EEO COMPLIANCE, ROUND TWO... ended in a TKO of over two dozen stations for various violations. Stations were hit with heavy fines, reporting conditions, and in some cases, short-term renewals. Commissioner Quello issued a "sort-of" concurring statement urging "reform of the FCC's stepped-up enforcement scheme." "With extreme reluctance, I concur with these items," he said, and believes compliance could be encouraged more effectively through a three-step process that issues punishments with gradual severity. The complete list of stations and their punishments are on page 6.

FORUM CHANGES FORM The American Forum Network, a division of Business Radio Network, has unofficially merged its programming in with the BRN net. The change-over took place last Sunday, May 1. BRN had been simulcasting a good chunk of the day on Forum for two years. Forum, which was a hybrid of the Albany-based American Radio Network, was created out of the merger of ARN and BRN in 1990 and relocated to Colorado Springs. Most of the existing Forum affiliates have picked up the BRN affiliation.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

Last week, the FCC announced they've received the first of ten new "interference tracking vehicles" designed to find pirate stations and monitor the radio spectrum. What you may not have heard about these \$75,000 vehicles is all the neat electronics contained in the trunks of these cars, which include GPS receivers linked to a CD-ROM map of every street in the U.S. Once the monitor has locked on to a signal, the vehicle finds it way to the signal through a series of bearing lines displayed on one of two flat panel screens in the car. The computer also maintains a list of all licensed transmitters, and their frequencies.

ELSEWHERE

WCCC-AM & FM, Hartford's shock-jock Sebastian, whose morning show likens Howard Stern's, is being slapped with a sexual harrasment complaint after Sebastian insisted on repeatedly referring to the station's new traffic reporter by the size of her breasts. Angela Diana, a former Traffic Net reporter, refused to allow the reference, and alleges she had to eventually quit her job because the traffic service wouldn't back up her complaints. *M Street*: It's always nice to see a broadcaster promoting a good image of radio.

News/Talk format audience share showed the most growth as a format for the Winter '94 book according to a just-released study from Interep Research. Interep's new format tracking system, which uses format data from M Street, showed an increase to 15.7 share, up from a 15.3 for Fall '93. Country continues its strong 9.5 share and is ranked second, followed by urban, and adult contemporary.

In Dayton, Regent Broadcasting is doubling up with the purchase of rocker WZJX, Englewood, OH to combo with soft AC WLQT, Kettering, OH. The purchase from Miami Valley Comms. is valued at \$2.15 million. Regent also recently announced it is buying WDJX-AM & FM Louisville KY. Regent's first move: WZJX is now oldies.

John Dille's Pathfinder Communications is diversifying in the Grand Rapids market by purchasing easy listening WKEZ-FM, Holland, MI from the Walton Company. Price was not disclosed. Pathfinder has country outlets WCUZ-AM & FM Grand Rapids.

Group W has been granted a one-to-a-market waiver for its purchase of KKHI-AM & FM, San Francisco, CA, from Buckley Broadcasting. Group W owns KPIX-TV there.

The Director of Park Communications, Inc. announced the retention of Goldman Sachs Group L.P. as its financial advisor in connection with the sale of the company. There has been a long tie between the two companies. First when G-S took the company public in 1983, it handled its issuance of \$50 million in 1986 and now will stay on for the sale of almost 90% of the Park's shares of stock. From the sale, the bulk will go to the non-profit Park Foundation for grants to educational, charitable and cultural causes.

The Contemporary Christian Morningstar Radio Network has hired away morning man and syndicated personality Jon Rivers from KLTU Dallas TX. Rivers will take over as Vice President/Programming for Morningstar, as well as handle morning drive. Morningstar also announced that they will be relocating their headquarters from Houston to Nashville during the next 90 days.

As Neil Rogers leaves WSUN, Tampa, the station will replace him with the "Hooters Girls". Hooters is a popular restaurant chain through the South. According to RBR, Hooters poster girl Lynne Austin, as well as "B.L." and Julie Williams will take over the mid-day slot.

