news broke that owner NewCity was looking to sell that station, most likely into a duopoly, "she called me crying and said, 'I may lose my job, dad, because of you.'"

Then there was KNIX Phoenix's Larry Daniels. Asked, by Ralph Emery at the faux-talk show that ended the CRS, about the ultimate effect of duopoly, Daniels said, "Does that mean radio is going to be better for it? I don't think so." Daniels was applauded, but KNIX's sister station KUZZ Bakersfield is in the process of assembling a duopoly of its own.

Attendance at this year's CRS was up sharply. The estimate going in was 2,000 people, up from about 1,200 last year. Despite this, CRS organizers made it through this year without an overcrowding problem on the order of last year's Garth Brooks concert fiasco, although there was some grumbling from PDs who had to wait in line for the first time at the artist taping session, something that radio folks had been able to wander in to in the past.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

In the long battle over 105.7 MHz in Manahawkin, NJ, the Commission has denied Jersey Shore Broadcasting Corp. and Press Broadcasting Co. reconsideration of an order which granted an application for review filed by Seashore Broadcasting Corp. and vacated a Review Board decision that dismissed Seashore's appeal for lack of standing (get all that?). The Order also vacated the ALJ's decision which approved a settlement agreement among the competing applicants. Pursuant to the settlement, Press would receive the Manahawkin permit, but under an option agreement with Jersey Shore, it could ultimately swap the newly constructed facility for an existing facility licensed to Jersey Shore.

The Commission has upheld an initial decision and a Review Board decision which granted the application of BEBE-F Broadcasting Corp. for a new FM station on 107.3 MHz in Baker, LA. It denied FM 104.9 Broadcasting's application for reconsideration of dismissal of its application for a new FM on 104.9 MHz in Clemson SC. The frequency was granted this week to Golden Corners Broadcasting, who also have WCCP (AM).

The Commission this week designated several new facilities for hearings:

- Moonbeam, Inc. and Gary E. Willson for 100.9 MHz in Calistoga, CA.
- Rural Initiatives for Shelter & Education and American Indian Broadcast Group for 103.7 MHz in Hartford, MI.
- Ojeda Broadcasting, Inc. and Rosemary Houston for 96.5 MHz in Hobbs, NM.
- Triad Family Network for 89.3 MHz in Winston-Salem, NC and Positive Alternative Radio, Inc. for 89.3 MHz in Asheboro, NC.
- Lehigh Valley Community Broadcasters and Beacon Broadcasting Corp. for 89.3 MHz in Allentown, PA and Northampton Community College for 89.5 MHz in Bethlehem Township, PA.

The Commission has proposed amending and updating its guidelines regarding its RF radiation standards. The new guidelines, which places new restrictions on currents induced by fields below 100 MHz, could significantly affect specs on transmitters, as well as broadcast station's monitoring and reporting systems. For more information, call Robert Cleveland at the FCC's office of Engineering and Technology at (202) 653-8169.

Former FCC chairman Al Sikes has resurfaced as the head of a new Hearst Corp., division responsible for new media and technologies. Sikes' turf will include fiber optics and electronic superhighways.

And if Al Sikes is back in these pages than Howard Stern can't be far behind. Last week, L.A. Times radio writer Claudia Puig forced KLSX to admit that it had indeed edited "the raciest portions" of Stern's morning show in hopes of avoiding more FCC complaints while the current \$105,000 FCC fine against KLSX is appealed. Now, KFBI Las Vegas has made a similar confession according to this week's Radio & Records. Both KLSX and KFBI are targets of anti-Stern crusader Al Wescott, leading one to wonder if it's actually Wescott who is "king of all media."

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

Meanwhile, Infinity made good on its promise not to put Stern on its newly acquired WZGC (293) Atlanta by instead putting its syndicated Greaseman show on mornings at 293. This has a couple of interesting implications. 1) Infinity, which is currently rebroadcasting morning man Stern at night in two of its markets is now also rebroadcasting a jock who appears at night on the following morning in Atlanta. 2) A jock whose career somehow survived a well-publicized gaffe he made on the first Martin Luther King, Jr., holiday in 1986 is now on the air in King's home town.

ELSEWHERE

The long-pending Shamrock-Malrite merger has finally taken place with Shamrock emerging as the controlling company. The merger, valued somewhere in the \$300-325 million range, gives the existing company 21 stations in 12 markets, excluding WEGX Philadelphia (see below) and Shamrock's WHB/KUDL Kansas City. Shamrock CEO Bill Clark and COO Marty Loughman retain those positions. Malrite chairman/CEO Milt Maltz is now a consultant to the Shamrock Holdings board. Meanwhile, WEGX--orphaned by the deal--is now jazz/new AC outlet WJZ, something which can't possibly sit well with the owners of recently launched adult standards AM WWJZ Mt. Holly, N.J.

