To commemorate this special year, RCA released important new product throughout the year including the unique 'Golden Celebration' album set which contains many rare and previously unreleased Elvis recordings. The Tim Rice/Abba project 'Chess' will remain a priority for RCA throughout 1985. The tremendous chart and sales response achieved already after just two months indicate the huge potential of the music from 'Chess'.

Important upcoming releases are, amongst others, Dire Straits - new album which will be supported by a worldwide tour April 85 - January 86 - Van Morrison, Martin Briley, Def Leppard, Berlin, Dio, Rush, Bon Jovi, Olivia Newton John, Elton John, INXS, Black Sabbath, Everly Brothers, Yello, Central Line, Kiss, Lindsey Buckingham, John Cougar Mellencamp.

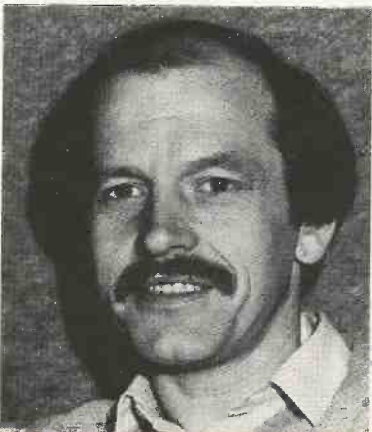
The Compact Disc will play an even more important role in 1985 and Phonogram Int. will give highest priority to simultaneous release with the conventional black disc and MC.

Although Richard Branson's new ventures such as his new Airline are getting continuous press attention, the record label deserves plenty of credit for a strong 84. There are now

The company has a lot of plans for the coming year. First of all, a lot of new bands are in the studio to record new material. The Blue Nile are recording their second album, China Crisis is in the studio with Walter Becker, Heaven 17 will soon be in the studio to work on new recordings, OMD will be recording a new album soon, just as the Simple Minds (they just released the main song to a new Universal movie Breakfast Club) and Scritti Politti. The Pale Fountains have just released a single called Jean's Not Happening and their second album will be out early February. Another album to look out for is Helen Terry's debut album on which she is currently working. Culture Club is taking a well-deserved break at the moment, their single Mistake No 3 is in the US Top 100 at the moment. The Eurythmics are continuing to have international success with their 1984 album and Malcolm McLaren Fans album, with its striking mixes of opera and pop has just been released and getting favourable reactions. Further to this, Julian Lennon continues to have international success with his Valotte album. Further new products include Mike Oldfield's album, the soundtrack to the David Puttnam film The Killing Fields, Julien Clerc just released an English language album and huge Paris shows are planned in April. More live dates coming from Telephone (spring), UB40 (more US dates planned and possibly after that Europe) and Sideway Look will have live dates in Germany in March and are at the moment recording their second album. New signings to watch out for in '85 are Dark City and Floy Joy.

STIFF

We at Stiff are all convinced that Kirsty MacColl will have a big hit with her single A New

England, which already entered the English charts. Composed by Billy Bragg, this tune was one of the critic's favourites on his debut album last year. At Kirsty's request, Billy wrote an additional verse especially for her version. Hopefully, Billy will be making an appearance in Kirsty's video. Last year was a busy one for Kirsty who also got married to producer, Steve Lillywhite (he produced this single) and they are expecting their first baby in February. Tracey Ullman releases her new single Terry on January 7th. You may remember that Terry was a minor hit for label-mate Kirsty MacColl last year. Kirsty wrote this song as well as Tracey's biggest hit They Don't Know. Terry is taken from Tracey's new album You Caught Me Out which is selling well both in the UK and the rest of Europe. A new video is almost completed and it looks as though it will be a classic. For the first few months of this year, Tracey will be filming two new TV series Girls

On Top and Faces Of Tracey.

The Pogues are planning some European dates in February and March with a new single or EP planned for release to coincide with the tour.

Billy Connolly releases the theme tune to a new tv series on Stiff at the beginning of February.

The single and title of the new series is Supergran. Billy is to appear in the series as well as singing the title song and the B-side will feature a humorous monologue which is sure to be in demand from his fans.

Jamie Rae has finished recording some songs with Ace producer Alan Tarney (well known for his work with Cliff Richard and more recently, he has produced a new album for David Cassidy) We will be releasing a new single called Pretty One in early February. It's a smash! We expect an album in the spring. The Mint Juleps are still recording their debut album for Stiff. We have also recently signed young American singer/songwriter Louise

Goffin (daughter of Carol King And Gerry Goffin) and are currently looking for a producer for her.

Yes Let's will shortly start recording their debut album for spring release with Clive Langer (of Madness fame) and will undertake an extensive college and club tour of the UK during the next few months with some European dates planned for May and June. We expect some Belle Stars demos soon from the three remaining Bellies and hopefully, something from Jona Lewie if he ever gets the hang of his 48-track studio which he has had built at his house...

EMI CAPITOL

To be able to boast a year which saw such tremendous hits from the likes of Tina Turner, David Bowie and John Waite, the ever popular Diana Ross and Joe Cocker, to name but a few, would seem to be success enough. But 1984 saw the emerge of sizable international interest both from public and media for artist like Peter Wolf, the body rocking Maria Vidal, hell raising W.A.S.P. and new comers Queensryche and Corey Hart.

Adding new dimension to EMI's already diverse look in 1985 is the launch of its New York based Manhattan label, which lists luminaries as Tania Maria and Stanley Jordan. Making further inroads in 1985 will be the impressive talents of Dalbello and new signing Grace Jones and kicking off the year, the refreshing sounds of Jason and the Scorchers, all set to overtake the achievement of 1984.

