Enter the Dragon: Capital on \$55m expansion trail

LONDON — Radio formats for everyone “from the cradle to the grave.”

That’s the concept behind this week’s £34 million (\$55m) expansion of U.K. broadcast group Capital Radio. Group programme director Richard Park outlined Capital’s strategy this week, as the group moved to acquire London alternative rock station

Xfm, and Red Dragon Radio, which operates two stations servicing South Wales.

In a deal which was announced as M&M went to press, the Capital group acquired Red Dragon Radio from Emap Radio for £18.25 million (\$29.6). The broadcaster runs CHR/rock service Red Dragon FM and gold broadcaster Touch AM; both are based in Cardiff, covering the city and its environs.

BRUSSELS — Irish siblings The Corrs are the latest act confirmed as performing live at this year’s IFPI Platinum Europe awards ceremony in Brussels on July 9.

They will join Danish pop quartet Aqua and another—yet to be confirmed—live act at Brussels’ Albert Hall during a ceremony in which the president of the European Commission, Jacques Santer, will personally present 12 European artists with platinum Europe awards in recognition of album sales in multiples of one million units across Europe.

NRJ joins music business

PARIS — NRJ is set to become the first major radio company in France to enter the business of music production.

The broadcaster is to launch its own record label in September. “For the past 18 months, we have received a lot of proposals from indies and majors to jointly exploit some titles or albums,” says NRJ group programming director Christophe



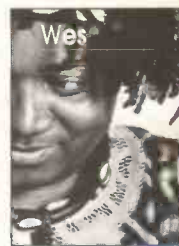
Sabot, who will head up the new division. “So far, we have always refused, but we think that now is the right time to do it.”

Many basic details—such as a distribution deal—are still to be worked out before the label’s September launch. However, it is understood that the scope of the label will echo NRJ’s pan-European radio activities in Belgium, Germany and Scandinavia.

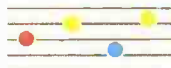

Upfront

So, by a mere \$200 million, North America has overtaken Europe as the world's biggest music market. Big deal.

Looking back on last week's IFPI world figures, it's hard to believe that Europe—which sells more or less the same quantities of records but at a higher wholesale price than North America—could have been outsold, as those statistics seemed to show. Currency fluctuations are probably responsible for Europe's slide, and those discrepancies will certainly come to an end once Europe shifts to a single currency.

But that's a mere detail. The real point is that the European market is almost stagnant. A four percent overall growth in value is proof that the music industry is not in Olympian shape, and that has far more crucial implications than losing the top slot.

Expenditure per capita on pre-recorded music is lower in every single European country than in the U.S. That is where the potential growth is—getting people to buy more records, and getting more people to buy records.

Getting people to buy more records will certainly require some pricing flexibility (and why not resuscitate that old French idea of lowering the VAT rate on records?) and also more artistic and marketing creativity. For its own benefit, the music industry has to get its hands on consumers'

money which otherwise would be invested in different cultural goods. To achieve that, it has to make its output attractive again (something it currently lacks), offer excitement to young consumers (more Spice Girls?), and deliver good music (a more subjective issue...).

Last week, Sony Music Entertainment Europe president Paul Russell rightly pointed out during the IFPI presentation that the music industry also needs to find new consumers. Easier said than done, undoubtedly, but let's face it, what has the industry as a whole done in recent years to bring new consumers to record stores?

Imagination has not been the main virtue of the music industry over the past 15 years or so, busy as it was recycling old analogue masters in digital form. But two recent events should offer food for thought to industry leaders—Bocelli and *Titanic*. Both the Italian tenor and James Horner's soundtrack have scored far beyond the natural reach of the genre they originate from.

Undoubtedly, removed from the streams of fashion, those phenomena have caught consumers' attention, and most certainly the attention of consumers who rarely buy music. This unconventional success is living proof that the industry can still deliver attractive platters without recycling old recipes.



New structure for Sony France

PARIS — Sony Music France CEO Paul-René Albertini has set up a new management structure aimed at giving the company more flexibility.

"Since 1994," Albertini explains, "Sony Music France's market share has increased from 20 to 25 percent; our pyramid organisation was no longer able to react quickly to changes in the market." Albertini has split the company's management into three operational and decision-making groups "to co-ordinate the strategies of the labels."

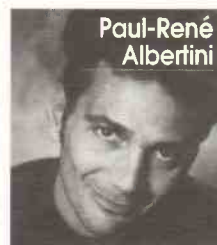
The new management groups will cover all Sony imprints in the spheres of strategy/management, marketing and A&R, and will sit as an extra layer of management on top of the existing label organisation.

The management group is to be

headed by Jean-Claude Gastineau (currently senior VP, Sony Music France and Senior VP, Sony Music Europe), the marketing group by Olivier Montfort (Columbia MD and Sony Music deputy MD), and the A&R group by Philippe Désindes, currently MD of the SMALL imprint.

Albertini says Désindes' brief is to create a more homogeneous A&R policy throughout the labels. "At the moment, there are some genres that we don't cover, such as rap, while at the same time, we sometimes have three or four labels devoted to the same type of music.

"[Desindes] is there to make sure that we cover all the artistic niches,

but he is not Sony France's A&R man—that would make no sense."

Both Montfort and Désindes, who retain their responsibilities at their respective labels, are made senior VPs of the company; sales manager Jean-François Loury becomes Sony Music France deputy general manager.

Changes have also been made at Sony France's LTC/Tristar and Epic imprints. The Epic management team of Christophe Lamegnière and Caroline Diament has been split up, with Diament joining LTC-Tristar as general manager and Lamegnière staying as Epic's sole general manager. LTC/Tristar chief executive Luigi Théo Calabrese will extend his input to Epic, "assisting" Lamegnière on the label's marketing strategy.

programming, AC commercial broadcaster Radio 1's stations in Oslo, Bergen, Stavanger and Trondheim have begun doing so. Jebesen—ex-head of music at Radio 1 Stavanger—has been appointed the embryonic network's music director.

Q: With the Norwegian syndication law in mind, what kind of music programming challenges

do you currently face?

A: I don't make many musical compromises, but I listen closely to what the heads of music in Trondheim and Bergen say. Radio 1 Trondheim is musically closer to P4 [national, AC] while Radio 1 Bergen is more similar to P3 [national, CHR]. Therefore, I don't schedule the syndicated shows with the local markets in mind.

I recommend the local heads of music develop their own music scheduling procedures which strengthen the local profile during morning and afternoon drive shows.

Q: In which ways do you expect Radio 1 to grow in the future?

A: By attracting more female listeners, because they're under-represented in our listener base. We've recently been conducting local audience research in Oslo to find out what their musical preferences are. We

have also done a positioning study to find out how a number of stations are perceived. There weren't many surprises: females aged over 25 like music with a slower tempo, and don't have preferences in terms of male or female artists. They tend, however, to be more critical of female presenters than men are of male presenters.

Q: How would you describe Radio 1's position in the market?

