WEST-IN OR IS IT IN-HOUSE? The Commission approved and the parties have closed on their applications to transfer control of Infinity Broadcasting Corp. to Westinghouse Electric Corp. related to conditional waivers of the broadcast multiple ownership rules, as well as applications to assign certain Infinity and Westinghouse radio stations to insulated trusts for six months. Mel Karmazin steps into the role of Chairman of the Radio division. The new broadcasting company has decided to keep its headquarters in New York City after speculation the company would relocate with the spin-off of the broadcasting division from the rest of Westinghouse. A new name and logo for the division is expected in February. More on page 12.

BONNEVILLE TRADES A LOT FOR A LITTLE . . . Entercom is strengthening its Seattle presence while adding four stations in Kansas City in a swap deal with Bonneville Communications. Bonneville will get Entercom's oldies KLDE, Houston and \$5 million cash for news-talk-sports KIRO, talker KIRO-FM and news KNWX in Seattle; and news-talk KMBZ, soft AC KLTH, talk KCMO, and oldies KCMO-FM serving Kansas City. Entercom already owns oldies combo KBSG, Auburn and KBSG-FM, Tacoma; progressive KMTT, Tacoma; and new rock KNDD, Seattle. Entercom is also in an LMA-to-buy with rocker KISW, Seattle. Paul Leonard of Star Media Group brokered the deal.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Bluestone Broadcaster's Inc.'s WMTD in Hinton, WV was granted a renewal of license despite being off the air since suspending operations in Jan. of 1993 as the result of the expiration of a long term lease on the station's transmitter/antenna site. The lease would not be renewed by the new owner of the property. The availability of sites was limited because the terrain is rugged and hilly and requires a relatively flat and clear site of no less than three acres for the operation of the station's AM antenna. Bluestone requested several temporary authorities to remain silent which were granted by the Commission. The most recent authority was denied in Feb. of 1996. In Nov. 1996, Bluestone requested an expedited special temporary authority to operate from a temporary antenna installation at a site less than .5 miles from its licensed site and a submitted a minor change application to move to a new site which was granted. The grant gives the station permission to commence construction but still has to return to the air by Feb. 8, 1997.

The Commission denied a request from Kenneth Ulbricht's, KSWB in Seaside, OR that a Notice of Apparent Liability for forfeiture in the amount of \$10,000 be rescinded. According to the Commission, Ulbricht violated Commission Rules by assuming control of the station without Commission authorization when an LMA between Ulbricht and "God's Ministry of Deliverance and Restoration" went into effect. The period of unauthorized transfer is slightly more than six months.

A permanent waiver of the one-to-a-market rule, was granted by the Commission for transfer of control of the licensee of WPRA(AM), Mayaguez, Puerto Rico, from WPRA, Inc. to Empresas Bechara, Inc. The application was unopposed. WPRA met the criteria required for the waiver, which included showing costs savings of operating WPRA(AM) with WOLE-TV/WKJB(AM)-FM in combo, remainder of a substantial number of competing media "voices" in the market and undue concentration of ownership of control of broadcast media will not be created by the combo.

License renewal applications for Progressive United Corp.'s KVKI-FM, KEEL(AM)/KITT(FM), Shreveport, LA were granted for a short term ending June 1, 2000, subject to reporting conditions and a Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture in the amount of \$30,000. The forfeiture was issued for failure to keep complete records, having deficient recruitment efforts and failure to engage in meaningful self-assessment of its EEO program. The Commission found no evidence of employment discrimination.

Walker County Communications, Inc., licensee of KSAM AM-FM, Huntsville, TX, and KTEM Radio, Inc., former licensee of KTEM(AM)/KPLE(FM), Temple, TX, sought reconsideration of forfeiture orders issued to them separately for violation of the Commission's EEO Rule for the license term that ended Aug. 1, 1990. The forfeitures of \$31,250 for Walker and \$25,000 for KTEM Radio remain unchanged.

The Commission denied Application for Review by The School Board of Indian River County, former permittee of WOAJ(FM), Vero Beach, FL, for reinstatement of WOAJ's construction permit and assignment of license to Moody Bible Institute. The School Board decided to spend school system funds on other projects but the Commission claims the obligation to timely construct WAOJ was not relieved by those decisions.

Twenty-One Sound Communications Inc.'s KFPS(AM), Salem, Missouri has its license canceled this week. Twenty-One was ordered to "show cause why the license should not be revoked" and voluntarily surrendered it's license.