Several months ago, there was widespread speculation that the Walt Disney folks would end up in some sort of joint children's network venture with ABC/SMN. For now, however, Disney has launched a joint venture with the Children's Satellite Network for the weekly "Disney Read-Along Storytime Theatre," which will debut on April 12, running at 12:30 PM CST Tuesday and 7:00 PM CST Thursday.

From the "Life's Little Ironies" department: Until a few years ago, KIOZ Oceanside, CA., was a San Diego North County station that couldn't really find a niche in San Diego. Whatever the then-KGMG-FM found success with, like classic rock, somebody in San Diego itself would steal from them. The idea of KIOZ managing to buy the then-market leader KKLQ (Q106) would have seemed far-fetched, at best. But it's 1993 and KIOZ has found its niche doing hard rock while Q106 seems to be stuck on the path from first to worst. And Par Broadcasting, owner of KGMG/KIOZ, has announced that it's purchasing KKLQ-AM-FM from Edens Broadcasting for \$13-million. Owner Gary Edens will consult Par. Q106 GM Bob Bollinger will stay on. The publicity for this sale identifies it as San Diego's first duopoly, but that's not entirely true. XHTZ (Z90), the station that has wrestled the churban format lead from Q106, is actually part of a three FM combo in Tijuana where duopoly has been a way of life for some time.

The WYAY-WYAI combo wasn't Atlanta's first duopoly either--that distinction actually belonged to two stations at the southern end of the Atlanta suburbs, but the pairing of those two stations certainly was a notable moment in the duopoly's history. Now the combo is being broken up. WYAY will go to ABC's WKHX-AM-FM for \$19-million. New City hasn't found a buyer yet for WYAI, the station at the south end of the market.

Associated Press has announced a new pricing structures for third or fourth stations in a multiple-ownership combo. Stations will now pay 50% of the normal cost for their third or fourth duopoly partners.

At Westwood One's Talknet, weekender Dr. Harvey Ruben moves to late nights, after Bruce Williams, as Myrna Lamb departs. "Motivational speaker and personal success expert" David Essel will handle weekends on the network now with his new "David Essel: Alive" program.

Lowell "Bud" Paxson has begun operating the Florida's Broadcasting Network following the acquisition of the network from Broadcast Equities, Inc. FRN, which has at least nine of the state's major sports franchises, has more than 60 affiliates.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

A number of major FCC disciplinary actions to report this week. According to Inside Radio, the commission has:

* Fined WGTZ (Z93) Dayton \$5,000 for unauthorized phone taping. The FCC says that "even saying 'Hello' before the caller informs the recipient of the intent to broadcast the call ... violate[s] Section 73.1206."

* Fined the former KHTK St. Louis (now KXOK-FM) \$2,500 for some gag on-air fundraising the station did after its tower was destroyed. The FCC referred to this as a "fraudulent solicitation of funds."

* Designated the licenses of WNCN New York and two Salt Lake City stations for a renewal hearing. WNCN is under fire from two challengers for a number of issues, down to potential RF interference from its new antenna application. SLC area outlets KBER and KQOL, which participated in a frequency swap several years ago, will be scrutinized to see if owner Chris Devine was actually exercising control over both stations at once.

In other actions this week, the Commission has also:

* Remanded on a misrepresentation issue the proceeding involving four mutually exclusive applications for a new FM on 95.3 MHz in Gulf Breeze, FL.

* Designated for hearing six mutually exclusive applications for a new station on 94.7 MHz in New Albany, IN.

* Designated for hearing two mutually exclusive applications for a new station on 103.5 MHz in Crozet, VA.

* Approved a settlement agreement among Skyline Broadcasters, Tom Seabase, and Cloud Nine Broadcasting, Inc.; and granted the application of Cloud Nine for a new FM on 106.3 MHz in Kalispell, MT.

* Approved a settlement agreement between John M. Giannettino and John T. Pritchard; and granted the application of Pritchard for a new FM on 103.1 MHz in Burlington, IA.

The NAB has, not surprisingly, come out in favor of Senate bill S.335--legislation proposed by Alaska Republican Ted Stevens and Hawaiian Democrat Dan Inouye exempting radio from any potential spectrum auctions. The FCC has long been against competitive bidding for stations or spectrum space.

Three new members have been elected to the NAB Radio Board of Directors to serve alongside those who were announced last month. The new members are NewCity's Dick Ferguson (District 1), WEAZ Philadelphia's Jerry Lee (District 3), and Paxson Broadcasting's Orlando GM Matt Mills (District 7). In addition, Cox president Nick Trigony was elected to the TV Board of Directors.