A: We probably lacked some focus until a couple of years ago. The Radio 1 group encompassed many more stations than now, and they each had different music styles. We weren't perceived as being one group of stations. Therefore, we changed our philosophy to concentrate only on the bigger cities and on urban, affluent listeners in the 22-37 age group. That's where our core strength at Radio 1 in Oslo lies.

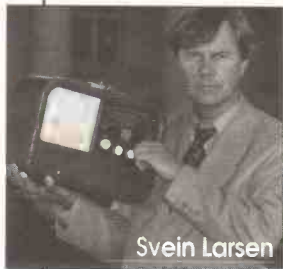

BERLIN-BRANDENBURG MERGER REJECTED

BERLIN — The Mayor of Berlin, Eberhard Diepgen, has ruled out a merger of neighbouring public broadcasters Ostdeutscher Rundfunk Brandenburg (ORB) and Sender Freies Berlin (SFB). Diepgen was responding to a recent proposal to that effect by national broadcasting umbrella body ARD, comprised of Germany's regional (state) broadcasters. ORB and SFB have already undertaken a number of joint ventures together, including the CHR network Fritz, rock/gold service Radio Eins and classical/jazz Radio Kultur. ORB director Hansjürgen Rosenbauer expressed disappointment at Diepgen's comments.

P4 MOVES INTO HUNGARY

BUDAPEST — Norwegian commercial AC network P4 has bought Hungarian classical broadcaster Radio M, which holds radio licences in Budapest and Erd. Radio M Classic will re-launch in Budapest under its new owners on May 13, and will be syndicated to the city of Erd from June. The estimated potential audience in both cities is 2.1 million. Says P4

president Svein Larsen: "This is P4's first positioning in central Europe, which constitutes a very interesting radio advertising market. We don't expect good results overnight, but it's essential to get involved right now if you want to be a part of this [future] growth."

POLYGRAM RAISES RUSSIAN STAKE

MOSCOW — PolyGram has increased its stake in its Russian subsidiary from 51 to 90 percent. It follows the acquisition of additional equity from its local joint venture partner Boris Zosimov, who moves from chairman to non-executive chairman of PolyGram Russia following his recent appointment as chairman and general manager of MTV Russia (M&M, April 18). Meanwhile, Giedrius Klimkevicius joins PolyGram Russia from Lithuanian label/distribution company Bomba as managing director; financial controller David Junk is promoted to vice-president, finance and administration.

MOBO SEEKS FRESH TALENT

LONDON — The organisers of the 1998 MOBO (Music of Black Origin) awards, to be held in London later this year, are looking for demo-tape entries for this year's Best Unsigned Act award, sponsored by clothing company Diesel. The categories are jazz, R&B, hip hop, dance reggae, jungle and gospel, and three of the entries will perform live in September at the official MOBO awards press conference. MOVING CHAIRS

NEW YORK — Thomas D. Mottola has been promoted to president and chief executive of Sony Music Entertainment—he has been president and chief operating officer since 1993. A statement from Sony Corporation president Nobuyuki Idei says: "The new title recognises Mr. Mottola's contributions to establishing Sony Music Entertainment as a leading entertainment company, and reflects his current broad responsibilities overseeing the company's operations."

MADRID — Javier González Ferrari, director of Spanish public broadcaster RNE since May 1996, has been appointed director of news services at parent corporation RTVE. His successor at RNE is expected to be named shortly.

PARIS — Sony Music France veteran Jean-Claude Gastineau has been appointed senior vice-president of Sony Music Europe, effective May 1. He will remain vice-president of Sony Music France, which he joined in 1971 (when it was CBS Records) as sales director.

London's breakfasts get sexy

LONDON — Listening is sexy again—and the figures prove it.

Breakfast radio in London provided a healthy start to 1998 for commercial radio's mainstream music broadcasters, according to first quarter official RAJAR ratings.

The combined breakfast shows of rock station Virgin Radio, AC outlet Heart 106.2 and market leader 95.8 Capital FM (CHR) added a average weekly total of about 500,000 new London listeners between 6:30-10:00 compared to the previous quarter, according to a breakdown of the figures.

About half of those listeners tuned in to Chris Tarrant's breakfast show on Capital FM during January 5-March 29. Tarrant's average weekly audience for the first quarter was well over two million.

Chris Evans' breakfast show on Virgin 105.8 FM in London pulled in 172,000 new morning listeners, reaching a total weekly London audience of 777,000. "People definitely see radio as sexy again," says Evans. He also says an increase in breakfast time listening has benefits for the rest of the day. "Before we were seeing a significant drop off after 10:00. That is starting to reverse," he says.

At Heart 106.2, the arrival of former Virgin Radio breakfast

presenter Jonathan Coleman to the breakfast slot helped attract a further 38,000 listeners to that daypart. Both Heart (with a 5.4 percent share) and, for the first time this quarter, Virgin FM/AM in London (5.8 percent share) are now ahead of oldies station 1548 AM Capital Gold in terms of both reach and share, although Capital Gold's share was also up this quarter, to 5.2 percent.

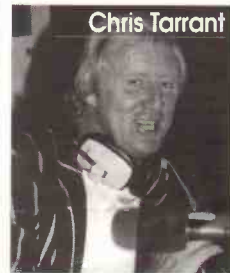
The rise in breakfast-time listening to London music stations has been, to some extent, at the expense of news/talk services and the BBC's national public CHR station BBC Radio 1. The network's Kevin Greening/Zoe Ball breakfast show lost 73,000 listeners in the capital.

The increase in London breakfast listening, as well as

the well-documented increase in overall radio listening in the U.K. during the last two quarters, has been attributed to a renewed awareness of radio as a

medium. This has been partly the result of extensive press coverage; stations like Capital and Heart also mounted comprehensive marketing campaigns over the period.

Nationally, MOR/AC network BBC Radio 2 reached its highest weekly audience (9 million) in two years, and increased its share of listening to 13.2 percent, the highest of any U.K. national station. But sister station Radio 1 has been overtaken by the BBC's talk-oriented local outlets for the first time, as its market share dipped to 9.4 percent from 9.9 percent.

New Swedish dance steps

STOCKHOLM — This year's Swedish Dance Music Awards displayed the new face of Sweden's dance music industry.

The Swedish "Eurodance" artists who broke export records in the early '90s have made way for music which is—so far—proving more popular on dance-floor than in record stores.

House/techno duo Antiloop (Stockholm Records) walked away with four of the nine awards—Best House/Techno, Best Album (for LP), Best Dance Track (*In My Mind*) and Best Artist/Group. Eric Gadd (Strawberry Records) was voted Best R&B Artist, Denniz Pop picked up the latest in a string of Best Producer titles, pop trio Drömhus (Arcade/ CNR) were Best Newcomers, and DJ duo C&N Project won Best Remix for their work on the huge Swedish hit *Burning* (performed by Cue). The Best Foreign Dance Artist prize went to Sash! (Scandinavian Records).