If you're looking for a new AC/jazz format, there's a brand new one to hit the bird from Knoxville-based Target Radio Satellite Networks. The format blends smooth jazz and new acoustic music with soft AC cross-over hits. The 24-hour format is available on a cash/barter basis by calling Andy Reeves at (800) THE-LYTE.

Arbitron announced that Seattle-Tacoma and Pittsburgh have qualified for the company's sample target increase plan effective with the Summer 1994 survey. The increase is for a 70 percent metro sample target increase by Spring 1996.

Billboard/Monitor has chosen the New York Hilton and Towers in mid-town Manhattan as the site for its Billboard/Airplay Monitor Seminar scheduled for September 8-10. The Seminar will feature sessions on chart methodologies, as well as format-specific discussions. Billboard's Radio Awards, which were moved away from the NAB Fall Show, will close the three-day session.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

With less than a month to turn in the Annual Employment Report station owners in LMA's are quite confused. Currently, the Commission says they want a list of the licensee's "employees". In theory this would exclude employees of anybody who LMAs a station. Inside Radio reports the law firm of Arent, Fox, Kinter, Plotkin and Kahn said "Conversations with...staff have yielded inconsistent advice, in some instances suggesting that the Commission may be seeking to impose a reporting obligation for employees of a time broker." The NAB filed a request for clarification. The filing asks for an interpretative ruling within the next ten days - or a delay in filing Form 395-B for stations in time brokerage deals.

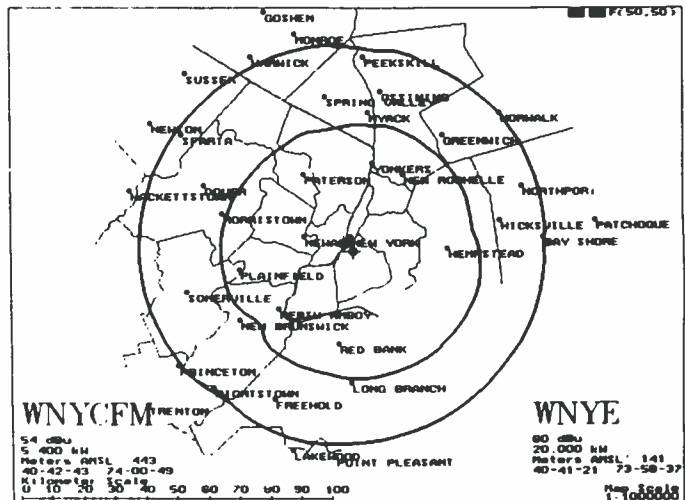
Three different organizations have asked the Commission for a declaratory ruling on Jacor's ability to operate joint sales agreements in Cincinnati with two stations. Jacor owns or has purchases pending for four other stations in the market. Susquehanna, Heritage Media, and The Dalton Group have attached the request to the proposed transfer of WIMJ Cincinnati from Pathfinder Communications to Jacor, and although it doesn't oppose the assignment of the station, asks the Commission to clarify its position on Jacor's existing SMA with WAQZ Milford, OH, and WSAI, Cincinnati, and children's WAHZ, Cincinnati. Jacor will own four stations in the market upon the transfer of WIMJ.

The NAB's President and CEO Edward O. Fritts stated in a April 29th letter to FCC Chairman Reed Hundt that the FCC could develop a more efficient emergency warning program that could offer potential net cost savings to broadcasters and others by taking advantage of recent developments. The proposed expansion of the NOAA Weather Radio System into an "all hazards" radio warning network was suggested to be an important factor. Mr. Fritts stressed the NAB's concern about the cost and its impact especially on small market stations. Amendment of "automation and unattended operation" rules was also suggested.

The Commission has revised form 316 (Application for Consent to Assignment of Broadcast Station Construction Permit or License or Transfer of Control of Corporation Holding Broadcast Station Construction Permit or License). The Commission will accept the old forms through June 30. Use of the revised FCC Form 316 will eliminate the need to file a separate FCC 155, Fee Processing Form. If you need forms, call (202) 632-FORM.

