BECHTEL PUTS FCC ON HOLD... after Susan Bechtel, an applicant for a new FM station at Selbyville, Delaware successfully argued to the U.S. Court of Appeals that the Commission's integration credit, one of the principal criteria used in evaluating applicants for new broadcast facilities, "is arbitrary and capricious" and therefore unlawful.

The freeze will put on hold all predesignation procedures, new applicant proceedings, and comparative renewal proceedings. The freeze will not affect those proceedings where integration credit is not an issue. Further, the Commission will not adopt FM filing windows for new filing opportunities. Also, the filing of amendments, integration proposals, or hearing fees are frozen, and no cases will be designated for hearings involving a standard comparative issue.

The Commission admits that because this issue "may take some time" to resolve, the Chief ALJ will appoint settlement judges to proceedings in which the applicants wish to voluntarily settle. In these cases, applicants will not be required to adhere to their original integration proposals.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Commission has revoked the licenses of two Southeastern AM stations for failing to respond to inquiries as to why they are off the air. Palmetto Communications' WDIK Yadkinville NC was a 1,000 watt station on 1570 kHz. Turner County Broadcasting's WNNQ Ashburn GA was a 1,000 watt daytimer on 1480 kHz.

Robert Tezak's Uno Broadcasting has lost the right to be a Commission licensee and, subsequently, will lose the licenses of his eight stations. Tezak was convicted in Illinois of two counts of conspiracy to commit arson and one count of conspiracy to obstruct justice. The eight stations are news/talk WJOL and album rock WLLI-FM Joliet IL (Chicago); oldies KBLU and country KTTI Yuma AZ; standards/talk KTOP and album rock KDVV Topeka KS; and standards KOLE Port Arthur and AC KKMV Orange TX.

ELSEWHERE

In duopoly news, Silverado Broadcasting will be doubling up in Stockton, CA, as they've announced their plans to purchase Spanish KCVR Stockton CA and CHR KWTN Lodi CA for \$3.3 million cash. Silverado already has oldies combo KWG Stockton CA/KEXX Tracy CA.

In Grand Junction, Mustang Broadcasters is buying its way into the market in two separate transactions that will give them a duopoly. The first purchase will be oldies KQIL and CHR KQIX-FM from Airwaves Communications. Price wasn't disclosed. The second transaction will be a purchase of oldies KEZO Grand Junction and adult hits KKLY Delta from Monument Broadcasters for \$525,000.

Former Unistar exec. Terry Robinson's Pourtales Holdings will be doubling up in Wichita. Robinson will be buying talk KFH and AC KXLK Hayesville KS from Midcontinent Media, Inc. Price was not disclosed. Pourtales has announced its intent to purchase adult standards KQAM and oldies KEYN-FM Wichita from Clear Channel Communications. Both transactions should close soon.

ABC Networks will be dropping their weekend specialty gardening show hosted by Ralph Snodsmith and the home repair show hosted by Mike McClintock. ABC says they are dropping the programs because stations usually have their own local experts. However, ABC is scheduling Jim Hightower from 1-4 pm and Bob Brinker from 4-7 pm for the weekend lineup.

American Freedom DJ's Inc. has announced the debut of the "USA Country Network" at the Country Radio Seminar - 25th Silver Celebration. The USA Country Network will occupy booth #70 from March 2-4 during regular exhibit hours. Also, their three hour "Elvis: The Legend of a King" is now being offered to metro market stations on an exclusive basis.

American Freedom DJ's Inc. has hired three new Affiliate Relations Representatives. Tony Garcia, Manager/Affiliate Relations, Sean McKay Affiliate Rep. for CST and Robin Mackinaw, Affiliate Rep. for EST.

The NAB has elected Howard B. Anderson, president of KHUY, Inc., Los Angeles, CA, to serve on the NAB Radio Board of Directors. Anderson will fill the District 24 seat (Southern California, Hawaii, Guam, American Samoa) now held by Chairman Robert L. Fox, chairman & CEO, KVEN/KHAY, Ventura, CA. Fox's term will end in June.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Sandusky's KEGL Dallas TX can breath a sigh of relief. Their license has been renewed after the Commission dismissed a complaint by Al Westcott, the guy who's been breathing down Howard Stern's neck the last couple of years. Westcott failed to show that Stern's material that aired on KFBI Las Vegas NV also aired on KEGL.