The awards, based on votes

from 350 DJs from across the Nordic region, were presented as part of Scandinavia's "Big Bang" dance convention, which took place aboard a cruise ship sailing between Stockholm and Helsinki between April 27-29. Also presented were the Norwegian Dance Music Awards,

in which Two Gees (Orange/Scandinavian) won Best Artist and Clubmasters scooped Best Song for *Give Me Some Horns* (Orange Scandinavian), and the Finnish Dee Jay Awards, where JS 16 won Best Artist and Best Song for *Stomp To My Beat* (Blue Bubble).

Flemish Minister confirms radio deregulation plans

BRUSSELS — Flanders' new radio decree, which will significantly deregulate the territory's radio sector, will be finalised before the summer—and a comprehensive frequency plan for the whole of Belgium will be published on January 1 1999.

The timetable was confirmed by Flemish media minister Eric Van Rompuy in his opening address at the first ever Flemish Radio Forum in Dilbeek on April 22. The event, organised by Flemish public broadcaster VRT and advertising sales house VAR, included nine radio workshops and was attended by some 350 radio professionals.

The new media decree will permit networking for the first time on com-

mercial radio in Flanders, and will also allow stations to broadcast on cable in the region (previously, only foreign stations were given cable access).

In the new frequency plan, drawn up in collaboration with Dutch consultants Broadcast Partners, the number of stations in Flanders will be reduced to between 160-180, compared to the 343 frequencies Flanders was allocated for commercial radio in 1991.

"This diminution will allow for improved listening without interference," promised Van Rompuy, who revealed that the plan will divide the FM dial in Flanders into three sections: public radio up to 102.2 MHz, regional commercial radio between 102.2 and 104.8 MHz, and smaller local commercial stations between

104.8 and 107.9 MHz.

"I think the Minister's address was very positive," says Radio Contact (Flanders) network manager Danny de Bruyn, "and I also believe the Radio Forum has potential to become an annual meeting place for all radio people. I assisted in two workshops and particularly appreciated the session on the new legislation."

Frank Leysen, managing director of commercial CHR network TOP Radio, was equally positive about the Forum, although he suggests that the next event should be more practical in its approach. "The success of this year's Forum paves the way for next year—but I hope they will include more stands in the trade fair section and persuade more companies to join in."

Management buy-out at R2

COPENHAGEN — Denmark's only national commercial radio station, the satellite-delivered Radio 2, has been acquired by its own management—yet is still effectively on the market.

Current Radio 2 managing director Glenn Lau Rentius, who is also the owner of Copenhagen CHR station Radio Uptown, will be the new owner in conjunction with a number of the station's consultants. The station has been bought from majority shareholder Tele Danmark, the Danish Red Cross and TV2 Danmark.

However, Lau Rentius says the arrangements are essentially interim ones—his plan is to sell up to 51 percent of the broadcaster and surrender his control of the company. "Many [investors] are interested [in Radio 2], and we will give them the opportunity to enter this company and form it as they wish," he says.

"We're open to any possibilities, and have been contacted by foreign and domestic investors. I think we have a

great package for a bright investor."

Radio 2 began broadcasting in March 1997, and since then its soft AC format has won 141,000 daily and 400,000 weekly listeners, despite being confined to cable and satellite distribution.

The station, in line with projections, has been losing money, but Lau Rentius says he expects to be in prof-

it "within a year."

Radio 2 has also applied for Denmark's fourth national FM frequency (the present three are all held by public broadcaster Danmarks Radio, which also wants the fourth frequency). "If we get the national frequency, we'll become a very interesting business indeed," predicts Lau Rentius.

Next move sees EMI axe A&R deal

VIENNA — EMI Austria has ended its co-operation agreement with Next Music Department, an agency which acted as a de-facto talent scout for the label.

The two companies linked up in 1996, with Next performing an A&R, marketing and promotion functions for EMI Austria. At the request of Next owners Gitti and Ernie Seuberth, EMI and Next decided not to renew the contract when it expired on April 7. EMI Austria managing director Erich Krapfenbacher says: "Artistic differences led to the end of the co-operation.

EMI Austria marketing manager Horst Unterholzner was chosen to head A&R activities at the label last year, when it was decided to put more emphasis on grooming local talent. According to Krapfenbacher, with Unterholzner in charge of A&R, there was less need to use an outside agency.

Three Next discoveries—dance act Two In One, pop artist Steve Nick, and the electronic duo Shanti Roots—

remain under contract with EMI. Contracts with other artists had already been terminated because, says Krapfenbacher, their first singles failed to meet expectations.

Two in One are the most successful Next discovery to date. The band's second single, *Makeema*, is close to going gold

in Austria, with nearly 25,000 copies sold. Talks are now under way to release the song in Germany, Hungary, Poland and the Czech Republic. The act's debut album, *Now and Forever*, was released in Austria on April 27.

Page and Plant adopt single minded approach to radio

Winning radio support in a CHR-dominated European market is a challenge for any rock act, even if you were the core of one of the biggest rock bands of all time.

That's one of the reasons why Jimmy Page and Robert Plant have broken with their album-oriented past as Led Zeppelin co-founders to endorse radio-friendly single releases. This year sees the 30th anniversary of the founding of Led Zeppelin, but with no major releases planned to mark the event in the wake of last year's *BBC Sessions* compilation (Atlantic), Plant and Page seem to have finally left the "good old days" behind and moved onto new musical pastures.

In contrast to the no-singles strategy enforced during Led Zeppelin's reign over the album charts on both sides of the Atlantic between 1969-1979, Page and Plant have embraced singles as an important tool in the marketing of *Walking Into Clarksdale* (Mercury). Their first full album of new material in almost 15 years, it was released on April 20 and jumped into the Top 10 of M&M's European Top 100 Albums chart at number six last week.

"There's no point in hiding in a corner once you've made a collection of songs," says Plant, "we want it to be heard by people. We're proud of it, we've got egos. I do admire artists who are quite obscure but I wish that people could hear more of them and the only way that could be by

record companies sticking singles out and grabbing people's attention; that's the game."

The album's first single, *Most High*, was released on March 30 and it will be followed up on May 25 by the album opener, *Shining In The Light*. In the U.K., radio support has come from an unexpected quarter: London's alternative station Xfm, probably the last station liable to be swayed by any "classic rock" reputation. Elsewhere in Europe, airplay has ranged from Finland's Radio Mafia, through Studio Brussels and Radio 21 in Belgium, OUI FM in France and, most notably, on to Cadena 100 in Spain, where *Most High* has been playlisted for seven weeks and is currently garnering four plays a day.

Unlike their 1994 album *No Quarter*, which coupled new versions of Zeppelin classics with four new

Page/Plant compositions, there are no remakes on *Walking Into Clarksdale*—but there is a distinct nod to the past. "When we write songs, there's a lot of Led Zeppelin in them because it's the way we interact," explains Plant, who says he wants people to make the link and then look beyond it.

"[Especially] in England, there's sometimes a problem with the idea of artists having been around so long that they've got nothing to offer, even when they're offering diamonds," notes Plant. "[The English press] are saying 'we didn't expect this,' which is great," he continues. "Well, what did they expect—*Kashmir*, *Whole Lotta Love*, *Stairway To Heaven*? How much similarity is there in all those? They're all radically different and this collection of songs is different again."