STATION TRADING

New York City Mayor Rudolph Giuliani has announced he intends to sell classical WNYC-FM in an effort to close the city's huge budget gap. M Street estimates the value of WNYC-FM at \$40-45 million. When sold, most of the station's classical and news programming would probably be moved to City School Board-owned WNYE, which currently programs some children's programming as well as world music. The city's WNYC-AM and WNYC-TV would not be affected by the sale. Although the transfer of the programming to WNYE would have a somewhat smaller listening area, it would certainly still be listenable in all five boroughs of the city. Infinity Broadcasting finally got a green light to purchase Cook-Inlet's WPGC-AM & FM, Morningside, MD (Washington DC), after they settled with the African American Business Association for \$2.75 million. Although Commissioner James Quello is reviewing the deal to make sure it complies with the FCC "Greenmail" rules, the settlement will go to fund minority businesses in the D.C. area. Some of the money will also go to fund "racial sensitivity" training for top executives.

EZ Communications gets big deal of the week honors as they're picking up urban WUSL Philadelphia and AC WTPX Miami from the court appointed receiver of TAK Communications for \$50 million. This will give them the urban franchise in Philly as they'll combo with WIOQ.

If you want to keep jazz on KJAZ Alameda (San Francisco), you'd better contribute to their listener fund drive soon. The station is trying to raise \$4.7 million to keep the station from going to Z-Spanish Network, who has the station under contract to be purchased for \$6 million.

Great Empire Broadcasting is rounding up the country franchise in Tulsa as they've announced they'll be buying hot country KCKI Tulsa from Boulder Broadcasting to couple with KVOO-AM & FM. They're in an LMA with the station until the sale closes.

MacDonald Broadcasting will have a duopoly in the Northwest Michigan market soon as they've announced plans to buy business news WMKT Traverse City and CHR WKHQ Charlevoix from A.J. Walker Communications for \$1.5 million. MacDonald owns standards and talk outlet WATT Cadillac and soft AC WLXV. MacDonald also owns nearby WMBN/WLXT Petoskey.

With all the talk of AccuRatings and Arbitron lately we thought you might like to see another new ratings service--A-R-M Actual Radio Measurement--from KBE in Albuquerque. A-R-M detects IF (intermediate frequency) coming from car radios. Detects are done at random from fixed locations that are changed every two hours. As A-R-M only does in-car listening and does not track demographics, a true comparison with Arbitron is not possible. We did think you would enjoy a fast look at how stations did in each survey for the Houston market. Arbitron measured from January 6 to March 20, 1994 with 3,055 diaries. A-R-M measured from March 7 to March 13 with 9,980 detects.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The NAB applauded the introduction of legislation that will set fair user fees for broadcasters who locate their tower sites on federal land. The original proposal hiked tower fees by more than 8000%. The new bill will only double plus some the typical broadcast fee. Although understood by both sides for the need for increased fees, James C. May, Executive VP/Government Relations stated that stations cannot support extreme proposals that would take away from broadcaster's vital programming services.

The beer and wine ad warning legislation will not go to a vote this year. Senator Strom Thurmond had pulled it from the Congressional agenda for this year due to insufficient votes to pass it. The NAB although happy about it are still urging broadcasters to continue their PSA in expectation that the legislation will come up again next year.

ELSEWHERE

In March (MSJ vol. 11, #12) we reported on a complicated move that would give Opus Media Group a sales lock on Jackson Mississippi's urban market.

Here is how it was supposed to happen:

- * Opus would complete the purchase of LMA partner WKXI-FM from CSB Communications.
- * Purchase WJMI 99.7's urban format and calls from Holt and move them to WTYX.
- * Purchase WOAD 1400's gospel format and calls from Holt and move them to WKXI.
- * Transfer WTYX 94.7's oldies format to 99.7, and form a SMA (Sales Marketing Agreement)
- * Transfer WKXI 1300's urban AC simulcast to 1400, and form a LMA.