CANADA THIS WEEK

It's long been the position of this column that the increased calls for protectionism by the NAB and individual broadcasters could make American broadcasting look a lot like its Canadian counterpart. It's also been a contention that U.S. broadcasters need to be careful about what they ask for in that regard, in case they get it.

For example, as many American broadcasters cover their eyes and hope that the satellite DAB issue will go away, Canadian broadcasters tend to see the end of radio as we know it (along with many other media) as a fait accompli. This was the overwhelming feeling one got at this year's radio conference sponsored by the Canadian trade publication The Record and held in Toronto on March 19-21.

As was the case at last year's Records, many of the sessions, including MIT Media Lab head Nicholas Negroponte's keynote and a subsequent state-of-the-industry panel called "Crisis What Crisis," were geared toward the day when media are produced at the receiving end, not the sending end, of their signal, and, as Negroponte put it, "the primary customer for media will be machines, not people."

In other words, not only is DAB coming, but so is the age of records and videocassettes produced at home. Copyright law will be harder to enforce, especially as media territories overlap; content restrictions--such an issue in Canada now--will be near-impossible to enforce. Much of the above was said at last year's Record conference too, but it's always a little surprising to hear this, if only because American broadcasters are trying to ignore this sort of scenario and hope it goes away.

Some interesting quotes from this year's Record: Danny Kingsbury, PD of Westcom's CILQ (Q107) Toronto and CJXY (Y95) Hamilton announced that he wasn't a fan of satellite radio before somebody from the audience pointed out that Q107's overnight show was syndicated across the country. And in a panel on the state of black and dance music in Canada, one audience member interrupted the litany of complaints about radio to announce that they had been to the awards luncheon the day before. "If radio isn't working," the audience member asked, "Why is everybody congratulating one another?"

One person who DID deserve their award was legendary CKLW Windsor/Detroit MD Rosalie Trombley, inducted into the Broadcasters' Hall of Fame. Attendance at the Record was put somewhere in the 600-650 person range with about half of those coming from the radio side.

ELSEWHERE

Radio sales have posted double digit increases for the first time in 2-1/2 years according to new figures from the Radio Advertising Bureau. Combined local and national revenue was up 14% for February, 1993 as opposed to the same month in 1992. Local revenue was up 14% by itself; national revenue was up 13%. All regions of the country were up for local sales with the Southwest doing the best (+22%). The Southwest, ironically, was the only region to show a decrease in national sales, off by three percent. For the year to date, local revenue was up 10% over the first two months of 1992; national revenue was up 6%.

National Public Radio board member Joseph Dembo has been named acting president of the network, replacing Doug Bennet who has been nominated as Asst. Secretary of State. NPR has also named a five person search committee and hopes to have a president in place by Labor Day.

Daily Variety reports that two of KFWB Los Angeles' sports anchors have been transferred from the Group W station's payroll to that of outside Shadow Traffic. Sports anchors Joe Calla and Rod Van Hook are now Shadow employees; instead of paying them a salary, KFWB is giving Shadow inventory. Variety says that Shadow "is taking separate steps with stations in New York, Chicago, and Philadelphia."

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

Well, Howard Stern the E! show is here. Howard Stern the movie is coming, so to speak. So it was inevitable that we would have an announcement, on March 23, that Howard Stern the book will be here in October, published by Simon & Schuster. Stern, getting what New York Newsday estimates as \$1-million for the tome, hasn't chosen a name yet. "I had a title, 'Mein Kampf,' but I was told that it might offend Jewish readers," Stern told the press conference.

Meanwhile, Stern's WJFK Washington co-host G. Gordon Liddy becomes the first of Infinity Broadcasting's talk stars to be distributed through Unistar Radio Networks as a result of the recent Infinity/Unistar deal. Liddy's 10 AM - 2 PM (eastern time) show goes national in late April. One interesting implication: WJFK tends to let Howard Stern run to 10:30 or 11 AM. Does this mean that WJFK will actually force Stern to end on time? Or will it join its own program when it's already in progress?

The Radio Advertising Bureau is upgrading the On-Line Express database that it's been offering for the last seven years. The new SALES-PLUS database will feature access to the RAB's extensive new ad copy library, an "Ask the Experts" computer bulletin board where users can leave questions for the likes of Irwin Pollack or Norm Goldsmith and daily features such as a promotion idea du jour. WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Last week the trade press reported that FCC chairman Jim Quello was threatening to pull some licenses if Howard Stern kept getting cited for indecency. So it must come as a big relief to KLSX Los Angeles this week that, according to R&R, the FCC has decided not to cite owner Greater Media for two more Stern complaints that have been pending in recent weeks. One complaint was judged to be just "really borderline"; the other wasn't accompanied by an aircheck or transcript.