ARIOLA/ARISTA GROUP

Major releases for the first quarter from Arista US are: A new album from the Alan Parsons Project - Vulture Culture set for release on Feb 14 preceded by a single - Don't Talk About Me in January. Dionne Warwick has a brand new album released on February 1 - Without Your Love and a self titled single is already available. 2 of Arista's major artists will be appearing at

Midem - Ray Parker who'll have a new single 'I've been digging you' and a greatest hits package Chartbusters, released in February. Jermaine Jackson will also be at Midem and Europe will be releasing his US hit - Do What You Do to follow his smash hit with Pia Zadora - When The Rain Begins To Fall. Arista US will be launching a major new signing to the label and their first new female artist for some time - Whitney Houston, a cousin of Dionne's. Her debut album will be How Will I Know followed by an album in March. Air Supply are working on their new album for release in March or April with UK producer Peter Collins. Arista UK, as well as continuing Meat Loaf, will have new releases from Nick Heyward, who will have a new album in February. February will also see the return to the music business of 70's idol David Cassidy. David quit the business at the height of his fame after a hectic world tour amid hysterical scenes. Now at the age of 32 he feels the time is right to return. His debut single - The Last Kiss, will be released on February 1st and followed by an album in March. The single and album were produced in London by Alan Tarney and features contributions from, a.o. George Michael of Wham!

New signings The One O'clock Gang release their new single Innocent in February followed by their debut album Trigger Happy in March. They'll also be a new album from Shriekback plus debut albums from Thomas Leer and The Engine Room.

The major release for the first half of the year will be a brand new album from The Thompson Twins, currently being recorded in Paris release in May. This will be followed by a world wide tour.

Meat Loaf, currently in Koblenz, Germany doing a TV show despite having an ear infection. He'll jet straight back to the U.S. afterwards to re-cuperate before embarking on another string of UK dates which have been added due to public demand. He is currently lining up European dates in March.

Currently in Europe on promotion are: Ray Parker Jr, Jermaine Jackson and Dionne Warwick.

ISLAND

With acts like Frankie Goes To Hollywood and U2 the label can look back on a successful musical year. Several new projects are planned for '85 including established artists as well as upcoming new artists. First of all artist/producer Hupert Hine is releasing an album end of January called The Wildest Wish To Fly. Frankie Goes To Hollywood is currently in the studio with Trevor Horn to record new material. New ZTT signing is Anne Pigalle who will come up with an album; and Propaganda will have material released in April. Trevor Horn will undoubtedly add another success to his impressive producer's career, with the production for the new Grace Jones album, called Slave To The Rhythm. Island's pride Robert Palmer just finished an interesting project with the Taylor boys, Andy, Roger and John of Duran Duran. They asked Robert to join them in for some vocal parts for their new album for EMI. The cooperation was so

successful that a lot of Palmer songs were recorded on this album. Palmer will also come up with his own album somewhere in '85. Pop/jazz formation Animal Nightlife will be in Philadelphia for a couple of months to record new product. New act Blue In Heaven will come up with a new album and new hopes for '85 include Eugene Wilde and Cashmere. It is further to be expected that artists like Steve Winwood, Marianne Faithfull, Galaxy, The Waterboys and Amazulu will come up with new material in the course of '85. After two albums for WEA, John Martyn is back on his old label Island with an album called Sapphire and to support this album, John will tour extensively throughout Europe. Exciting plans exist to persuade Tom Waits to come over to Europe. We'll keep our fingers crossed.

WEA

Obviously Prince was Warner's biggest success in '84. The label further reached remarkable sales with Chaka Khan, Van Halen, ZZ Top, Sheila E. and Rod Stewart. Affiliated labels like Elektra, Atlantic and Sire achieved gold and platinum records with acts like The Cars, Laura Branigan, Phil Collins, Yes and Madonna. Local WEA products reaching international success include of course Alphaville, Howard Jones, The Pretenders, Matt Bianco and Everything But The Girl. For '85 a lot of exciting new projects are planned. After nine years the legend John Fogerty returns to the music business with a new album called Centerfield. The single The Old Man Down The Road is already picking up responses all over Europe. Further upcoming products include George Benson's latest 20/20, Phil Collins' new album No Jacket Required, the single Sussudio already climbing up the European charts. Emmylou Harris' new album The Ballad Of Sally Rose and a solo record from Van Halen's singer David Lee Roth, the four-song EP called Crazy From The Heat. Atlantic will come up with a very special project very soon called The Firm, consisting of ex-Free and Bad Company singer Paul Rodgers, and Led Zeppelin guitarist Jimmy Page. Further upcoming WEA products

include the Soundtrack Paris Texas by Ry Gooder, new albums by the Australian bands Rose Tattoo (Sudden Stars) and Angel City (Two Minute Warning).

CBS

The most successful artist for CBS in '84 was of course Julio Iglesias, who sold with his latest 1100 Bel Air Place 5,000,000 copies worldwide. For those of you who will attend Midem, it is perhaps a nice idea to make a stop in Paris to see Julio perform. Later on this year he will have albums released in Spanish and French and at the end of the year another new English album will be out. Alison Moyet had a very good 1984 and will undoubtedly continue her success in '85, her solo debut Alf sold one million copies in the UK alone. Discovery of the year is Sade, her unique mix of soul and jazz elements sold three million copies worldwide last year. Other successful artists include Cyndi Lauper, Wham!, Nena etc.