What was not planned was the management of Holt's WJMI and WOAD linking up with New South Communications Frank Holladay and entering into an LMA with a purchase agreement for WWIN, a full signal FM on 98.7 (right next door to the soon-to-be former WJMI-99.7) and assuming Holt's former LMA of WZRZ 1590. WWIN changed to an urban format with WJMI's former staff and WZRZ became "Gospel 1590" with the old WOAD staff.

As Opus moves were predicated on the movement of "intellectual property," and part of that intangible is now working for New South, Opus has had to rethink its plans.

In the new plan, Opus will purchase WJMI and WOAD, keeping the formats in place on their present frequencies. Holt will purchase WTYX from Opus and keep the oldies format. Opus is presently the sales agent for WTYX, WKXI AM/FM, WJMI, and WOAD and will remain so.

Opus has filed suit in District Court against New South Communications, Inc. and Carl Haynes the former General Manager of WJMI. The Opus complaint, in part, is alleging New South and Haynes interfered with and diverted Opus advertising and employee contracts, and made false representations to station clients and listeners in order to create confusion as to the true identity of WWIN, WJMI, WOAD and WZRZ.

Frank Holladay, president of New South, said he knew of no improprieties and entered the Jackson market based on his belief in the staff and management of WWIN and WZRZ.

As Jackson leads the way in the development of Local Marketing Agreements it now appears it will lead the way in radio's next wave of "intellectual property" trading.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

The Arbitron Company and the Children's Satellite Network have released the results of a pilot study measuring children's radio listening. The study was held in the Minneapolis Metro area from October 7 to November 3, 1994 and measured the habits of 2-11 year olds (with parental assistance where necessary). The survey found the following: 91% of the children surveyed listen to the radio. Children spent an average of seven hours a week listening. Highest child listening hours are Monday-Friday 3:00 PM to 7:00 PM and Saturday-Sunday 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM. The study revealed that children listen to, in order of preference, were adult contemporary, CHR/top 40, AOR, country, children's format, oldies, news/talk, and other. The report indicates that children's listening is linked to adults' listening habits by the inclusion of older-skewing music formats. People in households with children 2-11 spent more of their time listening in the car during the average week than persons 12+ in the total population.

Westwood One is putting its feelers out for the infomercial market. In a fax to network affiliates, the web acknowledges discussions with several infomercial suppliers about buying time. In the fax, Westwood entices stations by asking if their interested in the "substantial income that might be generated by network-placed infomercials, and asks stations to fill in their 15- and 30-minute rates, as well as daypart information. There's no mention of how the network would keep track of how the station is credited with the resulting sales, or how the revenue might be split. If you're interested, call station relations at 703-413-8570.

Bonneville's news/talker combo in Seattle, KIRO-AM & FM, have announced they will buy talker KING (AM) from the Bullitt Sisters and will handle the advertising sales for KING-FM. Terms of the transaction were not disclosed. The Bullitt Sisters recently donated KING-FM to a local arts consortium.

Great American Communications is changing its name to "Citicasters." In a release, the new name is designed to "increase awareness...particularly among the financial community."

The migration continues as ABC Radio Networks will move even more of their operation to Dallas before the year's out, requiring them to find new space there. New York finance, MIS, research, and some affiliate positions will relocate. New York advertising and affiliate sales will move from the current West End Avenue office to midtown Manhattan, leaving only the News, Sports, and Engineering at the old address.

Broadcast Programming has begun shipping Chartbreakers Weekly Hit CDs. It contains the hottest new songs for CHR, AC, Country and AOR format stations including pre-produced "hooks" for each hit. Chartbreakers Weekly Hit CD is being offered for free for four weeks. For more information contact Broadcast Programming at (800) 426-9082 or fax (206) 441-6582.