Page and Plant believe the strength of the songs lies in their quest for a contemporary sound with the help of producer Steve Albini (Bush, Nirvana, The Pixies), drummer Michael Lee and bassist Charlie Jones. "Michael and Charlie's contribution has been really strong—it's a band," says Plant. "As a rhythm section... they bring a real fresh viewpoint to some stuff."

"Thank God we don't have some old fart playing the drums who hasn't heard any drum'n'bass or anything that is around now which helps you shape music for the present, never mind the future. Those guys are really important, as is Albini."

Bragg, Wilco bound for Guthrie

The first "new" Woody Guthrie songs to be heard in almost 40 years are to be unveiled in a collaboration by U.K. singer/songwriter Billy Bragg and U.S. band Wilco next month.

The album *Mermaid Avenue*—named after the street on Coney Island, New York where U.S. folk legend Guthrie lived during the '40s and

1950's—will be released on EastWest in Europe and Atlantic in the U.S. on June 22.

It's the result of a project which began when Bragg was invited by the Guthrie estate to put music to unrecorded lyrics found among the papers of the renowned protest singer who died of Huntington's Chorea in 1967.

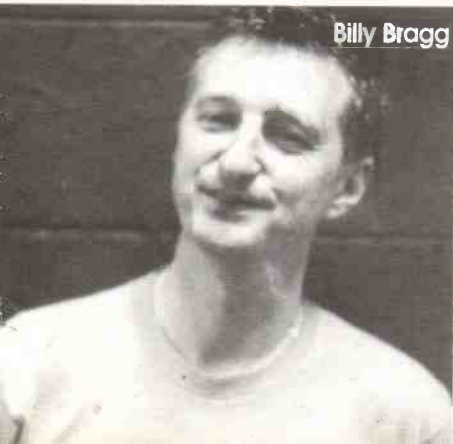
The lyrics were found by Nora Guthrie, Woody's daughter, in dusty boxes in the home of her mother Marjorie. Nora first met Bragg at a concert in New York in 1990 commemorating what would have been Woody's 80th birthday. At the time, she was looking for someone who could set the lyrics to music in the spirit of her father. "The first time I heard Billy I knew he was the one," she says.

"Woody asked [U.S. society] a lot of questions which they still can't answer," comments Bragg. "Maybe it's

easier for an English person born in the 1950s to get a feel for this than an American." Most of the lyrics chosen by Bragg come from the post-1945 era, whereas Guthrie is usually most associated with the depression era of the 1930's in the U.S.

Bragg explains: "I wanted to move it on and set the songs in a music reminiscent of the traditions of the 1940s and early 1950s like R&B and early rock'n'roll." Accordingly, the British singer then approached U.S. country/folk rockers Wilco to collaborate with him on the album.

East West believes that *Mermaid Avenue* could become Bragg's biggest selling album ever, crossing over folk, rock and new country markets as well as appealing to the artist's own loyal following. According to Bragg, a second album of Guthrie songs recorded together with Wilco is likely to be released in the near future.

BUZZING FOUNDATION

After Cornershop, Asian Dub Foundation were always the next most likely U.K.-based Asian crossover stars. On *Buzzing* (ffrr/Delabel), the Foundation's patented blend of guitar, uptempo break-beats and politically-charged but thoughtful wordplay combines with a truly insidious chorus to produce a potential hit with attitude and class. It's already causing a stir in the clubs and if radio goes for it, *Buzzing* could become the soundtrack of the early summer.

WORTH THE WAIT

J Raq's *Waiting For The Bass/Molecule*—on Roni Size's Full Cycle label—is the perfect antidote to the blunted edges of coffee table drum'n'bass. Spiky rhythms which take their time to resolve and earth-shaking bass form the core, while dark, jazz-tinged samples add colour. J Raq's take on drum'n'bass is truly an original one, neither hardstep nor nu-jazz; he makes bold, sensual music that doesn't take itself too seriously.

VERSATILE'S CHARTER

Paris-based Versatile Records, founded by French DJ Gilb R, has just released *5500 A-R*, the new Pepe Bradock EP. Five tracks of sublimely funky downtempo house including *The Charter*, a tune which could have been written by Herbie Hancock in the early 1970's. Bradock's bag is sophisticated, underground hip-house/soul laced with urgent voices, clattering percussion and subtle horn arrangements. Yet more evidence of France's strength in depth.

CLOSE AND KINKY

The Kinky Plant's *Closer* (Premium/Netherlands), with its disco and Giorgio Moroder references and handbag vibe is one to watch this summer. A cheesy but catchy keyboard motif, some well-timed drops and a minimal but memorable vocal contribution add up to a fine party record. There is also a radio edit which might turn *Closer* into a crossover tune.

THE PHANTOM STANDS UP AGAIN

Released May 4 for the second time with new mixes, Phunky Phantom's *Get Up Stand Up* (Distinctive/U.K.) has had more success in the U.S. than Europe—until now.

Why *Get Up Stand Up* (no relation to the Wailers' classic) failed to crossover into the pop charts last summer remains a mystery. However, undeterred by low feedback in '97, Avex's U.K. dance imprint Distinctive serviced the track to U.K. radio last month. Thus far, playlist uptake is healthy, at least on the specialist front. London-based Kiss 100 FM is a big supporter with Brandon Block, Graham Gold and Pete Wardman on the case while BBC Radio 1 DJ's Dave Pearce and Judge Jules have been playing the track on their respective weekly dance shows.

Feedback from regional U.K. stations has also generally been positive, with several putting the track straight on to their A-lists, with others such as Galaxy 105/Bristol and Forth FM/Edinburgh holding back from full commitment until the track crosses over into the pop charts. Outright rejection has been rare for a track with real broad-based appeal.

Norway's jazzers join the dance

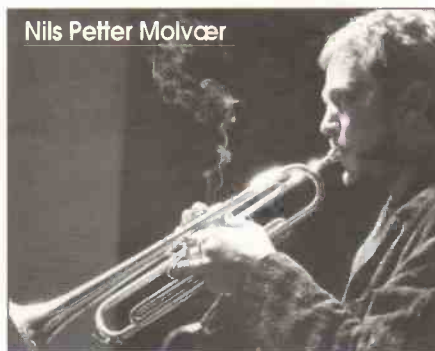
A volatile liaison between big beat and improvised music is beginning to cause ripples across Europe.

Dance-oriented material by Norwegian artists on established German label ECM and recently launched, Oslo-based imprint Jazzland is making its mark on the vibrant Norwegian jazz scene.

Norway has produced renowned jazz musicians like Jan Garbarek and Terje Rypdal in the past. Now Norwegian jazz musicians such as Nils Petter Molvær (ECM), Audun Kleive, Bugge Wesseltoft, and Eivind Aarset—all signed to Jazzland/PolyGram—are aiming to attract a younger audience by adding dance rhythms, techno, drum'n'bass and other related styles to their music.