The Commission granted Cox Radio, Inc. a temporary waiver to the one-to-a-market rule to permit the exchange of WYSY(FM) Aurora, IL and WCKG(FM) Elmwood Park, IL by Cox for WHOO(AM), WHTQ-FM and WMMO-FM, Orlando, owned by Infinity Holdings Corp. of Orlando. The grant is conditioned on the outcome of the FCC's ongoing rulemaking proceedings involving the one-to-a-market rule and the attribution of broadcast interests.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

Beginning Jan. 1, 1997, the new Emergency Alert System (EAS) replaced the old EBS for all broadcast stations. The new system replaced "only a test" messages with less obtrusive weekly tests and shorter, monthly, on-air tests. The EAS uses digital technology, developed by the National Weather Service, to distribute messages. Broadcast stations are only required to transmit the digital codes, test script, attention signal, and, for TV stations a visual message, once a month. The required weekly test only consists of the digital codes and should be less than 8 seconds in duration. The EAS requires monitoring of at least two independent sources of emergency information. The new system allows state and local officials to send specific state and local emergency information and it also recognizes the need to provide emergency information to people whose first language is not English. The EAS provides the option to permit new specially equipped consumer products, such as TVs, car radios, pagers and other devices to receive an EAS alert and warning. In effect, these newly designed devices will "turn themselves on" to receive and deliver this emergency information to audiences. It will also provide the President with a means to address the people in the event of a national emergency via broadcast stations, cable systems and participating satellite programmers. The Commission announced the appointment of Eric Jensen as new Deputy Director, Office of Communications Business Opportunities (OCBO). Jensen will be responsible for assisting the FCC's efforts to promote opportunities for small businesses. Jensen joins OCBO from the US Department of Commerce, where he served as Chief of the Legislative and Intergovernmental Affairs Division at the Minority Business Development Agency for three years. Eric Malinen was named Senior Legal Advisor of the OCBO. Malinen will oversee implementation of the program for compliance with the Small Business Regulatory Enforcement Fairness Act of 1996 which requires federal agencies to change their approach toward "final regulatory flexibility" analyses or certifications, which describe and explain steps taken by agencies to address small business concerns, as well as, general responsibility for wireless and common carrier issues. Malinen came to the FCC in 1988.

Several state broadcasters associations have come out in support of an NAB-sponsored proposal to collect annual regulatory fees based on the station's population served, rather than the current market size-based system. The Montana Association of Broadcasters first proposed the new system, which uses an actual count of people in a station's listening area. The state associations offering their support are Alabama, Arizona, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, New Hampshire, Pennsylvania, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming.

ELSEWHERE

Westinghouse and Infinity are officially one company. The merger is blessed with permanent waivers of the one-to-a-market rule for radio/TV combos in New York, LA, Chicago, Philadelphia, San Francisco, and Detroit. Temporary waivers were granted for New York, LA, Chicago, Philadelphia, San Francisco, Detroit, Boston, Washington DC and Baltimore, subject to the outcome in the pending television ownership rulemaking. The temporary 6-month waivers were modified by conditions that reflect the divestiture of WMMR(FM), in Philadelphia, and WBOS(FM) in Boston, pursuant to Westinghouse's settlement agreement with the Department of Justice. The Commission granted applications to assign the license of WSCR(AM), Chicago to Personal Achievement Radio; WYSY(FM), Aurora, IL to Spanish Broadcasting Systems, KTXQ-FM, Fort Worth and KRRW(FM), Dallas to WHFS, Inc., a subsidiary of SFX Broadcasting, Inc; KEWS(FM), Arlington, TX to Inspiration Media of Texas, a subsidiary of Salem Communications; and KDMM(AM) to Marcos Rodriguez, Inc. The transfers were opposed by the Ukrainian Congress Committee of America, Inc. (UCCA) and Spectrum Detroit, Inc. UCCA's petition primarily concerns an Oct. 1994 broadcast of "The Ugly Face of Freedom," an episode of "60 Minutes," which allegedly portrayed Ukrainians in an inaccurate and defamatory manner. Spectrum claims the waiver of the one-to-a-market rule does not fit the intent of the rule and should be granted sparingly and says the rule also causes minority owners, like itself, to face limited opportunity to achieve parity with owners like Westinghouse.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

American Radio Systems and Jacor are swapping stations to satisfy DOJ requirements for each company. Jacor is exchanging CHR WKRQ, Cincinnati for ARS' news-talk WHAM, news/talk/sports WHTK, and AC WVOR-FM, Rochester, NY. In addition, ARS will assign to Jacor an option to purchase new rock WNVE, South Bristol, NY (Rochester) from The Great Lakes Wireless Talking Machine, L.L.C. Simultaneously, in separate transactions, ARS is buying oldies WGRR, Hamilton, OH (Cincinnati) from the Dalton Group for \$30 million and WAQB, a construction permit in Brighton, NY from Brighton Broadcasting, L.P. for \$3.5 million. The Brighton station will serve the Rochester market. Bruce Houston of Blackburn & Co. was the broker on the Brighton purchase.