The new Interep study "Exploding Myths About Household Incomes of Black Americans" notes that the average income of black households is \$25,000, the black market will increase 13% by the end of the decade and that blacks are heavy radio listeners with an urban format preference. INFINITY INDECENCY FINES HIT \$1.8 MILLION. Infinity Broadcasting was hit for another \$200,000 as the Commission found more excerpts of the Howard Stern show to be "patently offensive." This time, the complaint came from a listener of Stern affiliate WWKB Buffalo, but the station wasn't fined. The Notice of Apparent Liability names four Infinity-owned stations: WXRK New York, WJFK-FM Manassas VA (Washington DC), WYSP Philadelphia, and WJFK Baltimore, who all carry the program. At the same time, the Commission cleared the way for the sale of WPGC-AM & FM Morningside MD (Washington DC) to Infinity from Cook-Inlet Radio Partners.

HATTIESBURG COMBO SHUT DOWN BY U.S. MARSHALS. As of this week, listeners in the Laurel-Hattiesburg market are living without talker WHSY and rocker WHSY-FM Hattiesburg MS. After a couple of bankruptcy restraining orders expired, the station moved to chapter 7 bankruptcy, and signed off the air. To hear the station tell it, poor Arbitron numbers killed the station's revenue potential and forced the station to shut down. To hear the IRS tell it, the station didn't pay their payroll taxes.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Putting a person on the air without prior permission cost WMOG, Brunswick, GA \$5,000. The station called the principal of a local elementary school to get reaction to a news story involving the school. The principal was then transferred on to a live talk show, but wasn't informed he was on the air.

Broadcasters may have a shot at Small Business Administration loans soon. Currently, the SBA is prohibited from making government-backed loans to broadcast stations because of the "Opinion Molder" rules. If the repeal goes through, the NAB estimates that 90% of radio stations could be eligible for the loans. The repeal could happen as early as this fall.

A consortium of radio and television broadcasters and associations have filed an appeal brief with the federal appeals court in Washington DC in an attempt to overturn a lower court ruling that found the FCC's indecency procedures constitutional. The group argues that the Commission's procedures are unconstitutional because forfeiture proceedings lack prompt judicial review, as required by the constitution.

ELSEWHERE

Terry Robinson's Pourtales Holdings is strengthening its hold on the Mobile-Pensacola market by buying news/talk WKRG (AM), Mobile, AL and talker WCOA, Pensacola, FL, from Wes Diamond and an employee group in a two-step transaction. The first step has Diamond buying WKRG-AM & FM, Mobile, and WCOA/WWRO, Pensacola from WKRG-TV, Inc for \$4.46 million. Diamond will keep WKRG-FM and WWRO, and spin off the AM's to Robinson for \$1.5 million. Robinson will combo the two with oldies WAVH Mobile, and country combo WKST (AM) Prichard, AL, and WKST-FM, Mobile.

American Radio Systems will purchase another station in Boston, bringing the total it owns there to four. They're buying Curt Gowdy's rocker WCGY Lawrence, MA. Price was not disclosed. ARS already owns hot AC WBMX, talker WRKO, and news/talk WHDH. Plans are to sell WCCM, Laurel, MA, WCGY's sister, to a local group.

The Radio Advertising Bureau has announced a new membership rate structure that provides a more equitable system for determining dues based on the station's gross revenues, rather than on average unit rates. The new system, which has twelve revenue classifications, better accommodates duopoly and LMA situations by treating commonly-owned stations as a single entity.

The RAB's Radio Mercury Awards selection committee has announced the forty finalists for best radio commercials for the year. The 40 commercials come from the work of 32 advertising agencies and various production houses and radio stations around the country. The winners are vying for \$200,000 in cash prizes and will be announced at the Radio Mercury Awards on June 15th at the Waldorf-Astoria in New York. The Christian Research Report is reporting KLTU-FM Dallas, TX, has announced that Jon Rivers will stay in his current position of VP/Programming and AM Drive host instead of joining the Morningstar Radio Group.