The Commission has fined another station for not getting permission from a caller before airing the conversation. This time, it cost KTBB Tyler TX \$5,000.

Your friends at the FCC want to remind you that the ownership and service rules for FM translators that were adopted in 1990 will be fully effective on June 1 of this year. The 1990 Report & Order provided that FM translators in operation prior to March 1, 1990 would be "grandfathered," and did not have to comply with the new rules until June 1, 1994. As of June 1, all FM translators must comply with the new rules.

The NAB this week asked the FCC to give better guidance to radio and TV stations on how to comply with the FCC's new EEO guidelines. Questions were raised about how the new guidelines were developed and how they will be enforced. The NAB stated that the FCC should first give the public the opportunity to comment on the new rules. The NAB went further to ask the FCC to clarify how it will apply the new standards. The NAB also asked to explain how focus on recruitment and record-keeping were going to increase broadcast diversity instead of the actual hiring practices.

The NAB is also pressing the FCC to revise its radio ownership rules. The NAB seeks greater relief for small market stations to give the stations the same flexibility to do duopoly and joint operating deals similar to their larger market counterparts. The NAB would like the FCC to adopt a small market waiver system which will permit the ownership of "up to 50%" of the stations in small markets rather than the current "less than 50%" requirement, and allow any single station or AM-FM combo owner to add one additional station.

ELSEWHERE

Garrison Keillor and his "A Prairie Home Companion" are going to Nashville to be a part of the June 4th grand opening festival of the Ryman Auditorium. Keillor will lead a live broadcast to help celebrate the completion of the \$8.5 million restoration of the 102-year-old landmark. Ryman Auditorium first opened as a church in 1892 and served as home to the Grand Ole Opry from 1943 until 1974 when the Opry moved to the Grand Ole Opry House. Keillor, incidentally, used to listen to the Opry long before he created "A Prairie Home Companion". The broadcast will be underwritten by Cracker Barrel Old Country Store Inc. will be carried on the American Public Radio Network. The Ryman is owned by Gaylord Entertainment, which also owns WSM-AM & FM and the Opryland Hotel.

M Street staff just returned from the Country Radio Seminar in Nashville--a record setting event in several respects. Dave Nichols, Executive Director of the Country Radio Broadcasters, reports a record attendance of 2,251 and 456 stations participating in the Artist Radio Tape Sessions. The most popular sessions included the "The Charts on the Hot Seat," where Radio & Records' Lon Helton defended (and quite well) the newspaper's new record charting system that links estimated airplay to the station's actual audience. Also well-attended was the Closing Session: "WCRS Live" which featured Suzy Bogguss, Alabama's Randy Owen, McBride and the Ride's Terry McBride, Gerry House from WSIX-FM Nashville, as well as several popular songwriters. The group talked about their experiences in country music and ran through a few of their favorite songs.

Coat-tailing on the rise of Country music in the U.S., London will get its first full-time country music station later this year. John Wellington, a British radio executive, will start broadcasting in May. The station will be called Country Music London, and will cover an estimated 15 million people in London.

Arbitron will be changing a couple of procedures with the goal of increasing response rates. First, the company will attempt to place diaries more quickly after a respondent has agreed to participate. Secondly, in an attempt to make it easier for larger households to participate, the packaging of the diaries and premiums have been changed to make it easier to recognize. The changes are taking effect for the Winter 94 book.

RADAR 48 is out, and it's not telling a very good story for network radio. Of the 14 measured networks, 13 of them lost audience. ABC's Genesis network was down a whopping 21.2 %. The average listenership loss was around 8 %. Only ABC's Galaxy network showed a gain--it was up 5.3 %.

Major Network's Major Sports has acquired Premiere's John Madden, Bob Costas and Pat O'Brien programs for a reported \$2.7 million. Shows include "Sports Calendar", "Sports Quiz", "Inside Sports Magazine", "Flashback" and "Costas Coast to Coast". Premiere will continue to sell the shows on an exclusive basis for the next five years.