One of the most exciting new releases in '85 will undoubtedly be Mick Jagger's solo album which is scheduled for a February release, entitled She's The Boss. The first single drawn from the album will be released end of January and is called Just One Night. Artists appearing on the album will be a.o. Pete Townshend and Jeff Beck. Bill Laswell (Material), Herbie Hancock and Nile Rogers will be producing this album of the Stones front man. In the fall a new album is expected from The Rolling Stones, they will start their recordings in Paris in spring. March will also see the release of the long delayed second album of Paul Young (The Secret Of Association) and an album by Jeff Beck (Get Working). Other important releases include Santana (Beyond Appearances), ELO (Face The Music), Third World (Sense Of Purpose) and Flash & The Pan (Early Morning Wake Up). Two Dutch

bands who were able to score abroad, Fox The Fox and Time Bandits will have albums released this month called The Dark Of The Night and Friction. Other Euro-Crossover artists with new albums include Nena (new album out in the spring), Art Company (an English album will be released somewhere in '85), Nina Hagen (In Ecstasy) and Spanish artist Ivan who currently has a hit with Fotonovela in France and Belgium will release a solo album with a mix of Spanish, English and Italian songs.

Toto is quite successful at the moment with their latest album Isolation and the Soundtrack for the film Dune (though for another label). Nothing confirmed yet, but plans are in progress to have Bruce Springsteen come over to Europe. Leonard Cohen who just had an album out called Various Positions is touring Europe at the moment. For the heavy metal fans an interesting project will be released later on this year. An album called New Gladiators including artists like Quiet Riot, Pretty Maiden, Trust and Kick Axe will be released and this package tour will also have shows on the road.

Geffen artist Don Henley who has been quite successful lately with the single *The Boys From Summer* from his latest solo album *Building The Perfect Beast* will come on a promo tour through Europe. Much is expected from John Hiatt's latest album *Warming Up To The Ice Age* where on one track John is assisted by Elvis Costello. Two other Geffen releases later on this year include Eric Carmen and the Soundtrack of *The Cotton Club*. Ex Ph.D. singer Jim Diamond is still very successful around Europe with his first solo single *I Should Have Known Better*. His album *Double Crossed* is planned for February. Former Supertramp member Roger Hodgson is having a lot of success with his album *The Eye Of The Storm*, the album is now for more than 3 months charted in France, Germany, Spain and Switzerland. Other A&M acts to look out for in '85 are Joan Armatrading's new album *Secret Secrets*, it will be released the first week of February and she will do a European tour the whole month of March. Bryan Adams is currently on tour with Tina Turner, this tour will last from February 19th till April 15th. At the moment his *Reckless* album is platinum in the USA and last but certainly not least, Sting will come up with a solo album in the near future. CBS artist performing at the Midem include Ivan, Art Company, Fox The Fox, Peter & Sicane and Paul Young.

MOTOWN

Financially speaking 1984 was the most successful year in Motown's history. Motown licensed with RCA throughout all of Europe with the exception of Italy (where RCA is licensed to Dischi Ricordi) and the successes of Stevie Wonder and Lionel Richie speak for themselves. Exciting things are expected to happen with the Commodores coming to Europe. To replace Lionel Richie, they have a new lead singer called J.D. Nicholas and to coincide with the tour, an album called *Nightshift* will be released. The tour starts in February 8th and lasts until March 12th. Dates will be played in the UK, Holland and Germany. Motown discovery Sam Harris, who is still quite unknown in Europe will do a promo tour through UK, Germany, France and after that to the San Remo Festival in Italy. January releases include along with the Commodores a new Rockwell album (*Captured*), the new DeBarge and the new Mary Jane Girls album. February sees the release of the Motion Picture Soundtrack *The Last Dragon*, the film features Vanity. Albums to look forward to and due in the first 6 months of '85 are those of Stevie Wonder (*In A Square Circle*) and Lionel Richie. Other new releases include Rick James, Dennis Edwards, Michael Lovesmith and Smokey Robinson.

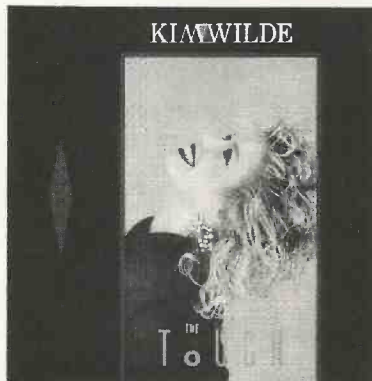
MCA RECORDS

1984 was a busy year for MCA and one that saw the start of an exclusive licensing