Heftel Broadcasting has acquired an option to buy Golden West Broadcasters' progressive KSCA, Los Angeles. The \$10 million option can be exercised upon payment of an additional \$102.5 million to Golden West. An LMA will begin immediately, which is expected to switch the format to some form of Spanish. Heftel was recently purchased by Clear Channel Communications. Heftel already owns Spanish talk KTNQ and Spanish soft AC KLVE, both Los Angeles.

Clear Channel is adding stations to its Milwaukee collection with the purchase of Chancellor Broadcasting's standards WOKY, Milwaukee and WMIL, Waukesha for \$40 million. The company already owns urban WKKV-FM, Racine. The purchase is subject to Chancellor successfully completing its acquisition of the stations from Colfax Communications.

Clear Channel Communications is buying up Osborn Communications' three stations serving the Ft. Myers market, bringing its total there to five. For \$11 million, Clear Channel will get standards WKII and country WFSN, Port Charlotte; and oldies WOLZ, Ft. Myers. Osborn will retain its non-voting interest in WDRR, Ft. Myers which is operated by Ruth Communications Corp. Clear Channel already owns 70's oldies WXRM, Naples Park and country WCKT, Lehigh Acres.

Capstar Broadcasting Partners is acquiring all eleven stations of Community Pacific Broadcasting Co. Terms weren't disclosed. Community's holdings include country KASH-AM and FM; classic rocker KBFX; and news-talk KENI, all Anchorage; religion KDMI, rocker KGGO, and country KHKI, all Des Moines; news-talk KFIV and AC KJSN, Modesto and classic rock KVFX, Mateca, CA serving Modesto; and news-talk KJAX, Stockton. The purchase will bring Capstar's group total to 70 stations. An LMA will begin soon. Community's CEO, David Benjamin, will run the stations under a newly-formed West Coast subsidiary of Capstar.

Nationwide Communications is picking up rocker KEGL, Fort Worth from Sandusky Radio in exchange for its Phoenix classic rock properties, KSLX-AM & FM, Scottsdale. The LMA begins this week. Nationwide already owns hot AC KDMX, Dallas. Sandusky holds sports KUKQ and rocker KUPD-FM, Tempe; and rocker KDKB, Mesa, AZ.

Citadel Communications is buying a third FM in Reno. It's getting silent KZSR from Larry Oakley for \$1.3 million. The LMA begins immediately. Citadel has news/talk KKOH and hot AC KNEV, Reno; and country KBUL, Carson City in the market.

Jacor Communications has filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission to raise \$250 million for working capital and acquisitions. The S-3 shelf registration will raise the cash through the sale of debt securities, convertible debt or equity securities, and common and/or preferred stock.

Premiere Radio Networks, Inc. has acquired After MidNite Entertainment, Inc. for \$9.2 million which consists of \$3.9 million in cash and 400,000 shares of Premiere's Class A Common Stock. If the stock falls to less than \$16,000, Premiere will pay additional consideration equal to the shortfall. Los Angeles based After MidNite Entertainment, Inc. produces the nightly After MidNite country music programming and provides other programming services.

Interep Research released a new report on the oldies radio format. 1987 marked a banner year for the emerging format and the number of oldies stations jumped from 350 to over 500 in one year. Major stations joined the switch and now, ten years later, the number of stations programming the format tops 700. The study shows over 20 million adults listen to oldies radio each week and it has the highest concentration of 25-54 listeners of any other format. True to Boomer statistics, oldies listeners are 30% more likely to have a college degree and 39% are more likely to be professionals. For more info, call (212) 916-0700.