The New York market will welcome a new duopoly soon as Way Broadcasting will buy Spanish-AC WKDM New York from United Broadcasting for an undisclosed price. Way owns Ethnic WNWK-FM Newark NJ.

Infinity has found a sister station for its oldies station, WOMC Detroit. They'll pay \$23 million for Fritz Broadcasting's WXYT, currently a news/talker. Fritz plans to sell WXYT's current urban AC sister, WMXD, to Booth American in exchange for some cash and Booth's country WTOD/WWKO Toledo and news-talk WSGW Saginaw MI/hot AC WIOG Bay City. Booth will combo WMXD with urban WJLB.

Liberty Broadcasting and Beck-Ross Communications are "becoming one" as Liberty will acquire all three Beck-Ross stations for an undisclosed sum. The transaction will create a Long Island NY duopoly, combining WBLI Patchogue with WBAB Babylon and WGBB Freeport. Liberty is in the process of buying WHFM Southampton, also on Long Island. Liberty also picks up WHCN Hartford and WSNE Taunton MA (Providence).

The Independent Broadcaster's Network (IBN) has purchased WBDN Brandon FL (Tampa), bringing its owned station total to three. IBN is planning to buy 11 other stations over the next two years. It also owns WGGG Gainesville FL and KLXR Redding CA. WBDN will be the flagship station of IBN, and was the flagship of the Sun Radio Network when it was known as WEND.

The Museum of Television & Radio announced it will be opening a new museum in Los Angeles. The entire 60,000 television and radio programs currently housed will be duplicated (with "no decrease in program quality") and made available when renovations to the former Bank of America building on North Beverly Drive are made and the museum is opened to the public. Facilities will include a Library to provide access to the computerized catalog of programming, a Television/Radio Console Room where visitors view and listen to programs they have selected; a 150 seat Theater for major Museum exhibitions, series, and seminars; a Radio Listening Room to feature radio programming; a Radio Studio enabling radio personalities to broadcast their programs from the Museum; Scholars' Room, an Education Room for classes, a Gallery for exhibits, artifacts and documents and a Museum shop.

Fox Children's Network has announced the launch of Fox Kids Radio. Set to hit the airwaves May 8, 1994 the Fox Kids Radio will initially be a two-hour weekly countdown show designed specifically for children and teens and will be broadcast on Sundays in cities in the U.S. and selected markets overseas. The format of the show will consist of a weekly countdown of top-rated songs chosen by kids and co-hosted by Fox Children's Network personalities, along with entertainment and special interest segments featuring current topics and celebrity profiles of interest to children. The show will also be formatted so Fox TV affiliates can use it to promote their local Fox Children's programming. For more information contact Rod Riegel at (310) 203-3851.

LATE SHOW with DAVID LETTERMAN's Top 10 List will be available as an exclusive feature from CBS Radio as of Friday, April 1st. The three minute, 6 days a week feature will be distributed by CBS Radio Programs.

Tribune Entertainment Company announced its plans to launch an integrated multi-media country music programming initiative in the fall of 1994. Outlined are plans that begin with the launch of a weekly country music television and companion radio program called "The Road" to syndicate with the 1994-1995 season. Additional pay-per-view events, home video releases, state-of-the-art performance clubs, and concert tours are also on the agenda. The syndicated radio show will feature new less well-known artists whose voices miss the format of traditional country music stations. Unistar Radio Networks is introducing Acoustic Country, a series of 90-minute in-concert acoustic performances by today's leading country acts. Acoustic Country is available on an exchange basis to stations in the top 170 Arbitron-rated Metro markets.

Joyner, who collected over 7,000,000 frequent flier miles on American Airlines over the past eight years while commuting between his morning show on KKDA Dallas and his afternoon show on WGCI-FM Chicago, will be presented with First Class Seat 4A and the seat adjacent to it by officials of the airline. The retired seats will be installed in the studio so that Joyner can conduct his interviews in "first class comfort."