agreement with WEA throughout the territories of Europe. MCA's new association with WEA was already resulted in major successes for Nik Kershaw and Kim Wilde in most countries and we look forward to an exciting 1985. At the beginning of 1985 we are pleased to welcome WEA's affiliated companies in Scandinavia who took over our catalogue on January 1st. Nik Kershaw has already achieved gold albums in Norway and Denmark and his European tour which commences on February 1st in Copenhagen takes him in all the Scandinavian countries. Kim Wilde has just released *The Touch*, her second single from *Teases And Dares* and it has already been selected as Veronica's record of the week in Holland. As well as consolidating our two major artists throughout Europe (both incidentally are touring: Nik in February/March and Kim in March) our other major releases for 1985 include *Southern Accent*, the long awaited studio album from Tom Petty & The Heartbreakers, the launch of ex-Dollar star Theresa Bazaar's first album for the label (produced by Arif Mardin), the introduction to an important UK signing Big Sound Authority, the Soundtrack album from the record *Breaking*, Beverly Hills Cop (already the fifth biggest grossing film of all time in the USA) featuring Glenn Frey and Patti Labelle who are both major MCA artists with albums this year and last but not least the first album on MCA from the legendary Boston. Priority artists with product already available include platinum acts, New Edition and The Fixx, Dan Hartman, Night Ranger, The Fixx and Guiffria and every effort will be made to break these artists in the year ahead. Dan Hartman kicks off the new year with a major promotion tour which takes in TV's in Holland (where he currently had his second hit single with *We Are The Young*), Germany, Luxembourg, France, Spain, Italy and Sweden. New albums are due in the fourth quarter from Nik and Kim making 1985 a year to reckon with as far as MCA are concerned!

POLYDOR

Zoolook is not necessarily the new look but it is the project uppermost in the minds of those at Polydor International at the turn of the year. Jean-Michel Jarre's new album was released in November and had enormous impact straight away. It bears the well-known Jarre stamp of innovation and the "12" of the title

track *Zoolook* is being released with its own video and a second single is planned before the summer. Another "12" release in January will be *Black Cars* from Gino Vannelli's excellent new album, his first one on the Polydor label. Another priority release from a leading name on the roster will be the eagerly awaited Bryan Ferry solo LP in mid-March. Final mixing is taken place in New York now and details of the album and first single due in late February can be expected soon. *Perfect Strangers* was the end product of the

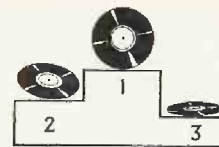
widely applauded reunion of the rock kings Deep Purple. Following hard on the heels of the release the group began the first stage of a world tour in Australia and New Zealand. They'll arrive in Europe mid- May with one or two dates per country starting in Portugal and ending in the U.K. Rumour has it that 2 or 3 other well-established acts will be part of the package. Meanwhile a second single *Knocking At Your Backdoor* will come out in March/April. The early months of the year will also see releases from Europe's favourite lady of rock Gianna Nannini with her new LP *Tutto Live* and the UK's leading jazz funk band Shakatak with live recordings from their monumentally successful Japanese tour.

One of 1984's highlights was *Breakin'*, both film and soundtrack were setting new records and now fast behind it comes the sequel *Electric Boogaloo* featuring more terrific dancing and music from the stars of *Breakin'* 1. The first single in Europe is Carol Lynn Townes' *Believe In The Beat* and she's appearing in several major TV shows at the beginning of February to promote the song. There is interest from a TV channel to produce a special on Carol and Africa Bambaataa about breakdance music. The second single will be Ollie & Jerry's *Electric Boogaloo*. There's a lot of recording activity at the moment. Robin Gibb is aiming at a pre-summer release with his next album, the *Style Council* and *Siouxsie & The Banshees* are releasing in April and new albums are expected from *Headpins* and *Ian Matthews* (produced by *The Quick*) in March. Saga, hard at work in Switzerland, hope to have an LP out in April. Producers Peter Walsh (Peter Gabriel, *Simple Minds*) and David Foster (Tubes, Chicago) are working with the band. After a two month US tour, Saga will be in Europe for dates at outdoor festivals in the summer and a major tour in September. European tours are also planned by *Killing Joke* from 15th February to co-incide with release of their Chris Kimsey produced album *Legacy* and *Southside Johnny & The Dukers* (Germany and France) in February. Their next LP is due in September. Amongst forthcoming debut releases on Polydor are names both old and new. Mink DeVille are in the States writing and recording for a new album in the summer and artists/songwriters *Mondo Rock*, a band which already made recording history in home country Australia, are preparing their first release aimed at making a well-deserved international breakthrough. Trevor Walters follows up his UK Top 10 single *Stuck On You* with an LP entitled *Super Love* in March and in February Richard Thompson, whose solo LP *Hands Of Kindness* was very successful, brings out a first album on Polydor. The Reddings, a talented threesome from the States (2 sons and a nephew of the legendary Otis Redding) release their soul funk album *Parasite* in March.

CRYSLIS

Chrysalis releases for early '85 will include the following a lot of new product. New signing Go West will have their first single and debut album out in February. The first album and new single from the *Colourfield* (led by ex-Fun Boy Three Terry Hall and produced by Hugh Jones) has just been released and so is *The Adventures* debut album. Further upcoming product comes from new signing *Refugee* with an album entitled *Affairs In Babylon*, Irish group *Les Enfants* (produced by Hugh Jones) will have first product out, and the first album from *Wreckless Eric's* new band *Captains Of Industry* on the *Go! Discs* label will see light in the near future. In addition there will be a second single from Pat Benatar's *Tropico* album as a follow-up to the international hit *We Belong* and the second single from *Sylvester's* *M 1015* album (an Ian Levine remix of *Heaven*) on the *Cool Tempo* label and a new EP from *Go! Discs'* *Billy Bragg* are planned.