FOR JACOR, NO MARKET IS TOO LARGE OR TOO SMALL. . . Jacor is busy again this week, picking up eight more stations in Ohio and Kentucky, and exercising a purchase option in Rochester, NY. In Kentucky, its buying dance WLKT, Lexington; AC WLRS, Louisville; and silent combo WLOC and WMCC, Munfordville, KY. All four stations are owned by companies controlled by Jim Champlin. Terms weren't disclosed. In Ohio, Lima Broadcasting is selling its four stations for an undisclosed amount. They are news/talk WIMA and country WIMT, Lima; oldies WBUK, Ft. Shawnee; and WLWZ, St. Mary's, which is not yet on the air. In Rochester, Jacor will pick up Great Lakes Wireless Talking Machine, L.L.C.'s new rocker WNVE, South Bristol, NY. Jacor received the purchase option from American Radio Systems in its recently-announced deal to swap stations in Cincinnati and Rochester.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Orion Communications', licensee of rocker WZLS, Biltmore Forest, NC, who has been forced by the FCC to give up control of the station because it built the new station without authority, changed call letters this week to WZRQ. The Commission awarded the station to a company who will operate the station until the Commission decides who will ultimately own the station. The interim operating company is made up of a group of original applicants for the station who were competing against Orion.

The Commission dismissed an application by Ladas Broadcasting Corp. for an experimental synchronous AM station at Lake Charles, LA to operate simultaneously with primary station KEZM facility at Sulphur, LA on same frequency, 1310 KHz, but with 40 w nights, ND.

The Commission amended its rules by adding a new subsection to its monetary forfeiture provisions to incorporate the inflation adjustment requirements contained in the Debt Collection Improvement Act enacted on April 26, 1996. The Act requires all federal agencies to adjust their civil monetary penalties for inflation no later than 180 days after the enactment and at least once every four years thereafter. The Act applies only to violations after Oct. 23, 1996 and prescribes that the inflation adjustment, calculated based on the formula outlined in the amendment, cannot exceed 10 percent of the statutory maximum amount.

Mario Loreda won the right to keep his CP for unbuilt station KQZD(FM) in Liberal, KS after he was ordered to show cause why the construction permit should not be revoked. Loreda mistakenly claimed to be a US citizen when he answered questions with respect to his citizenship on the assignment application back in early 1994. Loreda believed the question asked for the place of his legal residence, which has been the United States since 1970, not the country of his Citizenship which, at the time, was Mexico. As soon as the error was found, Loreda advised the Commission of the error and his intent to become a citizen of the US before he took control of the station. In December, 1995, Loreda became a US citizen and the Commission determined he had never operated a broadcast facility until that time. The Commission looked favorably upon the affirmative steps taken by Loreda to better serve the Liberal, KS Hispanic community.

Twenty One Sound Communications' KFPS in Salem MO's license was canceled and call letters were deleted. No reason was given for the cancelation.

ELSEWHERE

Mercury Broadcasting is cashing out on talker WWDB, Philadelphia. It will sell the station to Beasley Broadcast Group for \$65 million and will combine it with Spanish WTEL, country WXTU, black gospel/talker WDAS, and urban AC WDAS-FM. Mercury bought the station just over a year ago for approx. \$48 million. Peter Handy of Star Media Group brokered the deal.

Nationwide Communications is buying its second FM in Phoenix from Bonneville. Steve Berger will spend \$34 million for 70's oldies KHTC. Bonneville will keep its AM in the market, children's-programmed KIDR.

Pulitzer Broadcasting is expanding its radio holdings with the purchase of standards WAVG, Louisville from Sunnyside Communications for an undisclosed amount. Pulitzer owns CBS affiliate WLKY-TV, channel 32, in the market, and plans to launch a news/talk format on the station and change its call letters to WLKY. Pulitzer owns news-talker KTAR, and soft AC combo KMVP and KKLTV in Phoenix as well as seven other television stations.

Gulf Coast Radio Partners has decided to buy its LMA partners in the Biloxi-Gulfport market, as well as one other station there. For \$2 million, its buying gold-based AC WXLS and adult standards WXBD, Biloxi; classic rock WXRK, Gulfport; and CHR WXYK, Pascagoula from Southern Horizons Broadcasting Co., as well as rocker WCPR, Wiggins, MS from White Broadcasting Co. for \$1.6 million. Gulf Coast already owns country WXOR, Ocean Springs, MS.

American General Media is selling four stations in the Boise market, three of which it hasn't yet purchased. For \$8 million, it's selling silent station KCID-FM, as well as new rock KQXR, Payette ID; and standards KGEM, and classic rocker KJOT, Boise. Lartique Multimedia Systems is the buyer. American General's deal to buy KGEM, KJOT, and KQXR from Boise Viking Associates is still pending. Greg Merrill of Media Services Group represented American General Media in the deal.