The Interep Radio Store has announced that it will "significantly expand" the Format and Demographic Network program it implemented in 1992 to generate new radio advertising sales revenue. Currently, Interep offers three unwired Format Networks for urban, country, and news-talk and a 12-24 Demographic Network. WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The NAB has stepped up to the plate to take on the way the NAACP believes the FCC should handle EEO requirements by opposing a petition for reconsideration filed by the NAACP against the new FCC fine schedule as it relates to EEO violations. The NAB believes "the NAACP Petition exhibits a fundamental misconception of the purpose of the FCC's EEO rules..." That misconception being that the FCC should establish a forfeiture schedule that is applicable to "every aspect of a licensee's employment practices."

A petition for reconsideration has been filed by the Evangelical Crusade of Fishers of Men, Inc. to reinstate the construction permit of WYGG Asbury Park, NJ. The CP was granted in 1988, but never built. It's license was cancelled last month.

The Commission has granted one-to-a-market rule waivers in two more duopoly transactions, this time in Seattle and Mobile-Pensacola. In Seattle, Fisher Broadcasting, which owns soft AC/talk KOMO-AM and KOMO-TV was allowed to purchase news/talk KVI and hot AC KPLZ. In Mobile-Pensacola, WKRG-TV, Inc., which owns news/talk WKRG-AM, AC WKRG-FM, and TV was given approval to buy AC and talk WCOA and urban AC WJLQ-FM from BREM Broadcasting.

The FCC issued an order that allowed KRXS Globe AZ to go ahead with its recently approved upgrade to a class C3. The Commission was waiting on approval for the Mexican government.

ELSEWHERE

SFX Broadcasting has announced its intent to purchase CHR WYHY Lebanon TN (Nashville) from Legacy Broadcasting for an undisclosed sum. SFX already owns country WSIX-FM there, and has been operating WYHY under an LMA agreement since late 1993.

Just up the road, Wicks Radio LP has announced it will buy the construction permit for WVXA Signal Mountain TN (Chattanooga) from Signal Mountain Radio Consolidation, Inc. No price was given. Wicks already owns news WLMX Rossville GA & AC-oldies WLMX-FM Rossville in that market.

Larry King isn't just for breakfast anymore! The Florida Department of Citrus has signed on Larry King as part of a huge multimedia marketing campaign to toot the benefits of drinking orange juice. Local market-tailored promotions will accompany the spots and will give away trips to Disney and Thermos mugs. The Promotion was launched February 14th and will continue for 26 weeks. This is similar to the deal recently signed with Rush Limbaugh.

American Public Radio announced that Philip Boroff of MARKETPLACE has been named deputy New York bureau chief of the APR business and economic program.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

In fines this week, Fairview's WBHT, Mountaintop PA (Wilkes Barre-Scranton) got hit for \$3,500 for airing a taped conversation without prior permission. KBAC Las Vegas NM, who's main studio location was outside their primary city-grade contour, lost an appeal to have their \$20,000 fine reduced. The station is marketing to Santa Fe NM, and has a translator there, but their city of license is a good 40 miles from the market.

Quetzal Bilingual Communications, which owns Spanish KURS Chula Vista CA, spent \$20,000 for not turning the power down after sunset. The Commission's San Diego office received an anonymous complaint which alleged that the management of KURS had instructed station personnel to reduce their operating power at sunset, but to increase the power back to the daytime level after the local FCC office in San Diego had closed for the day. The Commission then measured the nighttime power over the period of ten days, and found it to be approximately their authorized daytime power.

WCSP Crystal Springs MS, owned by Wesley College, had its license cancelled and call letters deleted at the college's request.

ELSEWHERE

It's always good to have a company store where your headquarters is based, but six? Cincinnati-based Jacor Communications has picked up soft AC WIMJ from Pathfinder Communications for \$9.5 million. WIMJ's AM sister, news/talk WCKY, was sold to Charles Reynolds, a local attorney who is currently in an SMA (Sales Marketing Agreement) with Jacor for his two other stations--adult standards WSAI and new rock WAQZ Milford OH. Jacor also owns WLW, WLWA, and WEBN-FM. This gives Jacor a 22.2 share of the market with their owned stations. When you add in the SMA stations, Jacor is selling a 25.0 share of the audience in Cincinnati. Although neither Jacor or Reynolds are talking about the prospect of Jacor including WCKY in the current SMA, the combined share of all seven stations is 30.0.