"Norway belongs to the top three jazz markets in Europe [along with France and Austria]," remarks PolyGram International VP international marketing/jazz Wulf Müller on the international impact of the country's local jazz scene. With their new style, Norwegian artists have created "music for a younger generation," adds Müller. "You can dance to it or play it at home."

Wesseltoft is one of the driving forces behind the new musical style. Along with his work as a musician and composer, he owns and operates the Jazzland label—licensed to PolyGram Norway for the world. Currently operating from Wesseltoft's recording studio, Jazzland plans to open a larger office in Oslo on June 1 to co-ordinate promotion, marketing and international exploitation. PolyGram Norway international exploitation manager Yngve Næss, will be assisting the label in setting up a five-year busi-

ness plan.

Exports to other European territories are a firm priority for Norway's jazz artists; Germany, France and Italy are the key markets for big beat jazz from Norway, according to Næss. Jazzland's marketing abroad is co-ordinated locally by Christian Kellersmann

at PolyGram's Motor Music division in Germany, by Patrick Votan at Verve France and by Patrizio Romano at Verve Italy.

Looking further afield, Næss also sees future export potential in Japan. "[Japanese audiences] are used to the slick jazz of people like Lee Ritenour, but among young people there's also a market for different types of jazz."

ECM-signed Molvær earned the Norwegian Spellemannpris music award in March for his album *Khmer*, released last September and which has sold 6,000 copies in Norway to date, according to ECM—roughly double the average domestic sales for a major jazz release.

A separate four-track EP containing remixes by U.K. dance producers The Herbaliser and Rockers Hi-Fi was released at the same time as *Khmer* and found its "relevant audience", according to ECM Norway product manager Rune Kristoffersen. "[The project] could have easily fallen between the two chairs [of dance and jazz]," adds Kristoffersen "but [in the end] we sold more than we expected."

It remains to be seen whether Molvær, Wesseltoft, Aarset and their collaborators can come up with a breakthrough single with real hit potential, but in the meantime, Norway's jazz elite is producing some fine music for those in the know.

U.K. radio walks with the Woodys

Depending on your frame of reference, a woody is a half-timbered motor vehicle for taking your surfboard down to the beach, an insanely chirpy member of the Bay City Rollers or something best not discussed in polite company. Well, not for much longer, because there's a new Woody in town—or, to be more precise, a pair of them.

Michael and Dyann Woody are a Colorado-raised, Nashville-based, husband and wife duo whose debut album is causing a stir in roots circles—and picking up some handsome airplay on the way. The 12 tracks on *The Woodys* (Rounder) blend refreshing originals like *A Hundred Years Of Solitude* and *Alabama Shine* with astute covers of Gretchen Peters' *High Lonesome* and the Everly Brothers' *Like Strangers*.

"What we tried to do," explains Michael Woody, "is to give a whole picture of the Woodys, and if I didn't have a song myself for a particular mood, I went looking for one that did."

Joining the pair on record are country names such as Albert Lee and Emmylou Harris. The latter's presence—along with a co-writing credit for Chris Hillman, places *The Woodys* at the front of a line which stretches back through country rock in the '70s to the Byrds and Flying Burrito Brothers. It was hearing those bands that made Michael realise that: "Here was a voice that I could relate to, a type of music that spoke to me. I'd listened to

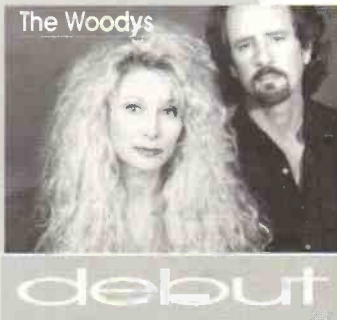
country music as a little kid, but then I'd gone more into rock, and it was those bands that brought me back."

With country related acts making an increasing impact in Europe, it could be that the Woodys have arrived at just the right time. Certainly radio and TV programmers in the U.K.—where the album has been handled by independent press/plugging outfit Frontier Promotions—seem to think so.

The band have enjoyed a two month stint on the playlist of national AC-leaning MOR network Radio 2 with the album's lead track, *Mama And Them*. Radio 2 head of music Geoff Mullin describes the track as "a great piece of up-tempo country," adding: "Our listeners love it."

The Woodys have also enjoyed significant support from stations in Scotland—notably BBC Scotland, Radio Clyde/Glasgow and Scot FM—and RTL Country1035/London. A live session for VH-1 is also in the pipeline.

European concert dates are on the horizon in the summer, although the recent cancellation of Hal Ketchum's tour, on which the Woodys were to support has pushed those plans back.

Sony chases EMI across European charts

LONDON — EMI's dominance of Europe's charts throughout 1997 was strongly challenged by Sony Music during the first quarter of 1998. However, the U.K. group remains the leading company in Music & Media's quarterly analysis of the European Top 100 albums chart.

During the first quarter of 1998, EMI maintained its lead with a 23.6 percent share of album sales as measured on the charts, up from 21.4 percent during the same period of 1997. Sony Music emerges as a close second with a 23.1 percent share, up from the first quarter of 1997's third position, achieved on an 18.1 percent share.

Sony scored with the top two leading albums of the quarter, Celine Dion's *Let's Talk About Love* and

James Horner's *Titanic* soundtrack—which incidentally also helps Sony Classical become the 4th most successful label overall, with a 5.9 percent share. Dion's staying power pushed Columbia to the top label spot in the album chart share table.

Once again Virgin, scoring with the Spice Girls, The Verve and Janet Jackson, was crucial in helping EMI grab the albums crown. PolyGram dropped from second to third place in the album charts share, while Warner Music, despite fresh releases from

Madonna and Eric Clapton, lost album share, slipping from a 1997 first quarter figure of 12.4 percent to 10.6 percent in 1998.

In the singles charts, BMG lost the top slot to PolyGram, and has also been overhauled by Sony Music and EMI; the German company has now dropped back to fourth place. Universal, with an 8.0 percent share buoyed by Aqua's sin-

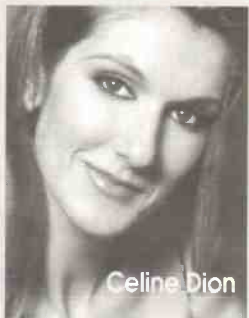
gles *Barbie Girl* and *Doctor Jones*, moved into fifth place, ahead of Warner Music.

Overall, "girl power" seemed to dominate the upper echelons of Europe's charts, thanks to a string of successful albums and singles from Celine Dion, Natalie Imbruglia, Janet Jackson, All Saints, Madonna and the Spice Girls.

The charts compilation figures are published by Music & Media on a quarterly basis. The percentages are based on cumulative chart points collected by artists' and label's charted products during the period surveyed. The M&M Eurochart Hot 100 Singles and European Top 100 Albums listings are compiled from the national sales charts of 18 European countries.