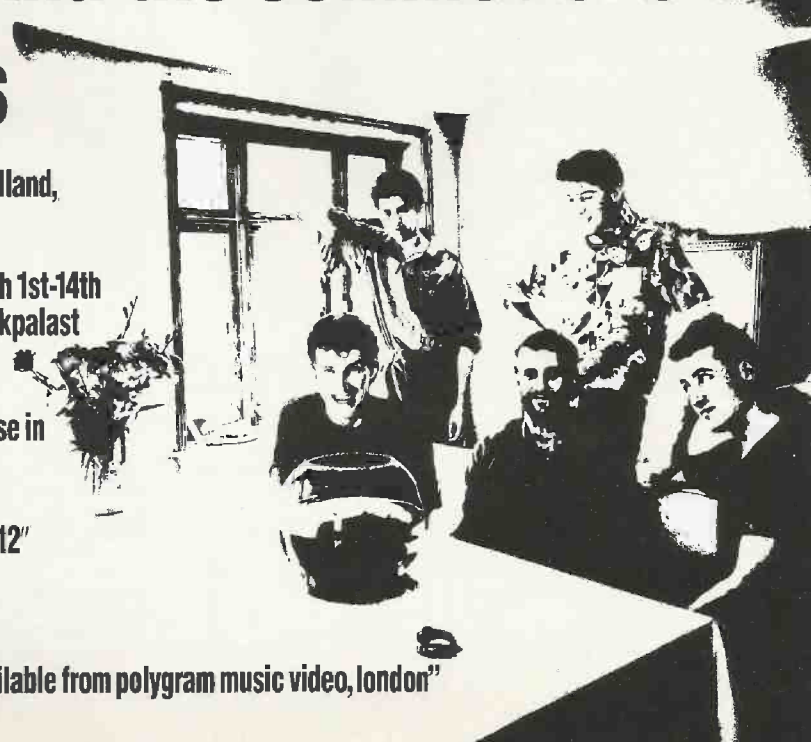

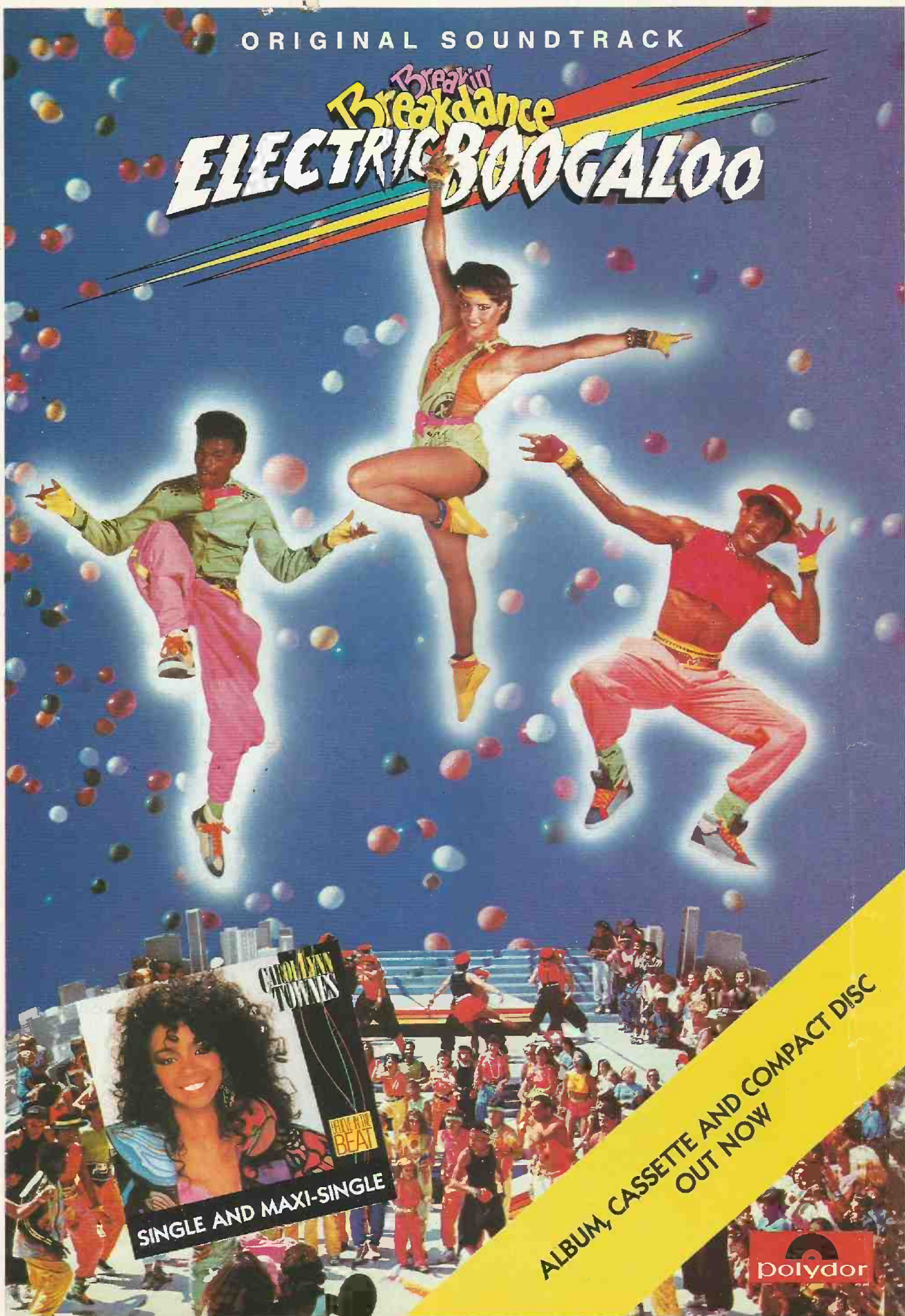

Against 'the rule' the single was released in the middle of the summer, it caught on immediately with the retailshops and with the help of both strong airplay and TV exposure the

Peter played the main part in the French Rock Opera La Revolution Francaise, performed on the million seller single Goldorak (very popular TV cartoon series over here) and last but not least he sang the signature tune in Claude Lelouch's highly successful film Les Uns Et Les Autres (music written by Francis Lai and Michel Legrand (see the connection?). Peter and Sloane met, signed with Deesse Disques, recorded this song together and the rest is history ... They will be performing at the televised Gala at Midem.