ELSEWHERE

Four years after its much heralded entry into the station arena, Westwood One has announced the sale of the former "Pirate Radio 100.3," KQLZ Los Angeles to Viacom for \$40 million. Viacom is the owner of KYSR, making this the market's first duopoly. (Viacom has announced its intention to sell KIKK-AM-FM Houston rather than try to double up there.) WW1 bought KIQQ for \$55 million. Add that to the fact that KQLZ is already programming modern rock and you now wonder if the station will be known as "Haircut 100."

Of course, there are those of us who remember when Pirate Radio was so exciting that Westwood actually felt compelled to protect the name. Return with us now to those thrilling days of yesteryear as the name game resumes in full effect this week at:

* Broadcast Programming, which has filed to cancel Alliance Broadcasting's service mark on the term "Young Country." Alliance, licensee of similarly named KYNG-FM Dallas. BP says it's been using the term since October 1991. KYNG signed on in January 1992. Hank Williams, Jr., of course, created the term in the late '80s, but nobody's asked him how he feels about this. For that matter, nobody has asked the Isley Bros., how they feel about WYXR Philadelphia trying to service-mark the name of its love songs show, "Between The Sheets," which takes its moniker from an early '80s Isleys hit.

* WHTZ (Z100) New York which has sent a C&D letter to WKSZ (Z100) Philadelphia over the latter's use of the Z100 nickname, something which never bothered them when the Z100 nickname was used in Portland, Ore., Lynchburg, Va., Columbus, Miss., or any number of other places during the mid-'80s. Z100 is worried about the places where the signals (both on 100.3) overlap. The waggish comment would be that WHTZ ought to be glad that somebody still wants to steal from them.

M Street welcomes the U.S. Army National Guard as a subscriber to the Journal this week. Each of the Guard's 54 field offices across the country are using the Journal to keep abreast of changes in their respective states and territories and help to further their partnerships with radio stations.

The Colorado-based Jones Satellite Network has signed a letter of intent to purchase the Las Vegas-based Sports Entertainment Network. SEN lists 100 full- or part-time affiliates.

Roughly a year after announcing its intention to do so, Evergreen Media has filed an initial public offering of 3.5 million shares with which it will fund the purchase of KTRH/KLOL Houston.

In other LMA/duopoly news: The United Broadcasting breakup continues with the announcement that Cathy Hughes will buy WERQ-AM-FM (92Q) Baltimore to pair with her WWIN-AM-FM for \$9 million ... The Summit Radio people who own WGTC-FM New Carlisle/South Bend, Ind.--not to be confused with the Atlanta based group--are responsible for two LMA-to-purchase simulcasts that you see in the format section this week; WGTC-FM has also entered into a sales-only LMA with crosstown urban/AC WUBU. Also, the owners of KLBJ-AM-FM Austin enter into an LMA-to-buy with KMXX, previously part of an LMA-to-buy with crosstown KHFI which has just been entered into a LMA-to-buy with crosstown KPEZ.

Kurt Hansen's Accuratings announces five more survey markets this week: Washington, D.C., St. Louis, Seattle, Milwaukee, and Oklahoma City. Some may be surveyed for the current spring book; all will be surveyed by this summer, Hansen says.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

ABC News has announced a worldwide newsgathering partnership with the BBC. The partnership covers both radio and TV news. The relationship provides for "the exchange of worldwide news coverage; joint planning for major news stories; and the exclusive sharing of correspondents and production teams." It may eventually expand to include some joint bureaus.

Inside Radio reports that Unistar president of sales David Landau is leaving after 10 years. Senior VP/national sales Jim Higgins will handle his duties for the time being.

The Nashville Network's radio operation, TNNR, has announced the addition of its "The Nashville Record Review" to WYNY New York, even in advance of that station's sale to Broadcast Partners. TNNR also adds WDAF Kansas City and WGKX Memphis.

WRFX Charlotte, which has already been syndicating its morning show to nearby WROQ Greenville, S.C., is now simulcasting a second show with WROQ, its Sunday night artist interview show, "East Coast Live." WRFX is looking for more affiliates; call GM Jack Daniel at 704-338-9970.

WMAQ-TV Chicago reporter Ray Suarez is the new host of National Public Radio's "Talk Of The Nation" effective April 12.

Catalog sales outlet Rivertown Trading Co., has acquired former Film House Exec. VP Tony Quin's Music-Link and Music-Barn music buying services. Quin becomes VP of Rivertown's new Select Music Systems division.