Drum'n'bass duo 4 Hero have become a household name in their niche market, respected for their creativity and attitude. They also produce rather fine music which should endear them to an audience who like a bit of jazz and soul. Having established a successful blueprint for marketing "jazzy" drum'n'bass with Roni Size/Reprazent's *New Forms* last year, Talkin' Loud has a four step

plan for promoting *Two Pages*. On June 29, the label will release a two-CD album for hardcore drum'n'bass fans. One CD features jazz and classical influenced tracks, with the act's harder material showcased on the second disc. The first single from the album will follow on July 13; the title has yet to be confirmed, but the timing is aimed at exploiting press coverage of the album to convince radio programmers that there is enough public interest to play the single outside the usual specialist programmes. As a third step, 4 Hero are scheduled to play with a full band—including saxophone, double bass and four extra vocalists—at this year's Montreux Jazz Festival on July 16. With mainstream media coverage from Mon-

treux, Talkin' Loud will then release a single CD version of *Two Pages*, targeting curious punters with a mix of 80 percent jazzy material and 20 percent of 4 Hero's more "underground" sounds.

MONSTER MAGNET POWERTRIP

International release date: June 1

Looks like a good summer for hard rock this year. First, Led Zep survivors Page and Plant shove their *Walking Into Clarksville* album into the charts (and up many critics' nostrils...), now former grunge rockers Monster Magnet are set to unleash the unabashedly commercial *Powertrip*. Decidedly younger than messrs. Page and Plant, the quintet led by songwriter/guitarist and singer Dave Wyndorf plays the kind of rock that could also appeal to hip-hop heads and big beat junkies. Dope beats plus big guitars and lines like "I'm never gonna work another day in my life" are dead on target for the blunt generation. With this, their fourth album, the boys from Red Bank, New Jersey, seem to have hit the zeitgeist bang on. First single *Space Lord*—released on May 4—was mixed by Metallica's studio wizard Randy Staub; it boasts a mighty fine groove and enough attitude to turn a few heads.

With the second single to be taken from their outstanding debut album *Moon Safari*, these two Frenchmen are out to prove that they are much more than one-hit wonders. This breezy tune also emphasises their versatility—with its psychedelic overtones, it certainly differs considerably from its successful predecessor, *Sexy Boy*. What both tracks do have in common, however, is the combination of a classic pop sensibility with distinctly unorthodox ideas. According to Marc Coenen, one of the programmers at Belgian public rock/alternative network Studio Brussel/Brussels, "It's an excellent record, which is greatly appreciated by our audience." Coenen continues: "In general, the new generation of French dance artists such as Pills, Daft Punk and these fellows have gained widespread acceptance by a wider audience (than previously), and it is good to see that the same trend is developing in other countries as well." He concludes: "We have been playing *Kelly Watch The Stars* as an album track for quite some time, and we playlisted the single as soon as it went into promotion (April 20). For the time being, we are playing the track 10-15 times in all dayparts."

On the air

M&M's weekly airplay analysis column

It's a good week up top for acts from down under...

This week, RCA's antipodean songstress Natalie Imbruglia achieves the rare distinction of having three singles on M&M's European Radio Top 50.

After almost six months on the chart, her anthemic debut *Torn* is hanging in there at 32; the song has been picking up plays in Hungary, and it's still getting airplay as a recurrent in other territories. The follow-up to that record, *Big Mistake*, is sitting pretty at 23, thanks to airplay in Belgium, Italy, Switzerland and Poland.

Now, we welcome the third single from Imbruglia's million-selling album *Left Of The Middle*, the catchy *Wishing I Was There*, which enters at 44. That track is currently hot on radio in the United Kingdom and in Germany.

One of the first continental European stations to play *Torn*—in November last year—was Radio Stockholm in Sweden. Robert Sehlberg, music director at the CHR outlet, remembers: "The first time I heard the record, I liked it and I thought it would be a big hit." Having picked up on the track early, the station subsequently broadcast an interview with Imbruglia on their lunchtime show.

Sehlberg's feeling about the track proved right, because *Torn* went on to become a Swedish No.1 for several weeks at the beginning of this year. In January, Sehlberg declared *Left Of The Middle* Album Of The Week. Currently the station is playing *Big Mistake*, although he adds: "The album track *Leave Me Alone* would also be a good choice for a single."

Meanwhile, at the top of the list, there's more good news for Australian artists: Savage Garden's *Truly, Madly, Deeply* (Columbia) finally hits the summit. That's an impressive feat for a record in its 15th week on the chart. *I Want You*, the first single from the duo's debut album, reached number 4 last June; the follow-up, *To The Moon And Back*, reached number 30 in October. However, the distance in chart points between *Truly, Madly, Deeply* and Simply Red's *Say You Love Me* (East West) is so small, Savage Garden's tenure of the top slot is likely to be a short one.

The number of recent bank holidays across Europe is undoubtedly a contributory factor in this week's chart remaining fairly static. The only other new entry is *Heaven's What I Feel* (Epic) by Gloria Estefan at 49. The record had early support in Italy and Switzerland, and is now starting to gain airplay in Germany. *Cleopatra's Theme* by Cleopatra (WEA) re-enters at 41, due to continuing interest in Belgium, France and Italy. In their home country the U.K. however, their new single *Life Ain't Easy* is already picking up plays. The outlook for that single is pretty good, as the video is on rotation with music TV channels across Europe.

Attractions for the coming weeks include *My All* by Mariah Carey (Columbia), *Turn Back Time* by Aqua (Universal), *Stranded* by Lutricia McNeal (Siljemark/CNR) and finally the reworking of Ronnie Lane's Faces classic, *Ooh La La* by Rod Stewart (Warner).

Columbia launches German satellites

FRANKFURT — In its search for more local talent, Sony Music Germany's Columbia division has de-centralised its A&R operations and hired three new talent scouts.

Berlin and Munich are the first two A&R outposts in Columbia's new network of "creative satellites." Former BMG Hansa A&R manager Hannes Kraus will run the Berlin operations, and producer Levent Karahan has

been appointed A&R scout in Munich. Columbia managing director Martin Brem hopes to establish a third satellite in Hamburg soon. "Germany has many musical hotspots," says Brem. "We want to establish a Columbia presence in all major local scenes to create the right environment for successful domestic A&R."

To monitor trends outside the country's main urban centres, Columbia has also appointed Tobias Schacht, who will work entirely "on the road" in an A&R

role, searching for new talent at live venues and studios across Germany.

Columbia's main A&R office remains in Frankfurt, staffed by Evelyn Junker and Jeanette Holly, although the label is planning to appoint a third Frankfurt-based A&R manager in the near future. Together with A&R consultant Michael Golla in Cologne, Columbia will have a total of eight A&R executives in five locations across Germany by the end of the year.

Capital on expansion trail

Combined, the two stations have 25.4 percent local market share. Day-to-day management of Red Dragon Radio will be handled by Sally Oldham, Capital's MD of group radio.