Worldstar in the truest sense of the word JULIO IGLESIAS opens the concert season with a series of concerts in the Rex Theatre and for the first time top Saturday Evening TV Variety Show Champs Elysees dedicated the whole programme to him and his career from his first international appearance during Eurovision Songcontest in Holland of 1970 until today.

Furthermore French singer/violinist CATHERINE LARA and cultstar CHARLELIE COUTURE will be filling concert halls this month and popsinger SHEILA will present her new show at the beginning of February.

MICK JAGGER is in town with his fellow Rolling Stones to record their new album and he's taking the opportunity while on the Continent to promote his upcoming solo album She's The Boss. Last week President Francois Mitterrand confirmed his promise to liberate the TV network for independent TV Channels, for which requests have been placed by Gaumont, Fox/Hachette, Mayor of Paris Jacques Chirac, radiostations NRJ and 95.2 and many more. Mitterrand explained in a formal press conference the politics concerned, also with regards to the existing 3 national channels and their future programming, satellite plans etc.

As with the Independent Radio Stations this new setup will change the whole TV network considerably. I will keep you posted on further developments.

RADIO GUIDE

We will stop complaining about not receiving enough new singles. Looking at the pile of product that is pouring in this week, there is no doubt that the season of hot releases has started now.

There is new product available from the Eurythmics, entitled Julia (new at 39 in the European Airplay this week), a beautiful atmospheric ballad from their 1984 album; Van Halen's lead singer David Lee Roth surprised us a bit with his version of Brian Wilson's California Girls, not quite what we expected, though very cheerful and light-hearted; Chaka Khan releases the second single from her I Feel For You album entitled This Is My Night (now at no 42 in the European Airplay this week). While the continent is still very keen on Jim Diamond's I Should Have Known Better, England released a follow-up already called I Sleep Alone At Night, a beauty!; Kirsty MacColl releases her first record for nearly a year with her version of Billy Bragg's A New England. Her husband Steve Lillywhite produced the single. Labelmate Tracey Ullman releases her follow-up to Helpless, called Terry, penned by (again) Kirsty MacColl; Brazilian composer/producer Deodato is picking up a lot of airplay in Europe at the moment with his disco tune S.O.S. Fire In The Sky (pay attention to the special 12" Disarmamix); Chris De Burgh releases another soft ballad with Moonlight And Vodka; new at 43 you'll find Dolly Parton's We Used To. Holland is very fond of Dolly and

it looks like they are repeating the success of last year (You Are was released only in Holland and stayed for weeks at no 1). Other new product include Jack Wagner (All I Need); Eurogliders (Heaven); Shalamar (Amnesia); and Big Country's new single Just A Shadow. And don't forget to check out George Benson's latest 20/20, a medium tempo track with a nice combined vocal/guitarline on the end.

SIMILAR FOLLOW-UPS

We are not surprised finding Phil Collins' new single Sussudio high in our European Airplay Top 50. The last few days the tips that came in for this funky tune were enormous. The single went straight in at no. 12, followed closely by Don Henley at no. 14. Another high entry for Neutron Dance by The Pointer Sisters (from the forthcoming Beverly Hills Cop Soundtrack). Bob Geldof's Initiative Band Aid is getting similar follow-ups in other countries, A Day For Africa is the cooperation between German artists like Bap, Udo Lindenberg, Spliff, Nena, Trio, Peter Maffay, etc. (32 in total) gathering money for Ethiopia; another project with Boney M., Barclay James Harvest, Trio, Raff and Angelo Branduardi working under the collective name of Frank Farian's Corporation is just on the market as well (and rumour has it that Stevie Wonder plays for this project as well.)

Close readers of the Euro-Crossover list will see that we recommend two new singles this week. Italian band Raggio Di Luna (Moon Ray) come up with a single with a true European sound, entitled Comanchero. The single is

already charted in Germany and Italy. Not only because of 'the good cause' but the above mentioned Frank Farian's Corporation (with their rendition of the Paul Simon penned Mother And Child Reunion) has enough catchy appeal to chart elsewhere in Europe.

APPARENTLY

What Prince couldn't accomplish with his 3rd European single I Would Die 4 U (only 2 weeks in our European charts), seems now to happen with the re-release of the double A-sided single 1999/Little Red Corvette, it is this week highest entry in the European Singles Chart. Another remarkable re-release in the UK this week is James Ingram's cooperation with Michael McDonald, the 1983 hit Ya Mo B There (new at 71 this week). It doesn't happen too often, but this week a long established American band is no 1 in the UK. Apparently the English couldn't resist the impact of Foreigner's love ballad. Three European crossover records are making big jumps this week, Dutch band The Limit are moving up to 37 due to the UK and Holland, Spanish artist Ivan moves up to 74 due to Belgium and France and singer Amii Stewart is breaking in the UK at the moment (single was a hit in Italy some three months ago). Upward movement is to be seen this week for the Chess project in all the European listings. Elaine Page's I Know Him So Well is one of the biggest movers in the European Singles chart, the album itself moves up 10 places (and is at a no 17), while Murray Head is no 1 in the European Airplay!