Classic Radio's KING-FM Seattle, which is owned by long-time Seattle patrons Patsy Bullitt Collins and Harriet Bullitt, will be donated soon to Seattle's Arts community. The commercial classical station will be run by a nonprofit corporation consisting of the Seattle Opera, the Seattle Symphony, and the Corporate Council for the Arts. The sisters will also establish a contingency fund in case the station falls short of its revenue needs. No changes in KING (AM)'s news/talk format are expected, but the station will be put on the block.

Opus Media Group has sealed a hold on the Jackson, MS market with announced plans to market 5 stations. Under the agreements with Holt Corp. and CSB Communications Opus will:

- * Complete the purchase of LMA partner WKXI-FM from CSB Communications.
- * Purchase WJMI 99.7's urban format and calls from Holt and move them to WTYX.
- * Purchase WOAD 1400's gospel format and calls from Holt and move them to WKXI.
- * Transfer WTYX 94.7's oldies format to 99.7, and form a SMA (Sales Marketing Agreement)
- * Transfer WKXI 1300's urban AC simulcast to 1400, and form a LMA.

In the end this will leave Holt selling and programming its LMA partner WZRZ and providing the programming for WTYX, Opus will sell the time and do the programming for the rest of the stations.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

The Boston Celtics have found a local buyer for WEEI. Back Bay Broadcasters, which already owns talker WARA Attleboro MA and churban WWKX Woonsocket RI (Providence), will begin an LMA with the station until the sale is consummated. Price was not disclosed. Back Bay plans to keep the currently sports line-up, but will spin off the Celtics play-by-play rights to American Radio Systems, which owns news-talkers WRKO and WHDH, and hot AC WBMX.

Progressive United Corp.'s KVKI AM & FM Shreveport will pick up two new sisters as they have purchased KITT and news/talk KEEL from Multimedia. With the sale, KITT flipped from AC to country. KVKI's former duopoly partner, oldies KLKL Benton LA, is now part of a duopoly with Gary Camp's gospel KOKA and urban AC KDKS.

Metroplex's news/talk WERE and classic rock WNCX have entered into an SMA (Sales Marketing Agreement) with Ardman's WENZ Cleveland. Metroplex also has a purchase option on the new rock outlet.

In the Portsmouth NH market, Knight Quality Stations, which owns album rock WHEB-FM, is buying WCQL-AM & FM for \$1.6 million. WCQL (AM) is currently sports talk; the FM is oldies.

The "Radio Ad Leasing Disclosure Act," the bill that will allow advertisers to run information about leases somewhere other than in their radio commercials, passed the Senate last week. The Act was "piggybacked" on the Community Development Banking Act. The House has already passed a similar bill. Now both bills go to a committee to resolve the differences.

Westwood One has announced the signing of controversial talk show host Tom Leykis. Leykis, who is currently at WRKO, Boston, is slated to do a new afternoon talk show this Spring. Westwood states that Leykis should not be seen as a replacement for Larry King, but rather "a different show targeted at a younger audience."

Billboard Data Systems is rolling out a new product that will allow home computer users to scan through Billboard's publications, charts, and other entertainment-related data. "Billboard Online" allows a user to request artist-specific information, as well as weekly chart information and articles. Users must buy the software to access the system, then pay a per-minute usage fee. The system is administered by Telescan, Inc. and managed by Billboard-owned BDS.

The NAB Convention: A First-timer's Perspective. By Jill Heller

I just flew in from Vegas and boy are my arms tired! Yes, its one of the oldest jokes but I am trying to recover from this year's NAB Convention. My first and hopefully not my last...So where to start? Let's try the informative sessions--from finding new employment to learning how to deal with duopolies to EEO law. The law session who's theme was "does the penalty fit the crime" covered EEO hiring practices, how to reduce your fines, and setting up a written station policy. Another law session included policy on promotions regarding casino gaming on Indian reservations. The one bit of advice given over and over: trust no one, check everything, and be EXTREMELY conservative when creating casino commercials.