The Red Dragon move came six days after Capital announced its intention to take a 90 percent controlling stake in Xfm for £15.9 million (\$25.8 million). Chris Parry, MD of Xfm and of Fiction Records, will retain the remaining stake and stay—for the foreseeable future—at the station. The deal is subject to approval by U.K. regulator the Radio Authority and the government's Office of Fair Trading. The acquisition of Xfm would give Capital one AM and two FM licences in London.

Capital says its first priority for Xfm, launched last September, will be to raise its profile. "Marketing is the first thing to be attended to," says Park, adding, "Going on air at the time they did [the day after the death of Diana, Princess of Wales], the station really did not have a launch." He contends that the present format/music output of the station is capable of building audiences, despite a market share of just 0.6 percent in the latest RAJAR ratings.

"There is nothing wrong with the music they play, or Chris Parry's vision of the station," says Park. "[However] we have to look at the way it is packaged and presented." One of Capital's goals is to double Xfm's current weekly reach to about 500,000 listeners.

"This [deal] is very important for the group," adds Park. "We have this dream of serving radio audiences from cradle to grave, with our pro-

posed Fun Radio service [for the currently-advertised north east of England licence] targeting 4-15 year-olds, plus what we currently have with our CHR and gold services."

The announcement that Capital was taking over Xfm was bitterly received at NRJ's headquarters in Paris. The French radio group was among the companies which unsuccessfully bid for the licence which Xfm won.

An NRJ source described as "a disgrace" the fact that the station has changed hands "after just a few months in operation." The source adds: "It also proves the point that London doesn't need an alternative station, because

That She Wants (Mega) by Swedish act Ace of Base, which clocked up 55 weeks on the Eurochart in October 1993.

Cameroon-born French resident Wes spoke to M&M at the World Music Awards in Monaco (May 6). "Honestly, I didn't expect such a success," he admits. The fact that a song sung in his native Bantu dialect has found fans across Europe is, says Wes, "a symbol of a new era where music is the only remaining common language on Earth."

Reflecting on the success, Columbia France managing director Olivier Montfort suggests: "First you need a success in your own country, and then you look at the territories that are most likely to be interested. In our case it was Belgium, which opened the doors to the Netherlands and then Germany."

TV was a key factor in the impact of *Alane*. It was the official "summer song"

most of this ground is already covered by other stations such as BBC Radio 1 and Kiss FM. "Meanwhile, some radio executives are calling for changes in U.K. broadcasting legislation which would prevent new stations from being sold within months of their launch.

At the recent Radio Academy Music Radio conference, Gordon McNamee, former MD of London dance station Kiss 100 FM, called for legislation banning changes of ownership for stations within three years of their launch. He claimed that new stations bought up by established radio groups were in danger of "losing their creativity and individuality," and risked becoming part of a homogenised radio landscape.

of French TV station TF1 last year, and a performance on German TV show *Wetten Dass* was instrumental in breaking it in Germany. Radio showed strong interest in *Alane* from the start, and the single benefited from a tie-in campaign with CLT-UFA owned French networks RTL (full-service) and Fun Radio (CHR) last summer.

Wes attributes part of his success to current electronic media: "Everything goes at such a fast speed. I can say I really benefited from this situation—I come from a small village of 12 houses and now I am part of the global village. It's quite amusing."

Comments Sony Music Entertainment Europe president Paul Russell: "Wes has an incredibly upbeat and happy personality. One of the key reasons for his success is that he is not trying to be something that he is not."

Germany or Sweden which are not signed for France, or vice versa," notes Sabot. "With this label, we could sign licensing deals for such products. We don't use our international network enough—hopefully this label will operate in all the territories where NRJ operates radio stations."

The French radio giant is following in the footsteps of the U.K.'s Capital Radio group, which last year set up the Wildstar label, to which Conner Reeves and Lutricia McNeal are signed.

Since the late '80s in France, TV channels such as TF1 and M6 have set up music production operations, and have used their airtime to promote their own productions. They have also pushed products on behalf of other

record labels in return for royalty cuts.

NRJ managing director Alain Weill says the idea of a label was inspired by the TV situation. "I don't see why, when we programme an act produced or co-produced by a TV channel, they make money and not us," he says.

But unlike the TV stations, NRJ says it will not exchange airtime advertising in return for royalty cuts for products originating from other labels. "If we find an interesting title, we will simply sign it to our label or co-exploit it [with the original record company]. Then, we'll play it," says Sabot.

Sabot says he is aware of the risks of the venture: "We don't want to be a substitute for record companies—we do not have the structure to do that job

and to develop new acts. Above all, we don't want to establish a 'pay for play' system, because it would be suicidal."

However, established labels are concerned by the prospect of a leading commercial radio network, with all its promotional power, entering the music production field. Jérôme Roger, general manager of French independent labels organisation UPFI, says the issue will certainly be raised by his members.

"It brings a new dimension to the ongoing problem of separating the business of broadcasting and of music production," says Roger. "Some of our members are in favour of a strict separation between the two businesses, and this issue has already been raised with regard to labels set up by TV channels."

cial award will be given to an artist who will then act as a spokesperson for the International Federation of the Phonographic Industry (IFPI) on artist-related issues over the next 12 months.

Among the artists confirmed to collect their Platinum Europe awards in person on July 9 are M People, Joe Cocker and Italian pop singer Nek. The show's producer, Lisa Anderson, says: "The main differences from the first Platinum Europe ceremony in 1996 are the integration of live performances into the event and generally enhanced production."

Sony Music Entertainment Europe president and Platinum Europe committee chairman Paul Russell is convinced that the second awards show will have "a bigger impact than the first one." He adds: "We are extremely pleased that Santer agreed to join us again this year."

According to Russell, IFPI and the European music industry have two main goals for the event: to make policy makers in Brussels aware of the industry's needs; and to give the European industry a sense of its own importance. "What we are trying to say to European artists is that a Platinum Europe award equals the same accolade as in the U.S.," says the Sony president.

The July 9 ceremony will be commemorated in a special brochure to be published in cooperation with Music & Media the week following the event. Says Russell: "Both Music & Media and Billboard have been extremely supportive of the event since the beginning. I am grateful for this support and I am glad that we can continue this partnership."

The wide range of domestic talent currently finding success across Europe is mirrored in IFPI's list of first-time platinum winners for April. Nek receives an award for his album *Lei Gli Amici E Tutto* (WEA), German rock band Rammstein for *Sehnsucht* (Motor) and Dutch MOR artist André Rieu for *Wiener Melange* (Polydor).

Other albums qualifying for their first Platinum Europe award in April were *Back For Good* (BMG Hansa) by Modern Talking, *Life Thru A Lens* (Chrysalis) by Robbie Williams, *Ultra* (Mute) by Depeche Mode and Eric Clapton's *Pilgrim* (Reprise).

MTV, VPL settle

LONDON — MTV Europe and U.K. collecting society Video Performance Limited (VPL) have settled their six-year legal dispute.

In June 1992, MTV claimed that VPL—which licences the broadcast of music videos—was an illegal cartel abusing a dominant market position. The music TV broadcaster began parallel actions in the U.K.'s High Court and through a complaint to the European Commission; the actions cited both VPL and the major labels (as represented by the IFPI). Both actions have now been dropped; terms of the settlement were undisclosed.