ABOUT THE CHARTS

With kind assistance from many industry organizations in the European countries EUROTIPSHEET is able to present every week the only EUROPEAN TOP 100 purely based on sales.

In many European countries one chart is recognized by the music industry as the "official" hitparade and is therefore used for the compilation of the EUROPEAN TOP 100. However there are other countries where

various charts are in existence and often equally important. For these countries E.M.R. is compiling a number of these national charts into one, representing the sales in that market. Each chart position for every country then receives, relevant to their position, an equal points rating which is in turn multiplied by a factor determined through the latest known sales percentage of total singles (or albums) sales which that country holds in relation to the rest of Europe. There are different percentages for singles and albums. It obviously means that the major sales territories like the U.K., France and Germany have an important impact in our charts. Statistical curves are provided with the help of a number of industry organizations such as Gallup in the U.K. For the EUROPEAN TOP 100 SINGLES we are using 26 charts from 16 countries. For the EUROPEAN TOP 100 ALBUMS 21 charts are used from the same countries. Since the sales percentages of a few countries are too small to get their hits into our TOP 100 (provided these records are not charted in any other territory), we are also printing a TOP 3 IN EUROPE list each week.

The EUROPEAN AIRPLAY TOP 50 is compiled through all our correspondents tips received in the week of publication. Records of the week receive extra points. The airplay lists of the media control organizations in some of the European countries are also used in the calculations, as well as playlists from the major radio stations.

The EUROCLIPS list is a rotation chart of music videos which are most broadcast in Europe in the week of publication. All in all more than 50 of the most important European television programs, which are showing videos, are included in the circulations.

ACCEPT NO ALTERNATIVE !

There are a few other so-called European Hitparades around. But they are not based on sales figures from 16 countries! They are not presented on more than 40 European Radio Stations; They donot use full national hitparades, but only parts; They are not using

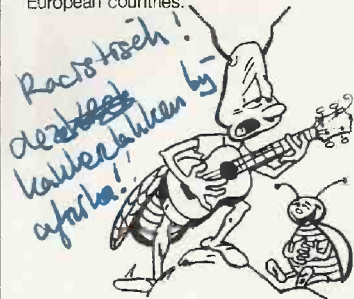
the same weighting system; they are not using a combination of national charts in those countries where one hitparade is not giving a real sales picture; they are not showing country codes from all 16 participating countries...so DO NOT ACCEPT ANY ALTERNATIVES !! If you want to know more details please do not hesitate to ask us.

THE RISE OF COMPACT DISC

In 1984 Compact Discs really made a great impact. We expect CD to be an even more important factor in 1985 and Eurotipsheet will start to spotlight on CD in the near future. There are other trade publications pointing at the retail of CD. We will be talking mainly about the programming aspect of CD. There are already a number of progressive European radio stations with special CD programs and no doubt there will be more added in the coming months.

MUSIC FOR AFRICA

When Bob Geldof initiated the Band Aid project with the Top UK pop acts joined together in an extremely successful production in aid of the fund against hunger in Africa, he didn't expect the record to generate such vast amounts of dollars. And apart from that he also started a trend with many countries following with their own music campaigns against hunger. This deserves the total backing of all media people. ZDF television in Germany is preparing a European television show in February to be broadcast all over the world and includes an enormous number of international top acts. The most important German national pop and rock bands have combined their efforts in yet another support record released on CBS under the name of "A day for Africa". And there are more of such projects underway in most of the other European countries.

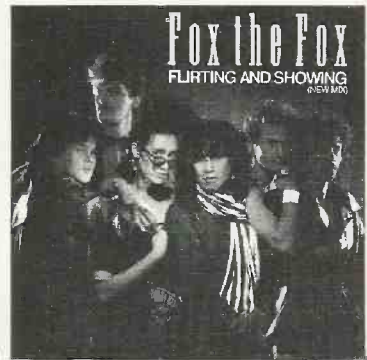

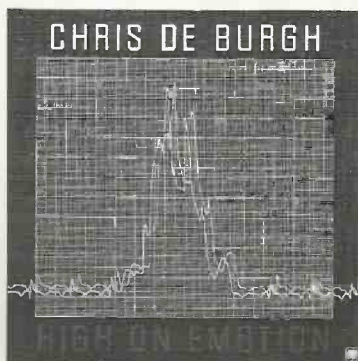

 used for the compilation of the EUROPEAN TOP 100. However
 there are other countries where various charts are in existence
 and often equally important. For these countries we have
 compiled a number of these charts into one representing the
 sales in that market.
 Each chart position for every country then receives, relevant to
 that position, an equal points rating which is in turn multiplied
 by a factor determined through the latest known sales
 percentage of total singles (or album) sales which that country
 holds in relation to the rest of Europe. There are different
 percentages for singles and albums. These figures are kindly
 provided on a regular basis by the industry-organisations such
 as IFPI (BPI-Gallup-Deutsche Phonoverband etc. For the
 EUROPEAN TOP 100 SINGLES 25 charts are used from 16
 countries, for the EUROPEAN TOP 100 ALBUMS 20 charts
 are used from 15 countries. Since the sales percentages of a
 few countries are too small to get their hits into the
 EUROPEAN TOP 100 (provided these records are not charted
 in any other territory), we are also pinning a TOP 3 IN EUROPE
 list each week.
 The EUROPEAN AIRPLAY TOP 50 is compiled through all our
 correspondents tips received this week. (Records of the week
 receive extra points. The airplay lists of the airplay report
 organizations within some of the European countries are also
 used in the calculations, as well as playlists of major radio
 stations. (Please note that not all received tips appear in
 Eurotipsheet but they are all used for the calculation of the
 Airplay Top 50.
 THE EUROCLIPS LIST shows the music-videos most aired on
 television throughout Europe in the week prior to publication. It
 includes video-t.v.programs and other t.v.shows partly using
 video's from 14 European countries.