Shadow Broadcast Services has signed Park Communications' WPAT-AM & FM, Patterson NJ (New York) for its morning news service. Shadow now claims 60 affiliates throughout the New York area.

American Public Radio's Saint Paul Sunday Morning show has topped the 200 affiliate station mark. The show, known for its chamber music and lively discussion, features Bill McGlaughlin, conductor of the Kansas City Orchestra.

CBS Radio Network announced the addition of a new daily business feature called "The New Economy." The show, hosted by Fortune magazine's new Managing Editor Walter Kiechel, will be one-minute long and replaces "Marshall Loeb on Business." Mr. Loeb will continue to anchor the daily show "Your Dollars."

SI Communications announced the tentative launch of "The Benjamin Chavis Commentary." The new show, said to debut the week of June 13th, will air six days a week and offers the thoughts and observations of Chavis, the Executive Director of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP). The program is a one minute commentary. Five minute commentaries for weekend broadcast are also available. For more information, contact Eva Lopez at (818) 501-0700.

**Where have all the POWERS gone?

Is it me, or are we in the radio business killing off AM radio in favor of the "bottom line?" As a passionate lover of the picture-free medium, I fear that what's really wrong with the radio business is that there's too much business and not enough radio.

Recently I read about Inner City Broadcasting in New York buying WOWO in Fort Wayne, IN. Perhaps it's because I grew up in the fringes of WOWO-land, (Indianapolis) and remember on-air legends like Jack Underwood, Jay Gould and Bob Seavers. Even KDKA's long-time favorite, John Cigna, perfected his warm style at the BIG 1190.

It looks to me as though Inner City wants this "Great American Radio Station" so they can castrate its powerful signal and open up a pathway for it's minority-formatted WLIB in New York to operate at night. Just what we needed...another AM in the Big Apple on at night. Few would argue that except for WFAN, WOR, WABC, WCBS, and WINS, all of the other AM's in New York combined equal a minuscule fraction of the total audience.

So, as one trade publication stated "If ya can't beat 'em...buy 'em." Now the only 1-B clear channel AM signal in the entire state of Indiana will have it's huge skywave severely cut back. The Hoosier state has only two 50,000 watt AM stations, the other being WIBC (1070), which is directional both day and night with six towers and reduced power at night.

In Detroit, a minority-owned news-talker on 1200 kHz, WCHB, has done something similar. Bell Broadcasting has a primo frequency but it's restricted (signal-wise) because of a 10,000 watt day-timer--WKNX at 1210 kHz in Saginaw--90 miles to the north. So they bought it. Why? To shut it down and expand coverage of their Detroit station on 1200 kHz. Only problem, WKNX has a respectable 4.6 share as an adult standards daytimer! So, speculation has the company looking to "relocate" the station from 1210 to 1250. The 1250 frequency is dark, and has been for about three years. It was last home to WXOX in nearby Bay City.

Is this a trend? Are we eating our young? Are we so concerned about the P & L columns that we have lost all of our feelings for the audience, the listeners, the people that we are supposed to be serving? Are there any radio people running radio? Is it all bankers, brokers and lawyers?

Over the last decade we have seen many heritage sets of call letters disappear...like: KHJ, WKBW, KWK, WNEW-AM, KOB, WCAU-AM and countless others. Often, great calls, when dropped, are picked up by small stations in communities not far from where the calls were once giants. Remember: WIFE, WIRE, WCFL, WAKY and KOGO? They all still exist...but in small markets. KOGO, a one-time San Diego monster, reappeared up the coast in Ventura on 1590 kHz. Now, in a rare move, the KKLQ (Q-106) owners have reclaimed the famous calls and have returned them to the powerful 600 kHz frequency which covers most of L.A. from San Diego, like a local!

Radio has survived everything it's ever encountered. As a kid who grew up in Indy, perhaps I should refer to all of this trading and exchanging as "WIFE-swapping." Stay tuned!