Bob Bittner has purchased his third station. He's buying talker WJTO, Bath, ME, in the Portland market, for \$150,000 from Carl Strube's WJTO, Inc. Bittner owns easy listening combo WJIB, Cambridge, MA, which serves Boston, and WNEB, Worcester, MA. Mel Stone of Kozacko Media Services brokered the deal.

Robert Frisch's Mountain View Broadcasting is buying another station to combo with the three it holds in the Northeast. It's buying progressive WNBX, Lebanon, NH from Radio South Burlington for \$925,000. Frisch owns talk and sports WTSL, Hanover, NH, which also serves the Hanover/Lebanon market, as well as country WXXK-FM, Newport, NH and classic rock WXGL-FM, Topsham, ME, which serves Portland.

ABC Radio Networks debuted a new 24-hour format of John Douglas' "Personal Achievement Radio." Douglas has been running the service on his stations in Los Angeles and Seattle for several months. The programming service includes a lineup of many of the Nightingale-Conant authors and motivational speakers. For more info, call (972) 776-4644.

CBS Radio completes coverage of Campaign '96 with a schedule of reports on the Inauguration of President Bill Clinton on Jan. 20 and 21. WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The license renewal for H.I.C. Broadcasting, Inc.'s WHIC (AM) in Hardinsburg, KY was dismissed this week per the licensee's request.

An FCC correction in the proposed allotments of 99.1 A to Pangburn, AR and 93.7 C3 to Salida, CO, changes the comment filing period to on or before March 10, 1997, and replies on or before March 25, rather than the period January 27 and February 11, respectively as specified in the Commission's notice.

ELSEWHERE

Just a week after it announced a four station purchase in Boise, Lartique Multimedia Systems is buying three stations in the Twin Falls market. For an undisclosed amount, its picking up country KEZJ-FM, news/talk KLIX, and oldies KLIX-FM from B & B Broadcasting. Greg Merrill, Tom McKinley, and Austin Walsh of Media Services Group, Inc. brokered the purchase.

Roberts Radio, L.L.C. is buying another combo in Aberdeen, SD with the purchase of Green Bay Broadcasting Company's AC/sports KSDN and rock-CHR KSDN-FM. Roberts paid \$850,000 for the stations. The company is buying country/talk KKAA and oldies KQAA. Blackburn & Company brokered the deal.

After nine months of programming only the tune "I Heard it Through the Grapevine," KZZC, Tipton, CA, this week adopted the ABC-Pure Gold format. The programming change accompanied the sale of the station to Westcoast Broadcasting, owners of crosstown KJUG AM and FM. This stunt, one of the longest running in American radio history, kept the station on-air while its previous owner looked for a buyer. The format, which featured four versions of "Grapevine," attracted numerous listener phone calls but failed to show in the Visalia market Arbitron ratings.

Chancellor Broadcasting's WHTZ, Newark, NJ (New York) has dropped its "Lovephones" show, which aired from 10 pm to midnight with Dr. Judy Kuriansky. The show was syndicated by Westwood One, but there's no word on whether syndication will continue.

Athen's Broadcasting's WPZM(FM), Tullahoma, TN and WZYP(FM), Athens, AL were flagged for rating bias and distortion in the recently released Huntsville book. The stations distributed a promotional survey - the "Loyal Listener Report Card" - which instructs listeners to write down the start and stop times of their listening, and offers prizes based on the amount of claimed listening to the stations.

Sony's SW Networks announced the new on-air line-up for its 24-hour network, Classic FM with the addition of Fred Child as morning show host. He joins SW Networks from WNYC radio. In addition, Kaaren Hushagen will move to the 10 am to 3 pm slot and Dennis Elsas will take over 3 pm to 6 pm.

FCC IN NO RUSH TO RENEW LICENSES . . . The Commission has officially implemented eight-year renewal terms for all television and radio stations, with the exception of experimental broadcast station license terms, which will remain one year. The 1996 Telecommunications Act spelled out that terms "should not exceed eight years." The Commission adopted the language in the act, concluding that ordinarily granting broadcast licenses for that term, "was consistent with both past practice and the legislative history of the Telecom Act." This action also equalizes the term of radio and TV licenses which were previously seven and five years, respectively. The Commission will probably adopt the eight-year policy for FM and TV translators, low power TVs, and international stations, as well. All renewal grants after the regulations go into effect will be eight years, as well as all those applicants that file as part of the current renewal cycle.