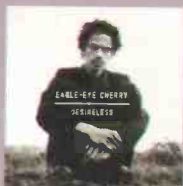

Off the record

Reconstruction time: as OTR was going to press, it was learned that BMG U.K. has acquired the 25 percent of **Dedicated Records** (home to **Spiritualized**, **Silkscreen** and **Mulu**) which it did not previously own from MD **Doug D'Arcy**. The move (M&M, March 21), sees Dedicated's three London-based staff switch to BMG, whose dance imprint **Deconstruction** is now handling marketing of the Dedicated roster. D'Arcy is no longer associated with the label he founded seven years ago.

Philips shares rose 12 percent on the Amsterdam and New York stock exchanges on May 6, after the company issued a statement announcing that it would embrace "any strategic option to maximise [the] value to shareholders" of its 75 percent stake in **PolyGram**. The statement re-fuelled persistent rumours that Philips is interested in selling off PolyGram to concentrate on its core electronics business.

A head-hunter has been appointed to find a replacement for **SACEM** president **Jean-Loup Tournier**, who will celebrate his 50th year at the French author's rights society in 2000. Sources say the body will consider looking internally and outside SACEM for Tournier's successor. Tournier himself plans to stay at the reins until 2000, to see SACEM celebrate its 150th anniversary.

East West Germany financial controller **Susanne Jahr-Seitz** has been appointed to the position of chief financial controller at **Warner Music Germany** in addition to her tasks at East West. Jahr-Seitz takes the post vacated by **Helmar Escher**, currently MD of **Warner Music Poland**, and will report directly to Warner Music president Central Europe **Gerd Gebhardt**.

OTR hears that London dance station **Kiss 100 FM** has renewed its partnership with **PolyGram Records U.K.** to release compilation albums covering various dance music genres. The three-year deal, understood to be at least £6 million, involves releasing at least five albums a year. The relationship between broadcaster and label began in 1994, with total sales to date of over 1.5 million units.

Current **Vive La Radio** president **Eric Baptiste**, whose departure from Paris news/sports station **95.2** was recently announced, is believed to be leaving the radio sector altogether. He is tipped to become general secretary of international federation of authors' rights societies **CISAC**, replacing **Jean-Alexis Ziegler** in January 1999. Baptiste is expected to relinquish all activities at **Vive La Radio** by the end of the year.

Satellite/cable TV news channel **CNN's** new music show **World Beat**—scheduled to be launched on June 6—will contain a special European segment called **Flipside**. The five minute contribution to CNN's 30-minute programme will be produced in London by **Jill Sinclair** and will be hosted by U.K.-based **BBC Radio 2** presenter **Steve Wright**.

Two days before the German release of her new single **Immortality** (**Columbia**), **Celine Dion** will premier the song on TV show **Geld Oder Liebe**. The **ARD** network programme will feature a live performance by Dion with the **Bee Gees**, writers of **Immortality**. Dion's **Let's Talk About Love** album (**Columbia/Epic**) has sold over seven million copies across Europe to date.

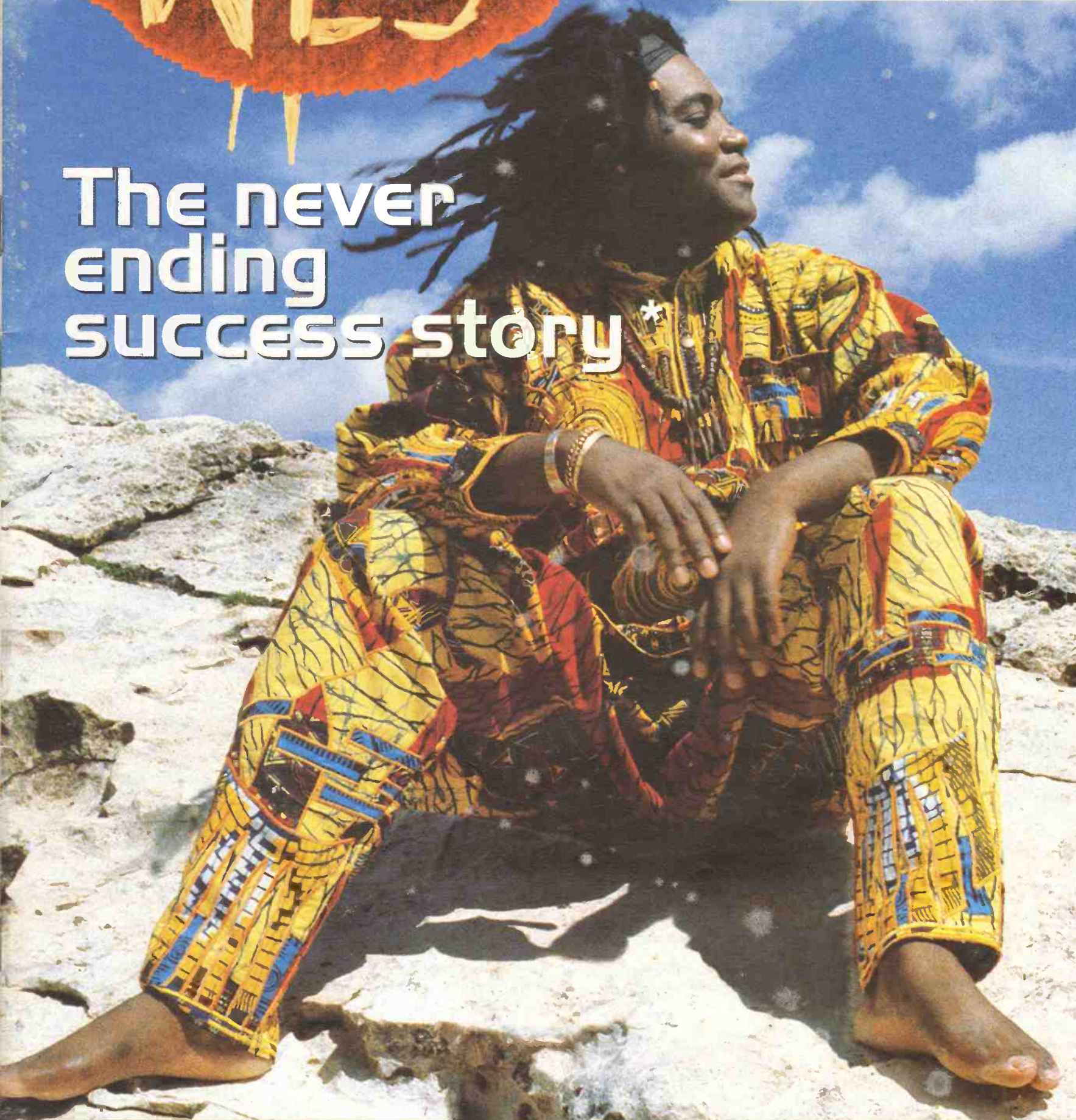