Besides the sessions, it seemed over 90% of the visitors came to see the new products. Wandering around the expo floor one could purchase anything from Sports programming, neon signs, lightning protectors, and the latest in computerized programming. It's a whirlwind if you don't know what you're looking for. I will, however, give the dealers the Patience of the Year award for dealing with me and my "So, what's that?" and taking the time to explain it. I now can completely set up, run and restructure a radio station, prevent lightning from destroying it and can properly promote it--and that was just the first two rows! My advice to those who are to go next time: Chart a course. Don't wing it, there is too much and it can, at times, overwhelm you.

INNER CITY NOT IN WITH CITY'S MAYOR AS PURCHASE OF WOWO QUESTIONED. Inner City Broadcasting may have every good intention to keep clear channel WOWO Ft. Wayne intact after it purchases the station and its FM from Price Communications later this spring. But Ft. Wayne's mayor isn't buying it. According to the Ft. Wayne Journal-Gazette, Mayor Paul Helmke is "very concerned about the sale", as rumors have been flying this past week that the station may be signed off or change patterns to allow Inner City's New York station, WLIB, which is on the same frequency as WOWO, to broadcast after sunset. The Journal-Gazette also said Inner City has refused to comment on the sale and has gone so far as to inform inquisitive journalists that they "are unaware of a pending sale at this point," even though the paperwork has already been filed at the Commission.

CRESCENT SHOOTING STARS. Crescent Communications' KSOL San Mateo (San Francisco) has announced it will buy Viacom's Star 99 combo KSRY San Francisco and KSRI Santa Cruz. KSOL has entered into an immediate LMA with the stations and is now simulcasting its churban format on KSRI. A release from KSOL says that changes are in store for KSRY, as well. Rumor is it will begin a Spanish format. The two stations had been simulcasting KSRY's adult hits format.

Now that we've gotten at least a year's worth of the new duopoly rules under our belts, we thought you might like to see how much fun the brokers and attorneys are having. Here's a look at the last three years of different types of changes from the M Street Database:

Yes, Virginia, duopoly is good for brokers. Sales are up across all market sizes. More realistic prices, forced sales by bankers, and duopolies lead the charge. Format changes were driven by cost-cutting, duopolies, and Rush Limbaugh. Like format changes, call letter changes have been on a slight increase. Santa has granted Eddie Fritz' Christmas wish; for the third year in a row, there are fewer new stations.

Following the death of Roy Park, Park Broadcasting has announced it will sell the entire company, with much of the proceeds to benefit the Park Foundation, a non-profit organization. RBR pegs the value of the company at \$500 million.

The RAB reports that February national spot radio was up 20% and local radio revenue was up 10%. Year-to-date radio revenue is up 12% overall with local ad growth up 11% through February.

San Diego welcomes another duopoly as SFX Broadcasting's KJQY will buy KYXY from Parker Broadcasting for \$17 million. The combination of the two AC competitors adds up to a 9.1 share in the Fall '94 book.

ABC Radio Network's "Fly Jock" Tom Joyner, who each day commuted between his drive shows between Dallas and Chicago for eight years before joining the network, was upgraded to a seat on Air Force One this past week as he flew with President Clinton for an in-flight interview. Joyner, who was attending the National Association of Black-Owned Broadcasters convention in Washington, joined Clinton to discuss "the real issues facing Americans--drugs, housing, jobs, and of course, health care." Clinton was heading back to Dallas with his family to attend his brother's wedding.

The Interep Radio Store has released a new research report detailing the lifestyles and spending patterns of American households in the 90's called "Family and Household Diversity in the '90's". Some of the findings include: Only 27% of American households have at least one child under the age of 18 living at home, and the average age at which men marry for the first time has gone from 23.2 years in 1970 to 26.1 years in 1990. Similarly, women, are also getting married later: 20.8 years to 23.9 years. For your copy contact Sue LoCasto at 212-309-9021.

Arbitron concurred with the suggestions of the council to "pursue aggressively" new options for increasing response rates. The total redesign of the market report that you're so used to has been softened, and is now being termed as an "improvement" of the existing form. The Council also recommended that the company continue to promote its 70% sample increase to those markets that haven't yet signed up for it and modify the Council's representation to account for emerging formats.

In an already tight battle for program syndication to radio stations, Time Warner and Sony have decided to team up to promote new program offerings this fall. According to the Wall Street Journal, the new group will be called SW Networks and will offer both talk and music programming, as well as morning show fare.