HIGH MUSICAL HOPES FOR 1985 !

This year will see many-media changes. After a few years of bad economics in the record industry, the past Christmas period has been very good for the major companies. Especially in the big countries like the USA and the UK sales have surpassed those of the previous year and we can state for sure that the music business is not going to die. Many problems are still there and it is harder than ever to look into the future of European media as well as the music that will flourish.

This is Eurotipsheet's first Midem and we reserve space for most of the major labels to tell us about their hopes and plans for 1985.

Music is here to stay and no doubt we will see many hits in '85. However, uncertainty remains over the way the artists will be best presented to the European public. National radio and television channels are slowly waking up to the challenge of fighting the new technology of satellite tv, satellite radio, cable programs etc. etc. Until recently Europe was well divided-media wise- and each country had its own system and its own stations. Since a few years they are challenged by multi national sound and image carriers of which satellite tv has the biggest impact so far. Video programs from Musicbox and Sky Channel are competing for good audience ratings. A number of European countries are extending their cable operation and without any doubt the European audience will have more channels to choose from in the coming year.

SATELLITE AND CABLE RADIO

One area which was quite silent so far, but which will become much more active in the future is satellite and cable radio. With the international giants fighting over the satellite- and cable tv channels, the many extra possibilities for radio signals have not been filled in at all. However, there are signs that in '85 a number of international organizations will be filling these radio channels up. The direct broadcast satellite (D.B.S.) will have more of an impact and therefore changes for new artists, new videos, new sounds will grow. The quality of recording becomes an even more important factor with the rise of compact discs continuing to become more penetrating. Although this gives big changes for producers of both audio and visual it will also be a catalyst as only the best quality will survive. In the last months of 1984 it already became apparent that tv programs just showing videos are losing impact and therefore the broadcasting organizations are streamlining their programs which are becoming more sophisticated and often mingled with a more live atmosphere. The record industry is glad that at least in some major territories sales have not declined too much again and although in 1985 there will be lots of rumours, deals which have to do with mergers, we still hope that the experts will continue their attention on new artists and A&R people with even greater enthusiasm.

Musically 1984 certainly was a great year with lots of new acts emerging and older acts returning to the foreground. 1984 was the year of Prince (as much as '83 was Michael Jackson's) but apart from the whole Prince entourage, the year also provided a number of other major international stars. It was a great time for UK act Frankie Goes To Hollywood as well as the combined efforts for Wham! and George Michael. The combination of pop and jazz sounds proved to be commercially very successful with CBS' Sade as the best selling new artist, but with plenty of others gaining their hits from this same kind of 'cool' pop like Matt Bianco. Some of the older artists were doing terrific business, with Stevie Wonder winning his biggest hit ever and Tina Turner surprising everyone with an incredible come back. But there were more, like The Cars, Mike Oldfield, Lionel Richie and good old Elton John surpassing any expectations. 1984 also was the year of continuation for such biggies like Bruce Springsteen while The Jacksons, although with a much criticized tour, still sold very big quantities. European radio played a very important role in breaking English acts like Nik Kershaw and Howard Jones to stardom. Atlantic's Laura Branigan continued to record covers of European songs and made it to no 1 with Self Control. Europe played an important musical role in the world, not only with songs but certainly also with artists of which German Nena and Alphaville were on top but the champion of them all, no doubt, was Spanish Julio Iglesias.

There are number of artists that already had an excellent record of success in 1984 but who are already about to surpass their previous sales in 1985. Phil Collins, who had a no 1 hit on the European Top 100 with Against All Odds (see separate photo), is releasing his 3rd solo album this month, backed by a 6 months and 5 continents world tour. Sire's Madonna is Top 3 in Europe now with Like A Virgin and will be even bigger in the new year. CBS UK act Alison Moyet already scored some hits during the 2nd part of '84; her album will reach gold and platinum status practically all over the world in this year. Kim Wilde changed labels but it looks like her hits for the new label as scored in the last months of the past year will lead her into a great '85. American band Foreigner has never been as big as now in Europe and are backing it up with promotion which undoubtedly will make their new album an enormous seller. CBS can rightly have big expectations for the first Mick Jagger solo album to be released soon. It remains interesting to see how the good start for Julian Lennon will be continued and whether he will be able to become a world star in his own right. These are just a few of the hopes of '85. Let's see what some of the major labels are planning for us in the near future.

RCA

Key RCA releases in early 1985 include new studio albums from Eurythmics, Pointer Sisters, Slade, Rick Springfield, Dolly Parton and Jo Boxers. Concert and promotion tours from all of these artists are currently under negotiation for 1985.

Following the very successful first year of RCA/Motown partnership in Europe with massive chart and sales success for both new and well-established Motown stars, the prospects for 1985 look even brighter: new albums from Stevie Wonder, Lionel Richie, Rockwell and The Commodores and exciting new products from rising artists including Dazz Band,
